REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOD WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA (UPHSD) – MOLINO CAMPUS REGARDING THE TRAINING OF ITS NURSING STUDENTS AT THE PUBLIC HEALTH CENTERS IN THE CITY OF BACOOD. PCR 446-2023 dated 20 November 2023.**

This report resolves the resolution authorizing the City Mayor to sign Moa with UPHSD-Molino campus, dated 31 January 2024. The said MOA was referred to the committee by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Presiding Officer Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola, during the 69th Regular Session dated 20 November 2023. Thus, the committee reports that:

Under Section 455 (b)(vi) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 7160 otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" authorizes the City to Represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

The UPHSD-Molino enlisted nursing students who are required to undergo clinical training and enjoined to complete a clinical practicum as part of their curriculum to gain related learning experiences designed to develop the competencies of students utilizing processes in various health institutions; and

The LGU Bacoor has under its jurisdiction health center/units through the Bacoor City Health Office. The LGU Bacoor agrees and allows the affiliation and training in its rural health Units of the Nursing Students of the UPHSD-Molino subject to the policies, procedures, and guidelines governing affiliation and training of Nursing students set forth in the Join Administrative Order (JAO) of Commission on Higher Education-Department of health (CHED-DOH) No. 2013-0034 and other rules and regulations pertinent thereto.

Findings:

The foregoing discussion clearly showed that the City Government of Bacoor is willing to assist in the training of the said nursing students so that they can become productive, efficient and competent health professionals. In line with this, there is a need to execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government of Bacoor and the University of Perpetual Help System Dalta (UPHSD) – Molino campus.



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RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review, the committee respectfully recommends the **APPROVAL** of the said resolution regarding the training of the nursing students at the public health centers in the City of Bacoor.

Coun. Pagulayan This resolution authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla to sign a MOA on behalf of the city with the University of Perpetual Help System. Can you explain to us Dean, what is the gist of a memorandum of agreement is?

Dr. Malubag We will be deploying students in the health center of Bacoor, so that they will experience in what it is like to be a community health nurse. They will be assisting in some of the activities of the midwives and nurses in the health centers, so that they will learn how things are done in community health. Of course, deploying them in such an area will also encourage them to work in that particular area in the future because they will understand the nature of work, and it's also a requirement of the curriculum of the course.

Coun. Pagulayan How many students will be deployed for one particular semester?

- Dr. Malubag For the second year, we have more than eighty (80) students. And for our third year, we have thirty-five (35) students.
- Coun. Pagulayan And as I understand it, based on the memorandum of agreement that I think the attorneys will confirm, and this will not entail or require any budgetary allocation from the local government.
- Dr. Malubag In fact, we will be the ones paying.
- Coun. Pagulayan I just wanted you to confirm it for the record and Dra. Yrastorza, do you care to comment?
- Dr. Yrastorza So far Konsi, the deployment of Perpetual nurses is ongoing. Actually, they are not the only schools that deploy nurses. We also have St. Dominic and Perpetual Las Pinas that are rotating to our health centers. And based on the feedback of the students and the clinical instructors, there are students who are learning in our health centers. So it's good exposure for the nurses.
- Coun. Pagulayan Okay. And to our legal department, do you find anything? Do you find everything in order, attorney?
- Atty. Gutierrez Actually, we've already received the draft MOA and have already reviewed it. We also have a back-and-forth with Dr. Lerma and the legal department through email. And they have already provided their comments. We just have a few clarifications.
- Dr. Malubag It's like two weeks at a time. So the students are deployed in various health centers. We have already submitted the names of the students along with the area that was assigned to us. Per health center, we only have eight (8) students per group.
- Atty. Gutierrez I'm asking for clarification. Because what's in the initial draft is 10-12 students. So if it's eight, we will incorporate that into the draft prior to the assignment.
- Dr. Yrastorza It depends on the enrollees, it can increase or decrease.
- Atty. Gutierrez Would everyone be amenable, at least 8-12?
- Atty. Gutierrez Another is from your email. You said that the board of resolutions is no longer needed.
- Dr. Malubag Yes, on our part. Actually, every MOA, not only from the City of Bacoor, even though we have MOA in Dasmariñas, it is directly from the school director. The school director is given the authority to enter into a MOA. So you don't need the Mayor to meet together and allow. Because it's part of the function of the school



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
(Contract of Affiliation for Nursing Students)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2023 (the "Effective Date") at Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, by and between:

CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, a local government unit duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, duly represented by its City Mayor, **Hon. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. _____ Series of _____, approved by the City Council of Bacoor dated _____ and hereinafter referred to as the "**LGU-BACOOR**".

and

UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA - MOLINO CAMPUS, an educational institution duly recognized by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), with business and postal address at Salawag-Zapote Road, Molino 3, City of Bacoor, Cavite, represented by **DR. RENO R. RAJEL**, School Director, duly authorized by virtue of Board Resolution No. _____, hereinafter referred to as the "**UPHSD-MOLINO**".

