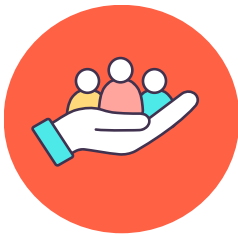

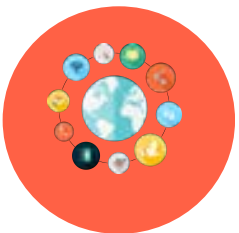

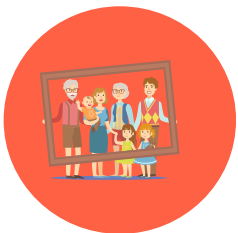

By closely monitoring international news articles on a mysterious, still unknown virus affecting hundreds in various countries during the last two months of 2019, the 4th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor made the following legislative measures that proved decisive in the manner by which the city government faced the threat of COVID-19:



## **11/10/19: Zoom Training**

### ***Begins***

The City Council members and selected SP Secretariat staff began training on how to use the Zoom videoconferencing app; Work-from-home rules formulated by the SP Secretary for review of the Vice Mayor



## **12/5/19: OnlineWork Library**

### **Resolution Approved**

City Resolution 2019-138 was passed allowing the City Council and its personnel to use the SP website in posting approved legislation and to work online



## **1/12/20: Taal Volcano**

### **Erupts**

The Sangguniang Panlungsod approved City Resolution No. 2020-146 on 14 January 2020 authorizing the grant of Php1.5M assistance to victims of the Taal Volcano eruption



## **2/13/20: Bacoor Quarantine**

### **Ordinance Approved**

City Ordinance No.61-2021 was approved— roughly a month before President Duterte ordered the lockdown of Metro Manila

**1. Short Title**

This Ordinance shall be cited as the “2020 Quarantine Ordinance of the City of Bacoor”.



















**2. Scope and Applicability of Ordinance**

In this Ordinance, quarantine shall be understood as having relation to measures for the inspection, exclusion, detention, observation, segregation, isolation, protection, treatment, sanitary regulation and/or disinfection of vessels, motor vehicles, domiciles, rooms, business establishments, public areas, persons, animals, goods and things and having as their object the prevention of the introduction or spread of diseases or pests affecting man, other animals, or plants necessary for the production of food. The provisions of this Ordinance shall only be applicable within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor as defined in Section 6 of Republic Act No. 101060 (also known as the “Charter of the City of Bacoor”) and shall be implemented in coordination with the Department of Health (DOH), the Bureau of

### A. 2012 Legislative Archives and Records Office (LARO) creation

The creation of the LARO through **City Ordinance No. 38-2012** paved the way to the launching of a number of innovations that helped the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor function more efficiently, swiftly, and effectively.

Among the projects borne out of the LARO initiative was the creation of the SP website, the digitization of the official records of the city council, the paperless deliberation program and other projects that are still being implemented to this day.

With the planned construction of an **Archives Building** and a new **City Library** under the Sangguniang Panlungsod, it is expected that the effectiveness of the LARO will become more evident in the years to come.



### B. The Digitization of SP Records

In December 2012, about a month after the creation of the LARO, the Sangguniang Panlungsod began digitizing all of its records. A team of SP personnel were trained, mobilized, and supervised by the SP Secretary with the task of scanning the voluminous records of the City Council for their eventual uploading into the **Sanggunian Information System (SIS)**. One year later, the task was completed and the next big idea was born: the **development of the Sangguniang Panlungsod Website**.

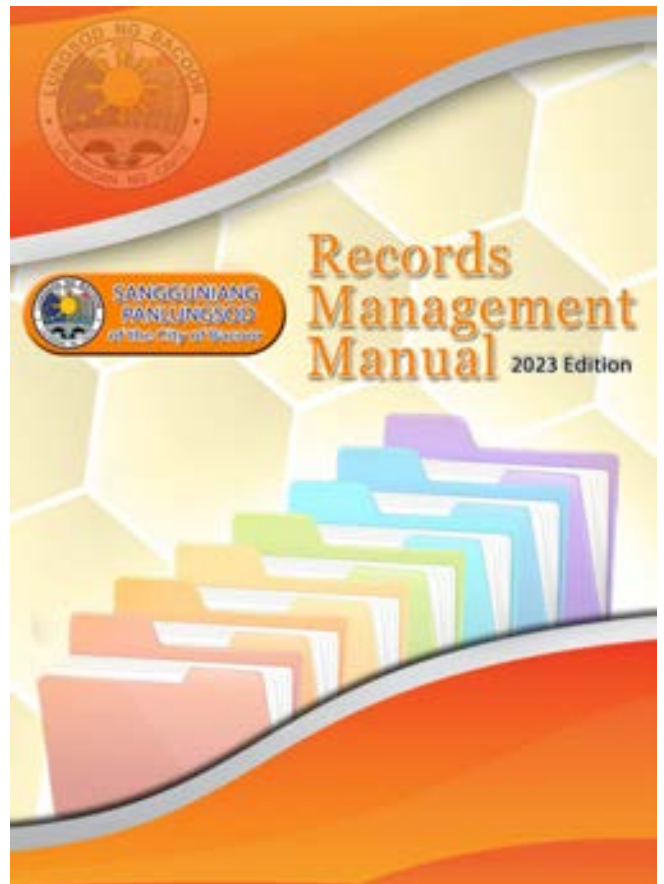
## **C. The Paperless Deliberation Project**

First conceived in 2008 by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bacoor, this trailblazing project was borne out of a desire to reduce the operational cost of legislation. Before the launch of this project, each member of the Municipal Council used to read reams of paper printouts containing the various matters for deliberation for a particular week. A month after the launch of this project, the expenses of the Municipal Council for the purchase of paper was cut in half.

