COMMITTEE REPORT NO. LTCI-007-S-2022

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SPECIAL INCENTIVES TO BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, PROFESSIONALS, AND INSTITUTIONS THAT WILL CONDUCT CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ACTIVITIES IN BACOOR CITY, CAVITE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY INCENTIVE ORDINANCE OF BACOOR".

On 17 October 2022, the aforementioned-subject matter was referred to the Committee on Labor, Trade Commerce and Industry.

On 10 November 2022, the Committee held a hearing attended by the following resource persons: Atty. Marius Sumira of the City Legal Services Office, Ms. Shirley Anne Gomez of the Business Permit and Licensing Office, and Ms. Amy Cristobal of the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce, and Industry.

Atty. Sumira mentioned that the proposed city ordinance was already checked by the City Legal Services Office. He suggested that in the Sec. 5 Penalty, "Any city government employee who refuses with justifiable cause to grant the incentives



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mentioned above to qualified business establishments, professionals, or institutions shall be deemed to have violated this Ordinance and shall be required - upon conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction - to pay a fine of P 5,000.00." Instead of "with," he recommended changing it to "without."

Ms. Gomez of the Business Permit and Licensing Office approved the 10% discount in their Mayor's Permit and Sanitation Permit fees for the year following the conduct of the CSR activity or activities. The discount indicated is still acceptable, knowing that the highest fees collected for the mayor's permit and sanitation permit are P700.00 per year.

The different representatives of the various city government departments invited to attend the hearing have no objection to the proposed ordinance being approved.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Committee respectfully recommends that the proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SPECIAL INCENTIVES TO BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, PROFESSIONALS, AND INSTITUTIONS THAT WILL CONDUCT CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ACTIVITIES IN BACOOR CITY, CAVITE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY INCENTIVE ORDINANCE OF BACOOR" be APPROVED.

MINUTES OF COMMITTEE HEARING NO. LTCI-007-S-2022

The committee hearing was conducted on November 10, 2022, at the Sangguniang Panlungsod 2nd Flr., Bacoor Government Center, City of Bacoor, Cavite was presided by Committee on Labor, Trade Commerce and Industry Chairman, Councilor Reynaldo M. Fabian together with Councilor Alejandro Gutierrez and Councilor Ramon Bautista. In attendance were Atty. Marius Sumira of City Legal Services Office, Ms. Shirley Anne Gomez of the Business Permit and Licensing Office, and Ms. Amy Cristobal of the Bacoor Chamber of Commerce, and Industry as the resource persons.

Atty. Sumira mentioned that the proposed city ordinance had already been checked by the City Legal Services Office, and they approved with it. With regard to the incentives, he wants to confirm this with the Business Permit and Licensing Office. He suggested that in the Sec. 5 penalty. Any city government employee that refuses with justifiable cause to grant the incentives mentioned above to qualified business establishments, professionals, or institutions shall be deemed to have violated this ordinance and shall be required—upon conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction—to pay a fine of P 5,000.00. Instead of "with," he recommended changing it to "without."



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Ms. Gomez of the Business Permit and Licensing Office approved the 10% discount in their Mayor's Permit and Sanitation Permit fees for the year following the conduct of the CSR activity or activities. The discount indicated is still acceptable, knowing that the highest fees collected for the mayor's permit and sanitation permit are P700.00 per year. She also stated that P 500.00 is the standard fee paid by facilities. The said discount will not greatly affect the city's income. Furthermore, this proposed ordinance will boost the corporate social responsibility activities of different companies and establishments. The various representatives have no objection with regard to the above-mentioned subject matter, the Committee recommended for the approval of the proposed ordinance.

The hearing was adjourned at 1: 47 pm.



In order to continue and expand the benefits and social services being given to the people of Bacoor and to ease the financial burden or constraints of the city government in providing various services to its constituents, the undersigned sees the need to encourage private businesses, professionals and institutions to take a more active role in contributing to the advancement, improvement and development of the City of Bacoor by maximizing the concept of application of corporate social responsibility.

In this regard, I respectfully request the esteemed members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass and approve a local ordinance, with utmost urgency, granting special incentives to business establishments, professionals and institutions that will conduct corporate social responsibility activities in the City of Baccor, Cavite.





PROPOSED CITY ORDINANCE NO. __ Series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SPECIAL INCENTIVES TO BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, PROFESSIONALS, AND INSTITUTIONS THAT WILL CONDUCT CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ACTIVITIES IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY INCENTIVE ORDINANCE OF BACOOR".

Sponsored by:

WHEREAS, the concept of corporate social responsibility was developed to give private businesses — large and small — the opportunity to help make the community and the country where they operate better places to live and work in. Though corporate social responsibility is not a novel ideal and has already been known by many entrepreneurs for many years, only large or multinational corporations are habitually performing CSR related activities in the City of Baccor.

