Subject: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) REGARDING THE DESIGNATION OF RELIEF WAREHOUSE FACILITY. (PCR 283-2023 dated May 02, 2023)

FINDINGS:

Under Republic Act 7160, the City Government of Bacoor shall provide relief services and assistance for the victims during and in the aftermath of disaster and their return to productive livelihood following the said event.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Offices is mandated to provide technical and relief augmentation assistance to Local Government Units (LGU's) affected by disaster beyond its capabilities.

RECOMMENDATION:

The LGU thru the Local Social Welfare and Development Office (LSWDO), with its available Designated Relief Warehousing Facility is willing to accommodate the prepositioned relief goods of the DSWD to be used exclusively during disasters.

With no objections from the body and with the Internal Rules suspended, the Presiding Officer Honorable Rowena Bautista-Mendiola ordered the APPROVAL of a "Resolution authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government of Baccor and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) regarding the designation of Relief Warehouse Facility", as recommended by Committee Chairperson, Adrielito Gawaran. It was unanimously seconded by all members of the council.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Offices is mandated to provide technical and relief augmentation assistance to Local Government Units (LGU's) whose capabilities are insufficient to address the various challenges caused by calamities.

The Local Government Unit under RA 7160 shall provide relief services and assistance for the victims during and in the aftermath of disaster and their return to productive livelihood following the said event.

The City Government of Bacoor through its City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) designated a Relief Warehousing Facility to take in the prepositioned relief goods provided by the DSWD to be used during disasters by the City Government of Bacoor.

The committee believes that services and relief goods must be easily and promptly delivered to Bacoor City residents. On the 41th Regular Session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod, the Committee Chairman, Adrielito Gawaran agreed with what is stipulated on the draft Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and found it beneficial to our constituents.

RELIEF PREPOSITIONING AGREEMENT

WITNESSETH,

WHEREAS, the DSWD through its Field Offices is mandated to provide technical and relief augmentation assistance to LGUs affected by disaster beyond its capabilities.

WHEREAS the LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) under RA 7160 shall provide relief services and assistance for the victims during and in the aftermath of disaster and their return to productive livelihood following the said event

WHEREAS the LGU thru the LOCAL SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (LSWDO), with its available DESIGNATED RELIEF WAREHOUSING FACILITY is willing to accommodate the prepositioned relief goods of the DSWD to be used exclusively during disasters.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and of the conditions herein after set forth, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

I. OBLIGATIONS OF DSWD:

- 1 The DSWD shall preposition emergency Food and Non-Food relief items to LGU designated relief warehousing facility as emergency relief augmentation to the LGU emergency response preparedness measure
- 2 During disaster situations upon the full utilization of the relief items of the LGU the LGU may utilize the prepositioned emergency food and non-food

relief items of the DSVVD for the affected families

- The DSWD shall preposition goods based on maximum quantity as identified in Annex A Twenty-Five percent (25%) utilization shall warrant replenishment

- 8 The DSWD shall monitor the distribution of the augmentation shall make the DSWD SWAD Items are selected the Relief Distribution Sheets through DSWD SWAD Items
- 9 The OSWO, upon submission of the LGU of the Food-For-Work proposal shall evaluate and approve the proposal based on existing accounting policies and guidelines
- to The OSVVD may withdraw the prepositioned goods and deliver it to another disaster affected LGU
- concerns related to prepositioning of goods are addressed
- accordance with existing policies and guidelines
- II. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL MUNICIPAL CITY COTY
- 1 The LGU, concurred by the DSWD, shall identify warehouse based on DSWD slandards suitable for storage of prepositioned lood and non-food items.
- S The LGU shall identify authorized representative as point of contact for related issues and concerns.
- 3 The LGU through the PAWCSWDO shall ensure proper management of prepositioned relief goods based on standards set during technical assistance.