Due to the effectiveness of this project, it is still being implemented by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor and the money being saved by the Council is being used for other projects.

## **D. The Records Management Manual**

First launched in 2012, the Records Management Manual of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor guides every employee of the City Council and of the Office of the Vice Mayor on how to properly mark, index, digitize, store, and organize hard, electronic, and digital copies of various official records. Now in the process of being revised (see proposed cover of the 2023 edition of the Revised Records Management Manual on the right), the Records Management Manual enabled the City Council to take a huge technological leap which led to the development of the Sangguniang Panlungsod Website.

### E. The Sangguniang Panlungsod Website Project

This project was first conceived in 2012 by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Secretary of Bacoor while the various records of the City Council were being digitized for their eventual uploading into the Sanggunian Information System (SIS). Beginning in 2013, two attempts were made to develop the said website involving outside consultants and some selected SP employees. Both attempts ended in failure. Luckily, payment to the said consultants were results based and since they failed to deliver the desired outcome — none of them were paid by the city government.

In 2017, the Sangguniang Panlungsod Secretary led another effort to develop the SP Website with the assistance of a newly-hired employee of the City Council by the name of Mr. Wally Gonzales. This time, all their efforts paid off. In

**September 25, 2018**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod Website ([www.bacoorcitysp.com](http://www.bacoorcitysp.com)) was officially launched.

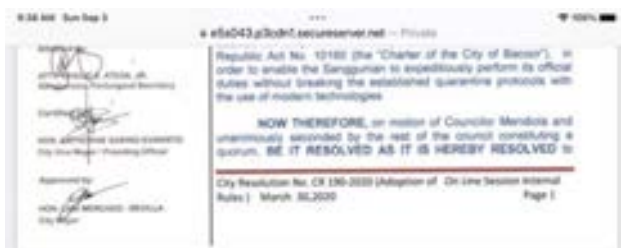
Updated every week, the SP Website contains all the ordinances and resolutions passed by the Sanggunian since 1996. It also contains the reports and notice of hearings of standing committees, and the schedule/venue of hearings.

The website also allows the public to submit their proposed pieces of legislation (**the Internal Rules of SP of Bacoor allow anyone to submit/author proposed ordinances/resolutions**), answer online surveys on pending legislation, and submit complaints or suggestions to city councilors through its “MAY REKLAMO?” and “TINIG NG BAYAN” pages.

### F. The E-Sessions Project

This project was launched out of sheer necessity brought about by the expected hardships to be caused upon the public by the then nascent COVID-19 virus. Eighteen days after President Duterte ordered the lockdown of Metro Manila, the Sangguniang Panlungsod passed **City Resolution No. 2020-190** adopting the Revised Internal Rules of the 4th Sangguniang Panlungsod authorizing the conduct of online sessions during a public health emergency, the existence of a state of calamity, or the existence of a national emergency.

The said resolution aims to ensure that the Sanggunian shall be able to fulfill its duties even during emergencies, safeguard the safety of Sanggunian members and employees as well as that of resource persons who might be invited to attend hearings of the standing committees of the Sanggunian.

Thanks to this innovation, the Sanggunian was able to hold 166 online sessions during the pandemic that led to the approval of 116 ordinances and 435 resolutions while minimizing the exposure of the public, SP members, and SP employees to COVID-19.

Due to the success of the said project, the Sangguniang Panlungsod decided to retain the said policy so that it can conduct **hybrid sessions** (sessions where some members attend online while other council members are at the Session Hall) or online sessions whenever the need to do so arises.

### G. The Records Room Modernization Project

This project began with the construction of a new Records Room and Records Section at the **Bacoor Legislative and Disaster Resilience Building (BLDR Bldg)** near the Bacoor City Hall in Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite. Located on the 4th floor of the BLDR Bldg, the Records Room has an area of 36 square meters while the adjoining Records Section has a floor space of 30 square meters.

The Records Room is climate controlled and is equipped with a digital smart lock and two all-weather, high resolution CCTV cameras to protect the integrity of all official SP Records. Two Records Officer who attend regular seminars on records management are permanently assigned to the Records Section. Aside from the Records Officer, only the SP Secretary and the Supervising Administrative Officer of the Sanggunian are allowed to enter the Records Room.

In May 2023, a file compactor system was delivered and installed at the Records Room enabling the Records Officers to better manage the voluminous tomes that the Sanggunian has accumulated over the years.
