Ronna Grace Torrijos a representative from City Treasurer's office and Hon. Angie Carriaso SK Chairperson of Barangay Molino IV.

The committee hearing for the above-mentioned subject matter was conducted on September 30, 2022. It was presided by Coun. Mac Raven Espiritu, Chairman on Youth Sports Research and Development. Presents ware Hon. Ramon Bautista, Hon. Levy Tela, Hon. Alejandrino Gutierrez, Sir. Abbey Gawaran of City Accounting Office, Atty. Nathaniel De Leon



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of City Legal Office, Mam. Ronna Grace Torrijos a representative from City Treasurer's office and Hon. Angie Carriaso SK Chairperson of Barangay Molino IV.

The subject matter of the hearing was regarding to the **"Proposed City Ordinance, entitled: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OF EACH BARANGAY IN THE CITY OF BACOOOR, CAVITE TO ISSUE CERTIFICATIONS NEEDED BY BARANGAY RESIDENTS AGED 30 YEARS OLD AND BELOW, MAINTAIN A "KATIPUNAN NG KABATAAN REGISTRY" AND COLLECT FEES IN EXCHANGE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE SAID CERTIFICATIONS"** the hearing started around 1:30 pm Hon. He mentioned some negative effects of the subject matter for the barangay captains in terms of fees collection and rights in every barangay. He noticed some issues on Section (12) of the said draft ordinance and suggested that revisions are necessary. This was agreed by Hon. Alejandrino Gutierrez and Hon. Levy Tela.

Second to share his notes and comments was Atty. Mendoza from the City Legal Office. He said that regarding on the issue of rights of the barangay captains being affected he suggested that on the ordinance section (7) could be removed to address the rights issue for the barangay captains. The representatives from City Treasury Office ask something about the validity of the certification. It was answered by Hon. Mac Raven and Hon. Angie Carriaso.



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
Hon. Mac Raven Espiritu announced that the meeting is adjourned at around 02:30 pm, seconded by Hon. Alejandrino Gutierrez.

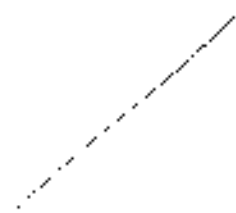

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OF BARANGAY IN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE TO ISSUE CERTIFICATIONS NEEDED BY BARANGAY RESIDENTS AGED THIRTY (30) YEARS OLD AND BELOW, MAINTAIN A "KATIPUNAN NG KABATAAN REGISTRY" AND COLLECT FEES IN EXCHANGE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE SAID CERTIFICATIONS.**

WHEREAS, Section of Republic Act No. 10742 (the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015") provides that "(t)he State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building, and thus, promotes and protects their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being, inculcates in them patriotism, nationalism and other desirable values, and encourages their involvement in public and civic affairs. Towards this end, the State shall establish adequate, effective, responsive and enabling mechanisms and support systems that will ensure the meaningful participation of the youth in local governance and in nation-building."

WHEREAS, Section 8 (e) of RA No. 10742 empowered the Sangguniang Kabataan to "hold fund-raising activities which are in line with the Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan, the proceeds of which shall be tax-exempt and shall accrue to the general fund of the Sangguniang Kabataan; Provided, however, that in the appropriation thereof, the specific purpose for which such activity has been held shall be first satisfied; Provided, further, that any appropriation thereof shall be in accordance with existing applicable budget accounting and auditing rules and regulations";

WHEREAS, the various Sangguniang Kabataan of the City of Bacor are in need of additional funds in order to enable them to better serve the members of the Katipunan ng Kabataan of their respective barangays.

WHEREAS, the existing funds of the Sangguniang Kabataan mandated under Section 20 (a) of RA 10742 are not enough to sustain their operation.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 provides that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance";

WHEREAS, the author, in his capacity as President of the Pederasyon ng Sangguniang Kabataan, proposes that the Sangguniang Kabataan of each barangay in the City be given the authority to issue the various certifications needed by

barangay residents aged thirty (30) years old and below, maintain a "Kaliyuanan ng Kabataan Registry, and collect fees in exchange for the said certifications as a way of raising funds.

BE IT ENACTED by the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panglungsod of the City of Bacoor, in regular session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Katipunan ng Kabataan Registry Ordinance of Bacoor". ✓

SECTION 2. Authority of the Sangguniang Kabataan to Maintain the "Katipunan ng Kabataan Registry". All Sangguniang Kabataan in the City of Bacoor, Cavite are hereby authorized to maintain a "Kaliyuanan ng Kabataan Registry" which shall contain the following information: *Profiling*

- a. The name, address, and birthday of all barangay residents aged thirty (30) years old and below on the date of effectivity of this Ordinance
- b. The names of their parents; and
- c. The picture of the said barangay residents at the time they signed the said registry.

SECTION 3. Purpose of the Katipunan ng Kabataan Registry. The Kaliyuanan ng Kabataan Registry shall be used for the following purposes:

- a. To ascertain the exact number of members of each Kaliyuanan ng Kabataan;
- b. To use the data contained in the said registry in the formulation of the Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan; and
- c. To determine the identity of barangay residents who should benefit from the various services and projects of the Sangguniang Kabataan.

