COMMITTEE REPORT No. SC-001-S-2023

FINDINGS:

After review of the Senior Citizens Federation's By-Laws under Memorandum Circular No. 01-2023 (see ANNEX A), the Committee proposed the following amendments:

Article VI -Officers - section 1 – Composition

- a. The officers of the Federation (Local Barangay Senior Citizens Association) shall be compose of the President (elected), Vice President (Elected), Secretary and Treasurer (appointed by the President), and 15 Board of Directors (elected).
- b. The following officers shall be appointed by the President from the elected Board Of Directors and discretely with the concurrence of the majority of the elected Board of Directors
- c. The Auditor shall be nominated and elected by all the elected officers.

Part II – By Laws- Article 1 – Election of Officers – Section 1

The Committee on Nomination and Election shall supervise the conduct of election in coordination with the representative of DSWD, representative from the **Office of Senior Citizens Affairs**, and the **Barangay Chairman** to oversee and monitor the proceedings.

Article V – Section 3 – Term of Office

- a. The **new set of elected** officers and Board of Directors shall serve for a term of three (3) years and can be reelected for not more than three (3) years **or two (2) consecutive terms**.

The requirement for a candidate who is allowed to run for election that he/she must be a member for 6 years was reduced to 1 year.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Senior Citizens Federation represented by its president, Ms. Nenita Reyes and the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs Office represented by its head, Atty. Venus De Castro agreed to formulate a uniform By-Laws with the assistance of our City Legal Office incorporating the above findings.

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 01-2023

TO : ALL PROVINCIAL,CITY, MUNICIPAL AND BARANGAY CHAPTER
SUBJECT : GUIDELINES OF SYNCHRONIZED ELCTION FROM CY 2023
FROM : MR. CIRIACO B. ANGELES
DATE : JANUARY 10, 2023

Pursuant to the provision of the PFSCACI Constitution and bylaws, as amended, (Article III, Section 2 – Membership and Article IV, Section 2 - Election), the schedule of Synchronized Election is as follow;

- a. January - Election of Barangay Senior Citizens Association
- b. February - Election of Municipal Senior Citizens Association
- c. March - Election of Provincial Senior Citizens Association
- d. April - Election of Regional Senior Citizens Association
- e. May - Election of National FSCAP

SECTION 3 - Date of election for the Barangay, Municipal/City, Provincial levels are discretionary and not mandatory but within the prescribed month stated above.

SECTION 4 - In order to obviate, confusion in the term of office of the Board of Trustees, those BOTS whose term of office will expire before the synchronized election are considered resigned and can run for election.

ARTICLE V

Section 3 - Term of Office

- a. The officer and members of the board of Director shall serve for a term of three (3) years and can be reelected for not more than three (3) years.
- b. The new set of elected officers under the new constitution and by-laws shall serve until the last day of December 2026. Therefore, they will be elected for a term of three (3) year.
- c. Synchronized elections beginning January 2023 will be held simultaneously from the barangays to the province up to March 2026 and every three (3) years thereafter.
- d. Complaint and Grievances. Shall be accept and decide on complaints and grievances on matter arising within the Federation.
- e. Nomination and Election. Shall formulate and recommend a set of criteria for member to be eligible for nomination as well as rule and regulations governing procedures.

ARTICLE VI Officers

Section 1 - Composition

The officers of the Federation shall be composed of the President, Executive Vice-President, one or more Vice President who shall represent geographical subdivision and Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Auditor, Public Relations Officer and Business Managers

PART II – BY LAWS

ARTICLE 1 ELECTION of OFFICERS

The committee on nomination and election shall supervise the conduct of election in coordination with a representative of OSWED to oversee and monitor the proceedings.

Section 7
President


Before the start of the meeting of the elected officers of the Federation, namely Executive Vice President, Vice President, and all appointed officers, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, Public Relations officers, and Business manager shall be announced to the present members by the Committee on Nominations and shall be proclaimed therewith. Greeting ceremony shall be held in a separate activity and at a place and date most appropriate for the occasion.



MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE HEARING NO. SC-001-S-2023

1. The committee hearing started at exactly 9:40am.
2. Councilor Rey Palabrica presided over the hearing and acknowledged the presence of the committee members and resource persons.
3. Invocation was led by Atty. Venus de Castro.
4. Hon. Palabrica explained that after review of the Senior Citizens Federation's By-Laws, the recommendation of the Committee for possible amendments were based on the existing By-Laws provided by the Federation (Memorandum Circular No. 01-2023) but modified and simplified. Below are the following suggestions:

Article VI -Officers - section 1 – Composition

- a. The officers of the Federation (Local Barangay Senior Citizens Association) shall be compose of the President (elected), Vice President (Elected), Secretary and Treasurer (appointed by the President), and 15 Board of Directors (elected).

