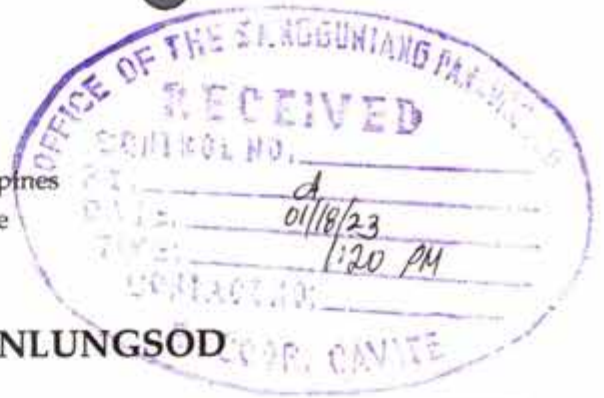

### JOINT COMMITTEE REPORT No. POPS-006-S-2023

Acting on the referral, a committee hearing was conducted last January 12, 2023 regarding the above-mentioned subject with the following attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

The purpose of this inquiry is to investigate the circumstances surrounding a concert event entitled "Mayonnaise 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tour" which resulted in massive traffic jam and overcrowding.

Thus, the committee respectfully reports that:

1. The organizers of the said concert namely, Miss Rebecca Licuanan, Jhoiye Castillo and Levi May Magdarag (employees of SOMO-A Vista Mall) while under oath, admitted that they did not secure the necessary permit nor coordinate with the concerned agency/s.
2. The event organizers only asked for the assistance of the BFP-Bacoor personnel and the visibility of fire truck on the concert ground.

3. The crowd is beyond the limit capacity of the area and possible occurrence of stampede is likely to happen due to the uncontrolled movement of the crowd.
4. Incident report shows that two (2) individual (female) who “collapsed” due to difficulty of breathing while inside the concert grounds. The on-duty BDRRMO personnel confirmed that several attendees of the concert also experienced the same situation.
5. As per Provincial PNP Representative on-ground during the event, there has been five (5) reports of gadgets lost. During this time, local PNP where of no representation in the event.
6. As per BTMD personnel on ground managing the traffic, there has been no coordination for traffic control and augmentation of resources.
7. SOMO-A Vista Mall Management did not extend any help or take any action to check the situation of the injured or affected concert goers after the event.
8. The event organizer was ordered to stop the event due to the overcrowding situation but they decided to push through until the last act of the concert.

### RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Committee respectfully recommends the following:

1. The Sangguniang Panlungsod Secretary shall draft an ordinance or a resolution requiring all concert organizers and other big events which would entail heavy turnout of attendees to secure a special permit and coordinate with the concerned agencies like, BPLO, PNP, BFP, BTMD, and BDRRMO a month or two prior to the event in order to map out the corresponding security measures in the actual venue, rerouting plan in the vicinity of the venue, deployment of event marshalls and force multipliers from concerned LGUs to avoid the same mistakes which took place in this recent event.
2. The City Legal Office shall submit their position paper or legal opinion with recommendation as to what cases should be filed against the organizers and what sanctions would be meted out for the venue owner.



### MINUTES OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE HEARING No. POPS-006-S-2023

On January 12, 2023, the Committee conducted a committee hearing regarding the above-mentioned subject matter with the following attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

Coun. Gutierrez acknowledged the presence of the attendees and gave his opening statement afterwards.

According to Mr. Christian Gawaran of the BPLO, he is not aware of the said concert event. The concert organizers did not secure any permit from their office.

According to Miss Sofia Pardo, Barangay Molino IV Secretary, the event organizers only asked assistance for ambulance.

Miss Rebecca Licuanan, Jhoiye Castillo and Levi May Magdarag, event organizers and employees of SOMO-A Vista Mall were asked to take their oath before the committee.

According to Miss Levi May Magdarag, Marketing Officer of SOMO-A Vista Mall, they did not expect an overwhelming large crowd of attendees for the event. They asked assistance for ambulance from BFP. They also called 161 for assistance but they can't be reached. They also provide barricades and railings for the event.

According to Miss Jhoiye Castillo, Marketing Head of SOMO-A Vista Mall, they do not secure temporary business permit ever since. They did not also inform the concerned agency/s like the BTMD for assistance.

According to Coun. Gawaran, the event organizers did not receive any assistance from PNP and BTMD because they do not have the needed necessary permit.

The Marketing Head apologized for such shortcoming but Coun. Gawaran did not accept the apology.

According to SFO4 Jonasis Paile of BFP, the event organizers only asked assistance for fire truck to standby. Due to the absence of necessary permit the BFP considered the event postponed.

According to BDRRMO ten (10) people were hurt and injured during the event. 161 assisted and responded to the victims.

According to BFP, two (2) individuals collapsed due to difficulty in breathing while inside the concert grounds.

According to Councilors Palabrica, Tela and Fabian, the event organizers committed a violation and they admit it without hesitation.

According to FO3 Louie Panes of the BFP, when Chief Fire Officer Gardose learned that there is already an overcrowding on the ground, the latter gave an instruction to discontinue the concert. But the organizers decided to push through until the last act of the performers. Crowd estimate is forty thousand (40,000) people but the capacity of the concert venue is only twenty seven thousand (27,000).

According to Atty. Jess Salvador, representative from the Office of the City Administrator, there is a negligence on the part of the concert organizers. He is looking on the possibility of pressing charges against the organizers. He also suggested that event or mall organizers may place bonds that may be answerable for all liabilities.

According to Coun. Gutierrez, big events should have proper coordination with the concerned agencies like, security deployment plan, traffic rerouting plan, <sup>FORCE</sup> ~~CROSS~~ multipliers from LGUs, meetings for proper coordination in order to prevent similar situations from occurring in the future.

According to PSSG Wilson Mendoza, there has been five (5) reports of gadgets lost. During this time, the local PNP were of no representation in the event.

According to Atty. Marius Sumira of the City Legal Office, the concert organizers are liable and violated the existing revenue and traffic code which may result to the suspension of their business permit.

Having no other matters to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned at exactly 2:50pm.

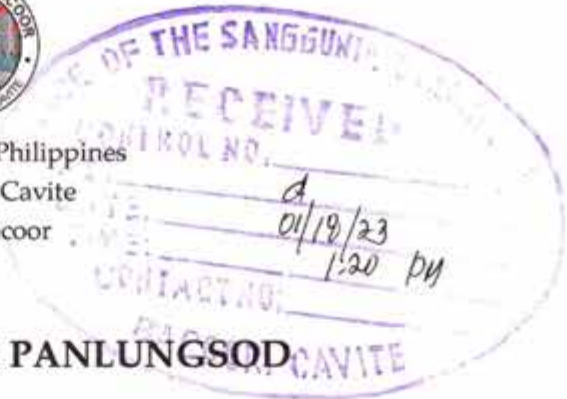
