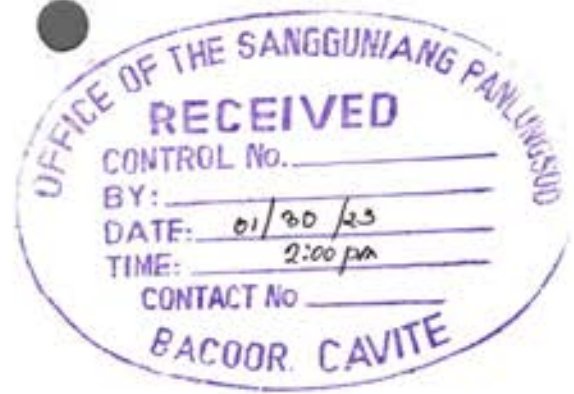

The Office of the Mayor endorsed a proposed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to Sangguniang Panlungsod for necessary actions. The proposed MOA between the city government of Bacoor and the School will provide educational grant/and or assistance to the qualified students within the City of Bacoor.

The MOA involves the schools willing to be part in the implementation of the above-mentioned program to be called "**S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project**". Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) students are the beneficiaries of the said program.

Educational grant and/or assistance to be given to the qualified students provided by the LGU Bacoor in behalf of the school will be Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00). It is the response to the needs of the students and support to the parents of the learners.

The implementation of the said agreement will encourage the students to work hard knowing that the city government of Bacoor well-planned the said program to support financially.



MINUTES OF COMMITTEE HEARING

The Committee on Education, Science and Technology headed by Hon. Guerrero supported the draft memorandum of agreement endorsed by the Office of the Mayor. The local government units are authorized to partner with public and private schools through the provision of educational grant/or assistance to qualified students as mandated by law.

A draft Memorandum of Agreement between the city government of Bacoor and School who is willing to take part in the implementation of the above-mentioned program was submitted to Sangguniang Panlungsod for necessary action.

"S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project" shall apply only to qualified Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) residing in the City of Bacoor. All qualified students must undergo assessment and evaluation.


Through the implementation of MOA, educational grant and/or assistance will be given to qualified students provided by the LGU Bacoor. Giving financial assistance is the response of LGU Bacoor to the parents in support for the educational expenses.

The parents, LGU Bacoor and the school have certain roles indicated in the provision. Grounds for termination or forfeiture of educational grant/or assistance also included in the provision.

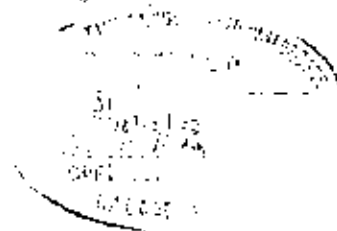

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into and executed this ____ day of _____, 20__ (the "Effective Date") at the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

<NAME OF SCHOOL>, an educational institution established under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal address at <insert Complete Office Address> represented in this Agreement by its <Position Name/Designation>, <COMPLETE NAME> and herein referred to as "SCHOOL"

and

The CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR a local government unit duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Molino Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented in this Agreement by its City Mayor, Hon. **STRIKE B. REVILLA**, and hereinafter referred to as "LGU BACOOR"

"PARTY" shall mean either SCHOOL or LGU BACOOR, if applicable, while the term "PARTIES" shall mean SCHOOL and LGU BACOOR, collectively

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, LGU BACOOR is one of the component cities of the Province of Cavite, authorized to partner with public and private educational institutions in the upliftment of the lives of its youth through the provision of educational grant and/or assistance to qualified students;

WHEREAS, the SCHOOL is an educational institution that provides quality education among students, and sought the assistance of the LGU BACOOR to provide educational grant and/or assistance to its students;

WHEREAS, LGU BACOOR and the SCHOOL recognize the need to establish a partnership and cooperation in giving educational grant and/or assistance (the "S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project" or the "Project" for brevity) to qualified students who are residents of the City of Bacoor;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the PARTIES hereto agree as follows:

- PROJECT COVERAGE.** The S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project shall apply only to qualified Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) students who are residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite
- OBJECTIVE.** This Project aims to provide financial assistance to qualified Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) students who are residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite to augment the students' educational needs. This is LGU BACOOR's response to support the parents in

sustaining their children's right to education considering the effect of COVID-19 pandemic to their present economic condition

- iii. **POLICIES** For the purposes of implementing the Project, the following policies are hereby enumerated:

A. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **PROGRAM BENEFITS AND BENEFICIARIES.** The educational grant and/or assistance to be provided by the LGU BACCOR to the qualified students, in behalf of the SCHOOL, under this Project shall be for the amount of **FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 5,000.00) ONLY PER STUDENT BENEFICIARY** who are residents of the City of Bacoor Province of Cavite

The qualified beneficiaries under this Project shall be exclusively for

- Junior High School Students from private schools, and
- Senior High School Students from private schools

2. **PROJECT QUALIFICATIONS.** For this Program, the following student qualifications shall be strictly followed as indicated:

- a. Residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite;
- b. Must be from low income families or those whose income is not enough to support the educational needs of their children;
- c. Must have no failing grades, and
- d. Must undergo assessment and evaluation at the concerned *Strike sa Serbisyo* Action Centers that cover the students' respective Barangay.

B. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **ROLES OF THE PARENTS**

- a. Attend all meetings concerning the Project;
- b. Provide needed documents as requirement for the proper implementation of the Project;
- c. Monitor and supervise their children and ensure that the parents abide by the terms and conditions of the Agreement;
- d. Consult, advise, or inform the *Strike sa Serbisyo* on Scholarship Program of any concerns or queries that may arise during the implementation of the Project;
- e. Perform and participate on any and all other functions and responsibilities concerning the Project.

2. **ROLES OF LGU BACCOR**

- a. Conduct assessment of the student beneficiaries.
- b. Evaluate and validate any and all documents submitted by the student beneficiaries
- c. Coordinate with the SCHOOL on matters regarding the Project
- d. Award and distribute the financial assistance to the student beneficiaries
- e. Prepare all necessary documents for the distribution and liquidation of the Project fund.
- f. Prepare an Accomplishment Report; and
- g. Arrange meetings with the Parents and the SCHOOL

3. ROLES OF THE SCHOOL.

- a. Recommend deserving and qualified students to the Project.
- b. Monitor and supervise the student's academic performance
- c. Provide and submit the status report of the students subject of the Project
- d. Attend consultation meetings concerning the implementation of the Project, and
- e. Inform and advise the *Sinke sa Serbisyo* on Scholarship Program on any concern or queries regarding the Project

C. GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION/FOREFEITURE OF EDUCATIONAL GRANT AND/OR ASSISTANCE

1. If any of the PARTY have violated any of the provisions as stipulated in the Agreement
2. Voluntary withdrawal from the course/program by either of the PARTY
3. Grave violation of existing rules and regulations and/or policies of the LGU BACOOD and/or SCHOOL.
4. Grantee shall maintain a GPA of _____ () without any failing grades both in academic and non-academic subjects during the effectivity of the Grant

D. PROCEDURE

1. LGU BACOOD shall immediately disseminate the availability of the Project slot allocation
2. LGU BACOOD shall prepare a shortlist of the best qualified candidates and submit it to the SCHOOL.

3. Both PARTIES shall come up with the list of approved student beneficiaries at the very start of every academic year.
4. The procedures in this Agreement shall not be amended without prior written agreement of both PARTIES.

IV. **EFFECTIVITY.** This Agreement governing the *S.T.R.I.K.E. sa Karunungan Scholarship Project* shall immediately take effect upon signing by both parties and shall continue to be effective for a period of _____ () years from _____ until _____ unless sooner terminated, revoked or cancelled by either of the PARTY, with or without cause, by written notice to the other PARTY at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination.
