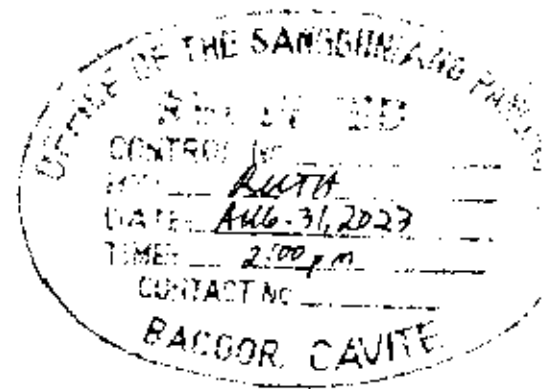

Subject: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FIVE (5) UNITS MOTOR VEHICLES BY THE GENERAL SERVICES OFFICE (GSO) IN SUPPORT OF THE PEACE AND ORDER/PUBLIC SAFETY PROGRAM OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BACoor. – PCR-360-2023 dated August 7, 2023.

Referred to this Joint Committee on the 55th Regular Session is the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

Perusal of the supporting documents attached with the endorsement letter of the Office of the City Mayor, Bacoor City dated August 1, 2023 will readily show that the request for the purchase of (5) motor vehicles are in order and reasonable.
