**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2**

Series of 2009

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL PUBLIC UTILITIES OPERATING OR DOING BUSINESS IN BACOOR TO SECURE A PERMIT TO OPERATE FROM THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 447 of Republic Act No. 7160 (otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991"), every Local Government Unit has the power to regulate all businesses and professions being conducted within the respective territorial jurisdictions of the said local government units including public utilities.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, during regular session assembled, upon motion of Councilor Avelino B. Solis be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan that:

**Section 1. Short Title--** This ordinance shall also be known as the "Public Utilities Regulation Ordinance of Bacoor".

**Section 2. Scope/Coverage--** All public utilities doing business, operating, or maintaining an office within the territorial jurisdiction of Bacoor, Cavite shall be covered by this Ordinance.

**Section 3. Doing business, defined--** A public utility, under this Ordinance, is deemed to be doing business within Bacoor if it engages in any commercial, construction, or maintenance activity within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality.


**Section 4. Permit to Operate--** All public utilities within the ambit of this Ordinance shall be required to secure a Permit to Operate on or before the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January of every year following the approval of this Ordinance. A fee of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP 50,000.00) shall be paid by the public utility concerned in order to obtain a Permit to Operate. The said permit shall be issued by the Office of the Municipal Engineer after payment of the above-mentioned fee subject to the Implementing Rules and Guidelines to be prepared by the Office of the Municipal Mayor after the approval of this Ordinance.



Section 5. **Penalties--** A public utility that fails to obtain a Permit to Operate within the period to do so shall be required to pay a fine of **Two Thousand Pesos (PhP 2,000.00)** for every day that it operates without a Permit to Operate. *Provided:* that if the offending public utility fails to obtain a Permit to Operate within thirty (30) days from the day it was first declared by the Office of the Municipal Engineer to be operating without the required Permit to Operate, its business permit shall be cancelled and/or revoked by the Municipal Mayor. *Provided, lastly,* that the Municipal Mayor or his duly appointed representative must first notify the offending public utility in writing of its violation of this Ordinance and the subsequent cancellation/revocation of its business permit at least five (5) days prior to the cancellation/revocation of the said permit.

Section 6. **Separability Clause--** Any provision of this Ordinance found void by a court of competent jurisdiction shall not affect the rest of this Ordinance not affected by the said judicial finding of invalidity.

Section 7. **Effectivity --** This Ordinance shall take effect within fifteen (15) days after it has been posted in at least two (2) conspicuous places within the Municipality of Bacoor, Cavite.

Section 8. **Repealing Clause --** Any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed and/or modified.


