After a thorough discussion with the City Legal Officers, Atty. Rey Marco Mendoza and Atty. Marius Sumira, regarding the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Dalta Jonelta Foundation and assured the delivery of free medical and health services with the provision of adequate facilities. The indigent residents of the city of Bacoor, including those in public schools and local government employees will benefit from it. 

MINUTES OF JOINT COMMITTEE MEETING No.SS-04-S-2022

Members present were Councilor Adrielito G. Gawaran, Councilor Simplicio O. Dominguez, Councilor Michael E. Solis, Councilor Reynaldo D. Palabrica, Councilor Alejandro F. Gutierrez, Councilor Levy M. Tela, Atty. Rey Marco Mendoza, Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza and Dra. Consuelo Reyes, Atty. Ireneo Martinez Jr. representatives from Dalta Jonelta Foundation, Inc. (DJFI).

Chairman of Committee on Social Services, Coun. Adrielito Gawaran welcomed the participants and made the introductory remarks at exactly 3:10pm.

Chairman of Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances, Councilor Reynaldo Palabrica presided the hearing. He started by reading the subject matter, "REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH DALTA JONELTA FOUNDATION REGARDING THE FREE MEDICAL SERVICES TO INDIGENT RESIDENTS, PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES". He stated that the objective of Dalta Jonelta Foundation is very timely to this unprecedented health situation in the city of Bacoor.

Dra. Ma. Consuelo C. Reyes explained that the foundation is a charity arm, a non-stock, a non-profit organization, providing comprehensive range of high quality services to the people of Las Pinas City and other nearby communities particularly, Bacoor City. Their topmost advocacy is towards the health care of the less fortunate of the community. She mentioned that the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) during the previous administration were not followed. Thus, they want to offer the same partnership with the Local Government of Bacoor.



Councilor Gawaran asked about the Education services, scholarship or school discounts. Atty. Ireneo Martinez, a legal representative of Dalta Jonelta replied that the Foundation as a social development arm, is tasked to Health, Education and Livelihood programs.

Atty. Rey Marco Mendoza asked, "If the foundation is under socialized medical services program of Bacoor, as there were previous batches of MOA in diagnostic centers, hospitals, funerals and others. If so, DSWD as the proponent has to be consulted on this matter".

Councilor Palabrica stressed that Jonelta is a foundation and not a hospital.

Dra. Consuelo Reyes explained, the foundation facilitate the expenses based on a forwarded billing statement covering the amount under the Guarantee Letter (GL). "As a matter of fact, 30% of Bacoor residents is being catered at Perpetual Hospital", she added.

Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza affirmed that Bacoor residents were referred to Perpetual hospital especially, ICU patients and pregnant women because of lack of hospital facilities in Bacoor. Atty. Ireneo Martinez emphasized that Jonelta is a recognized institution with legal accountability.

Councilor Palabrica asked the requirements in order to qualify on the program. Dra. Consuelo Reyes mentioned the following are necessary; Certificate of Indigency, Application Fee of P50.00, Family of Low Income and an orientation meeting is also required. According to her, there is no financial accountability. Residents may inquire at the Barangay Center for pre-orientation, and the latter will also facilitate the membership.

Councilor Gawaran and Councilor Palabrica recommended to include the members of the Sanggunian Council and the department heads as beneficiaries for emergency purposes. Dra. Ivy Mary Yrastorza suggested that the Sangguniang Council may endorse the members. Medical Missions in Bacoor may be included in the Foundation's objectives as suggested by the two councilors.

Councilor Michael Solis and Councilor Levy Tela, both appreciated what the Foundation offers and they both agreed with the partnership. Councilor Palabrica gratefully pointed out that, we still have to find more ways and means to help the people of Bacoor.

After thorough review of the proposal of Dalta Jonelta Foundation, all members of the council recommended to revise a Legal Tripartite Agreement before finalization. A close coordination with Dalta Jonelta Foundation legal team was respectfully assigned to Atty. Rey Marco Mendoza the preparation of draft Memorandum of Agreement (MOA).



Finally, Committee Chairman Gawaran humbly acknowledged the presence and cooperation of all participants particularly the Dalta Jonelta Foundation representatives.

There are no other matters to discuss, the committee hearing was adjourned at 3:45 P.M.


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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Agreement is made and entered into this ___ day of August 2022 in the City of Bacoor, Cavite, by and between:

The CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, a local government unit of the Philippines, represented herein by its City Mayor, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, acting pursuant to Sangguniang Panglungsod Resolution No._____ dated ____ July 2022, and herein referred to as the "FIRST PARTY";

- and -

DALTA JONELTA FOUNDATION, INC., a non-stock non-profit foundation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with business address at Alabang-Zapote Road, Pampiona III, Las Piñas City, represented by its President, LTC. RICHARD ANTONIO M. TAMAYO and bereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY".

WITNESSETH That:

WHEREAS, the numerous indigent residents of the City of Bacoor have requested the FIRST PARTY for assistance in relation to their medical problems and conditions:

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY desires to extend free medical services to its indigent residents, as well as to public school employees and local government employees and as such suitable hospital facilities are required for such purpose;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY has suitable facilities needed to accomplish the FIRST PARTY's needs for its free medical services program and it has intimated to the FIRST PARTY that it is willing and able to render such medical services to patients referred by FIRST PARTY at the latter's expense:

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY, duly accredited by Philhealth, is one of the referral hospitals of the FIRST PARTY.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, and of the mutual covenants herein contained, the PARTIES have AGREED to be bound, as follows:

