Subject: AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE MASTERAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM FOR VARIOUS CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE. PCO 2023-108 dated 14 August 2023.

This report resolves the institutionalization of the masteral education and training program for various city officials and employees of the Local Government, during the 61st Regular Session, dated 18 September 2023.

The pertinent fact about the subject matter:

• In Chapter 5, Section 30 of Executive Order No. 292 (the "Administrative Code of 1997") provides that "the development and retention of a competent and efficient workforce in the public service is a primary concern of government it shall be the policy of the government that a continuing program of career and personnel development be established for all government employees at all levels. An integrated national plan for career and personnel development shall serve as the basis for all career and personnel development activities in the government."

The following were the proposed requirements from the Human Resources Development and Management Department regarding the said draft ordinance:

An applicant for the scholarship for Graduate School must possess the following:

- Must be a permanent employee for at least two (2) years at the City Government of Bacoor;
- Must sign a Service Obligation Agreement of two years after the completion of the Graduate Program with the City Government of Bacoor; and
- Must possess a relevant Bachelor's Degree to the Graduate Program.

Endings:

The foregoing discussion clearly showed that the matter comprising the legislative agenda of the 4th Sangguniang Panlungsod at the City of Baccor was the establishment of a masteral education and training program for selected City Government officials and employees intended to enhance the capacity development of the said individuals for the benefit of the general public. Due, however, to the COVID-19 pondemic and the need to devote the City Government's resources to meet the said health emergency, the astabishment of the said program was deterred. On 22 July 2023, President Ferdinand 8, Marcos Jr. issued Proglamation No. 297 effectively lifting the said state of public health emergency. The City Government can now devote some at its resources to the capacity development of the employees and officials.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review, the committee respectfully recommends **APPROVING** the proposed ordinance, which seems very beneficial to the City Officials and **E**mployees who will be given the opportunity to be selected.

Subject: AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE MASTERAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM FOR VARIOUS CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE. PCO 2023-108 dated 14 August 2023.

The committee hearing was presided over by the Committee Chairman on Education. Science, and Tachnology, Hon. Councilor Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan. In attendance were Hon. Councilor Adrielito G. Gawaran, Hon. Cauncilor Rogelio M. Nolasco, the Human Resources Development and Management Department represented by Natividad Ludwig I. Op.e. Philippine Christian University Covite - Campus representatives headed by Ms. Katrina R. Casue, City Livelihood and Development Office representatives, and the Office of the City Budge: Officer represented by Elvina S. Guerrero

Coun, Pagulayan called the roll and read Section 3 of the proposed draft ordinance. The good councilor emphasized the need to priorilize the departments that are much needed for the said ordinance (e.g., Urban Planning). It was seconded by Coun, Gawaran and suggested being very cautious in selecting the beneficiaries. While Coun, Pagulayan then tasked Ms. Opla to prepare the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and form a selection body to identify the beneficiaries. Furthermore, some instructional methods need to be discussed to comply with the Civil Service Code.

Ms. Guerrero, the City Budget Officer, was recognized. According to her, the availability of funds should be considered for the said ordinance.

Ms. Casue of PCU Cavita was also recognized. According to her, they offer several non-thesis master's degree programs. With regard to Local Government difficials and employees, she recommends a master's degree in Management and Public Administration (MMPA). Crisis Management, Disosler Resiliency (CMDR), and National Security Administration (NSA). She also hands out leaflets for the programs they offer. (a copy of which is attached hereta for reference).

Since there are no other comments of suggestions, the committee hearing was ADJOURNED at 10:45 a.m.

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE MASTERAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM FOR VARIOUS CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BACCOR, CAVITE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 5, Section 30 of Executive Order No. 292 (the "Administrative Code of 1997") provides that "the development and relention of a competent and efficient work force in the public service is a primary concern of government. It shall be the policy of the government that a continuing program of career and personnel development be established for all government employees at all levels. An integrated national plan for career and personnel development shall serve as the basis for all career and personnel development activities in the government."

WHEREAS, among the matters comprising the legislative agenda of the 4th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor was the establishment of a masteral education and training program for selected City Government officials and employees intended to enhance capacity development of the said individuals for the benefit of the general public. Due, however, to the COVID-19 pandemic and the need to devote the City Government's resources to meet the said health emergency, the establishment of the said program was deferred.

WHEREAS, on 22 July 2023, President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. issued Proclamation No. 297 effectively lifting the State of Public Health Emergency declared by former President Rodrigo R. Duterte due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHEREAS, due to the lifting of the said state of public health emergency, the City Government can now devote some of its resources in the capacity development of its employees and officials.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the 5th Sangguniang Pantungsod of the City of Baccor, Cavite that:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Personnel Career Enhancement Ordinance of the City of Baccor".

SECTION 2. Establishment of Master Education and Training Program. A masteral education and a comprehensive skills development training program under the supervision of the Human Resources Management and Development Department is hereby established.

SECTION 3. Who May Qualify. All regular employees and all elected officials of the City Government are qualified to participate in the above-mentioned program subject to availability of funds, the requirements of the educational/vocational institutions who shall participate in the said program, and the pertinent civil service regulations. The HRDMD is hereby authorized to enumerate the vanous qualifications that interested city officials and employees must meet in order to qualify for the said programs.

SECTION 4. Funding. The City Government shall devote a portion of its annual budget in financing the said programs.

SECTION 5. Implementation. The HRDMD shall enforce this ordinance and shall take the lead in formulating its implementing guidelines with the assistance of the City Legal Services. Office which shall be submitted for the approval of the City Mayor not later than sixty (60) calendar from the effectivity date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. Separability. Any provision of this Ordinance declared void or unconstitutional by a competent court of law shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Automatic Review. The Sangguniang Panlunsgod shall review this Ordinance every two years to determine its effectiveness.

SECTION 8. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places within the City of Baccor, Cavite.