Note: Sa composition nilagay na din ang 15 Board of Directors na elected sa kadahilanang ang basis ay nasa Article V section 3 - term of office which states that The officer and members of the board of Director shall serve for a term

of three (3) years and can be reelected for not more than three (3) years. Meaning meron talagang mga BOD.

- b. **The following officers shall be appointed by the President from the elected Board Of Directors and discretely with the concurrence of the majority of the elected Board of Directors**

Note: The President has the power to appoint the secretary, assistant secretary, treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Public Relations Officer, and Business Manager. Yong na appoint ni President should be approved by the majority of the elected BOD.

- c. **The Auditor shall be nominated and elected by all the elected officers.**

Part II – By Laws- Article 1 – Election of Officers – Section 1

The Committee on Nomination and Election shall supervise the conduct of election in coordination with the representative of DSWD, representative from the **Office of Senior Citizens Affairs**, and the **Barangay Chairman** to oversee and monitor the proceedings.

Article V – Section 3 – Term of Office

- a. **The new set of elected officers and Board of Directors shall serve for a term of three (3) years and can be reelected for not more than three (3) years or two (2) consecutive terms.**

5. Sa 12 Barangays na nagkaroon na ng eleksyon ay napagkasunduang uulitin upang sundin ang bagong systema na kasama ang pag elect ng fifteen (15) BOD.
6. The Sanggunian will pass a resolution on Monday, February 6, 2023 directing the CSWD to deploy personnel to supervise the election as well as OSCA representative in 10 venues everyday.
7. Who can vote in the election – in the barangay level, those registered senior citizen in a particular association with senior citizens ID issued by the city will be allowed to vote. Ang pagkulekta ng “butaw” ay allowed ngunit hindi ito basihan upang makaboto ang isang senior. Ang association membership fee ay aalisin upang lahat ng senior ay magkaroon ng right to vote. It was suggested na sa isang barangay ay may masterlist of members at magkaroon na lang ng remarks kung ang isang myembro ay “paying” or “non-paying” kung saan ang nasabing paying ay makakasali sa mga perks at benefits mula sa gobyerno at sa asosasyon samantalang ang “non-paying” ay makatanggap lamang kapag ang pondo ay galing sa gobyerno. In addition, the “non-paying” members are allowed to vote but are not allowed to run and be elected except in areas where “butaw” is not being implemented.



8. Regarding sa requirement ng isang candidate na at least 6yrs ay napagkasunduang ibaba ito sa 1yr dahil sapat na ito upang ang isang myembro na magkaroon ng familiarization sa kanilang asosasyon.
9. Hon. Palabrica suggested to convince the associations to adopt the By-Laws of the Federation para maresolve at malign ang mga by laws ng bawat Barangay at hikayatin na ito ay magpa accredit sa Sangguniang Panlungsod kung saan ay magiging isa ito sa mga gagawing requirements ng Sangunian upang sila ay maacredit.
10. Atty. De Castro suggested that OSCA and Federation will sit down together in the formulation of By-laws. Hon. Palabrica agreed and suggested to include the City Legal Office to assist OSCA and Federation para ayusin at magkaroon ng uniform by laws ang Senior Citizen patterned to the constitutional by laws ng Federation of the Philippines.

There being no other matters of concerned or for discussion, the Committee Hearing was adjourned at exactly 10:40am.

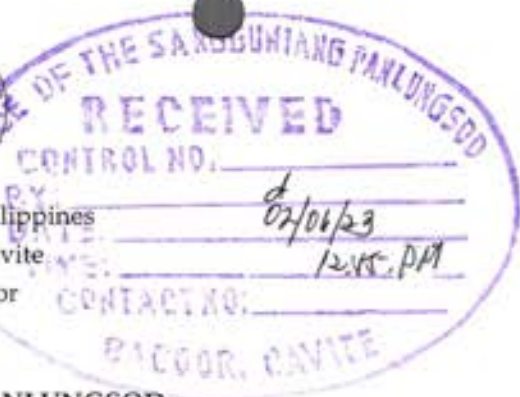

2. Councilor Simplicio Dominguez presided over the hearing and acknowledged the presence of the committee members and resource persons.
3. Invocation was led by Jocelyn Bautista.
4. Reading of Committee Hearing Protocol by Arlene Hernandez.
5. Reading of letter received regarding the above subject matter by Hon. Rey Palabrica
6. Clarification on item #1

