Subject: *A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR, THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP) BACOR CITY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd) BACOR CITY REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED RESPONSE (SBR) TRAINING FOR BACOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS. PCR 434-2023 dated 06 November 2023*

This report resolves the authorization of the city mayor to sign a tripartite memorandum of agreement, dated 14 November 2023. The said memorandum of agreement was referred to the committee by the Sangguniang Panlungsod President Pro-Tempore, Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica, during the 67th Regular Session dated 06 November 2023.

The committee on Housing, Land Utilization and Urban Development, chaired by Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan, respectfully reports the following:

Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental; for its efficient and effective governance, and those essential to the promotion of the general welfare. (Section 16, Chapter II, Title I, Local Government Code of 1991);

BFP-Bacoor, with the support of the LGU-Bacoor, created the Strike Fire and Rescue Village (SFRV) purposely to foster fire safety awareness and education, life protection, and disaster preparedness among its citizens;

DepEd-Bacoor plays a primordial role in molding the minds of our youth through substantial education.

Findings:

The foregoing discussion clearly showed the commitment of BFP-Bacoor and DepEd-Bacoor to train an active and participative citizenry well-equipped with the basic knowledge in fire and life safety, discipline in emergency preparedness and response, and to educate them at an early age and/or during school age. The said training venue will be held at Strike Fire and Rescue Village, Barangay Molino IV, Bacoor City, Cavite.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough evaluation, the committee respectfully recommends the **APPROVAL** of the tripartite memorandum of agreement.

The committee hearing commenced with Hon. Councilor Alde Joselito F. Pagulyan extended greetings to all attendees and introduced the agenda. The focus was on the implementation and conduct of school-based response training for Bacoor public teachers and students. Clarification was sought regarding the involvement of the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), and it was confirmed that the PTA would not be included. Coun. Pagulayan then acknowledged Hon. Coun. Rogelio M. Nolasco for the opening remarks.

The subsequent discussion delved into the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), outlining the purpose, duties, and responsibilities of LGU Bacoor, BFP Bacoor, and DepEd Bacoor. Specific points, such as the approval process, coordination, and provision of certificates for participants, were addressed.

Hon. Pagulayan emphasized the importance of coordinating school-based training with BFP Bacoor for students' safety.

A discussion ensued regarding scheduling training sessions, confirming participant attendance, and the possibility of incorporating units for teachers. Various suggestions were



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made, including holding contests in schools and involving students in the barangay-farm brigade competition, paintings, and essay writing contests.

The meeting concluded with expressions of support and gratitude from participants, and a proposal to include the discussed matters in the Local School Board (LSB) Resolution. The Chair, officially adjourned the committee hearing.




Section 5, Article II, 1987 Philippine Constitution enshrines the principle that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the employment by the people of the blessings of democracy. Pursuant to City Ordinance No. 248-2022, Series of 2022, all students, parent-teacher association (PTA) members, employees of business enterprises, tricycle drivers and operators, and public officials/employees to undergo training on emergency response in line with the Disaster Preparedness Program of the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

In line with this, the City Government of Bacoor, the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), and the Department of Education-City Schools Division of Bacoor (DepEd-Bacoor) recognized the need to execute a Memorandum of Agreement for the conduct of School-Based Response (SBR) training for Bacoor public teachers and students. Attached herewith is the proposed Memorandum of Agreement draft between the City Government, BFP, and DepEd-Bacoor for your perusal.

TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN AND AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOOR, BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION-BACCOOR CITY and THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION BACCOOR CITY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED RESPONSE "SBR" TRAINING FOR BACCOOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **Tripartite Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement")** is made and executed into among and between this ___ day of _____, 202__ (the "Effective Date"), in the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, among and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOOR**, a local government unit created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented by its **City Mayor, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority embodied and conferred under **City Resolution No. 2023-_____** Series of 2023, approved by the City Council of Bacoor dated _____ and herein referred to as "**LGU-BACCOOR**".

The **BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP)**, a National Agency created by virtue of Republic Act No. 6975, with office address at Camp Vicente Lim, Barangay Mayapa, Calamba City, Province of Laguna, herein represented by **FCSUPT JAIME DOLLENTE RAMIREZ** in his capacity as Regional Director of BFP R4A CALABARZON and hereinafter referred to as "**BFP-Bacoor**".

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION-CITY SCHOOLS DIVISION OF BACCOOR**, a government entity mandated by law, particularly B.P. 232, otherwise known as the "Education Act of 1982", as amended by Republic Act No. 9155, otherwise known as the "Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001", with a principal address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, City of Bacoor, Cavite represented by its School Division Superintendent, **DR. BABYLYN M. PAMBID** herein called the "**DepEd-Bacoor**".

