Referred to this Committee on the 33rd Regular Session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod is the above-captioned subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

The City Resolution sought be approved by this august body is the grant of authority for City Mayor to sign the Memorandum Of Agreement involving the use of various advertising mediums and structures in all primary, secondary and tertiary roads including lamp post/post banners, directional signages, waiting shed signages, led boards, mini-billboards, pedestrian overpass signages, wall billboards, light boxes, back lit ads, hollywood/build-up ads and vehicular bridgeway signages within the territorial jurisdiction of Bacoor City and proposed to be leased by the City Advertising Ventures Corporation with principal address at 6th and 7th Floor, MG Tower, #75 Shaw Boulevard, Daang Bakal, Mandaluyong City, Metro Manila.

A Committee hearing was conducted on March 9, 2023 to clarify some of the terms and conditions provided in the agreement. It was attended by the representatives from the advertising company led by Mr. Hospicio G. Neri, Jr. and the resource persons from the City Government of Bacoor, namely, Atty. Marius Sumira and Atty. JD G. Gutierrez representing the Office of the City Legal Services

The proposed Memorandum of Agreement earlier submitted by the advertising company was revised, presented and discussed by Atty. Marius Sumira. The particular revisions (in bold letters) are hereunder quoted:

"XXX

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4. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION

- 4.1 This Agreement shall take commence on the Effective Date as abovementioned and shall automatically expire TWO (2) years thereafter, subject to renewal upon mutual agreement of both Parties. The Parties shall negotiate with each other in good faith with respect to any extension of the term of this Agreement but not later than two (2) months prior to the expiration of the term. The FIRST PARTY grants the SECOND PARTY the right of first refusal and the right to match any bids by any THIRD PARTY concerning the subject matter of this Agreement.
- 4.2 Except as otherwise provided above, either Party may terminate this Agreement without cause, subject to sixty (60) days prior written notice to the other Party. However, either Party, upon violation or non-compliance of obligations and/or the terms and conditions herein, including.

The representative from City Advertising Ventures Corporation manifested no objection on the revisions/amendments made by the Office of the City Legal Services.

It was further noted by the Honorable Members of the Committee the dispositive portions of the following conditions, we quote:



5th SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD

"1. OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY

XXX

 The FIRST PARTY hereby authorizes the SECOND PARTY to remove or dismantle all advertising paraphernalia posted by unauthorized parties.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY

XXX

- 2.2. The SECOND PARTY shall secure the required business permit/s and clearance/s and pay the necessary fees as required by the Revenue Code of Bacoor City, and thus, all precautionary measures and regulations pertaining to cleanliness, orderliness, beautification, peace and order and public safety shall likewise be strictly observed.
- 2,3, The SECOND PARTY shall coordinate with the Office of the City Engineer prior to construction, installation, maintenance and dismantling of the various advertising materials to avoid the being taken down and to prevent further inconvenience.
- 2.4. The SECOND PARTY shall install and maintain WAITING SHEDS with WI-FI and LED BOARDS in selected locations within the City of Bacoor to provide shelter to the commuting public, internet access and assist the City in its public information dissemination campaigns. In exchange, the FIRST PARTY shall allow the SECOND PARTY to install/air advertisement in these structures to help recoup the SECOND PARTY's investment."

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing and considering that the draft of the Memorandum of Agreement had been properly reviewed and revised by the Office of the City Legal Services, Bacoor City, the Honorable Members of the Committee hereby recommend *TO APPROVE* the City Resolution authorizing City Mayor, Honorable Strike B. Revilla to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement with City Advertising Ventures Corporation, Mandaluyong City, Metro Manila, subject to the existing laws. policies, rules and regulations in advertisement and marketing communications.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this day of 20 (the "Effective Date") in the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

The BACOOR CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, a local government unit duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at The City of Bacoor Government Center, Meline Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay San Nicelas IIBayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, Philippines, duly represented herein by its City Mayor, Honon, STRIKE B. REVILLA, acting pursuant to the authority granted to him under City Resolution No.

