Subject: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 238 AND 239 OF THE BACOOR REVENUE CODE AND AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF THE CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION FEE FROM OWNERS/OPERATORS OF ALL RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL LOTS AND BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR—PCO-2023-094 dated June 19, 2023

The above-captioned subject matter was referred to this Committee on June 19, 2023. The Committee held public hearings on Proposed City Ordinance No. 2023-094 on June 29, 2023 which were attended by various stakeholders.

Section 14 of Republic Act No. 9729 known as "Climate Change Act of 2009" provides that: "The LGUs shall be the frontline agencies in the formulation, planning and implementation of climate change action plans in their respective areas, consistent with the provisions of the Local Government Code, the Framework and the National Climate Change Action Plan". It further provides that: "The LGU is hereby expressly authorized to appropriate and use the amount from its Internal Revenue Allotment necessary to implement said local plan effectively, any provision in the Local Government Code to the contrary notwithstanding."

The City Government of Bacoor formulated plans and programs related to climate change adaptation and mitigation, including the implementation of preventive measures, planning, preparedness management and contingency planning for droughts and floods in anticipation of the possible impact of climate change upon local communities and the environment.

Reportedly, the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund and the other local resources are not enough to finance various projects in anticipation of challenges that Bacoor City will face due to the effects of climate change. In addition, it was also disclosed that the Environment Protection and Sanitations Fees being collected by the city government are not enough to defray the cost of inspecting and regulating the establishments and residences covered by the said fees, and that the rising cost of

hauling the solid waste generated by residents of Bacoor City will soon be beyond the financial capabilities of the city government.

Accordingly, there is a need to amend Article 48 of the Bacoor City Revenue Code, particularly Sections 238 and 239 to increase the Environment Protection and Sanitation Fees and the inclusion of a Climate Change Adaption Fee so that the City may cope with the foreseen deficits.

Below is the draft of PCO 2023-094:

Section 1. Amendments to Sections 238 and 239 of the Bacoor Revenue Code (as amended). Section 238 of the Bacoor Revenue Code (the "Code") is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

"ARTICLE 48 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND SANITATION FEE

Section 238. Imposition of Fee. -- To defray the cost of protecting the environment there shall be collected an Environmental Protection and Sanitation Fee, as follows:

(a) For every operator of business establishments located within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor, the fee shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

Section 238-A. Climate Change Adaptation Fee. The owners of all residential lots and buildings in the City of Bacoor shall be required to pay a Climate Change Adaptation Fee in the amount of P1,000.00 per annum. Lots that are solely devoted to the planting of trees, vegetables and other plants shall be exempted from paying this fee. Residential buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens, or that contain functioning solar panels, or whose design incorporated a living tree to avoid it being cut down shall be given a 10% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing. Residential buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens AND that contain functioning solar panels shall be given a 20% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing.

The owners/operators of commercial buildings in the City of Bacoor as certified by the BPLO shall be required to pay a Climate Change Adaptation Fee in the amount of P2,000.00 per annum. Commercial buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens or that contain functioning solar panels, or whose design incorporated a living tree to avoid it being cut down shall be given a 10% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing. Commercial buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens AND that contain functioning solar panels or whose design incorporated a living tree to avoid it being cut down shall be given a 20% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing.

An en banc public hearing was held in order that the public may know and participate in the dialogue, and to ensure that the proposed amendments are fair, reasonable and within the parameters of the law.

During the hearing, the public and the Office of the City Assessor opined that the Climate Change Adaptation Fee under the proposed Section 238-A should be computed based on the area and sizes of the lots, establishments and improvements.

In a letter dated July 5, 2023, the Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriation requested the Office of the City Assessor to formulate a tentative table/matrix of Climate Change Adaptation Fee, and to submit the same for study and consideration of the Honorable Members of Sangguniang Panlungsod. The photocopy of the Committee letter is herewith attached as Annex "A".

The reply letter dated July 13, 2023 of the Office of the City Assessor was received by the Committee on July 14, 2023 together with the Comparative Study Matrix of Climate Change Adaptation Fee. Change Adaptation Fee are herewith attached as Annex "B" and Annex "B-1", respectively.

All the required processes and procedures have been properly complied with, and the Committee suggests to consider the following findings in the final draft of ordinance.

FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

- To adopt the amount of fees as suggested by the Office of the City Assessor under its Comparative Study Matrix of Climate Change Adaptation Fee.
- 2. To re-write the provisions under Section 238-A and to insert a table/schedule of Climate Change Adaptation Fee with the amount of fees based on the suggestion of the .Office of the City Assessor under its Comparative Study Matrix of Climate Change Adaptation Fee, and to include the industrial establishments in the provision. We drafted:

Section 238-A. Climate Change Adaptation Fee. The owners of all residential lots and buildings in the City of Bacoor shall be required to pay a Climate Change Adaptation Fee in accordance with the following schedule:

Lots that are solely devoted to the planting of trees, vegetables and other plants shall be exempted from paying this fee. Residential buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens or that contain functioning solar panels or whose design incorporated a living tree (see attached photo below) to avoid it being cut down shall be given a 10% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing. Residential buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens AND that contain functioning solar panels shall be given a 20% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing.

