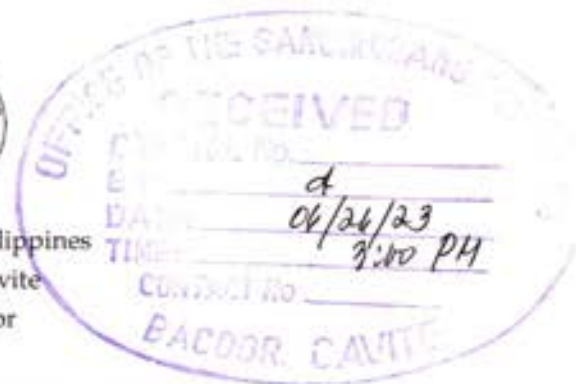

Subject: *A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BACOR CITY COMPONENT POLICE STATION (CPS) LOCALIZED ANTI-CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN (LACAP) "IMPLAN SAGIP MARIA". (PCR 330-2023) dated JUNE 19, 2023*

1. 2. Bacoor City is committed to understanding and addressing the underlying causes of the prostitution issue by focusing on promoting proper employment opportunities;
3. Bacoor CCPS in coordination with the Local Government Units (LGUs), other Government Agencies (GAs) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), will provide security coverage and standard operating procedures for the implementation of the said plan.

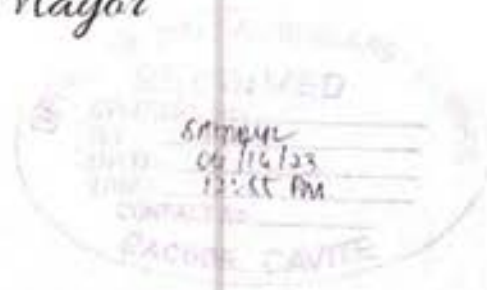



Bacoor CCPS IMPLAN 06/2023 "Implan Sagip Maria" Operational Guidelines for Campaign Against Prostitution, Vagrancy and Indecent Shows

I. REFERENCES:

- a. Coordinating Meeting from the Office of the Bacoor City Administrator dated May 24, 2023 re "Oplan Sagip Maria"

II. PURPOSE:

This IMPLAN provides the operational guidelines and procedures for the security coverage, public safety measures, and other support services to be provided by the PNP during anti-trafficking operations targeting prostitution and to address prostitution activities while prioritizing victim identification, support, and ensuring the safety of all individuals involved.

III. SITUATION:

Bacoor City is committed to understanding and addressing the underlying causes of the prostitution issue by focusing on promoting proper employment opportunities. The city aims to ascertain whether women and children who have been rescued from exploitation are willing to engage in lawful employment, even if it offers a lower minimum salary compared to their previous earnings. Additionally, the city's operations target establishments such as nightclubs, beer houses, spas, and massage parlors, which are known to facilitate prostitution activities. These efforts also aim to identify and address instances of minors engaged in prostitution and individuals working without permits. By taking these initiatives, Bacoor City seeks to create a safer environment, protect vulnerable individuals, and promote sustainable livelihood options for those affected by the prostitution crisis.

IV. MISSION:

Bacoor CCPS, in coordination with the Local Government Units (LGUs), other Government Agencies (GAs) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), will provide security coverage and standard Operating procedures for the implementation of this implementation plan.

V. EXECUTION:

1. Pre-Operation Phase:

- a. intelligence Gathering and conduct preliminary assessments to identify areas and establishments associated with prostitution activities.
- b. Coordinate with relevant agencies, such as CSWD, CHO or NGOs, to ensure victim

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support services are available during operations.

2. Operational Planning:

- a. Conduct risk assessment to identify potential hazards and vulnerabilities associated with the operation.
- b. Formulate an operational plan that includes objectives, specific tasks, roles, responsibilities.
- c. Ensure compliance with legal requirements and human rights principles during the planning process.

3. Victim Identification and Support:

- a. Recognize signs of trafficking or exploitation within the context of prostitution.
- b. Establish protocols for victim interviews, emphasizing sensitivity, empathy, and trauma-informed practices.
- c. Coordinate with support service providers to facilitate immediate assistance and long-term support for identified victims.

4. Operational Execution:

- a. Brief all personnel involved on the operation's objectives, risks, and specific tasks assigned to them.
- b. Conduct operations in a coordinated manner, focusing on evidence gathering, victim identification, and ensuring officer safety.
- c. Document all relevant information, observations, and actions taken during the operation.

5. Arrest and Detention:

- a. Follow legal procedures for conducting arrests, ensuring the rights of suspects and preserving evidence.
- b. Treat arrested individuals with dignity and respect while taking appropriate measures for their safety and security.
- c. Provide clear instructions to personnel regarding the transportation and processing of arrested individuals.

6. Victim Support and Referral:

- a. Facilitate immediate medical attention, if required, for victims identified during the operation.
- b. Coordinate with support service providers to offer victims access to medical care, counseling, legal assistance, and safe accommodation.
- c. Document victim details and ensure their information is treated confidentially and securely.



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7. Post-Operation Phase:

- a. Debrief all personnel involved in the operation, addressing any issues or concerns that arose during the operation.
- b. Securely store all evidence and documentation related to the operation according to established protocols.
- c. Conduct an evaluation of the operation to identify lessons learned and areas for improvement.

8. Reporting and Documentation:

- a. Prepare accurate and comprehensive reports detailing the operation, including actions taken, arrests made, and victims identified.
- b. Submit reports to designated authorities or units within the PNP in a timely manner.
- c. Maintain confidentiality and data security when handling sensitive information.

9. Review and Revision:

Review and update this Implan in response to legal and policy changes, operational feedback, and emerging best practices.

A. Tasks:

1. The **Deputy Chief of Police (DCOP)** shall serve as the Overall Supervisor.
2. **Admin**
 - a. Issue orders for the detail of personnel involved in this IMPLAN.
 - b. Activate and organize the Team Oplan Sagip Nena ready for deployment upon orders;
 - c. Perform other tasks as directed.
3. **Intel Section**
 - a. Provide Covert Team for the implementation of the activity.
 - b. Perform other tasks as directed.
4. **Operation Section**
 - a. Supervise and monitor the implementation of this IMPLAN.
 - b. Undertake necessary preparations and coordination with other concerned government agencies and security sectors;
 - c. Deploy detailed security personnel for the activity
 - d. Perform other tasks as directed.
5. **Supply Section**
 - a. Provide logistical support to tasked units upon request/order;
 - b. Perform other tasks as directed.
6. **PCAD Section**



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- a. Provide photo and video coverage of the activity; and
- b. Perform other tasks as directed.

7. Finance Section

- a. Provide fund support
- b. Perform other tasks as directed.

8. Invest (WCPD)

- a. OPR of the activity
- b. Provide Support for Investigative requirements and Documentation
- c. Perform other tasks as directed.

B. COORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. All detailed personnel shall observe this IMPLAN
- 2. Detailed personnel must adhere to the POP
- 3. Lateral coordination is encouraged
- 4. All tasked personnel shall be ready to perform other tasks as directed

VI. EFFECTIVITY

This IMPLAN shall take effect immediately upon approval