Series of approved of the City Council of Bacoor City, Cavite, and hereinafter referred to as the "FIRST PARTY":

-and-

CITY ADVERTISING VENTURES CORPORATION, a company organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with official business address at 6th and 7th floor MG Tower, #75 Shaw Boulevard, Daang Bakal, Mandaluyong City, Metro Manila, duly represented herein by its President, Mr. HOSPICIO G. NERI, JR., and hereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY"

"Party" shall refer to the FIRST PARTY or SECOND PARTY, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall refer to the FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY, collectively,;

WITNESSETH: That

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY owns lamp posts, footbridges, waiting sheds and other properties/spaces within the Baccor City of Baccor, Province of Cavite, which may can serve as tools to generate additional revenue to the city FIRST PARTY as advertising media by way of display of advertising paraphernalia;

WHEREAS, on 20 February 2023, the SECOND PARTY submitted a letter of intent to the Office of the City Mayor to undertake the task of marketing of advertising spaces within the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite to prospective clients/advertisers;

WHEREAS, on 23February 2023, the City Mayor requested the City Council the authority to enter into and sign a memorandum of agreement with the SECOND PARTY.

WHEREAS, on 27 February 2023, the City Council approved City Resolution No. _____, aA Resolution Authorizing the City Mayor, Honorable Strike B. Revilla, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with City Advertising Ventures Corporation, represented by its President, Hospicio G. Neri, Jr., for the Lease of City Owned Properties for Advertisements:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereto have agreed and stipulated as follows:

1. OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY

- 1.1. The FIRST PARTY hereby designates the SECOND PARTY as partnerLESSEE of various advertising mediums/structures in all primary, secondary and tertiary roads, such as but not limited teincluding LAMP_POST/POST BANNERS, DIRECTIONAL SIGNAGES, WAITING SHED SIGNAGES, LED BOARDS, MINIBILLBOARDS, PEDESTRIAN OVERPASS SIGNAGES, WALL BILLBOARDS, LIGHTBOXES, BACK LIT ADS, HOLLYWOOD/BUILD-UP ADS, AND VEHICULAR BRIDGEWAY SIGNAGES for advertising purposes within the territorial jurisdiction of the FIRST PARTY.
- 1.2. The FIRST PARTY hereby authorizes the SECOND PARTY to remove or dismantle all advertising paraphernalia posted by unauthorized parties.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY

- 2.1. The SECOND PARTY, shall be responsible for the production, installation and maintenance of all advertising media covered by this Agreement at no cost to the FIRST PARTY. Electrical consumption of these advertising paraphernalia shall be for the account of the SECOND PARTY.
- 2.2. The SECOND PARTY shall secure the required business permit/s and clearance/s and- pay the necessary- fees as required by the Revenue Code of Bacoor City, and thus, all precautionary measures and regulations pertaining to- cleanliness, orderliness, beautification, peace and order and public safety- shall likewise be strictly observed.
- 2.3. The SECOND PARTY shall coordinate with the Oeffice of the City Engineer prior to construction, installation, maintenance and dismantling of the various advertising materials to avoid the same being taken down and to prevent further inconvenience.

- 2.4. THE SECOND PARTY shall install and maintain WAITING SHEDS—with WiFi and LED BOARDS in selected locations within the City of Bacoor to provide shelter to the commuting public, internet access and assist -the City in its public information dissemination campaigns. In exchange, the FIRST PARTY shall allow the SECOND PARTY to install/air advertisements in these structures to help recoup the SECOND PARTY's investment.
- 2.5. The SECOND PARTY is prohibited to display, install or advertise paraphernalia that do not conform to the moral, legal and ethical standards established by the advertising industry as well as policies of the FIRST PARTY.
- 2.6. The SECOND PARTY has the right to replace any or all authorized advertisements or paraphernalia. Provided, that costs of the replacements, as well as any other incidental expenses related thereto, shall be for the account of the SECOND PARTY. The FIRST PARTY shall answer for and hold the SECOND PARTY free and harmless from any liability, including but not limited to claims from third parties, arising from the replacement of all authorized advertisements or paraphernalia pursuant to this Agreement.

3. FORCE MAJEURE

Force Majeure Event shall occur if either Party is unable to perform any of its obligations for any reason beyond its control, such as but not limited to: national emergencies, wars, hostilities, insurrections, civil commotions or rebellion, or apprehension or imminence of war (whether declared or not), blockade, hijacking, Acts of God, actions of any government or governmental authority, fire, flood, shortages of labor and materials, extraordinary contraction recession, epidemics and pandemic.

Should a Force Majeure Event make it impossible for either Party to perform its obligations under this Agreement, the Parties' respective obligations, including the payment of the fees for the use of the lamp posts, shall be suspended only for the duration of said Force Majeure Event.

