AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR PERTAINING TO THE MANDATORY TRAINING ON EMERGENCY RESPONSE OF THE BACOOR RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE. () dated 25 SEPTEMBER 2023

Acting on the referral, a joint committee hearing was held on October 5, 2023 regarding the above-mentioned subject matter with the following attendees. (See attached attendance sheet)

FINDINGS:

The committee gathered some opinions and suggestions which may be needed in the deliberation of the soid memorandum of agreement. Thus, the committee respectfully reports that:

- i. The TaskUs Outsourcing Philippines, Inc. (TaskUs) requested the City Government of Baccar (LGU Baccar) through the Baccar Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (BDRRMO) to allow the conduct of mandatory training on emergency response in the premises of taskUs instead of its employees attending the seminar in the City Government of Baccar;
- To effectively comply with existing laws, ordinances and circulars on emergency response training and other Occupational Safety and Health Standard (OSHS), the LGU Baccoor agrees to targe this partnership with TaskUs for the convenience and benefit of TaskUs employees and personnel;

- 3. The LGU of Bacoor guarantees that the cost of the training seminars to be conducted by the BDRRMO shall be shouldered by the EGU Bacoor, and no fees shall be charged from any of the employees of TaskUs:
- Fasklis ensures that all its employees shall attend the training seminars to be conducted by the BDRRMO;
- In support of the training seminar, ToskUs shall provide the venue for the conduct of seminar, the accommodation and harding area, meals for all the participants, and other technical requirements for the conduct of training seminar.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing. The Committee recommends that a resolution be passed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod authorizing the City Mayor. Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign a memorandum of agreement between ToskUs Phil., Inc. and the City Government of Bacoar pertaining to the mandatory training on emergency response of the Bacoar Risk Reduction and Management Office.





To effectively comply with existing laws, Ordinances, and Circulars on emergency response training and other Occupational Safety and Health Standard (OSHS), the LGU Baccoor agrees to forge this partnership with TaskUs for the convenience and benefit of TaskUs employees and personnel.

This Administration supports this proposed partnership to ensure the safety and health of workers in the workplace and to equip every Baccoreño with the proper training on emergency repsonse. Attached herewith is the draft Memorandum of Agreement, for your perusal.

In view thereof, I respectfully request the esteemed members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to perform the appropriate actions that will grant me the authority to enter into and sign the abovementioned Agreement with TaskUs.

TASKUS OUTSOURCING PHILIPPINES, INC., Business Process Outsourcing Services; and Digital Solutions Provider entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at 5F-6F MDC101, Molino-Paliparan Road, Baccor City, Province of Cavite, represented herein by its DVP for People Operations, Ms. REGINA AGUILA, and hereinafter referred to as "TASKUS."

"Party" shall mean LGU BACOOR or TASKUS, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall mean LGU BACOOR and TASKUS, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 18, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State affirms labor as a primary social economic force. It shall protect the rights of workers and promote their welfare:

WHEREAS, Article 162 of the Labor Code of the Philippines provides that the Secretary of Labor and Employment shall, by appropriate orders, set and enforce mandatory occupational safety and health standards to eliminate or reduce occupational safety and health hazards in all workplaces and institute new, and update existing, programs to ensure safe and healthful working conditions in all places of employment;

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment issued Department Order No. 198 Series of 2018, otherwise known as the "Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 11058, entitled "An Act Strengthening Compliance with Occupational Safety and Health Standards and Providing Penalties for Violations thereof";

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2012," provides for the development of policies and plans and the implementation of actions and measures

pertaining to all aspects of disaster risk reduction and management, including good governance, risk assessment and early warning, knowledge building, and awareness raising, reducing underlying factors, and preparedness for effective response and early recovery:

WHEREAS, Rule 1, Section 3 (m) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 10121 provides that one of the aims of the said law is to engage the participation of civil society organizations, the private sector, and volunteers in the government's disaster. risk reduction programs towards complementation of resources and effective delivery of services to the citizenry;

WHEREAS, Bacoor City Ordinance No. 248-2022, Series of 2022 or the "Bacoor Emergency Response Training Seminar" requires all students, Parent-Teachers Association members, employees of business enterprises, tricycle drivers, and operators, and public officials/employees to undergo training on emergency response in line with the Disaster Preparedness Program of the City of Baccor;

WHEREAS, TASKUS requested LGU BACOOR to allow the conduct of mandatory training on emergency response in the premises of TASKUS instead of its employees attending the seminar in the City Government of Baccort

WHEREAS, the LGU BACOOR agrees to forge this partnership with TASKUS for the convenience and benefit of TASKUS employees and personnel;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Parties have nereunto agreed as follows:

ARTICLE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

SECTION 1.

