Subject: AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF ALL TYPES OF PERIMETER FENCES, WHETHER TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT, IN BACOOR CITY AND THE IMPOSITION OF A FENCING PERMIT IN THE ISSUANCE OF THE SAME. (PCO 2024-172 dated 18 March 2024)

This report on regulating the construction and installation of all perimeter fences was referred to the committee by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Presiding Officer Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola during the 83rd Regular Session on 18 March 2024. The committee reports the following:

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 1096, known as the National Building Code of the Philippines (NBCP) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), the decree establishes minimum standards governing the location, site, design, quality of materials, construction, occupancy, and maintenance of buildings and structures nationwide.

However, amendments to Presidential Decree No. 1096, titled "Adopting A NBCP," are necessary to address the evolving needs of the public and align with Bacoor City's development goals and infrastructure programs. These amendments should include modern technological requirements to ensure up-to-date design and construction standards.

There is a compelling need to regulate perimeter fences and other types of fence structures in Bacoor City to safeguard life, health, property, and public welfare.

Under Section 458, Paragraph (1)(i) of the Local Government Code, the Sangguniang Panlungsod, has the authority to enact ordinances for the general welfare of the city and its residents, including measures to maintain peace and order and impose penalties for violations. This authority is reinforced by Section 11(a)(1)(ii), Article IV of the R.A. No. 10160, also known as the "Charter of the City of Bacoor".

FINDINGS:

During the committee hearing dated 18 March 2024, discussion focused on:

- Implications of the proposed ordinance include its applicability to existing fences and the requirement for registration.
- Concerns about administrative burden on the local government and enforcement challenges for owners of undeveloped land.
- Deliberation on whether penalty questioning should be administrative or entail criminal liability, with reference to penalties outlined in the National Building Code for guidance.

The committee plans to consolidate and refine the proposed ordinance based on feedback from the attendees.

RECOMMENDATION:

After further deliberation, the committee recommends **TEMPORARILY ARCHIVING** the proposed ordinance pending submission of written comments and suggestions by the Office of the Building Official (OBO) and the City Engineering Office (CEO).



The joint committee hearing was called to order, with the agenda item being the ordinance regulating the construction and installation of all types of perimeter fences in Bacoor City and the imposition of a fencing permit. Hon. Gutierrez greeted everyone. All members of the committee are present, including Hon. Palabrica, Chairperson of the Committee on Rules Privileges, Laws and Ordinances, and City Councilors.

Resource persons identified themselves. The discussion began with Engr. Megia asked about the proposed ordinance implications, particularly concerning existing policies and whether it was an amendment or a new requirement.

Engr. Megia highlights that the National Building Code already requires a fencing permit for temporary fences, but the proposed ordinance extends to existing perimeter fences, necessitating registration. He raised concerns about the administrative burden on the local government.

Engr. Jutba added that in subdivisions, fence regulations are typically part of the main development plan, but enforcement may be more challenging for private individuals with undeveloped land.

The discussion shifted to penalties with Engr. Megia is questioning whether they should be administrative or for criminal liability. Atty. Flores explained that initially, they were considering criminal penalties, but they opted for administrative fines and demolition for non-compliance.

Engr. Megia and Atty. Flores discussed the reconciliation of local penalties with those in the National Building Code, agreeing to align penalties with administrative fines and referencing the building code for guidance.

Hon, Gawaran emphasized the need for fairness in implementing the ordinance, ensuring it applies equally to all residents, regardless of socio-economic status,

The discussion concluded with plans to consolidate and fine-tune the ordinance, taking into account feedback from the Office of the City Building Official and the City Engineering Office, Hon. Palabrica suggested deferring the approval pending further coordination and submission of position papers.

Overall, the meeting highlighted the importance of fair and balanced regulation, ensuring that the ordinance serves the best interests of all residents while avoiding undue administrative burdens.





AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF ALL TYPES OF PERIMETER FENCES. WHETHER TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT, IN BACOOR CITY AND THE IMPOSITION OF A FENCING PERMIT IN THE ISSUANCE OF THE SAME

WHEREAS Presidential Decree No. 1096 otherwise known as the National Budding Code of the Phalippines (NBCP) and its implementing Rives and Regulations (PR) provide for a framework of minimum standards and requirements to regulate and rendro, the rotation, site design quanty of materials construction occupancy and maintenance or buildings and structures uniformly enforceable nationwide.

WHEREAS while there is a Presidential Cecree No. 1496 Entitled. Adopting A biational Suiding Code of the Philippines (NBCP), the same needs at amplification of its provision to properly address the current needs of the general public address and conform with the developmental goals and infrastructure program of the Edda Government and adequately provide for all the technological requirements of buildings and structures in terms of up to date design and construction standards and or terms.

WHEREAS there is a need to problem and or regulate the construction of permitter lendes and other types of fence structures in Baccor City to ensure and saleguard to health property and public welfare.

WHEREAS Section 458 Paragraph (Time of the Code authorizes the Sangganang Panurigsod to enact ordinances approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants for an efficient and effective city government and shall claimfain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness disprove not violence rebellion or sed ton and impose population for the violation of sale promances. Such is exewise echoer in Section 11 to 15 and 2 Acole (Violitie RIA No. 10150) also known as the Charter or the City of Bacon.

NOW THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the 5th Sangguniang Partitions of of the Savor Frozince of Cavite that

ARTICLE 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. TITLE. + This Ordinance shall be known as the PERIMETER FENCE ORDINANCE OF BACOOR CITY

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVE. – This orginance aims to regulate the construction and installation of perimeter fences and other forms of feace within the ody limits to protect challe health, safety, and welfare and prevent potential danger to the general public.

