Subject: *A resolution on mandatory submission of medical data (morbidity, mortality, vaccination family planning, pre and postnatal care).*

The above-mentioned subject matter underwent first reading on February 19, 2024 during the 79th Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said subject matter was referred by the Presiding Officer, Bacoor City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Health and Sanitation.

The Committee on Health and Sanitation sent out invitations to the resource persons and conducted a committee hearing on February 29, 2024 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall at 9:40 a.m.

FINDINGS:

During the meeting of the City Health Board held last February 15, 2024, it was raised that there is a necessity to obtain data from private medical establishments such as but not limited to hospitals, medical clinics and birthing homes.

The said data will be used for the reporting of the City Government of Bacoor to the Department of Health. The same data will be used by the city government in planning and implementation of health programs beneficial to the constituency.

The Office of the City Health Services shall provide official template which will be used in reporting system of concerned medical establishments. Data collected shall be handled with utmost confidentiality in compliance to the Data Privacy Act of 2012 or R.A. 10173.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review of all the circumstances and statements from the resource persons, the Committee respectfully recommends that the Sangguniang Panlungsod approve the above subject matter.



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By the motion of Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica duly seconded by all the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the above subject matter was **APPROVED** during its 81st Regular Session.

MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE HEARING

Subject: *A resolution on mandatory submission of medical data (morbidity, mortality, vaccination family planning, pre and postnatal care.*

A committee hearing on the above-subject matter was conducted last February 29, 2024, 9:40 a.m. at the Sangguniang Panlungsod presided by Committee Chairman Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica.

- The Presiding Officer, City Councilor Hon. Reynaldo Palabrica read the above-subject matter and the committee hearing was called to order.
- The Presiding Officer then proceeded with the introduction of the members of the Honorable Committee and City Councilors present in the committee hearing.
- The Presiding Officer asked the resource persons to introduce themselves before the Honorable Committee.



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- The Presiding Officer asked the City Health Services Head, Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza to enlighten the Honorable Committee regarding the proposed resolution.
- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza explained before the Honorable Committee that the request for the passage of an ordinance regarding the above-subject matter resulted from the meeting with the hospital directors two years ago.
- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza added that during that meeting, they requested the private hospitals to submit medical data of health services rendered to the City Health Office for it is a requirement for the Child Friendly Local Governance Audit. She further mentioned that the city does not meet the target due to the lack of data. The only data they have come from the City Health Units and from the Barangay Health Stations.
- Data provided by the private hospital will greatly improve the health services rendered by the City Health Office and the office will see the real picture of the health situation of the city. Planning and programming of health services were only based on the data seen in the city health units and barangay health stations, Dra. Marie Yrastorza narrated.
- The Presiding Officer showed his support to the statements made by the City Health Services head and further said that the medical data from the private hospitals will greatly help in the planning of health services of the city. He also asked her of the specific data the private hospitals need to submit to them.
- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza replied that they needed the following medical data from the private hospitals: morbidity, mortality, vaccination, family planning, pre and postnatal care.
- The Presiding Officer manifested his concern regarding the data privacy act and further asked if the data will include the names of the patients.
- Dra. Ivy Marie Yrastorza said that names are not necessarily needed. Only numbers like what they are doing presently. She added that they will be providing template form for the reporting of purposes of the private hospitals.
- City Councilor Hon. Alde Pagulayan asked the City Legal Services Representative that the submission of data is required under R.A. 11223 or the Universal Health Act.
- Atty. Nathaniel de Leon replied that there are two kinds of data processing, discretionary processing and mandatory processing of data. Mandatory processing of data which is under the national law like what the city submitting to the Department of Health, it is a lawful processing of data which is exempted to the data privacy act.
- The Presiding Officer asked the comments/suggestion of the resource persons from the private medical establishments.




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- Ms. Jinky Saltoc, representative from St. Michael Hospital said that they have morbidity and mortality records to the Department of Health. They don't have the template for the reporting of said records and further said that are able and willing to submit to the City Health Services Office data needed once the template is received.
- Ms. Maribel Row-I, representative from Molino Doctor's Hospital said that they have the same data as of St. Michael's Hospital that is also submitted to the Department of Health. She added that the hospital has no immunization, pre and post-natal care records but is willing to have one to be submitted to the City Health Services Office. She also manifested their support for the proposed program of the City Health Services office.
- The Presiding Officer gave his gratitude for the support and cooperation of the private medical establishments for the proposal for the betterment of the health services rendered by the city.
- The Presiding Officer asked for additional comments/suggestions from the members of the Honorable Committee.
- City Councilor, Hon. Alde Pagulayan found no reason why the proposed resolution would not be approved and further moved for its approval duly seconded by all the City Councilors present.
- The Presiding Officer solicited a motion for the adjournment of the committee hearing.
- City Councilor Hon. Alde Pagulayan moved for the adjournment of the committee hearing duly seconded by all the City Councilors present.
- The committee hearing ended at 10:15 a.m.

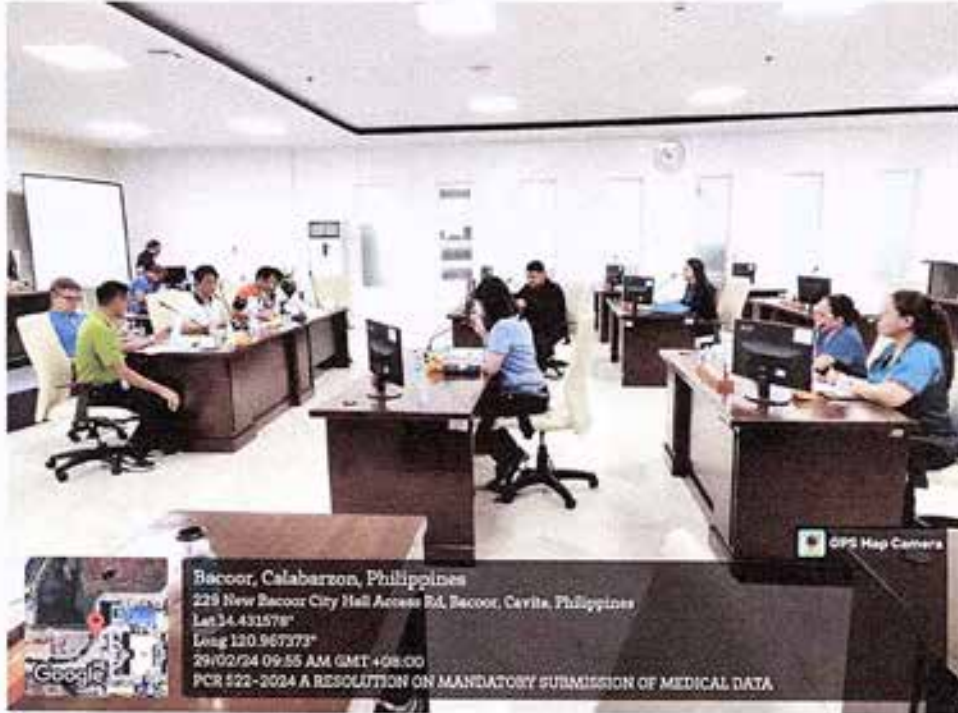

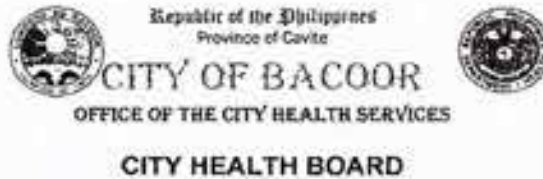