The LGU BACOOR, through the Bacoor Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office, shall:

- A. Conduct the Mandatory Training for Emergency Response (the "Training") and other Occupational Safety and Health Standard (OSHS) related seminars within the designated venue as determined by TASKSUS;
- B. Design the training program to be used in the implementation of the Training for the covered employees of TASKUS;
- C. Provide the services of the trainers and other personnel from BDRRMO who shall be conducting the training seminar,
- D. Guarantee that the cost of the training seminars to be conducted by the BDRRMO shall be shouldered by the LGU BACOOR, and no feeshall be charged from any of the employees of TASKUS;
- E. Inspect the safety and health protocols implemented in TASKUS to quarantee compliance with the laws.

ARTICLE II RESPONSIBILITIES OF TASKUS

Section 1. TASKUS shall:

- A Ensure that all its employees shall attend the Training seminars to be conducted by the BDRRMO;
- B. in support of this Training Seminar, we shall provide the following:
 - a. Venue for the conduct of the Training seminar;
 - Accommodation and holding area for the trainers and other personnel of LGU BACOOR;
 - Meals for its participating employees and representatives of LGU BACOOR;
 - d. Technical requirements for the conduct of the Training seminar;
 - e. Audience mobilization;
 - Health and safety protocols such as marshals, ushers, safety officers, and standby medics.
- C. Coordinate with LGU BACOOR the intended date of the Training seminar to be conducted in their chosen venue provided that a written notice be sent by TASKUS to LGU BACOOR at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of the Training seminar;
- D. Guarantee to LGU BACOOR that all its Safety Health Officers are trained by DOLE or DOLE-Accredited Training Organization and tasked to implement all Occupational Safety and Health Programs.

ARTICLE III TERM AND TERMINATION

Section 1. Unless otherwise terminated as provided herein, this Agreement shall be effective, remain in force from the Effective Date, and automatically be terminated on 30 June 2025. This Agreement may be renewed by one Party by sending a formal written notice to the other Party at least thirty (30) days prior to the termination date.

Either Party may terminate this Agreement without cause by written notice to the other Party at least thirty (30) days before the intended termination date. Pre-termination by either Party under this section shall be based only on valid and equitable grounds.

If either Party commits a material breach under this Agreement or commits a material breach of any other terms and conditions of this Agreement, or unjustifiable refusal or fails to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement, the aggrieved Party may terminate this Agreement (i) effective immediately, if the breach cannot be remedied; or (ii) if the breach may be remedied, within thirty (30) days from receipt of written notice of the breach and the Party in breach has failed to cure such breach or perform its obligations.

ARTICLE IV CONFIDENTIALITY AND DATA PRIVACY


- Section 1.
- The Parties expressly warrant and agree that they shall not, during and after the existence of this Agreement, disclose not reveal to any person or any other entity all Confidential Information or records of the other Party, including the training materials or modules, which may come to their knowledge and/or possession, in the performance of, or in connection with this Agreement. Such confidential information shall include, but not be limited to, the Parties respective trade secrets like training modules and presentations and any other methods, processes, formulae, systems, and data pertaining to the training manual and other relevant details and/or information of either Party. The Parties agree to ensure that their directors, officers, nominees, employees, and/or agents are bound by the provisions of this paragraph.
- Section 2.
- In compliance with RA 10173 or the "Data Privacy Act of 2012", each Party agrees that it will and will ensure that its employees, officers, directors, representatives, and other personnel will hold in confidence all information, documentation, data, or know-how disclosed to the other Party (the "Information"), and will not disclose to any third party or use the information or any partithereof without such other Party's prior written approval. Likewise, the Receiving Party undertakes to prevent the transfer of all strictly confidential and confidential information about this Agreement or by any of its members to any Party without the knowledge and written consent of the Disclosing Party.
- Section.3.
- Each Party shall be solely and exclusively liable for any preach of its obligations under this Agreement and for any breach by it of Philippine Privacy Laws during the effectivity of this Agreement. TASKUS shall indemnify and hold LGU BACOOR free and harmless from any direct, actual, and documented liability, damages, claims, action expenses, losses, or fees that may arise from any relevant breach or negligence in relation to the personal data of its employees.

ARTICLE V MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 1.

SEVERABILITY. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is declared by any judicial or competent Government Instrumentality to be void, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, the Parties shall amend that provision in such reasonable manner as will achieve the intention of the Parties or any remaining provision of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unless the Parties mutually agree that the effect of such declaration is to defeat the original intention of the Parties in which event, by mutual agreement, the Parties may decide to terminate this Agreement





- Section 3. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes all prior agreements, discussions, proposals, representations, or warranties, whether written or oral, on this subject matter.
- Section 4. AUTHORITY. Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement on its behalf is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.