SECTION 3 SCOPE AND DURATION. - Fins Chalmance applies to all types of unboosed or existing construction projects involving the construction and installation of thoses whether for residential commercial industrial regreational or otherwise within the ball took across choose Baccor City.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. – As used in this Ordinance, the following terms and phrases shall be understood and defined as reliaves.

- 1. Perimeter Fence means any structure, wall or barrier other than a boulding lengthed at grade to betine boundaries of a property separating open space, restricting ingress to or egress from the property and providing security or protection to the property if associated encompass all types of tence, wall or barrier, including but not brinted to barricade tence, wood fence, passade fence, welded with mesh fence, chain-link fence, rolled mesh fence, metal railings, steer railings, inon railings, other forms of fence.
- 2. Barricade Fence any fence or wall separating any Common Area from a public street or right of way or from property outside of another property and is intended to provide full or partial enclosure of property along or near the property lines. It shall also mean a barrier between adjacent residential properties on the northern eastern western and southern property lines.
- 3 Wood fence refers to a tence constructed of world.
- 4. Palisade fence means a fence constructed of stakewall or a paling and placed in a row of closely placed high vertical standing tree numbs or wooden or non-stakes for enclosure.
- Welded Wire Mesh Fence is a steel fence consisting of wire strands welded together to form a high-strength mesh.
- 6. Chain-link fence also known as wice netting, who mesh fence chain-wire fence, cyclone fence, humbarie fence, or diamond mesh fence, shall refer to a type of woven fence usually, made from stee wire. The wires run verboally and are bent into a zigzag pattern so that each "zig" hooks with the wire immediately or one's de and each zag", with the wire immediately on the other. This forms the characteristic diamond pattern seen in this type of fence.
- Rolled mesh (ence = refers to a fence consisting of wire strands that are made of materials other than steel
- Metal railings refers to a type of fence made of inetal attached to posts
- Steel railings refers to a type or fence made of steel attached to posts
- 10 Iron railings refers to a type of fance made of non-
- Other forms of fence = fence not herein mentioned but are considered encrosure and erected for the purpose of defining noundaries separating open space restricting ingress to briegress from property providing security or protection to property.

Words and phrases embodied in this Ordinance that are not specifically defined toroid shall have the same definitions found in R.A. No. 7160, also known as the Local Severement Code of 1991.

ARTICLE 2 REGULATED ACTS

SECTION 5. REGULATION ON CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF PERIMETER FENCES. — No person lentity or organization inatoral or junctical shall construct and/or install any fund of perimeter fence, whether temporary or permanent, on any public and private area within the City of Baccor, without first securing a Fencing Fermit, therefore, from the Office of the Building Official.

SECTION 6. REGULATION ON EXISTING PERIMETER FENCES. - Proposed and existing perimeter fences, whether permanent or temporary, on any public and pricate area located within the territorial jurisdiction of Baccori City shall be subject to the requisition of this Ordinance. All existing perimeter fences within the city limits must be registered and must obtain a permit with the Office of the Building Official within one if year from the effective date of this Ordinance, in profit is derived from the operations of the fence, the same must be registered as a business and pay the necessary permits fees, and taxes. In case of renovations, the Owners, Contractors, Architects, and of Engineers shall be required to follow air provisions of this ordinance.

ARTICLE 3 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF FENCING PERMIT FOR BOTH TEMPORARY AND PERMANENT FENCES

Pesos but not more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P. 2.500.00) or imprisonment of not less than one (1) month out not intre-than six (6) months for both such fine and imprisonment is! the discretion of the Court. The owner administrator shall trie a complete application for the necessary permit within thirty (30 days from the time hersite receives a written notice of violation failure to do so within the given period sharrhe sufficient ground for the Ottvis torced demostron or the fence.
 - b. For Contractors Architects and or Engineers and personstentities who constructed and/or installed the fence is violation of this organizate is fine of PhP 2,500,00 or imprisonment of not less than one if the month but not more than six (5) months or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court. The personstratity who constructed and/or installed the fence shall file a complete application for the necessary permit within thirty (30) days from the time hershell receives a written notice of violation. Failure to do so within the given period shall be sufficient ground for the City's forced denrolition of the fence.

SECTION 13. SECTION 14 IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The City Legal Services Office shall submit the draft implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance to the City Mayor for his approval holiater than sixty (60) days after its effective moleomentation.

SECTION 15. AUTOMATIC REVIEW The Sangguniang Paintaryson shall butomatically review this Ordinance once every three (3) years after its approval of whenever the need to such review arises.

SECTION 16 BUDGET APPROPRIATION. The City Severement of Bacoccish to approve the incits annual budget or any supplemental budget that may be approved the amount necessary to implement the provisions of the Codinabne.

SECTION 17. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE will for any reason, any provision or part of this solutionard is declared invalid or unconstitutional intheir provisions are not affected transport shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 18. REPEALING CLAUSE — All ordinances roles and regulations or makes thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are necessary repealed and/or modified accordingly provided that the rights vested upon this Ordinance's effectivity shall not be repaired.

SECTION 19 EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after publication in a newspaper of local circulation. In the absence of any newspaper of general circulation, the gist of the circinance shall be pristed after ten 40 days on a bulletin board at the entrance of the city or Barangay hall as the case may be and as at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the local government unit concerned