The owners/operators of commercial and industrial buildings in the City of Bacoor as certified by the BPLO shall be required to pay a Climate Change Adaptation Fee in accordance with the following schedule.

Commercial and industrial buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens or that contain functioning solar panels or whose design incorporated a living tree (see attached photo below) to avoid it being cut down shall be given a 10% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing. Commercial and industrial buildings whose rooftops have been converted into vegetable gardens AND that contain functioning solar panels or whose design incorporated a living tree to avoid it being cut down shall be given a 20% discount on the said fee but only after this has been confirmed by the CENRO in writing.







3. To re-write Section 239 which was inadvertently omitted in the draft of City Ordinance and to insert paragraph (c), as follows:

Section 239. Time and Manner of Payment

Hon. Coun. Rogelio M. Nolasco: "An Ordinance amending Sections 238 and 239 of the Bacoor Revenue Code and Authorizing the collection of the Climate Change Adaption Fee from Owners/Operators of all residential and commercial lots and buildings within the City of Bacoor, Cavite is an order."

Hon. Coun. Nolasco: "Magandang Hapon po sa inyong lahat, bago po tayo magsimula nais ko pong ipakilala sa inyo ang aking mga kasama: Hon. Coun. Levy Tela, Hon. Coun. Reynaldo Palabrica, Hon. Coun. Simplicio Dominguez, Hon. Coun. Alejandro Gutierrez and Hon. Coun. Adrielito Gawaran. At ang inyong linkod Coun. Regelio Nolasco, Chairman of Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriation. Pwede po bang paki sabi ang inyong name and position for record purposes po."

Hon. Coun. Rogelio M. Nolasco: Stated "The Proposed City Ordinance Amending sections 238 and 239 of the Bacoor Revenue Code and authorizing the collection of the Climate Change Adaptation Fee from Owners/Operators of all Residential and Commercial Lots and buildings within the City of Bacoor Cavite."

Whereas, on 25 August 2022, the Sangguniang Panlungsod passed City Ordinance No. 217-2022 amending certain provisions of the Bacoor Revenue Code (City Ordinance No. 2013-060)."

Whereas, during a meeting between the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod and the City Mayor, it was disclosed that the Environmental Protection and Sanitation Fees being collected by the City Government pursuant to Article 48, Sections 238 and 239 of the Bacoor Revenue Code as amended are not enough to defray the cost of inspecting and regulating various establishments and residences covered by the said fee. Moreover, it was reported by the City Mayor that the cost of hauling the solid waste generated by residents of the City is continuing to rise and will soon be beyond the present financial capabilities of the City Government."

Whereas, the City Mayor also reported that the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund of the City is not enough to finance the various projects that the City will face due to the effects of climate change such as power outages, more severe flooding, water and food shortages, and unusually hot days."

Whereas, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has the power to pass ordinances that will promote the general welfare, protect the environment, and make preparations to mitigate the effects of various disasters including the raising of revenues that will make the performance of the said duties."

"Yun po yung nakasaad para sa article 238 and 239. Kung mapapansin nyo po yung ating mga Fees ay may pagbabago. Atty. Jessie Salvador, ano po ang masasabi nyo dito sa Ordinansa?"

Atty. Sumira: "Good afternoon po, tungkol po dito sa pag amend ng Revenue Code natin, tama lang po na magkaroon ng additional fee kasi kailangan po nating magkaroon ng fund specially doon sa nararanasan nating power outage kasi kasama po ito sa climate change para po makatulong kung sakaling maging regular itong power outage na ito para po hindi na mabigla at ma adjust or maitataas natin ang ampere ng kuryente as per building code. PROPOSED CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-094 Series of 2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 238 AND 239 OF THE BACOOR REVENUE CODE AND AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF THE CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION FEE FROM OWNERS/OPERATORS OF ALL RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOTS AND BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE.

WHEREAS, on 25 August 2022, the Sangguniang Panlungsod passed City Ordinance No. 217-2022 amending certain provisions of the Bacoor Revenue Code (City Ordinance No. 2013-060).

WHEREAS, during a meeting between the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod and the City Mayor, it was disclosed that the Environmental Protection and Sanitation Fees being collected by the City Government pursuant to Article 48, Sections 238 to 239 of the Bacoor Revenue Code as amended are not enough to defray the cost of inspecting and regulating various establishments and residences covered by the said fee. Moreover, it was reported by the City Mayor that the cost of hauling the solid waste generated by residents of the City is continuing to rise and will soon be beyond the present financial capabilities of the City Government.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor also reported that the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund of the City is not enough to finance the various projects that the City Government intends to implement in anticipation of the various challenges that Bacoor will face due to the effects of climate change such as power outages, more severe flooding, water and food shortages, and unusually hot days.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has the power to pass ordinances that will promote the general welfare, protect the environment, and make preparations to mitigate the effects of various disasters including the raising of revenues that will make the performance of the said duties possible.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod that:

Section 1. Amendments to Section 238 of the Bacoor Revenue Code (as amended). Section 238 of the Bacoor Revenue Code (the "Code") is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

"ARTICLE 48 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND SANITATION FEE

Section 238. Imposition of Fee. — To defray the cost of protecting the environment there shall be collected an Environmental Protection and Sanitation Fee, as follows:

(a) For every operator of business establishments located within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor, the fee shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

Section 2. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted in at least three conspicuous places and after it has been published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.