The SECOND PARTY shall provide written notice within seven (7) working days from the occurrence of the Force Majeure Event to the FIRST PARTY stating the location and duration of said Force Majeure Event.

4. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION

4.1 This Agreement shall take commence on the Effective Date as abovementioned and shall automatically expire TWO (2) years thereafter, subject to renewal upon mutual agreement of both Parties. The Parties shall negotiate with each other in good faith with respect to any extension of the term of this Agreement but not later than two (2) months prior to the expiration of the term. The FIRST PARTY grants

the SECOND PARTY the right of first refusal and the right to match any bids by any THIRD PARTY concerning the subject matter of this Agreement.

- 4.2 Except as otherwise provided above, either Party may terminate this Agreement without cause, subject to sixty days (60) days prior written notice to the other Party, However, either Party, upon violation or non-compliance of obligations and/or the terms and conditions herein, including.
 - False representation of warranty;
 - b) Where a Party becomes voluntarily or involuntarily the subject of reorganization or liquidation proceedings under any bankruptcy or insolvency law, or other law or procedure for the relief of the financially distressed debtors, or is unable to, or admit in writing, its inability to pay its debts when due as they mature, or becomes insolvent or takes or suffers any action for its liquidation or dissolution, or has a receiver or liquidator appointed for all or a substantial part of its assets and in the event any such occurrence is involuntary, the action or proceeding against either Party remains pending for a period of thirty (30) business days; and
 - c) Any other acts which compromise the mutual trust relationship of the Parties.
- 4.3. In case of breach or violation of this Agreement pursuant to Clause 4.24 above, either Party is given at least sixty (60) days from receipt of the other Party's prior written notice to remedy the breach or violation. Only in case of failure to remedy the breach or violation of the Agreement within the foregoing before shall the Agreement be deemed terminated.

This Agreement shall take effect for a period of Five (5) Years from 01 March 2023 to 29 February 2028, subject to renewal upon mutual agreement of both Parties. The Parties shall negotiate with each other in good faith with respect to any extension of the term of this Agreement but not later than two (2) months prior to the expiration of the term. The FIRST PARTY grants the SECOND PARTY the right of first refusal and the right to match any bids by any THIRD PARTY concerning the subject matter of this Agreement.





In view thereof, I respectfully request the esteemed members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to perform the appropriate actions that will grant me the authority to enter into and sign the abovementioned Memorandum of Agreement with City Advertising Ventures Corporation.





MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between

BACOOR CITY GOVERNMENT, a local government unit duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at The City of Bacoor Government Center, Molino Boulevard, Barangay San Nicolas II, Bacoor City Philippines, duly represented herein by its City Mayor, HON, STRIKE B. REVILLA, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY:

CITY ADVERTISING VENTURES CORPORATION, a company organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with business address at 6th and 7th floor MG Tower, #75 Shaw Boulevard, Daang Bakal, Mandaluyong City, Metro Manila, duly represented herein by its President, HOSPICIO G. NERL JR., hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY:

WITNESSETH: That

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY owns lamp posts, footbridges, waiting shed and other properties/spaces within Bacoor City which can serve as tools to generate additional revenue to the city as advertising media by way of display of advertising paraphernalia;
WHEREAS, on the SECOND PARTY submitted a letter of intent to the Office of the City Mayor to undertake the task of marketing of advertising spaces within the City of Bacoor to prospective clients/advertisers;
WHEREAS, on, the City Mayor requested the City Council the authority to enter into and sign a memorandum of agreement with the SECOND PARTY.
WHEREAS, on, the City Council approved Resolution No, A Resolution Authorizing the City Mayor, Honorable Strike B. Revilla, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with City Advertising Ventures Corporation, represented by its President, Hospicio G. Neri, Jr., for the Lease of City Owned Properties for Advertisements;
NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the

1. OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY

parties hereto have agreed and stipulated as follows:

1.1. The FIRST PARTY hereby designates the SECOND PARTY as LESSEE of various advertising mediums/structures in all primary, secondary and tertiary roads like LAMPPOST/POST BANNERS,



DIRECTIONAL SIGNAGES, WAITING SHED SIGNAGES, LED BOARDS, MINI-BILLBOARDS, PEDESTRIAN OVERPASS SIGNAGES, WALL BILLBOARDS, LIGHBOXES, BACK LIT ADS, HOLLYWOOD/BUILD-UP ADS, AND VEHICULAR BRIDGEWAY SIGNAGES for advertising purposes within the territorial jurisdiction and owned by the FIRST PARTY

