COMMITTEE REPORT NO. HS 008 S-2023

Acting on the request of the Department of Health (DOH) to reconsider the cancellation of the deployment program of Human Resources for Health (HRH), the committee on health and sanitation chaired by Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan respectfully reports that:

In 2014, the Department of Health started the "Nurse Deployment Program," which was later changed to "Human Resources for Health." Through the said program, nurses under the employ of the DOH were deployed to the City of Bacoor to enhance public access to quality healthcare. Back then, the city's accomplishments in various health programs were low due to the insufficient number of health workers, and

In 2022, the City of Bacoor had 35 nurses and 5 midwives who conducted various health programs for the city government, particularly in barangays with high numbers of informal settlers and indigent populations. The said health workers employed by the DOH also played a crucial role in helping the City of Bacoor face the challenges brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Findings:

It is clearly shown that the sudden cancellation of the continued deployment by the DOH of the 35 nurses and 5 midwives under its employ to the City of Bacoor will severely affect the conduct of essential health care programs/activities of the city government due to the insufficient number of health workers that will remain in its various health centers.

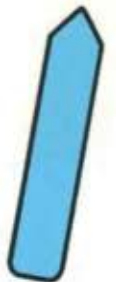