Ms. Nenita Reyes, Senior Citizen President ay nagpahayag kung bakit nagkaroon ng alituntunin. "Ang election ngayon ay mayroong amendment na synchronize ang election na binase sa National Federation of Senior Citizen sa buong Pilipinas". Ipinaliwanag din ni Ms. Reyes na ang alituntunin patungkol sa isang miyembro na makakalahok sa eleksyon ay kailangan miyembro ng Samahan ng mahigit sa anim na buwan ay depende pa din sa pangulo ng senior citizen association sa bawat barangay ayon sa nakasulat sa kanilang by-laws. Kaya may nakalagay na "bagaman" na ibig sabihin ay depende pa din sa pangulo ng asosasyon at dapat bago mag eleksyon ay mayroong general assembly upang ipaliwanag ng bawat senior president kung ano ang mga alituntunin na napapaloob sa kanilang by-laws.

Sa opinion ni Hon. Palabrica, ang nasabing provision ay medyo critical dahil sa kanyang pananaw na kung siya ang incumbent president at sa tingin nya na ang isang botante ay wala pang anim na buwan at sa kanyang palagay ay hindi sya iboboto nito, ito ay hindi nya na bibigyan ng pagkakataong bomoto. "It will defeat the purpose of principle of democracy that everybody should participate in electing their leaders. Their right to vote will be suppressed. Ang suggestion ko diyan sa provision na iyan ay dapat idefine na lang natin sino ang mga pwedeng makaboto at dapat simplified and specific ang qualification ng boboto".

Si Atty. Venus de Castro ay nagpahayag din ng kanyang opinion ukol sa nasabing provision na dapat ang tao kapag 60yo na ay dapat pahintulutan ng bomoto maging miyembro man sya ng asosasyon o hindi. Ito ay inayonan ni Hon. Rogelio Nolasco sa kondisyong may senior ID na ito. Ganun din ang pag sang ayon ni Kapitan Jun Enriquez dito at binigyang diin nya na ang binibigay ng ating pamahalaan para sa mga senior ay para sa pangkalahatang senior ng isang barangay at hindi lamang para sa miyembro ng asosasyon kaya dapat lahat ng senior ay may karapatang bomoto at pumili ng kanilang lider. Sumang-ayon din dito si Mr. Benny Boquerin ng Camella Homes, Mambog 1 at ayon sa kanya "the moment na nakakuha ang isang senior ng ID, automatic naenjoy ng isang senior ang kanyang discount meaning to say that they are being recognized and given the privilege as senior citizen kaya dapat ganun din pag dating sa botohan. Once senior, you have the right to vote and be voted upon". Dagdag pa nya na sa kanyang experience ay may mga asosasyon na kung saan sya ay humingi ng kopya ng kanilang by-laws ngunit wala itong maipakita.

Sa usaping pagpapamyembro sa asosasyon, nagpahayag si Ms. Reyes ng kanyang saloobin at obserbasyon na simula pa ng sya ay naupo bilang president ng senior federation ay may tinatawag na na active at inactive members. Paano malalaman ng isang asosasyon kung ang isang senior ay gusto maging member kung hindi sila lalapit para magpamyembro dito dahil sa isang barangay ay napakarami ng mga senior at mahirap malaman kung ilan na ang mga bago na senior. Sumasang ayon din sya na dapat lahat ay maging myembro ng asosasyon dahil ito ay para sa lahat ng mga senior pero paano naman yong ayaw lumapit at hindi naman lahat sila ay kilala kaya paano nila ito maisasama para maging myembro. Tungkol sa mga sinasabi nilang butaw2 o monthly dues, it depends sa bawat barangay na senior citizen association. Sa kaniyang paniniwala ay hindi dapat pilitin ang mga myembro na magbigay ng butaw though meron sila different activities na kailangan ng funds. Yong may kakayanan magbigay yon lang ang dapat magbigay at hindi kailangang pilitin ang mga myembro nito.

Nagpahayag din ng karagdagang information ang OSCA head na si Atty. Venus na mayroong mga senior citizen na gustong sumali sa asosasyon subalit hinihingan sila ng monthly dues at kapag hindi na ito nakabayad ay tinatanggal sila sa listahan ng mga myembro.