- 4 The LGU through the P/M/CSWDO shall submit a monthly report to the DSWD on the status of the prepositioned relief items/commodities including the liquidation documents for the release FNts.
- 5 The LGU shall ensure that the storage of their life items shall adhere to the following
 - a The LGU shall ensure that the ground and flooring around and within the warehouse is dry and clean at all times.
 - b The LGU shall cover its waste disposal system, including the maintenance and removal of visible litter or waste which may attract rodents, insects, and pests
 - c The LGU shall maintain cleanliness of walls and floors of the warehouse and prevent water dripping that will contaminate the prepositioned relief items.
 - d The LGU shall ensure adequate ventilation (installation of exhaust fan wellfan, and the like) and lighting in the warehouse.
- 6 The LGU shall conduct a regular bi-monthly general housekeeping, sanitation and inspection on storage area should be conducted.
 - a The LGU shall conduct regular cleaning operations to eradicate if not minimize food and non-food item stockpile contamination.
 - b The LGU shall ensure maintenance and preventive measure to eliminate rodents, insects, pests and the like in the warehouse. Use of pesticide, under precautions and restriction to prevent confamination of food stockpiles.
 - The EGU shall facilitate the installation of baits and traps based on their assessment and
 - d The LGU shall adhere to the minimum standards set by DSWD during technical assistance to LGU for storing of food and non-food items to ensure orderly and properly storing of relief items.
- 7 The LGU shall ensure adherence to the First-in-First-out (FIFO) or First-Expiry-First-Out (FEFO) policy in the release of FNIs
- 8 In case that the prepositioned relief food commodities were not utilized within the period of three (3) months prior to its expiration, the LGU shall submit request for Food for Work on disaster preparedness and mitigation related activities.
- 9 The LGU shall grant the DSWD with full access and control to monitor the quality of relief goods stored at the facility at any given time
- 10 The LGU in no cases shall distribute, disburse, or dispose prepositioned relief items without the approval from the DSWD.

W. CONFIDENTIALY CLAUSE

Both parties acknowledge that certain confidential data and documents as well as technical information proprietary to both parties have been or will be

disclosed to each other pursuant to the terms of this agreement

Both parties agree not to use or allow the use of the confidential information for its own or any other purposes except in the performance of its obligations under this agreement. Both parties further agree that it will not disclose or allow others to disclose confidential information to any persons and agree to take and protect secrecy of and to avoid disclosure or use of the confidential information in order to prevent it from falling into public domain or into possession of persons not bound to maintain the confidentiality of confidential information.

W. TERM and TERMINATION

This agreement shall be effective from ______ and shall be binding for a period of ______ unless sooner terminated by the parties for violation of the Terms and Conditions herein and provided a thirty day (30) prior notice given to the other party

V. PENALTY CLAUSE

Any violation in the provisions of this agreement and Section 19 of RA 10121 shall be a ground for the pre-termination. In case of fraudulent act causing disadvantage to any of the parties, the disadvantaged party shall be remunerated equivalent to damaged incurred.

RA 10121 Section 19 Prohibited Acts

- Dereliction of duties which leads to destruction, loss of lives critical damage of facilities and misuse of funds;
- b Preventing the entry and distribution of relief goods in disaster-stricken areas including appropriate technology, tools equipment, accessories, disaster teams/experts.
- Buying, for consumption or resale, from disaster relief agencies any relief goods, equipment or other and commodities which are intended for distribution to disaster affected communities.
- d Buying, for consumption or resale from the recipient disaster affected persons any relief goods, equipment or other aid commodities received by them.
- Setting of relief goods, equipment or other aid commodities which are intended for distribution to disaster victims.
- Forcibly seizing relief goods, equipment or other aid commodities intended for or consigned to a specific group of victims or relief agency.
- g Diverting or misdelivery of relief goods, equipment or other aid commodities to persons other than the rightful recipient or consignee.
- Accepting, possessing, using or disposing relief goods, equipment or other aid commodities not intended for nor consigned to him/her.
- Misrepresenting the source of relief goods equipment or other aid commodities by

- Either covering replacing or defacing the labels of the containers to make it appear that the goods, equipment or other aid commodities came from another agency or persons.
- Repacking the goods equipment or other aid commodities into containers with different markings to make it appear that the goods came from another agency or persons or was released upon the instance of a particular agency or persons.
- Making false verbal claim that the goods, equipment or other and commodity milts untampered original containers actually came from another agency or persons or was released upon the instance of a particular agency or persons.
- Substituting or replacing relief goods, equipment or other aid commodities, with the same items or inferior/cheaper quality.
- k triegal solicitations by persons or organizations representing others as defined in the standards and guidelines set by the NDRRMC.
- Deliberate use of laise at inflated data in support of the request for funding relief goods equipment or other aid commodities for emergency assistance or livelihood projects and
- Tampering with or stealing hazard monitoring and disaster preparedness equipment and paraphernalia