1.2. The FIRST PARTY hereby authorizes the SECOND PARTY to remove or dismantle all advertising paraphernalia posted by unauthorized parties.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY

- 2.1. The SECOND PARTY, shall be responsible for the production, installation and maintenance of all advertising media covered by this Agreement at no cost to the FIRST PARTY. Electrical consumption of these advertising paraphernalia shall be for the account of the SECOND PARTY.
- 2.2. The SECOND PARTY shall secure the required business permit/s and clearance/s and pay the necessary fees as required by the Revenue Code of Bacoor City, and thus, all precautionary measures and regulations pertaining to cleanliness, orderliness, beautification, peace and order and public safety shall likewise be strictly observed.
- 2.3. The SECOND PARTY shall coordinate with the office of the City Engineer prior to construction, installation, maintenance and dismantling of the various advertising materials to avoid the same being taken down and to prevent further inconvenience.
- 2.4. THE SECOND PARTY shall install and maintain WAITING SHEDS with WiFi and LED BOARDS in selected locations within the City of Bacoor to provide shelter to the commuting public, internet access and assist the City in its public information dissemination campaigns. In exchange, the FIRST PARTY shall allow the SECOND PARTY to install/air advertisements in these structures to help recoup the SECOND PARTY's investment.
- 2.5. The SECOND PARTY is prohibited to display, install or advertise paraphernalia that do not conform to the moral, legal and ethical standards established by the advertising industry as well as policies of the FIRST PARTY.
- 2.6. The SECOND PARTY has the right to replace any or all authorized advertisements or paraphernalia. Provided, that costs of the replacements, as well as any other incidental expenses related thereto, shall be for the account of the SECOND PARTY. The FIRST PARTY shall answer for and hold the SECOND PARTY free and harmless from any liability, including but not limited to claims from third parties, arising from the replacement of all authorized advertisements or paraphernalia pursuant to this Agreement.



3. FORCE MAJEURE

Force Majeure Event shall occur if either party is unable to perform any of its obligations for any reason beyond its control, such as but not limited to: national emergencies, wars, hostilities, insurrections, civil commotions or rebellion, or apprehension or imminence of war (whether declared or not), blockade, hijacking, Acts of God, actions of any government or governmental authority, fire, flood, shortages of labor and materials, extraordinary contraction recession, epidemics and pandemic.

Should a Force Majeure Event make it impossible for either Party to perform its obligations under this Agreement, the Parties' respective obligations, including the payment of the fees for the use of the lamp posts, shall be suspended only for the duration of said Force Majeure Event.

The SECOND PARTY shall provide written notice within seven (7) working days from the occurrence of the Force Majeure Event to the FIRST PARTY stating the location and duration of said Force Majeure Event.

4. TERMINATION

- 4.1. Except as otherwise provided above, either Party may terminate this Agreement, subject to sixty days (60) days prior written notice, upon violation or non-compliance of obligations and/or the terms and conditions herein, including.
 - a) False representation of warranty;
 - b) Where a Party becomes voluntarily or involuntarily the subject of reorganization or liquidation proceedings under any bankruptcy or insolvency law, or other law or procedure for the relief of the financially distressed debtors, or is unable to, or admit in writing, its inability to pay its debts when due as they mature, or becomes insolvent or takes or suffers any action for its liquidation or dissolution, or has a receiver or liquidator appointed for all or a substantial part of its assets and in the event any such occurrence is involuntary, the action or proceeding against either Party remains pending for a period of thirty (30) business days; and
 - c) Any other acts which compromise the mutual trust relationship of the Parties.
- 4.2. In case of breach or violation of this Agreement pursuant to Clause 4.1 above, either Party is given at least sixty (60) days from receipt of the other Party's prior written notice to remedy the breach or violation. Only in case of failure to remedy the breach or violation of the Agreement within the foregoing before shall the Agreement be deemed terminated.



This Agreement shall take effect for a period of two (2) Years from execution of this MOA, subject to renewal upon mutual agreement of both Parties. The Parties shall negotiate with each other in good faith with respect to any extension of the term of this Agreement but not later than two (2) months prior to the expiration of the term. The FIRST PARTY grants the SECOND PARTY the right of first refusal and the right to match any bids by any THIRD PARTY concerning the subject matter of this Agreement.