The term "Party" shall mean **UPHSD-MOLINO** or **LGU-BACOOR**, if applicable, while "Parties" shall mean **UPHSD-MOLINO** and **LGU-BACOOR**, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **UPHSD-MOLINO** enlisted nursing students who are required to undergo clinical training and enjoined to complete a clinical practicum as part of their curriculum to gain related learning experiences designed to develop the competencies of students utilizing processes in various health institutions;

WHEREAS, the **LGU BACOOR** has under its jurisdiction health center/units through the Bacoor City Health Office;

WHEREAS, the **LGU BACOOR** agrees and allows the affiliation and training in its rural Health Units of the Nursing Students of the **UPHSD-MOLINO** subject to the policies, procedures, and guidelines governing affiliation and training of Nursing Students set forth in the Joint Administrative Order ("JAO") of Commission on Higher Education-Department of Health (CHED-DOH) No. 2013-0034 and other rules and regulations pertinent thereto;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF UPHSD-MOLINO

- 1.1 Submit to the **LGU-BACCOOR** the list of all qualified nursing students who will undergo affiliation and training;
- 1.2 Prepared assignments or rotation plans for individual students and in groups following the CHED's guideline of student-faculty ratio. The training schedule shall be determined by the **UPHSD-MOLINO**, subject to the approval of **LGU-BACCOOR**.
- 1.3 Provide a clinical instructor in each group in every area who will be responsible for the students while undergoing clinical practicum in the **LGU-BACCOOR's Health Units**. **"NO CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR, NO STUDENTS"** policy shall be observed.
- 1.4 **UPHSD-MOLINO** shall hold the **LGU-BACCOOR** free and harmless from any liability arising from the implementation of this agreement.
- 1.5 **UPHSD-MOLINO** shall pay the **LGU-BACCOOR** the equivalent amount of any property/ies and/or equipment/s damaged or destroyed due to the fault or negligence on the part of its nursing student or replace such damaged property/ies and/or equipment/s with the exact specifications, kind, brand, and quality thereof, *Provided* that proper investigation will be conducted to determine the negligent Party. Otherwise, the amount damaged shall be borne equally by both parties.
- 1.6 For and in consideration of the affiliation and clinical practicum of its nursing students, the **UPHSD-MOLINO** agrees to provide an honorarium of **ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (PHP150.00)** per student per semester to be paid to the **LGU-BACCOOR**.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF LGU BACCOOR:

- 2.1 ~~Allow~~ **Accept** ~~to~~ **twelve (10-12)** Nursing students of the **UPHSD-MOLINO** for affiliation, training, and clinical practicum per Health Center/Unit of the **LGU-BACCOOR**, subject to the policies, procedures, and guidelines governing the affiliation and training of Nursing students in accordance with the provisions prescribed by the Department of Health (DOH) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED);
- 2.2 Facilitate the designation of Nursing Students to the **LGU-BACCOOR's** health center for the affiliation, training, and clinical practicum. Each student shall stay with the LGU BACCOOR's health centers for the period of at least eighty to ninety-six (80-96) hours per semester;
- 2.3 Provide maximum opportunity for students to gain experience and training, including use of all available materials except for a thermometer, BP apparatus, and stethoscope, which will be provided for by the **UPHSD-MOLINO**;

- 2.4 Permit the attendance of the students in specific activities of the professional program of the Health Centers to be determined during the Program;
- 2.5 Enforce rules and regulations regarding admission, conduct, and training of nursing students by the health center's head;
- 2.6 Undertake disciplinary measures or terminate the affiliation of any student who fails to comply with the regulations of the health centers or who commits acts detrimental to the health, safety, and welfare of its patients and personnel.

3. TERM AND TERMINATION

- 3.1 This Agreement shall have a term of one (1) year, commencing on **October 1, 2023**, and expires until **September 30, 2024**. The term may be extended annually thereafter upon mutual agreement of the Parties in writing.
- 3.2 This Agreement shall be deemed terminated upon the occurrence of any of the following events:
 - 3.2.1 Willful violation of the terms and conditions stipulated herein; or
 - 3.2.2 Mutual consent of both Parties, provided one of the Parties shall furnish the other party the written notice of its intent to terminate this Memorandum at least thirty (3) days before the intended termination date.
 - 3.2.3 Either party may, without the written 30-day notice, forthwith terminate this Memorandum if the other party commits a material breach of its obligations under this Memorandum of Agreement, and such breach is not corrected within the period of Seven (7) days from receipt of notice of default from the non-defaulting party to correct such breach.

