Subject: A RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH THE ACTIVE TRANSPORT PROJECTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOTR) IN RELATION TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF BIKE LANES AND BUS TERMINALS IN THE CITY OF BACOR.
(PCR 481 - 2023 dated January 08, 2024)

The 73rd regular session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite held on January 08, 2024 at the Session Hall, Bacoor Legislative and Disaster Resilience Building, Bacoor Government Center, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite was presided over by the Acting Presiding Officer Hon. Reynaldo Palabrica. The Acting Presiding Officer called the session to order at 12:30pm.

The Department of Transportation (DOTr) thru its Undersecretary for Road and Infrastructure, Ms. Anneli R. Lontoc, sent a letter to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod requesting its concurrence to the active transport projects of its department funded through Republic Act No. 11936 or otherwise known as the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for Fiscal Year 2023.

The DOTr through the Active Transport Project Office (ATPO) plans to improve the active transport infrastructure in the City of Bacoor giving highest priority to pedestrians and cyclist among all road users and to promote a more sustainable mode of transport.

The ATPO has identified a proposed bike lane network traversing specific road sections within the City of Bacoor and its alignment will have an approximate length of nineteen (19) kilometers, both ways.

FINDINGS:

The City Government of Bacoor concurred in the construction of bike lanes and bus terminals in the City of Bacoor to be implemented by the DOTr. In addition to proposed 19-km bike lane, the City Government would also like to propose the establishment of a 31-km bike lane along Daang Hari Road.

Dear Honorable Council of Bacoor:

This is in reference to the Department's implementation of specific components of the Active Transport Program funded through Republic Act No. 11936 or the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023.

Through the Active Transport Project Office (ATPO), the Department plans to improve the Active Transport Infrastructure in the City of Bacoor to fulfill its mandate through the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028 - giving the highest priority to pedestrians and cyclists among all road users. The AT infrastructure aims to promote a more sustainable mode of transport within the economic centers of both urban and developing local governments.

This Office has identified a proposed bike lane network traversing specific road sections in Bacoor City (see Annex A, Table 1). The proposed bike lane network alignment will have an approximate length of Nineteen (19) km, both ways (see Annex A). This has been previously discussed with the Office of the Mayor, to which the Department has received positive feedback and agreement to the project's implementation (See Annex B).

With this development, the undersigned would like to seek the Honorable Council's approval of the project through a Sanggunian Resolution, which will signify the continuance of the planning and design preparation and subsequent project execution.