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- 1.1 GUARANTEE LETTER (GL). All patients referred by the FIRST PARTY to the SECOND PARTY as service patients under the City of Bacoor Hospitalization Program (CBHP) of the Office of the City Mayor must be issued a GUARANTY LETTER (GL) bearing the signature of the City Mayor of Bacoor. The pro-forma GL to be used by the FIRST PARTY under this Agreement is attached here and made integral part of this Agreement as Annexes "A" "B" and "C". GL's shall be valid for a period of fourteen (14) days only from date of issue as appearing thereon;
- 1.2 The GL shall be deemed to be an acknowledgment by the FIRST PARTY of its obligation to pay for costs, charges, expenses and fees incurred by the SECOND PARTY in the treatment of the service patient from his admission to discharge. A billing statement under the GL shall be submitted by the SECOND PARTY to the FIRST PARTY every end of the month, payable within thirty (30) days from receipt of such statement.
- 1.3 The FIRST PARTY may review the billing statement within fifteen (15) days from receipt. Should the SECOND PARTY receive no notice of dispute as to the content of said billing statement within the stated period, it shall be deemed conclusive as to the amount payable without further need of demand from the SECOND PARTY. The patient or his family member shall be interviewed for profile intake. No interview, no GL. If no GL is presented the SECOND PARTY shall not consider the patient to be covered by the CBHP.
- 1.4 The SECOND PARTY shall temporarily hold the granting of its services to the beneficiaries of CBHP should the FIRST PARTY's unpaid bills reaches the limit set by the SECOND PARTY amounting to Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 500,000.00). The SECOND PARTY shall notify the Office of the Mayor regarding the immediate payment thereof. Resumption of services by the SECOND PARTY shall be done once the obligation of the FIRST PARTY is settled and paid.
- 2.1 Treatment of regular patients. Upon initial assessment, SECOND PARTY shall evaluate the patient's condition and provide an estimate of costs, charges, expenses and fees which may be incurred in the treatment of the patient who will be applying for coverage under the CBHP. This estimate shall be submitted to the Office of the City Mayor for application for coverage in the CBHP. The FIRST PARTY may issue a valid GL which will be submitted by the service patient to the SECOND PARTY for provision of the necessary and appropriate treatment, medical attention and services. Admission under this program/agreement shall be limited strictly to Service Ward facilities of SECOND PARTY.
- 2.2 Should the costs, charges and fees be in excess of the amount covered by the GL, the service patient may apply for additional coverage with the FIRST PARTY only after three (3) months from issuance of the previous GL, and the additional coverage shall be under a new and separate GL.
- 2.3 The SECOND PARTY shall not demand from the service patient bearing a valid GL any deposit or upfront payment as a pre-condition for admission, treatment or discharge. Nor shall it refuse admission by reason of the amount in the GL being deemed as insufficient to cover the patient's complete treatment.

- 3. Treatment of emergency patients. In case of emergency, the SECOND PARTY shall treat and provide emergency medical treatment to a patient in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. The SECOND PARTY may inform the patient regarding the CBHP and may advise the patient or his family to apply for coverage. The application may also be submitted by the nearest of kin or the patient's family member to the FIRST PARTY in behalf of the patient, and the latter is given the next working day, or official twenty-four (24) bours within which to approve or deny such application for GL. Should the application submitted by SECOND PARTY in behalf of the emergency patient remain unacted upon by the FIRST PARTY after the said period shall have lapsed, it cannot be deemed approved, but the patient or his family will have to make a personal follow up with the FIRST PARTY or file another application. No GL will be issued without prior personal interview with patient or his family for intake of patient's profile.
- 4. Medical Services. The rates of professional services of medical practitioners under this Agreement shall be specified in a List of resident physicians, consultant, specialists, nurses and other personnel of SECOND PARTY. The LIST shall also contain available medicines, laboratory services and diagnostic procedures and a copy of the LIST is made an integral part of this Agreement as Arinex "D".
- 5. Visitation of Patients. The FIRST PARTY may visit patients covered by the program during designated visitation hours for the purpose of monitoring the medical conditions of service patients. The representatives of FIRST PARTY may coordinate this visit with the Office of the Deputy Director for Health Operations, subject to existing laws, rules and hospital regulations on visitation and/or copying or disposition of records. Expenses incurred in relation to this paragraph shall be for the expense of the FIRST PARTY.
- 6. Medical Benefits. The SECOND PARTY shall deduct the applicable Philhealth Employees' compensation and other government mandated medical benefits from the billing statement of a service patient. The SECOND PARTY shall be responsible in ensuring that all requirements to avail of this benefit are duly accomplished and submitted by the patient prior to his discharge.
- 7. The SECOND PARTY shall remit to the FIRST PARTY any compensable charges paid or reimbursed by the PHILHEALTH in excess of the amount deducted by the SECOND PARTY from the account of the patient within thirty (3) days from receipt of payment from Philhealth. Should Philhealth remittance be less than the amount deducted by the SECOND PARTY, the discrepancy shall be included in the monthly billing statement of the SECOND PARTY to the FIRST PARTY.
- The SECOND PARTY shall participate in the Special Bacoor Resident (SBR Card) Program of the FIRST PARTY and abide by the rules and regulations issued by the City Mayor in relation thereto.
- 9. Validity. This Agreement shall be valid for one year beginning on _August 2022 until __ August 2023. It shall be renewed automatically for a period of one (1) year after expiry date, unless either party gives notice of its intention not to renew, at lesst thirty days prior to expiration. Either party may pro-terminate this

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agreement on valid and equitable grounds by giving the other party at least thirty-day prior written notice.

10. Data Privacy and Protection. The parties agree that each will comply with their respective obligations as required under the applicable privacy and data protection laws, using appropriate technical and organizational measures for the processing, integrity, confidentiality and security of personal information of the CBHP beneficiaries.
