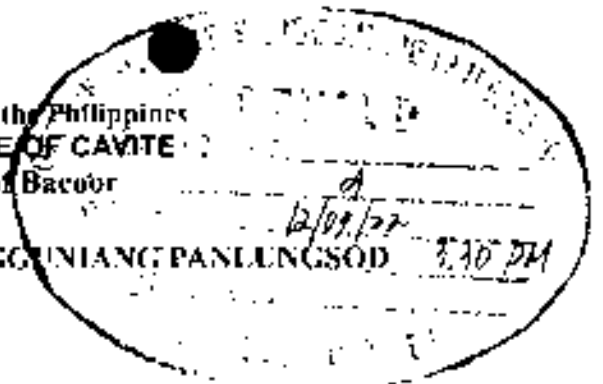

The committee hearing was conducted on November 28, 2022, 1:30 PM at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall, led by the Committee Chairman Hon. Levy M. Tela together with Committee Vice Chairman Reynaldo Fabian and Committee Member Hon. Reynaldo Palabrica and Hon. Rogelio Nolasco, CENRO OIC Mr. Rolando Vocalan, from the office of City Legal Services Atty. Nathaniel de Leon. Representatives from Philippine Wildlife Sentinel Lt. Col. Crispin Datiles, Lt. Col. Allan Glomar, Maj. Pepito Separa, 2Lt. Ramil Octavio, and Sgt. Jay Riyadh Egar.

Representative from the Philippine Wildlife Sentinel (Philippine Mountain Trooper Regiment) said the purposes of their organization are to help and rescue animals. They provide protection and security to animals that not allowed to be sold. PWS is a Non-Government Organization and they are affiliated with the DENR CALABARZON. They have enough manpower resources, well-trained personnel. The PWS is a volunteer group that has the primary objective of environmental protection and wildlife preservation.

After a thorough review of the above-mentioned subject matter, the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources Chairman Hon. Tela said the PWS have the skill and knowledge for the rescue for the wildlife. Both parties are cognisant of the need to collaborate and forge an alliance between and among them to improve public services, enhance political accountability and social responsibility.

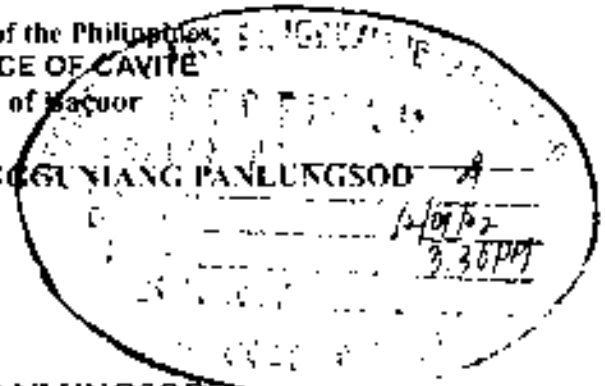

Hon. Palabrica, request to have a training or orientation regarding search and rescue for the wildlife. How to proper handling endangered animals.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

This Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2022, in _____, Philippines by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR**, a local government unit created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, represented herein by **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, with authorization from the Sangguniang Panlungsod under City Resolution No. _____, in the capacity as the **CITY MAYOR**, with office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Dasmagay Extension, Bacoor City, hereinafter referred to as the "**FIRST PARTY**",

and

Philippine Wildlife Sentinel (Philippine Mountain Trooper Regiment), a non-profit & non-government organization with registered address at Trinidad, Cavite, La Paz, Brig. Sto. Tomas, Davao, 8808, represented herein by its Unified Commanding General Vice Admiral Francisco Ramos III, hereinafter referred to as the "**SECOND PARTY**".

Collectively referred hereafter as "**PARTIES**".

WITNESSETH THAT

WHEREAS, the **FIRST PARTY** thru its City Mayor is mandated to issue and regulate policies and plans, a major role in a community's development, provide the links between the people and government, address its community's problems and concerns, enforce policies and hold influence over its constituents;

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY** thru their voluntary involvement in local and community development projects have demonstrated that they are capable workers in nature building and can contribute effectively to the welfare of our society and the progress of the community they actively serve;

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** are fully cognizant of the need to collaborate and forge an alliance between and among them to improve public services and work patterns, accountability and social responsibility;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the **PARTIES** agree to undertake the following:

1. COMMITMENT OF PARTIES

- a. Establish networks and services between and among themselves for the exchange of data, information or reports;
- b. The **FIRST PARTY** shall provide support in terms of material and resources when conducting community services. The **SECOND PARTY** will assist the **FIRST PARTY** in terms of manpower resources;
- c. Both **PARTIES** agree to collaborate in developing reports, communication pathways and other initiatives that will leverage resources and advance a mutually shared mission of protecting the environment.

- c. Both **PARTIES** agree to commit and share resources and other support services to implement the community projects.
- d. Both **PARTIES** agree to Document the implementation processes and lessons learned for possible replication in other subsequent cases.

II. DISCLAIMER

This agreement in no way restricts both **PARTIES** from participating in similar activities with other public or private agencies, organizations, and individuals.

III. PERIODIC REVIEW

This Agreement, even when in force, shall be subject to periodic review every year by both **PARTIES** or upon the serving of a written request for review by one party at any time in between the scheduled review for the sole purpose of updating the parameters affecting the objectives of the agreement-based project.

IV. EFFECTIVITY

This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing hereon by both **PARTIES**.

V. TERMINATION AND DISPUTE

Any violation of the provisions stipulated shall cause the suspension, termination or revocation of this Agreement, whichever may appropriately apply. Any dispute that may arise in the interpretation or implementation of this Agreement shall be resolved amicably through mutual good faith negotiation and consultation. Further, this Agreement may be terminated by either party upon the serving of written notice to the other party thirty (30) days prior to the proposed date of the termination, provided that said written notice shall contain full justification for the demand for termination.

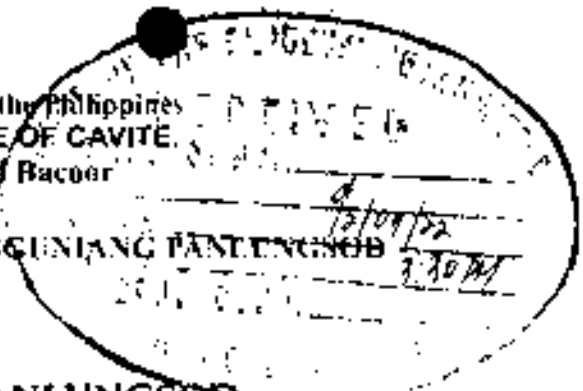

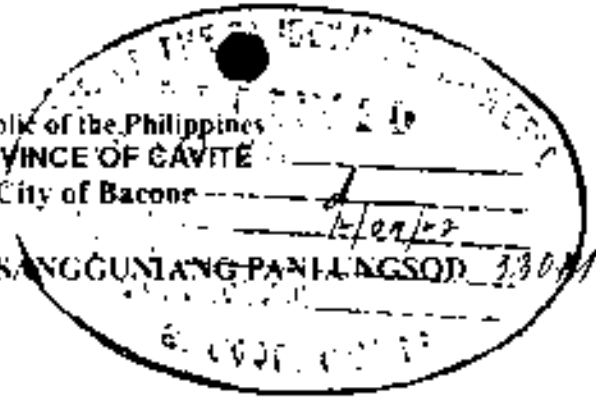