SECTION 4. Data Privacy. All Sangguniang Kabataan in the City are prohibited from committing any act that will violate the data privacy rights of all persons whose personal information appear in the Kaliyuanan ng Kabataan Registry as defined and penalized in Republic Act No. 10173 (also known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012")

SECTION 5. Katibayan ng pagiging Kasapi ng Katipunan ng Kabataan (KKKK). The Sangguniang Kabataan Secretary of each barangay in the City are hereby authorized to issue a certification to be known as the Katibayan ng pagiging Kasapi ng Katipunan ng Kabataan to every barangay resident aged thirty (30) years old and below. The KKKK shall be valid for one year from the date of its issuance.





**SECTION 6. KKKK Fees.** The Sangguniang Kabataan Treasurer of each barangay in the City are hereby authorized to collect fees in exchange for the issuance of the KKKK amounting to ₱30.00. Kalipunan ng Kabataan members who belong to indigent families as certified by the City Social Welfare and Development Office are exempted from paying the said fees. All KKKK fees collected shall form part of the funds of the Sangguniang Kabataan and shall be exclusively used by it. Official receipts shall be issued by the Sangguniang Kabataan Treasurer upon payment of the fee mentioned above. The use of the said fees shall be subject to audit as mandated by law.

**SECTION 7. Recognition of the KKKK by Barangay Officials.** All Barangay officials shall recognize the validity of the KKKK issued by the Sangguniang Barangay Secretary and shall not require the holder thereof to apply and pay for a Barangay Certificate as long as the KKKK remains valid and the holder thereof is aged 30 years old and below.

**SECTION 8. Prohibited Acts.** The following acts are prohibited:

- a. Issuance of a KKKK to a person aged 31 years old and above at the time the said certification was issued
- b. Falsification of the KKKK; and
- c. Disclosure of any personal information contained in the Kalipunan ng Kabataan Registry to third parties in violation of the Data Privacy Act of 2012.

**SECTION 9. Penalty.** Any person aged 18 years old and above shall be penalized as follows upon conviction by a court of law:

- a. First Offense: payment of a fine amounting to ₱2,000.00.
- b. Second Offense: payment of a fine amounting to ₱3,000.00.
- c. Third Offense: payment of a fine amounting to ₱4,000.00 or imprisonment for not less than sixty (60) days but not more than one hundred twenty (120) days at the discretion of the court.

**SECTION 10. Revenue Sharing.** Fines paid by violators of this Ordinance shall be equally shared by the City Government and by the Barangay where the apprehension was made. The share in the said revenues shall be used by the Barangay to pay for the meals and other allowances of the Barangay Tanods of the said Barangay while the share of the City Government shall inure to the General Fund of the city.

**SECTION 11. Implementing Rules on Revenue Sharing.** The City Treasurer and the City Accountant are hereby directed to formulate rules that will be used by the city government in implementing the revenue sharing provision of this Ordinance.



The said rules must be submitted to the City Mayor within thirty (30) working days from the effectivity date of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 12. Procedure in the Handling of a Child Offender.**

The following procedures shall be observed by all city government departments/units and by all barangay officials/personnel implementing this Ordinance in case the violator is a child:

- a. A child, who is cited for violation of the Ordinance shall be recorded as a "child at risk" and not a "child in conflict with the law". He/she shall be brought to any Barangay Official at the Barangay Hall to be referred to the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO), which shall, with the assistance of the Barangay Official, release the custody of the child to his/her parents or guardian, or in the absence thereof, the child's nearest relative. If the parents, guardians or nearest relatives of the child offender cannot be located, or if they refuse to take custody, the child may be released to any of the following:
  1. A duly registered nongovernmental or religious organization;
  2. A Barangay Official or a member of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC);
  3. A City Social Welfare and Development Officer (CSWDO), or when and where appropriate, the DSWD.
- b. The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) shall determine and design the intervention program for the child. The intervention program shall consist of counselling, attendance in group activities for children, etc. and for the parents, attendance in parenting education seminars as mandated under Republic Act 10630 and its implementing rules.
- c. If the child has been found by the CSWDO to be dependent, abandoned, neglected or abused by his/her parent and the best interest of the child requires that he/she be placed in the "Sahay Kalinga halfway house" or any similar facility being operated by the city government, the child's parents or guardians shall execute a written authorization for the voluntary commitment of the child. Provided, that if the child has no parents or guardians or if they refuse or fail to execute the written authorization for voluntary commitment, the proper petition for involuntary commitment shall be immediately filed by the CSWDO pursuant to Section 6 of Republic Act 10630, amending Section 20 of Republic Act 9344.
- d. Section 21 of Republic Act 9344, pertaining to the "Procedure for taking the child into custody" shall, at all



times be observed by any law enforcer who takes a child into custody.

**SECTION 13. Repealing Clause.** All Ordinances and rules inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinances are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

**SECTION 14. Separability Clause.** Any provision of this Ordinance not declared void or unconstitutional by the proper court of law shall remain valid.

**SECTION 15. Effectivity Clause.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

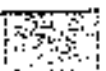
