**Subject: AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CITY GOVERNMENT'S DEPARTMENT LOGOS TO BE USED IN ALL FORMS AND DOCUMENTS TO REPRESENT THE IDENTITY OF ITS RESPECTIVE OFFICES – PCO 2024-208 dated September 9, 2024**

Referred to this Committee on the 107<sup>th</sup> Regular Session is the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

The Sangguniang Panlungsod is aware that there was frequent occurrence of evasion in the proper payment of taxes and city permits, including the avoidance in the compliance of certain city regulation by way of falsified official letter heads and forms of the City Government of Bacoor.

For these reasons, the ordinance as proposed intends to discourage and/or deter such criminal acts in order to protect the public and the interest of the City Government of Bacoor in particular its properties, public documents, and records, as well as, the enforcement of city regulations. Likewise, the designation of official logo for every operating unit, office and department of the city government could immediately determine the origin and veracity of the document/s presented and submitted by the transacting public or clientele.

In the proposed ordinance, the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod is further established by citing the specific provision of Republic Act No. 10160 otherwise known as the "Charter of the City of Bacoor", and we quote:

"WHEREAS, Section 11, paragraph (1), sub-paragraph (x) of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Bacoor, Cavite") empowered the Sangguniang Panlungsod to "approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective city government and, in this connection, xxx provide a mechanism and the appropriate funds therefore to ensure transparency in all city government transactions and the exercise of fiscal-discipline and the accountability of all city government employees for the safety and protection of all city government properties, public documents or records such as those relating to property inventory, land ownership, records of births, marriages, deaths, assessments, taxation, accounts, business permits and such other records and documents of public interest in the offices and departments of the city government."







It is noted by the Committee that in the designation and approval of unit, office and department logos, the proposed ordinance set the following design features with the symbolic meaning:

Design Features	Symbolic Meaning
a) The numbers "1671" appearing on the façade of a representation of a bridge	Symbolizes the year (1671) when the town of Bacoor was founded
b) Double concentric rings	Represents the continuity of Bacoor's time-honored traditions despite its conversion into a city
c) Representation of a bridge made of bricks appearing on the foreground	Symbolizes the Zapote Bridge where the historic Battle of Zapote Bridge took place during the Philippine Revolution
d) Seventy-three rectangular shapes appearing on the façade of the bridge representation	Symbolizes the seventy-three barangays of the City of Bacoor and how the cooperation of each contributes to the stability of the city
e) Representation of a bamboo appearing on the left-hand corner	Denotes the irrepressible bamboo from which the name of the city was taken and signifies the resilient nature of the character of its people
f) Representation of mussel shells appearing equidistant from each other within the dual concentric rings	Signifies the main agricultural produce of the city and its two new districts
g) Yellow sun rayonnant with eight outward pointing rays	Symbolizes the eight provinces the first took up arms against the Spaniards during the Philippine Revolution which includes the province of Cavite
h) Representation of buildings appearing on background	Denotes the progressive nature of the City
i) White background	Represents the peaceful nature of the people of Bacoor
j) Gules background	Signifies the courage of Bacooreños and their determination to fight for freedom
k) Azure background	Symbolizes the city government's commitment to save the environment and its pristine water resources as well as the calmness and serenity which are hallmarks of the people of Bacoor's character
l) The figures "2012" appearing on the lower portion of the concentric rings	Stands for the year when RA 10160 was approved by Congress and ratified resoundingly by the people of Bacoor in a plebiscite
m) Representation of eleven humanoid figures with drums marching on the bridge representation	Symbolizes the eleven existing musical marching bands in Bacoor that were established in 1925 that has become a familiar fixture in all important events that took place in Bacoor over the years

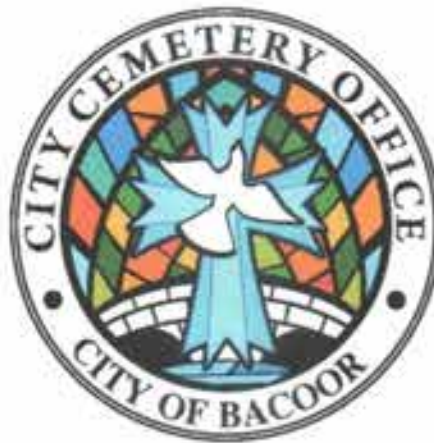

Honorable Rowena Bautista Mendiola, Presiding Officer called the 107<sup>TH</sup> Regular Session to order.
