Subject: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT (DOLE) REGION IV-A FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS (OSHS) ACT. PCR 334-2023 dated 03 July 2023

Acting on the proposed resolution authorizing the City Mayor to sign the memorandum of agreement between the City Government of Baccor and the Department of Employment (DOLE) Region IV-A, the committee on health and sanitation chaired by Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan respectfully reports that:

In accordance with Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the state shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.

Under Article XIII, Section 3 provides further that the state shall afford full protection for labor, local and overseas, organized and unorganized, and promote full employment and equality of employment opportunities for all.

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11058, approved on 17 August 2018, the State shall protect every worker against injury, sickness, or death through safe and healthful working conditions, thereby assuring the conservation of valuable manpower resources and the prevention of loss or damage to lives and properties consistent with national development goals and with the State's commitment to the total development of every worker as a complete human being.

In Paragraph 2, Section 3, Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution guarantees the rights of all workers to decent and humane conditions of work.

Section 18 and Article II of the 1987 Constitution provide that the state affirms labor as a primary social-economic force. It will protect the rights of workers and promote their welfare.

Section 3, Article IX-B of the 1987 Constitution provides that the Civil Service Commission (CSC), as the central personnel agency of the bureaucracy, shall adopt measures to promote morale, efficiency, integrity, responsiveness, and courtesy of government, and

On 04 March 2020, DOLE, CSC, and DOH, through Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, directed all heads of Constitutional Bodies, department Bureaus, and Agencies of the National

Government, Local Government Units, Government-Owned and/or controlled corporations with the Original Charters and State Universities and Colleges to adhere to Occupational Safety and Health Standards in their respective workplaces.

#### Findings:

It is clearly shown that the DOLE REGIONAL IV-A has the constitutional mandate and authority to ensure compliance with the provisions of the standards through the inspectors. The LGU-BACOOR recognizes that the authority to conduct inspections is solely within the mandate of the DOLE REGIONAL IV-A, including expertise and resources. Furthermore, the LGU-BACOOR established a Safety Office (Mandatory Safety).

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Upon review of the copy of the draft Memorandum of Agreement, the committee respectfully recommends that the said proposed resolution **BE PASSED** by the Council in regard to compliance with provisions of the Occupational Safety and Health Standards (OCHS) Act.

WHEREAS, on 23 June 2023, the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter-request from the Office of the City Mayor of Bacoor for the authority to sign a draft Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Labor and Employment Region IV-A relating to the implementation of Republic Act No. 11058 ("An Act Strengthening Compliance with Occupational Safety and Health Standards"). The Draft Memorandum of Agreement is deemed incorporated and made an integral part of this Resolution.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11058 aims to protect workers against injury, sickness, and death through the implementation of safe and healthful working conditions. thereby manifesting the State's commitment to occupational safety and health.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines asserts the State's obligation to protect and promote the right to health of the people. affirming the fundamental human right to health for all citizens.

WHEREAS. Article XIII, Section 3 of the Constitution emphasizes the State's duty to afford full protection to labor. underlining the nation's commitment to the safety, welfare, and overall well-being of its labor force.

> WHEREAS, under the proposed Memorandum of Agreement, the City Government of Bacoor will create a Safety Office through which it will monitor compliance of all business establishments in the City to OSH Standards.

> WHEREAS, the signing and implementation of the proposed Memorandum of Agreement is consistent with the duty of the City Government of Bacoor under its Charter (Republic Act No. 10160) to ensure the provision of basic services including those that promote the health of its residents.

> WHEREAS, the City Mayor has the power to represent the City in its business transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod under Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991.

Memorandum of Agreement between City Government of Bacoor and Department of Labor and Employment Region IV 1

WHEREAS, on 04 March 2020. DOLE. CSC and DOH, through a Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 directed all Heads of Constitutional Bodies. Departments. Bureaus and Agencies of the National Government, Local Government Units, Government-Owned and/or Controlled Corporations with Original Charters and State Universities and Colleges to adhere to Occupational Safety and Health Standards in their respective workplaces.

