Subject: PCO 2023-113 - A CITY ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 29 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 11-2019 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-2 AS AMENDED BY CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-047 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOOR AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF". (PCO 2023-113 SEPTEMBER 4, 2023).

This report states that the ordinance is to amend City Ordinance to recommend to abolish the Bacoor Traffic Management Trust Fund and revert to General Fund.

FINDINGS:

After careful investigation, review and deliberation, the CLFC discovered that there is an underutilization of funds of BTMTF.

The City Government of Bacoor mandate to increase the utilization of funds in order to provide quality and efficient service to its residents, the CLFC decided it will be more advantageous and practical to the City Government and the Bacooreños, to amend the recording of the funds in the BTMTF for this Year 2023 by recording in and reverting the same to the General Fund and to revise the disbursement of the BTMTF for Year 2024 onwards.

RECOMMENDATION:

Considering the objective of increasing the collection efficiently, it is more advantageous and practical to assign the Trust-Fund under the BTMD to the General Fund with the assurance that the necessary programs and projects germane to the purpose of its collection will be accordingly appropriated.

Resolution No. 01 s. 2023

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE ENACTMENT OF AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE BACOOR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT TRUST FUND AND REVERTING ALL UNUSED FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND AND THE RECORDING OF ALL SUBSEQUENT FUNDS ACCUMULATED BY THE BACOOR TRAFFIC AND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT UNDER THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. CO 11-2019 or An Ordinance Amending Certain Provisions of City Ordinance No. 2013-2 as Amended by City Ordinance No. 2013-047 Otherwise Known as the Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor and Providing Penalties for Violations Hereof created the Bacoor Traffic Management Trust Fund. To wit:

"Section 29. Amendments to Section 53, 54, 55, and 56 of the Revised Traffic Code. Particularly the amendment in section 56.

Section 56. Creation of the Bacoor Traffic Management Trust Fund. There is hereby created a Bacoor Traffic Development Trust Fund generated from all receipts from franchising, supervisory and regulatory fees, fines, and surcharges set forth in this Ordinance, including parking charges, terminal fees, towing fees, and similar imposition for specific services rendered.

All payments, collections, and interest earnings of the said Trust Fund shall be directly remitted to the Office of the City Treasurer and the City Accountant shall keep and maintain a special account therefor. All records related thereto shall likewise be in the custody of the City Accountant.

XXX

The remainder of the trust fund shall be disbursed by the BTMD only to finance traffic improvement projects in the City of Baccor, the operational and training expenses of the BTMD, including the maintenance of its facilities and checkpoints, the purchase of vehicles, uniforms, cctv, and body cameras, and other equipment and the purchase and maintenance of traffic control and safety devices. Any unused balance at the end of the fiscal year in excess of 25% of the previous year's expenditures shall revert to the city government's general fund.

WHEREAS, a Trust Fund is defined by the Local Government Code under Section 309 (b) as follows:

"(b) Trust Funds shall consist of private and public monies which have officially come into the possession of the local government or of a local government official as trustee, agent or administrator, or which have been received as a guaranty for the fulfillment of some obligation. A trust fund shall only be used for the specific purpose for which it was created or for which it came into the possession of the local government unit."

WHEREAS, the General Fund is defined by the Local Government Code under Section 308. To wit:



"Section 308. Local Funds. - Every local government unit shall maintain a General Fund which shall be used to account for such monies and resources as may be received by and disbursed from the local treasury. The General Fund shall consist of monies and resources of the local government which are available for the payment of expenditures, obligations or purposes not specifically declared by law as accruing and chargeable to, or payable from, any other fund."

WHEREAS, in a meeting of the City Local Finance Committee dated 13 June 2023, the Committee observed that the various Trust Funds under the City Government have the tendency to reduce the reported collections under the General Fund because they are not included under the budgeting and accounting rules:

WHEREAS, considering the objective of increasing the collection efficiently, it is more advantageous and practicable to assign the Trust Fund under the Bacoor Traffic Management Department (BTMD) to the General Fund with the assurance that the necessary programs and projects germane to the purpose of its collection will be appropriated accordingly;

WHEREAS, under Section 458 (a)(2)(xii) of the Local Government Code empowered the Sangguniang Panlungsod to:

"Approve the annual and supplemental budgets of the city government and appropriate funds for specific programs, projects, services and activities of the city, or for other purposes not contrary to law, in order to promote the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants,"

WHEREAS, Section 11 (2)(i) of Republic Act No. 10160 or the Charter of the City of Bacoor also empowered the Sangguniang Panlungsod to:

(i) Approve the annual and supplemental budgets of the city government and appropriate funds for specific programs; projects, services and activities of the City, or for other purposes not contrary to law, in order to promote the general welfare of the City and its inhabitants: Provided, That no annual or supplemental budget shall be approved without deliberation and hearing to be attended by the respective heads of all the departments, units or offices of the city government and by reputable representatives of civil society, church groups, irrespective of denomination, and the media;"

WHEREAS, it is declared as a Fundamental Principle in Local Fiscal Administration, particularly under Section 305 (e) of the Local Government Code that:

"(e) Trust funds in the local treasury shall not be paid out except in fulfillment of the purpose for which the trust was created or the funds received."

