Reynaldo Palabrica, Committee Vice Chairman Hon. Levy Tela, Committee Member Hon. Alejandro Gutierrez, ABC President Hon. Ramon Bautista, BTMD Head Mr. Geronimo Del Rosario, BTMD Asst. Head Mr. Adel Udarbe, Traffic Operations Officer Mr. Rommel Bunag, Bacoor Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors member Ms. Sallie C. Lacson, Barangay Councilor Efren Arcos and Punong Barangay Ronald Javier.

The Committee read the proposed City Ordinance amending Section 139 of the Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor and penalizing the tampering, destruction, or unauthorized removal of tire clamps. BTMD Head Mr. Geronimo Del Rosario requested to lower the towing fees in this manner:

Tricycle, e-tricycle	2,000

Also Ms. Sallie Lacson asked a reduction of towing fees on various motor vehicles that will be used by some businesses. Mr. Del Rosario also asked the Sanggunian to insert a provision to authorize the BTMD to purchase 20 tire clamps using the BTMD Trust Fund. Hon. Palabrica then answered that it can be added to the proposed city ordinance.

**MINUTES OF HEARING**  
**Series of 2022**

The Committee hearing was held on August 11, 2022 at 10:00 am. It was led by the Committee Chairman, Hon. Roberto L. Advincula together with Committee Vice Chairman Hon. Adrielito Gawaran and Committee Members Hon. Michael Solis and Hon. Reynaldo Fabian. Also in attendance were the Committee Chairman on Rules, Privileges, Laws and Ordinances Hon. Reynaldo Palabrica, Committee Vice Chairman Hon. Levy Tela, Committee Member Hon. Alejandro Gutierrez, ABC President Hon. Ramon Bautista, BTMD Head Mr. Geronimo Del Rosario, BTMD Asst. Head Mr. Adel Udarbe, Traffic Operations Officer Mr. Rommel Bunag, Bacoor Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors member Ms. Sallie C. Lacson, Barangay Councilor Efren Arcos and Punong Barangay Ronald Javier.

The Committee read the proposed City Ordinance amending Section 139 of the Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor and penalizing the tampering, destruction, or unauthorized removal of tire clamps. Brgy. Councilor Efren Arcos asked which the secondary roads are. Also Mr. Arcos asked if the barangay can pass an ordinance with the same context as the proposed city ordinance would not be redundant. Hon. Palabrica answered that the secondary roads are the city roads and in regards with the redundancy of proposed ordinance, it can be done by the barangay because they have



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also the right to propose an ordinance provided that the penalty imposed are different, if BTMD enforces the city ordinance the penalty that will be used is the penalty under the city ordinance while if the barangay imposes the ordinance, they can use either the city ordinance or the barangay ordinance.


Mr. Del Rosario requested to lower the amount of towing fees in this manner:

Type of Motor Vehicle	Minimum Towing Fee (in pesos)
pedicabs	1,000
motorcycle, e-motorcycle, motorized scooter	1,000
Tricycle, e-tricycle	2,000

Ms. Sallie Lacson also asked a reduction of towing fees on various motor vehicles that will be used by some businesses. Hon. Palabrica asked if there will be no problem with the private towing companies if the amount of towing fees will be reduced. Mr. Del Rosario answered that the amount of Php1, 000 is the amount charged by the towing companies for pedicabs and motorcycles, he also added that the amount provided in the ordinance are the amount that the towing companies are following. Hon. Palabrica said that if it is agreed between the city and the towing companies there will be no problem with the fee imposed. Mr. Del Rosario asked the Sanggunian to insert a provision to authorize the BTMD to purchase 20 tire clamps using the BTMD Trust Fund. Hon. Palabrica then answered that it can be added in the proposed city ordinance.

The meeting adjourned at exactly 11:20am.

**PROPOSED CITY ORDINANCE NO. ....**  
**Series of 2022**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 139 OF THE REVISED TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOR AND PENALIZING THE TAMPERING, DESTRUCTION, OR UNAUTHORIZED REMOVAL OF TIRE CLAMPS.**

**WHEREAS**, on 24 June 2019, the Sangguniang Panlungsod passed City Ordinance No. 11-2019 which amended City Ordinance No. 2013-2 (the "Revised Traffic Code") and authorized the clamping, towing, and impounding of illegally parked vehicles.

**WHEREAS**, City Ordinance No. 11-2019 was approved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on 15 June 2020 and became effective on 06 July 2020 after the said ordinance was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite.

