COMMITTEE HEARING REPORT

NO. NGO-025-S-2023

Subject: **AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs), CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs), AND PEOPLES'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs) THAT WISH TO PARTNER WITH THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR TO BE DULY ACCREDITED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, PROVIDING THE STANDARDS GOVERNING SUCH ACCREDITED, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF. (PCO /cs-2023 dated July 17, 2023)**

The above-stated proposed ordinance was referred to the Committee by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena Roubato Marañon, on July 17, 2023 during the 52nd Regular Session.

FINDINGS:

Under the Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as Local Government Code of 1991, local government unit shall exercise "powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare.

In this regard, under the Section 108 of the Code provides that the Sanggunian shall accredit non-governmental organizations (NGOs), civil society organizations (CSOs), and people's organizations (POs) subject to such criteria as may be provided by law.

Each NGO and CSO in the City of Bacoor will be given an equal opportunity to obtain accreditation. This ordinance will not prevent them from operating or impede them, but it will make sure that they are in line with the objectives of the City and the welfare of its residents.

RECOMMENDATION:

COMMITTEE HEARING MINUTES

NO. NGO-025-S-2023

Subject: *AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs), CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs), AND PEOPLES'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs) THAT WISH TO PARTNER WITH THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR TO BE DULY ACCREDITED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, PROVIDING THE STANDARDS GOVERNING SUCH ACCREDITED, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF. (PCO 294-2023 dated July 17, 2023)*

The 52nd Regular Session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod was presided over by City Vice Mayor, Rowena Bautista-Mendiola held on July 26, 2023, 11:00 AM at the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP) Session Hall, 6th Flr. City of Bacoor Legislative and Disaster Resilience Building, Bacoor Government Center.

The following factors were carefully taken into account by the Committee, which resulted in the approval of the proposed city ordinance:

1. All NGOs, POs and CSOs who wish to work with the City of Bacoor ensure that they operate according to standards of good governance and ethical practice and are given the privilege of being accountable while benefiting the community.
2. The accomplishment of the requirements for application will be the basis for accreditation. Failure to comply will result in the application being disapproved.
3. This will apply to all NGOs, POs and CSOs regardless of their scale, scope, or area of operation.
4. All organizations must comply with this ordinance for the commencement of their projects, programs or activities and ensure that they are in line with the objectives of the City Government of Bacoor.

The Committee Chairman, Hon. Fabian motioned for the approval of the aforementioned subject, which was unanimously seconded by the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. This highlighted the strong consensus among the members regarding its importance and relevance.