4. DATA PRIVACY

- 4.1 Whenever applicable, in performing its obligations under this Agreement, both parties shall always comply with the provisions of the Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10173, or the "Data Privacy Act of 2012", its implementing rules and regulations, and all other related laws and governmental issuances by the National Privacy Commission.
- 4.2 The Parties guarantee that they have their respective appointed Data Privacy Officers (DPO) to ensure the Data Privacy Act provisions are complied with.

5. ARBITRATION

- 5.1 This Agreement is based primarily on mutual trust and confidence. The Parties hereto agree to carry out this Memorandum fairly and cooperatively for their mutual benefit. Should any dispute or disagreement

that may arise in connection with or because of this Memorandum, the Parties hereto shall endeavor to resolve such dispute or disagreement amicably and in a spirit of friendship.

5.2 In the event that such dispute or disagreement cannot be settled by mutual agreement, the same shall be settled before the appropriate courts having jurisdiction in Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, to the exclusion of other courts.

6. SEVERABILITY

6.1 In the event that any provision of this Agreement is declared by any judicial or competent Government Instrumentality to be void, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, the Parties shall amend that provision in such reasonable manner as will achieve the intention of the Parties or any remaining provision of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unless the Parties mutually agree that the effect of such declaration is to defeat the original intention of the Parties in which event, by mutual agreement, the Parties may decide to terminate this Agreement.

7. AMENDMENTS

7.1 This Agreement and any of the Annexes may not be modified except in writing, signed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties after reasonable negotiations and discussions. It is understood that all terms and conditions herein provided are subject to and subordinate to the existing laws, rules, and regulations of the LGU-BACCOOR. In case of conflict, the pertinent provisions of the law, rules, and regulations shall prevail.

8. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION

8.1 This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement and supersede all prior agreements, discussions, proposals, representations, or warranties, whether written or oral, on this subject matter.

9. GOOD FAITH

9.1 In complying with and implementing the terms of this agreement, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective of providing accessible learning and training to nursing students.

10. AUTHORITY

10.1 Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement on its behalf is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.

11. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES

11.1 The relationship of the Parties under and in relation to this agreement shall be limited to the matters herein contained. Nothing herein provided shall be considered or interpreted as constituting the relationship of the parties or any of them as a partnership in which any one or more of the Parties may be liable for the acts or omissions of any other Party or

Parties, nor shall anything herein contained be considered or interpreted as constituting any Party as the general agent of any other Party.

12. IN CASE OF FORTUITOUS EVENTS/FORCE MAJEURE

12.1 No Party shall be liable for any failure or delay in performing its respective obligations as herein provided if any force majeure event shall be the proximate cause of the same. For purposes of this Agreement, a "Force Majeure Event" shall include, but not be limited to (i) declared or undeclared war, armed hostilities, revolution, rebellion, insurrection, riot, public disorder, and the like; (ii) unforeseen rock formations in the geodetic layers of the identified deep well sites; and (iii) extreme and unforeseen weather conditions, fire, unusual flood, earthquake, and similar calamities or acts of God, and the Government's, local or national, declaration of community quarantines and other restrictions; and (iv) expropriation on any part of the site in which the Project will be located.

12.2 The Party invoking the existence of a Force Majeure Event shall immediately notify the other Party, specifying the nature and details of the Force Majeure Event, how it affects the Party's ability to comply with its obligations hereunder, and a proposed mitigating action to address the same.

12.3 Upon the cessation of such Force Majeure Event, the Parties shall immediately resume the performance of their obligations hereunder. However, if the Force Majeure Event extends for a period in excess of 180 continuous days, the Parties hereto shall meet to discuss the basis and terms upon which this Agreement be continued or mutually terminated.

13. NONWAIVER OF RIGHTS

13.1 The failure of a Party to insist upon strict performance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants under this Agreement shall not be deemed a relinquishment or waiver of any right/remedy that the aforesaid Party may have, nor shall it be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or other terms, conditions, and covenants. Any waiver, extension, or forbearance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants of this Agreement by any Party shall be in writing and limited to the particular instance only and shall not in any manner whatsoever be construed as a waiver, extension, or forbearance of any other term, condition, and/or covenant of this Agreement.

14. EFFECTIVITY

14.1 The Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon the date of signing of both parties.
