Subject: PCO 2023-131 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, MODIFYING AND REPEALING PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023, ALSO KNOWN AS THE 2023 EXPANDED SOLIDARITY ROUTE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BACOR. (PCO 2023-131 dated October 23, 2023)

This report states the amending, modifying and repealing provisions of City Ordinance No. 255-2023. Also known as the 2023 expanded solidarity route ordinance of the City of Bacoor. The said Ordinance was referred to the Committee by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola on October 23, 2023.

FINDINGS:

The foregoing discussion clearly showed that approving City Ordinance No. 255-2023 for amendment, modifying and repealing provisions will efficiently help the HOAs for the improvement of the 2023 Expanded Solidarity Route Ordinance of the City of Bacoor. Since their proposed revisions in the IRR are embodied in City Ordinance No.255-2023, it is in the best interest of the City Government of Bacoor and the affected HOAs to revise the said City Ordinance to effectively address the concerns of the residents of the said communities. On October 16, 2023, the Office of the City Administrator, with the approval of the City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to amend certain provisions of the City Ordinance No. 255-2023, Series of 2023.



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RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review of all the matters brought before its attention, the Committee recommends that this resolution be **APPROVED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod. It will help in public service, local governance and administration.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, MODIFYING, AND REPEALING PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023, ALSO KNOWN AS THE 2023 EXPANDED SOLIDARITY ROUTE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BACCOOR.

WHEREAS, on 24 April 2023, City Ordinance No. 255-2023 (also known as "AN ORDINANCE EXPANDING THE NUMBER OF ROADS COMPRISING THE SOLIDARITY ROUTE AND AMENDING, MODIFYING, AND REPEALING PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-047 AND CITY ORDINANCE NO. 11-2019 ON THE REGULATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SAID TRAFFIC DECONGESTION SCHEME WITHIN THE CITY OF BACCOOR, PROVINCE OF CAVITE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.") was approved by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

WHEREAS, on several dates in October 2023, City Mayor Strike B. Revilla met with the affected Homeowners Associations ("HOAs") in the City of Bacoor for the implementation of the new Solidarity Route Sticker;

WHEREAS, during these meetings, the HOAs raised their issues, concerns, and comments on the Implementing Rules and Regulations ("IRR") of the City Ordinance No. 255-2023.

WHEREAS, since their proposed revisions in the IRR are embodied in City Ordinance No. 255-2023, it is in the best interest of the City Government of Bacoor and the affected HOAs to revise the said City Ordinance to effectively address the concerns of the residents of the said communities.

WHEREAS, on 16 October 2023, the Office of the City Administrator, with the approval of the City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to amend

certain provisions of the City Ordinance No. 255-2023, Series of 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod THAT:

SECTION 1. SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 3. The Solidarity Route Sticker.



Access to the Solidarity Route shall be limited to those motor vehicles that have a genuine and valid Solidarity Route Sticker. The Solidarity Route Sticker shall be issued by the E-Governance Department or by any other department under the Office of the City Mayor authorized to do so by written order of the City Mayor."

SECTION 2. SECTION 4 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 4. Solidarity Route.

The Solidarity Route shall be comprised of the main thoroughfares located in the following residential subdivisions:

1. F&E De Castro Village
2. Vista Verde Subdivision
3. Addas Village
4. Bellazona Subdivision
5. Town and Country Subdivision
6. Camella Springville Subdivision
7. Queensrow East, Central, and West Subdivisions
8. Gardenia Valley Subdivision
9. Soldier's Hills Subdivision
10. San Miguel I Subdivision
11. Villa Felicia Subdivision
12. Progressive Village
13. Perpetual Village VII
14. Sampaguita Subdivision
15. Camella Salinas



16. Meadowoods Executive Village
17. Bahayang Pagasa Subdivision
18. Casimiro Westville Homes
19. Reyville Subdivision

The enumeration above is not an exclusive list. Other roads and streets situated within the various residential subdivisions within the City already forming part of the Solidarity Route prior to the approval hereof shall also be covered by this Ordinance. Other homeowners associations operating within the City of Bacoor are encouraged to participate in the Expanded Solidarity Route Project through the submission of a Board Resolution manifesting their intent towards the same to the Office of the City Mayor.

The Bacoor Traffic and Management Department (BTMD) shall determine the names of the roads and streets within the aforementioned subdivisions comprising the Solidarity Route and shall enumerate them in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of this Ordinance.

The use of the Solidarity Route Sticker is limited to the said roads and streets as provided in this Ordinance, the IRR of this Ordinance, and future legislative and executive issuances.

A vehicle equipped with a Solidarity Route Sticker shall not access any road or street located within the covered subdivision that is not part of the Solidarity Route unless the homeowners association of the said community allows such access."

SECTION 3. SECTION 6 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 6. Who May Use The Solidarity Route.

Four handwritten signatures are present on the left side of the page, arranged vertically. From top to bottom, they appear to be: a signature that looks like 'Avelina', a signature that looks like 'Carmelita', a signature that looks like 'Marta', and a signature that looks like 'Ed'. Each signature is written in dark ink and is somewhat stylized.

Only vehicles with an authentic and valid Solidarity Route Sticker that is properly mounted on the windshield of the vehicle may use the Solidarity Route.

The Office of the City Mayor, the BTMD, and the E-Governance Department shall determine the process of review and evaluation of the authenticity of the Solidarity Route Sticker and SBR Card and the manner of inspecting the vehicles concerned.

Section 6.1. Exemptions.