WHEREAS, the second paragraph of Section 344 provides for the disbursement of special or trust funds as follows:

"In cases of special or trust funds, disbursements shall be approved by the administrator of the fund."

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend City Ordinance No. CO 11-2019 to abolish the Bacoor Traffic Management Trust Fund and revert the unutilized





amounts therein to the General Fund and record all the subsequent funds received by the same Department to the General Fund;

WHEREAS, the collections accruing to the BTMD Fund are no different from local tax and regulatory collections, and no specific external funding s are expected to be transferred thereto;

WHEREAS, the Amending Ordinance shall also provide assurance that the collected fund that will be reverted or recorded to the General Fund shall be used or disbursed for the purposes enumerated in Section 29 of City Ordinance No. CO 11-2019 to ensure unhampered and efficient delivery of public service in transportation, traffic management, and public safety by January 2024;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority of this committee to formulate or adopt such policy or plan of action that will ensure the effective discharge of its functions, the City Local Finance Committee, RESOLVED to recommend to the City Mayor the following:

- To amend City Ordinance No. CO 11-2019 for the purpose of abolishing the Bacoor Traffic Management Trust Fund effective 2024;
- To revert all unutilized funds therein to the General Fund and to record all subsequent thereafter under the General Fund; and
- To have the amending ordinance provide assurance that the necessary programs and projects germane to the purpose of its collection will be appropriated accordingly.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 29 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 11-2019 (REVISED TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOOR) CREATING THE BACOOR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT TRUST FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVERTING ALL UNUSED FUNDS TO THE GENERAL, FUND AND RECORDING OF ALL SUBSEQUENT FUNDS ACCUMULATED BY THE BACOOR TRAFFIC AND MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT TO THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, a Trust Fund is defined by the Local Government Code under Section 309 (b) as follows:

"(b) Trust Funds shall consist of private and public monies which have officially come into the possession of the local government or of a local government official as trustee, agent or administrator, or which have been received as a guaranty for the fulfillment of some obligation. A trust fund shall only be used for the specific purpose for which it was created or for which it came into the possession of the local government unit."

WHEREAS, the General Fund is defined by the Local Government Code under Section 308. To wit:

"Section 308. Local Funds, - Every local government unit shall maintain a General Fund which shall be used to account for such monies and resources as may be received by and disbursed from the local treasury. The General Fund shall consist of monies and resources of the local government which are available for the payment of expenditures, obligations or purposes not specifically declared by law as accruing and chargeable to, or payable from, any other fund."

WHEREAS, the City Local Finance Committee (CLFC) issued a CLFC Resolution No. 01, Series of 2023 recommending the approval of an ordinance that will amend the recording of the funds in the BTMTF for this Year 2023 by recording in and reverting to the General Fund, and that will abolish the BTMTF from the Year 2024 onwards;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoot, Cavite that:

Section 1. Amend Section 29 of CO 11-2019.

Section 29 of City Ordinance No. 11-2019 amending Section 56 of the Revised Traffic Code is hereby amended to read:

"Section 56.

XXX

- c) Twenty percent (20%) of the total accumulated amount in the Trust Fundis to be shared equally by all the Units under the BTMD before the end of the fiscal year subject to compliance with all relevant government rules and policies.
- d) The remaining seventy percent (70%) of the Trust Fund shall be recorded in and reverted to the General Fund and may be disbursed for purposes as may be defined by the local chief executive or in accordance with the usual rules and regulations for disbursement of the General Fund.

Provided further that before the end of everyFiscal Quarter, any unutilized collection or funds in the Trust Fund allocated to traffic aides, barangays, and the BTMD in accordance with Section 56.a, 56.b, and 56.c of the Traffic Code, shall be recorded in and reverted to the General Fund.

All provisions of City Ordinance No. 11-2019, City Ordinance No. 2013-2, and City Ordinance No. 2013-047inconsistent with this Section are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Recording of the unutilized funds in BTMTF for Year 2023.

All unutilized collections or funds under the BTMTF upon effectivity of this Agreement shall be recorded in and reverted to the General Fund.

Section 3. Effect of the Amendment stated in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Starting 01 January 2023, the seventy percent (70%) allocation in the BTMF shall be automatically recorded in and reverted to the General Fund without prior need of approval.

Every start of Fiscal Quarter, any unutilized funds or collections from the rhirty percent (30%) shall automatically be recorded in and reverted to the General Fund

Section 4. Separability.

In case certain provisions of this Ordinance are declared void by a court of law, the provisions hereof not affected by the said judicial declaration shall continue to have legal force and effect.

Section 5. Repeal.

All ordinances, resolutions, or executive orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 10. Effectivity,

This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation as prescribed under the Local Government Code.