WHEREAS, the DOLE REGIONAL IV-A has the constitutional mandate and authority to ensure compliance to the provision of the standards through its inspectors:

WHEREAS, the LGU-BACOOR recognizes that the authority to conduct inspections is solely in the mandate of the DOLE REGIONAL tV-A, including expertise and resources

WHEREAS, the LGU-BACOOR has a Vision to "Create a Healthy and Well-Protected Working Citizen of Bacoor. To have a Caring and Responsive Work Environment brought about by sound OSH Policies and Laws, Research. Training, Information Exchange, and Technical Expertise.

WHEREAS, the LGU-BACOOR established a Safety Office (Mandatory Safety Business Regulatory) to support the Vision. The Safety Office will inspect and monitor compliance of all establishments in the City to OSH Standards.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows.

# ARTICLE I. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES. .

#### 1 The LGU-BACOOR shall

- 1.1 Through its Safety Office's (Mandatory Safety Business Regulatory) OSH Compliance Auditor, inspect and monitor compliance of all establishment to OSH Standards
- 1.2 Through its Safety Office's (Mandatory Safety Business Regulatory) OSH Capacity Building Specialist prepare and submit to DOLE REGION IV-A
  - 1.2.1 a regular report of establishments visited and inspected.
  - 1.2.2 recommended action for establishment that does not meet the standards
- 1.3 Provide assistance to non-compliant establishment by recommending actions to comply with OSH Standards

#### 2 The DOLE REGION IV-A shall:

- 2.1 Acknowledge and deputize Bacoor Government Safety Office's OSH Compliance Auditor to conduct establishment OSH visit to follow Section 25 "Delegation of Authority" of DO198-18
- 2.2 Provide technical assistance to the Safety Office personnel of the LGU-BACOOR through advance safety training

ARTICLE II. ETHICAL CONDUCT OF EXTENSION ACTIVITIES. - The DOLE REGION IV-A has the responsibility of ensuring that the conduct of the activities is in

accordance with ethical standards especially those affecting all parties concerned. The same sanction cited in the next preceding Section shall apply to violations found under this provision of the Contract.

may, based on evidence of failure of the DOLE REGION IV-A to comply with the terms of the grant agreement or in the event the DOLE REGION IV-A incurs unreasonable delay, maction, or break of obligation under the Memorandum of Agreement, issue a notice of intent to terminate the grant agreement. The notice of intent to terminate has the force and effect of extending or modifying the conditions of the suspend order. Any modification of the condition of the suspend order shall be shown in the notice and discussed with the implementing grantee. The LGU-BACOOR shall give not less than ten days written notice to the DOLE REGION IV-A of intent to terminate the grant in whole or in part.

After the DOLE REGION IV-A has been notified and/or afforded opportunity for discussion, the Director concerned may request authorization from the Commission en Banc to terminate the grant in whole or in part. If the Commission en Banc concurs in the termination action, the termination notice will be forwarded to the DOLE REGION IV-A. The termination notice shall establish the effective date of the termination of the grant and the amount and date of payment of any sums due either party.

If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever shall arise between the parties in connection with the implementation or interpretation of this contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve amicably such dispute or difference by mutual consultation.

ARTICLE IV. BASIS FOR TERMINATION - A grant may be terminated by the LGU-BACOOR for cause. Cause for termination of the LGU-BACOOR includes failure of the DOLE REGION IV-A to make satisfactory progress toward achieving level of participation, or other evidence satisfactory to the LGU-BACOOR that the DOLE REGION IV-A has failed or is unable to perform in accordance with the provisions of the agreement

ARTICLE V. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - In the event that one or more provisions contained herein shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect and for any reason, the remaining provisions shall remain valid, legal and enforceable

ARTICLE VI. DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THIS AGREEMENT - All appendices hereto attached are hereby expressly made an integral part of this agreement by reference, excluding inconsistencies with any/all part terms, and conditions contained in this Memorandum of Agreement

ARTICLE VII. EFFECTIVITY OF THE AGREEMENT - This Agreement shall take effect upon the release of funds to the concerned HEI for the project implementation and shall be in effect for a period of three (3) months from the release of funds and is automatically extended should the community quarantine is extended by government
