This subject matter was referred to this Committee on the 30th Regular Session for appropriate action and recommendation of the Bacoor City Council.

In the letter dated 02 February 2023 of Hon. Mayor Strike B. Revilla then addressed to Hon. Vice Mayor Bautista-Mendiola, as the Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Re: REQUEST FOR AUTHORITY TO ENTER AND SIGN THE COMPROMISE AGREEMENT WITH ALEA RESIDENCES CONDOMINIUM CORPORATION TO CAUSE DISMISSAL OF CIVIL CASE NO. 22-031 BEFORE THE MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURT IN THE CITY OF BACOOR.

Findings:

 The civil case for refund and/or tax, environmental fee and plate sticker fee on Branch 2 Municipal Trial Court in the "Alea Residences Condominiums Corp. v. City Treasurer, City Government of Bacoor";



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- The Alea Residences Condominiums Corp. has submitted documents showing its source of income to the City Government of Bacoor;
- The City Treasurer, City Government of Baccor has determined and validated that the Alea Residences Condominiums Corp. is nontaxable for the year 2022 based on the documents submitted.

The Alea Residences Condominiums Corp. and City Treasurer, City Government of Bacoor, MUTUALLY AGREES to resolve the issues of the civil case amicably and to settle the matter among themselves with the guidance of the Honorable Court and shall jointly manifest their intention of the DISMISSAL of the civil case.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the members of the Committee recommend immediate APPROVAL of the COMPROMISE AGREEMENT between the ALEA Residences Condominium Corp. and the City Government of Bacoor.



In 2022, ALEA Residences Condominium Corporation, a duly organized corporation with principal office at Las Piñas-Talaba Diversion Road, Barangay Zapote 3, Bacoor City, Cavite instituted a civil case for refund and/or tax credit of collected local taxes before Branch 2 of the Municipal Trial Court in the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite.

Both parties in the said case mutually agreed to resolve the issues amicably and settle the matter by entering into a compromise agreement. This agreement manifests the joint intention of the Parties to cause the dismissal of the case. The compromise agreement is attached hereto for your reference.

COMPROMISE AGREEMENT

(ALEA Residences Condominium Corp. v. City Treasurer, City Government of Bacoor; Civil Case No. 22-031)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

	This Compromise Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this
day of	, 2023, in the City of Baccor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

The ALEA RESIDENCES CONDOMINIUM CORPORATION, a duly organized corporation existing under Philippine laws, with principal office located at Las Pinas-Talaba Diversion Rd., Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its Officer-in-Charge, ENGR. ROMEL YABUT, and hereinafter referred to as the "FIRST PARTY"

-and-

The CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, a local government unit in the Province of Cavite, duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center. Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented by its Local Chief Executive, the HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, and hereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY"

"Party" shall mean FIRST PARTY or SECOND PARTY, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall mean FIRST PARTY or SECOND PARTY, collectively.

WITNESSETH: That

WHEREAS, there is a civil case for refund and/or tax credit of collected local business tax, environmental fee and plate and sticker fee before Branch 2 Municipal Trial Court in the City of Baccor, in particular Civil Case No. 22-031 entitled ALEA Residences Condominium Corp. v. City Treasurer, City Government of Baccor,

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY has submitted documents showing its source of income to the SECOND PARTY;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY, through the Office of the City Treasurer has determined and validated that the FIRST PARTY is a non-taxable entity for the year 2022 based on the documents submitted by the latter:

WHEREAS, the PARTIES mutually agree to resolve the issues in the civil case amicably and settle the matter of among themselves with the guidance of the Honorable Court:

WHEREAS, the PARTIES shall jointly manifest their intention of the dismissal of the civil case;

WHEREAS, the representative of the FIRST PARTY is allowed by its Board of Trustees to enter into this Agreement as evidenced by a Board Resolution/Secretary's Certificate dated 16 December 2022 attached herein as ANNEX "A";

WHEREAS, the repr	esentative of the	SECOND PARTY I	s empowered by th	1e
Sangguniang Panlungsod to	enter into this	Agreement as evide	ence by Sanggunian	ıg

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the further stipulations hereinafter set forth, the **PARTIES** agree as follows:

- That the PARTIES agree to a tax credit amounting to ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND AND FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE PESOS AND EIGHTY-TWO CENTAVOS PHILIPPINE CURRENCY (PHP 122, 521.82) (the "settlement amount");
- The SECOND PARTY shall issue a tax credit in favor of the FIRST PARTY in the following manner:
 - a. The amount stated in paragraph one (1) herein shall be applicable solely for Business Permit Fees of the SECOND PARTY due from the year 2024 cowards; and
 - b. The settlement amount shall be used to pay the Business Permit Fees of the SECOND PARTY until the said amount is exhausted.
- The FIRST PARTY, through the City Treasurer's Office, shall issue a Tax Credit Certificate in favor of the SECOND PARTY upon the execution hereof;
- 4. This Agreement shall be valid and binding upon the heirs, executors, and assigns and successors of both the contracting PARTIES. Any action or suit arising hereunder shall be brought to the appropriate court in Baccor City to the exclusion of all other courts.
- The PARTIES shall submit a joint motion or manifestation submitting this
 Agreement to the Court for the latter's approval and shall pursue the eventual
 dismissal of Civil Case No. 22-031, at no costs.
- For the succeeding years, the FIRST PARTY shall likewise provide the SECOND PARTY with the necessary documentation showing its source of income for the purpose of determining and validating the FIRST PARTY's status as a non-taxable entity for the relevant year, and the proper tax base for the computation of its local business taxes, as has been done for 2022.