The term "**PARTY**" shall mean **LGU-BACCOOR, DepEd-Bacoor, or BFP-Bacoor**, if applicable. While the term "**PARTIES**" shall mean **LGU BACCOOR, DepEd-Bacoor, and BFP** collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, it is a well-entrenched constitutional principle that "The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of Life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the employment by the people of the blessings of democracy" (Section 5, Article II, 1987 Constitution);

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 248-2022, **Series of 2022** requires all students, **Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) Members, employees of business enterprises, tricycle drivers and operators, and public officials/employees** to undergo training on emergency response in line with the Disaster Preparedness Program of the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

WHEREAS, every local government **unit** shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessary **implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary**, appropriate,

or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those essential to the promotion of the general welfare. (Section 16, Chapter II, Title I, Local Government Code of 1991);

WHEREAS, BFP-Bacoor, with the support of the **LGU-BACCOOR**, created the Strike Fire and Rescue Village (SFRV) purposely to foster fire safety awareness and education, life protection, and disaster preparedness among its citizens.

WHEREAS, DepEd-Bacoor plays a primordial role in molding the minds of our youth through substantial education.

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** commit to train an active and participative citizenry who will be well-equipped with the basic knowledge in fire and life safety and discipline in emergency preparedness response.

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** recognize that fire safety, life protection, and disaster preparedness education should begin at an early age of discovery and/or during school age.

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** agree that the venue of SBR training will be held at Strike Fire and Rescue Village, Barangay Molino IV, Bacoor City, Cavite.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the **PARTIES** hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT.

The purpose of this **Agreement** is for the parties to agree to come together to commit the following:

- a. To foster the culture of fire safety, life protection, and disaster preparedness for the people of Bacoor City;
- b. To empower the public teachers employed in schools found within the Bacoor City with adequate skills in responding to destructive fire, disaster, and life and medical emergencies and life at school;
- c. To nurture the public students in Bacoor City schools with knowledge in fire and life safety protection, disaster preparedness, and emergency medical situations.

Section 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

a. LGU-BACCOOR

- a. Shall be responsible for the approval through the City Mayor of the submissions made by the **BFP-Bacoor** and **DepEd-Bacoor** as required in this Agreement;
- b. Shall provide supplemental manpower support for the administration and operations of the training;
- c. Shall provide transportation vehicles for the participants during the duration of the training; and

- d. Shall ensure the safety of all participants during the training period.

b. BFP-Bacoor

- a. The **BFP-Bacoor** will **adopt** the modules provided by the BFP National Headquarters under the *Oplan Ligtas na Paaralan* Safe School Initiative (OLP-SSI) and translate those into instructional videos and actual demonstration during the period of training;
- b. Shall be the overall in charge of the School-Based Response ("SBR") training with the **concurrence** of **LGU-BACOOOR** and **DepEd-Bacoor**;
- c. Shall coordinate with **LGU-BACOOOR** and **DepEd-Bacoor** as to the status and updates **in order** to smoothly **accommodate** the participants who will undergo the SBR training;
- d. Shall **provide a** Certificate of Completion for **participant teachers and students** who successfully finished the SBR Training **and**
- e. Shall **coordinate with LGU-BACOOOR to** ensure the safety of all participants during the training period.

c. DepEd-Bacoor

- a. Shall select **the** teachers and students who will participate in the SBR training;
- b. Shall ensure that **the** parent's approval of the students participating in the training is secured, gathered, and filed.
- c. Shall coordinate with **BFP-Bacoor** the status and updates of the participating teachers and students who will undergo the **SBR** Training.
- d. Shall not be allowed to conduct re-echo training to students without **coordinating with BFP-Bacoor** for safety purposes.
- e. Shall ensure the safety of all participants during the training period.

Section 3. DATA PRIVACY

Information collected from private individuals shall be **used and utilized** for the sole purpose of this MOA and may not be subject to third-party transfers or sharing without the consent of the data subject. Relevant rules and regulations promulgated by the National Privacy Commission and the Data Privacy Act must apply and obligate or restrict any party's activity.

Section 4. AGREEMENT TERM AND TERMINATION

- a. **Unless otherwise terminated**, this **Agreement** shall commence on its **Effective date** contained herein and shall **be terminated** until December 31, 2034.
- b. This **Agreement** may be renewed by written agreement of the **PARTIES** for a successive one (1) year period from the automatic termination date as needed.
- c. **GOOD FAITH**. In complying with and implementing the terms of this **Agreement**, the **Parties** shall **exercise good faith and cooperation** to fulfill their common objective.