WHEREAS, encouraging private businesses to take a more active role in improving the City of Baccor will not only benefit the public but will also ease the financial burden of the city government in providing various services to its constituents.

WHEREAS, making the practice of CSR mandatory, on the other hand, is inadvisable as the said concept is founded on generosity and altruism and forcing entrepreneurs to engage in CSR activities in the City will surely dampen the enthusiasm of entrepreneurs in doing good for their fellow citizens.

WHEREAS, studies conducted abroad show that giving incentives and due recognition to private businesses engaged in meaningful CSR activities produce better results than making the holding of such activities mandatory.

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 4 was passed by the defunct Sangguniang Bayan of Bacoor, Cavite on February 6, 2012 and it mandated corporations, partnerships, and businesses operating within the City to conduct CSR activities without providing any form of incentive or recognition to said private entities in exchange for the commendable work they were supposed to do for the community.

WHEREAS, very few companies have been compelled to comply with Municipal Ordinance No. 4 which means that a new strategy must be employed by the City Government in order to enhance its partnership with the private sector.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon.	. BE IT ORDAINED by the 5'
Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite THAT:	

- Section 1. Application. This Ordinance shall apply to all business establishments, professionals, and institutions (such as schools and hospitals) doing business, working or operating within the City of Bacoor, Cavite.
- Section 2. Definition of Terms. The following terms as used in this Ordinance are defined as:



- 2.1. Business Establishments any natural or juridical person not engaged in the practice of profession that is duly registered as a business with the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) of the City of Bacoor and is engaged in the trade or delivery of goods and services to any member of the public.
- 2.2. Corporate Social Responsibility or Citizen's Social Responsibility (CSR) Activities any activity conducted within the City of Baccor by any business establishment, professional, or institution that aims to improve society, the environment, the lives of the poor, the sick, the victims of injustice, or the underprivileged.
- Institutions any school, hospital, or charitable organization operating within the City of Baccor, Cavite.
- 2.4. Professionals any resident of the City of Bacoor duly registered with the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) or the Supreme Court of the Philippines as a professional who are practicing their profession within the City.
- Section 3. Grant of Incentives. All business establishments, professionals, and institutions that will conduct CSR activities in the City of Bacoor in coordination with the Local Economic and Investments Promotion Office (LEIPO) or any other department under the Office of the City Mayor prior to the holding of such activities shall be entitled to the following incentives:
 - Free advertising of their products or services to all free cable television channels airing in the City of Bacoor for a period of thirty (30) calendar days.
 - Public recognition of the business establishments, professionals, and institutions that will conduct CSR activities in all social media accounts owned by the city government.
 - Free use of selected advertising spaces owned by the city government for not more than ten (10) calendar days.
 - d. 10% discount in their Mayor's Permit and Sanitation Permit fee for the year following the conduct of the CSR activity/ies.
 - Use of an express lane at Business One-Stop Shop facility at the Bacoor City Hall for for their transactions with the city government, and
 - Assistance to be provided by the LEIPO in the processing of their applications of various permits to be issued by the city government.
- Section 4. Conditions for the Grant of Incentives. The incentives mentioned above shall only be granted if the business establishment, professional, or institution applying for the same complies with the following conditions:
 - It has no unpaid taxes or other accountabilities to the city government.
- 4.2. It is consistently complying with all city ordinances and has not filed suit against the city government or is not the subject of a legal action filed against it by the city government;
- 4.3. It coordinated with the LEIPO or with any department/unit under the Mayor's Office or with the Office of the Vice Mayor before the CSR activity/ies was/were held, and



- 4.4. The business establishment, institution, or professional applied for the grant of the said incentive in the manner to be provided in the implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance.
- Section 5. Penalty. Any city government employee that refuses with justifiable cause to grant the incentives mentioned above to qualified business establishments, professionals, or institutions shall be deemed to have violated this Ordinance and shall be required upon conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction to pay a fine of P5,000.00.
- Section 6. Implementing Rules and Regulations. The BPLO, LEIPO, and the City Legal Services Office shall work together under the supervision of the City Administrator and submit to the City Mayor the proposed implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance not later than thirty (30) working days after the date of effectivity hereof.
- Section 7. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared void by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining portions, provisions, sections, or parts hereof which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.
- Section 8. Repealing Clause. Municipal Ordinance No. 4-S-2012 is hereby repealed. All other ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby considered repealed, amended or modified, accordingly.
- Section 9. Date of Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite.
- UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED by the 5° Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite on __ October 2022 during its regular session held at the City of Bacoor, Cavite.