Sumang ayon si Hon. Palabrica sa mga obserbasyon na ito at sinabi nyang pagkatapos ng hearing ay maglalabas ang Sangguniang Panlungsod ng opinion at suggestions ukol dito upang macorrect ang mga bagay bagay sa bawat asosasyon at

malamang ay kakailanganin ng local legislation from Sanguniang Panlungsod na susundan ng lahat ng asosasyon to prevent this unwanted situations na nagiging sanhi ng hindi pagkakaintindihan.

7. Clarification on item #2

Sa usaping patungkol sa katangian ng miyembrong maaring inomina o tumakbo sa pwesto ng Pangulo at Pangalawang Pangulo ay ipinaliwang ni Ms. Reyes na unang-una sila ay hindi namimili ng edad dahil ito ay against sa human rights. Sa kasalukuyan sila ay nakapagpaeleksyon na ng 12 barangays at 2 sa mga ito ay 92yo at 93yo na. Ipinaliwanag din nya kung bakit isa sa criteria na dapat may sapat na katangiang pisikal at intelektual ay upang matugunan ang mga patawag at reports na kailangan ng OSCA at CSWD. Umayon dito si Hon. Palabrica at napagkasunduan na mga criteria ay mai-modify as follows: 1. Physicall at mentally fit 2. Physically residing in the jurisdiction of the same barangay he/she is running. Nagbigay din ng karagdagang input si Hon. Adriel Gawaran na para sa kanya dapat ang isang mamumuno ng senior citizen ay yong may puso, may malasakit, tumutulong at may pagmamahal, at may oras para sa kanyang kapwa senior citizens.

Atty. De Castro raised her concern regarding term of tenure ng mga opisyaes ng asosasyon na nakapaloob sa kanilang by-laws ay magkakaiba at hindi malinaw ang nakasaad na provision dito. Ito ay sinag-ayunan ni Hon. Palabrica na dapat ayusin.



TO : ALL PROVINCIAL,CITY, MUNICIPAL AND BARANGAY CHAPTER

SUBJECT : GUIDELINES OF SYNCHRONIZED ELCTION FROM CY 2023

FROM : MR. CIRIACO B. ANGELES

DATE : JANUARY 10, 2023

Pursuant to the provision of the PFSCACI Constitution and bylaws, as amended, (Article III. Section 2 – Membership and Article IV, Section 2 - Election), the schedule of Synchronized Election is as follow;

- a. January - Election of Barangay Senior Citizens Association
- b. February - Election of Municipal Senior Citizens Association
- c. March - Election of Provincial Senior Citizens Association
- d. April - Election of Regional Senior Citizens Association
- e. May - Election of National FSCAP

SECTION 3 - Date of election for the Barangay, Municipal/City, Provincial levels are discretionary and not mandatory but within the prescribed month stated above.

SECTION 4 - In order to obviate, confusion in the term of office of the Board of Trustees, those BOTS whose term of office will expire before the synchronized election are considered resigned and can run for election.

ARTICLE V

Section 3 - Term of Office

- a. The officer and members of the board of Director shall serve for a term of three (3) years and can be reelected for not more than three (3) years.
- b. The new set of elected officers under the new constitution and by-laws shall serve until the last day of December 2026. Therefore, they will be elected for a term of three (3) year.
- c. Synchronized elections beginning January 2023 will be held simultaneously from the barangays to the province up to March 2026 and every three (3) years thereafter.
- d. Complaint and Grievances. Shall be accept and decide on complaints and grievances on matter arising within the Federation.
- e. Nomination and Election. Shall formulate and recommend a set of criteria for member to be eligible for nomination as well as rule and regulations governing procedures.

ARTICLE VI Officers

Section 1 - Composition

The officers of the Federation shall be composed of the President, Executive Vice-President, one or more Vice President who shall represent geographical subdivision and Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Auditor, Public Relations Officer and Business Manages

PART II – BY LAWS

ARTICLE 1 ELECTION of OFFICERS

The committee on nominations and elections shall supervise the conduct of election in coordination with a representative of USMCA to oversee and monitor the proceedings.

Section 7
President

Before the close of the meeting of the elected officers of the Federation namely:

Executive Vice President, Vice President, and all appointed officers, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, Public Relations officers, and business manager shall be announced to the present members by the Committee on Nominations and shall be proclaimed therewith. Gift taking ceremony shall be held in a separate activity and at a place and date most appropriate for the occasion.


