**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 8**  
Series of 2011

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE OWNERS OF ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING IN BACOOR, CAVITE TO BECOME A MEMBER OF A DULY-ACCREDITED BUSINESS ASSOCIATION OR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AS A PREREQUISITE FOR QUALIFICATION AS RECIPIENT OF ANY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of the municipal government to give all business establishments every opportunity to realize a profit and become successful commercial enterprises.

**WHEREAS**, the municipal government also has a standing policy of providing financial grants, subject to strict compliance with pertinent laws and regulations and the availability of funds, to various non-government organizations which may include business groups.

**WHEREAS**, requiring the owners of all business establishments operating in the municipality to become members of a business association or chamber of commerce duly-accredited by the municipal government will help the said aggregations combat cutthroat competition among its members thereby ensuring the economic viability of all businesses within the municipality.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, upon motion of Councilor Bayani M. De Leon and unanimously seconded by all the members present of the Sangguniang Bayan in regular session assembled **BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** that:

Sec. 1. *Title.*— This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Chamber of Commerce Registration Ordinance of Bacoor**”.

Sec. 2. *Regulation.*— All business establishments operating within Bacoor, Cavite regardless of its nature are required to become a member of a chamber of commerce or business association duly-accredited by the municipal government for it to qualify as a recipient of any financial grant from the municipal government subject to strict compliance with pertinent laws and regulations and the availability of funds.

Sec. 3. *Period of Compliance.*— All business establishments covered by this Ordinance shall be given sixty (60) days from the date of effectivity hereof within which to comply herewith.

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Sec. 4. *Guidelines and Implementation.*-- The implementing rules and guidelines of this Ordinance shall be drafted by the Office of the Municipal Mayor. The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) of the municipality shall implement this Ordinance.

Sec. 5. *Incentives.*-- Aside from qualifying as a recipient of financial grants, members of the accredited business aggregations may also qualify for any incentive that the municipal government may grant by virtue of an ordinance.

Sec. 6. *Repeal.*-- All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, or guidelines in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and/or revised.

Sec. 7. *Effectivity.*-- This Ordinance shall take effect within fifteen days after its approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.

Sec. 8. *Separability.*-- Any provision of this Ordinance found void by a court of competent jurisdiction shall not affect the rest of this Ordinance not affected by the said judicial finding of invalidity.