A. The following may be allowed access to the Solidarity Route even without a Solidarity Route Sticker:

1. Properly marked government-owned vehicles used only in official government business, Provided that the persons driving the motor vehicle have sufficient documentary evidence to prove that they are actually on official government business, such as but not limited to the following: mission orders, travel orders, and certifications;
2. Emergency vehicles such as ambulances, fire trucks, and emergency response vehicles, among others; and
3. Other vehicles, as may be determined by the Office of the City Mayor through the recommendation by the BTMD and the affected HOA.

B. The rules on Solidarity Route Sticker shall not be applicable to the following vehicles:

1. Public utility vehicles (PUV) that are legally allowed to transport persons or cargo within the residential



subdivision. The relevant transport and franchise laws, City Ordinances, and the HOA rules shall be controlling and applicable to these PUVs. The PUVs, however, must be: (a) operating only within the territory of the participating subdivisions as enumerated and described in Section 4 of this Ordinance; (b) must have a valid franchise; and (c) must be duly registered with the City Government of Bacoor.

2. Vehicles used by residents of the residential subdivisions covered by the Ordinance are subject to the rules and regulations of the HOA concerned; and
3. Other vehicles as may be determined by the Office of the City Mayor through the recommendation by the BTMD and the affected HOA.

Section 6.2. Validity of the Old Solidarity Route Sticker and the New Solidarity Route Sticker.

The Old Solidarity Route Sticker previously issued pursuant to City Ordinance No. 11-2019 shall be valid until 31 December 2023.

The New Solidarity Route Sticker issued pursuant to previously issued pursuant to City Ordinance No. 255-2023 shall be valid until 30 June 2025, unless sooner revoked through a legislative or executive issuance."

SECTION 4. SECTION 7 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 7. How to Secure a Solidarity Route Sticker

A Solidarity Route sticker shall be issued by the City Government of Bacoor applicants upon their proper compliance with the documentary requirements that will be enumerated in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance."

SECTION 5. SECTION 8 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 8. Fees

The fees for the payment for the Solidarity Route Sticker shall be between Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00) and Three Thousand Pesos (Php 3,000.0) per car. The City Mayor, however, may provide discounts to qualified applicants and may increase the fees at his discretion.

The qualifications for eligibility and the terms and conditions for availing the free Solidarity Route Sticker for the first two (2) cars shall be detailed in the IRR of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. CORRECTION OF SPELLING IN SECTION 9 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 AND SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 9. SOLIDARITY ROUTE STICKER AND SBR CARD DESIGN FEATURES."


SECTION 7. DELETION OF SECTION 11 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023.

Section 11 of City Ordinance No. 255-2023 shall be deleted.

SECTION 8. SECTION 12 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL BE RENUMBERED AND SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 11. Installation of Scanners and CCTV Cameras.

The BTMD, City Engineering Office, and E-Governance Department are




hereby authorized to install scanners and other devices capable of validating the authenticity of Solidarity Route Stickers. The said offices are also authorized to install closed circuit television (CCTV) cameras at the entrance/exit gates and at the other places within the residential subdivisions covered by this Ordinance."



SECTION 9. SECTION 13 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL BE RENUMBERED AND SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 12. Deputation of Homeowners' Associations.

The City Mayor is hereby empowered to issue orders deputizing the duly elected officers of participating homeowners' associations and members of participating neighborhood associations who are persons of good moral character in the City of Bacoor, Provided that the said persons who shall be deputized shall comply with the requirements of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance."



SECTION 10. SECTION 14 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL BE RENUMBERED AND SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 13. Authority to Charge Entrance Fees; Exemption of Deliveries of Food Products and Other Perishable Goods from Payment of Fees.

Participating Homeowners' Associations may charge an entrance fee to the driver of any vehicle that does not bear a valid and properly mounted Solidarity Route Sticker; Provided, that the participating Homeowners' Association shall comply with the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance.

Motor vehicles delivering food products, vegetables, perishable



goods, and water shall be exempted from paying the said fees."

SECTION 11. SECTION 23 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 255-2023 SHALL BE RENUMBERED AND SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 22 Penalties.

- a. The violation of any of the provisions of this City Ordinance shall be punishable with an administrative fine of THREE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,000.00) payable to the Office of the City Treasurer.
- b. The following acts shall be punishable with an administrative fine of FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP5,000.00) payable to the Office of the City Treasurer or with a thirty (30) day imprisonment or both upon conviction by a court of proper jurisdiction, to wit:
 1. Misrepresentation or submission of false information in acquiring a Solidarity Route Sticker;
 2. Unauthorized sale of a Solidarity Route Sticker;
 3. Use of a fake Solidarity Route Sticker;
 4. Unauthorized use of Solidarity Route Sticker;
 5. Using a Solidarity Route Sticker to access roads and streets not provided under this Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations unless allowed by the participating HOA;
 6. Unauthorized use of the Solidarity Route Sticker without the payment of the proper fees due to the HOA;

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- 7. Misuse of data or information collected under the Ordinance and its IRR;
- 8. Commission of any act analogous to the acts mentioned above."

SECTION 12. RENUMBERING OF SECTION 12 TO SECTION 27.

Section 12 to Section 27 of City Ordinance No. 255-2023 shall be renumbered as follows:

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SECTION 13. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS.

This Ordinance adopts Section 23 of City Ordinance No. 255-2023 for the formulation of the implementing rules and regulations for this Ordinance.

SECTION 14. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All ordinances, resolutions, implementing rules and regulations, and executive orders related to this Ordinance are considered expressly repealed or modified.

SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY.

In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared void by a court of law, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance not affected by the said judicial declaration shall remain valid and enforceable.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its approval and after it has been published for a minimum of three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite. A copy of this Ordinance shall be submitted to the UP-ONAR before its effectivity.
