WHEREAS, under Section 27 (b) of the Universal Health Care Act (Republic Act No. 11223) the Department of Health (DOH) was mandated to institute a licensing and regulatory system for stand-alone health facilities, including those providing ambulatory or primary care services and other modes of health service provision. Pursuant to the said mandate, the DOH released Administrative Order No. 2020-0047 on 30 September 2020 entitled "RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE LICENSURE OF PRIMARY HEALTH CARE FACILITIES IN THE PHILIPPINES" (AO 47).

WHEREAS, the city government needs to spend at least Php 45,000,000 00 in order to make the seven (7) health centers in the City of Baccor, Cavite compliant with the various requirements under AO 47. Considering that the city government has yet to fully recover from the revenue collection challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, it does not have the said funds needed to renovate the said health centers in compliance with so AO 47.

WHEREAS, the city government also does not have the funds needed to pay for the salaries of the five (5) medical technologists required to be assigned to each of the said health centers under AO 47.

WHEREAS, while AO 47 allows local governments to outsource the said laboratory services to privately owned health facilities in the City, a quick assessment made by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the said private health facilities showed that many of them are also presently incapable of complying with the stringent requirements of the said administrative order.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Alde Joselito Pagulayan, duly approved by the rest of the city council, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the 5" Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite in regular session duly assembled to respectfully appeal to the Department of Health (DOH) through Undersecretary Maria Rosario Vergeire to revise the current requirements for the licensing of primary care facilities under Administrative Order No. 2020-0047 pursuant to Republic Act No. 11223 so as to give the Bacoor City Government enough time to raise the funds needed to renovate or construct the various public health care centers in the City of Bacoor, Cavite.



RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Office of the City Mayor, the CHO, the DOH, the University of the Philippines-Office of the National Administrative Register (UP-ONAR), and other government agencies concerned with copies of this Resolution.