**WHEREAS**, on 27 October 2020, the Department of Interior and Local Government issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-145 directing local chief executives to continue road clearing operations pursuant to Section 17 (b) of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") and Section 4 of Republic Act No. 11494 (the "Bayanhan to Re-cover us One Act").

**WHEREAS**, the unexpected increase in fuel prices due to the Russian invasion of Ukraine has hampered the towing operations of the Bacor Traffic Management Department of illegally parked motor vehicles as the towing fees mentioned in the City Ordinance No. 11-2019 are no longer enough to pay for the cost of operating the tow trucks being used by the BIMF.

**WHEREAS**, not all illegally parked vehicles in public places within the City can be towed right away due to the limited number of tow trucks being used in the said clearing operations and the limited space in the area where towed motor vehicles are impounded.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to mandate the clamping of illegally parked vehicles on secondary roads in order to minimize the cost of the road clearing operations of the BTMD.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite **THAT**:

**Section 1. Purposes.** This Ordinance is intended to give the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) enough revenues to effectively carry out the arduous task of clamping, towing, and impounding of illegally parked motor vehicles on various public places within the City of Bacoor, Cavite and penalize the tampering, destruction, damaging, or unauthorized removal of tire clamps by amending various provisions of the Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor (the "Revised Traffic Code").

**Section 2. Amendment and/or Repeal of Other Traffic Ordinances.** - The various provisions of City Ordinance No. 2013-2 as amended City Ordinance No. 2013-047, and all other existing Ordinances, Resolutions, Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and Executive Orders that either duplicate, contravene, or that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended, repealed, or modified accordingly.

**Section 3. Amendments to Section 139 of the Revised Traffic Code.** Section 139 of the Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

**"Section 139. Towing and Clamping Fees.**— The following towing and clamping fees shall be paid by the registered owner of any motor vehicle towed pursuant to the provisions of the Revised Traffic Code:

motorcycle, e-motorcycle, motorized scooter	<u>2,500.00</u>

SUV, van, owner-type jeep, multicab, and similar types of vehicles	<u>4,500.00</u>
jeepney	<u>4,500.00</u>
4-wheeler closed van (10 feet long)	<u>5,500.00</u>
4-wheeler closed van (more than 10 feet long)	<u>6,500.00</u>
6-wheeler closed van (ELF)	<u>6,500.00</u>
8-wheeler or 10-wheeler truck	<u>9,000.00</u>

The failure or refusal of the registered owner to pay the corresponding towing fees in full shall result in the impounding of the subject motor vehicle. Aside from the towing fees, the registered owner or driver of the subject vehicle shall also be required to pay the fine corresponding to the offense that was committed. **PROVIDED that:** accredited tow truck companies shall render their towing services for free in times of conflagration, earthquakes, flooding and after the occurrence of other calamities within the City of Bacoor. A tow truck company that violates this provision shall pay a fine of P6,000.00 and return any amount it charged from the owner of the vehicle that was towed. Otherwise, it shall lose its authority to operate within the City of Bacoor for one (1) year.

**Section 139-A. Clamping of Illegally Parked Vehicles on Secondary Roads and Other Public Places.** Illegally parked motor vehicles on secondary roads and other public places within the City of Bacoor that either impede the flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic or both shall be clamped by BTMD personnel or barangay officials duly deputized to do so if no tow truck is available to tow them or if towing the said vehicles would obstruct the flow of motor vehicles. Unless the registered owner of the clamped motor vehicles pay the clamping fees provided in Section 139, the said clamps shall remain in place until it is removed or until the BTMD tows the vehicle for impounding. In case the vehicle is towed and impounded, the registered owner of the clamped vehicle shall pay the corresponding clamping, towing and impounding fees before the said vehicle can be released.

**Section 139-B. Penalty for Tampering, Damaging, Destruction, Vandalizing, or Unauthorized Removal of Tire Clamps.** Any person who tampers with the lock of the tire clamp attached by the BTMD to an illegally parked motor vehicle or who damages,

destroys, vandalizes or removes the said clamp without the authority of the BYMO shall be required to pay a fine of P2,500.00. If the offender is a minor or a mentally impaired person, the said fine shall be paid by the parent/s or guardian/s of the said offender.

**Section 4. Separability.** In case certain provisions of this Ordinance are declared void by a court of law, the provisions hereof not affected by the said judicial declaration shall continue to have legal force and effect.

**Section 5. Implementing Rules.** The City Mayor shall form a task force that will formulate the rules to be used for the implementation of this Ordinance.

**Section 6. Effectivity.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Bacoor, Cavite.
