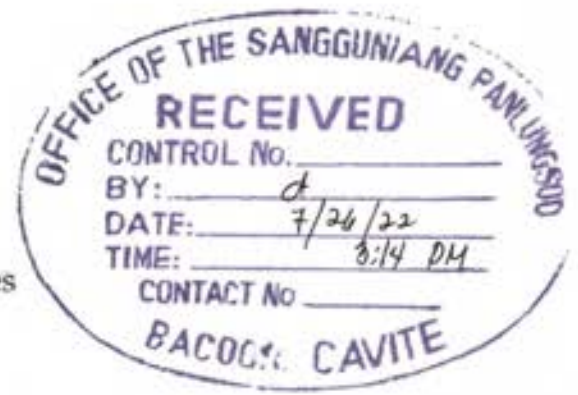





**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

**FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF THE INSTALLED TRASH TRAP OF THE DENR CALABARZON UNDER THE PROVINCIAL ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE - CAVITE.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into by and among

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Regional Office IV-A (CALABARZON), a national government agency of the Republic of the Philippines with office and principal address of DENR IV-A (CALABARZON) Compound, Mariposa Walk Road (along BLEX), Barangay Mariposa, Calamba City, Laguna represented herein by the Regional Executive Director NILO B. TAMBORA, CESO III hereinafter referred to as the "DENR"

The City of Bacoor, a Local Government Unit (LGU), created under the Law of the Philippines with office address at Bacoor City Government Compound, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanin, City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite represented herein by the Mayor, HON. LAM MERCADO-REVILLA, herein referred to as the "City"

The Barangay \_\_\_\_\_ City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite a Local Government Unit (LGU) created under the Law of the Philippines with office address at Barangay Lages II represented herein by Barangay Chairman GEORGE O. MEDINA, herein referred to as the "BARANGAY"

**WITNESSETH, that:**

**WHEREAS**, Section 18, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature"

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 4, Executive Order No. 192, the DENR is the primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management, development, and proper use of the country's environment and natural resources.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 17 (b) (1) (ii) (2) (ii) (3) (ii) Chapter 1 Book I of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the local government units (barangay and City) to provide services and facilities related to general hygiene and sanitation.

**WHEREAS**, Section 10 Chapter 2 of RA 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 mandates LGUs primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their respective jurisdictions. It is further stated that segregation and collection of solid waste shall be conducted at the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes and the collection of non-recyclable materials and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the City or city."

**WHEREAS**, Section 20 Chapter 3 of RA 9275, otherwise known as the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 states that the LGU shall share the responsibility in the management and improvement of water quality within their territorial jurisdictions."

BACK

WHEREAS the Supreme Court Continuing Mandamus Order dated December 13, 2006 defendant government agencies are directed to clean up, rehabilitate and preserve Manila Bay, and restore and maintain its water to SB level (Class SB sea water classification under DAO 40-04) to make them fit for swimming, skin diving, and other form of contact recreation;

WHEREAS the DENR Administrative Order No. 18, series of 2010 "Expediting the Rehabilitation and Restoration of the Coastal and Marine Ecosystem of the Manila Bay and Creating Manila Bay Task Force" directs the convergence of the national government agencies and the LGUs in the Manila Bay Region that includes Province of Cavite and the active participation of private and public stakeholders, are necessary to facilitate the robust and integrated implementation of all the rehabilitation efforts at the Manila Bay;

WHEREAS all parties have envisioned a practical and beneficial undertaking based on the strong sense of mutual cooperation, and sharing of available resources and recognized the indispensable participation of Local Government Units (LGUs), the private sector, Non Government Organizations (NGOs) and other sectors of the society in the successful implementation of Operational Plan for Manila Bay Coastal Strategy (OPMBCS) which aims to clean-up the Manila Bay

WHEREAS based on available studies and trials, trash trap had demonstrated high levels of effectiveness in trapping trash that goes into drains and waterways. Of the tests done, it revealed that such structures are effective in trapping all kinds of garbage. However, as these structures can only accommodate limited to a certain amount of waste maintenance and cleaning should be done regularly to keep it functioning properly and effectively.

NOW THEREFORE, he and in consideration of mutual consent hereinafter set forth the parties have agreed, as they hereby agreed on the following responsibilities:

**A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DENR:**

1. In coordination with the City and Bantayog, install trash trap along the selected waterways of the Zapote River System to reduce some waste dumping to the Manila Bay;
2. Provide technical assistance and Communication Education, and Public Awareness (CEPA) in rehabilitating, protecting, conserving and managing of waste and waterways relative to the established trash trap;
3. Together with other signatories of this agreement, jointly monitor and evaluate the performance and condition of the installed trash trap;
4. Consolidate reports submitted by the Bantayog and City regarding waste collection and disposition to accredited Sanitary Disposal Facility/Sanitary Landfill;
5. Designate the Provincial Focal Person for Manila Bay as oversight for the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the trash trap; and

B. Establish Public-Private Partnership in the protection and maintenance of the Zapote River and its tributaries to provide continuous support in the repair of the trash trap, empowerment of the community/ residents, and strict enforcement of enacted policies.

**B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT:**

1. Provide assistance to the Barangay during the conduct of weekly or daily clean-up of wastes trapped in the installed trash trap by weighing, hauling and disposal to accredited sanitary landfill or disposal facility.
2. Submit weekly report to the DENR on the handling, transport and disposal of collected wastes in the trash trap to sanitary landfill or accredited disposal facilities.
3. Designate a local person for the oversight of trash traps installed in the barangay within their administrative jurisdiction.
4. Provide support in the Barangay in the protection and maintenance of the trash trap and the cleaned areas from unlawful acts of the residents by conducting regular patrolling and implementation of relevant environmental laws, rules and regulations, and
5. Provide additional logistical and financial support for the improvement of the installed trash trap if necessary.

**C. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BARANGAY:**

1. Enact a Barangay Ordinance for the protection and maintenance of the installed trash trap located within Brgy. Ligan II, City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite.
2. Conduct patrolling and monitoring of events and activities to safeguard the trash trap and the cleaned areas from unlawful acts of the residents and submit report to the DENR thru the City.
3. Together with the DENR and City, conduct Communication Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) on the importance of water quality, riverbank stabilization and riverbank protection relative to the established trash trap.
4. Designate the Committee Chairman on Environment to serve as the local person who will work in coordination with the DENR and City local person in the proper implementation clean-up activity in the installed trash trap.
5. Assist the DENR-CALABARZON and BACOR CITY in its regular clean-up activities in the trash trap installed in its barangay jurisdiction.

**D. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTE**

Should there be any conflict with respect to the interpretation or operation of any of the provisions of this Agreement, the parties shall exert their best efforts to settle such dispute amicably. The dispute shall be settled through arbitration in accordance with the Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004 should the parties unable to settle the dispute or disagreement within fifteen (15) days from the initial meeting. All actions arising out of this agreement shall be filed exclusively with the appropriate and competent courts in Cavite Province, Philippines.
