Referred to this Committee on the 86th Regular session is the above subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

Pursuant to Section 16 of Republic Act No. 71260, otherwise known as the Local Government Code," (e) a local government shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those essential to the promotion of the general welfare."

On March 26, 2024, the Bacoor City Government, Department of Education, City Schools Division, Liga ng mga Barangay, Sangguniang Kabataan Federation-Bacoor City, and Bacoor City Organization of Private Schools signed and entered into a Memorandum of Understanding. Its goal is to encourage and provide the support required for the execution of youth initiatives and activities in designated barangays within the City of Bacoor. This guarantees the appropriate planning, teamwork, safety and security, and most extensive information sharing of programs and activities targeted at improving the lives of young people in the City of Bacoor.

Upon thorough review of the Committee on Youth and Sports Development and Committee on Barangay Affairs, the terms and conditions stipulated in the to benefit the youth Memorandum of Understanding have no contradiction to the law, and the objectives will rebound, Hon. 

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(Partnership on Youth Programs and Activities)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is made and entered this 26th day of March 2024 (the "Effective Date") in Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, by and between:



The term "PARTY" shall mean LGU BACOOR, DEPED BACOOR, LNB BACOOR, SK FED BACOOR, or BCOPS, if applicable, while the term "PARTIES" shall mean LGU BACOOR, DEPED BACOOR, LNB BACOOR, SK FED BACOOR and BCOPS, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the LGU BACOOR was converted into a City on 10 April 2012 pursuant to Republic Act No. 10160, otherwise known as the Charter of the City of Bacoor;

WHEREAS, under Section 16 Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, [e]very local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-rellant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, under Section 17(a) of the said Code, [l]ocal government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and fecilities;

WHEREAS, under Section 17(b) of the same Code, such basic services and facilities include, but are not limited to, the [s]ocial welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, welfare of the elderly and disabled persons; community-based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile delinquents, and victims of drug abuse; livelihood and other pro-poor projects; nutrition services; and family planning services;

WHEREAS, under Section 35 of the Code, [I)ocal government units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people's and non-governmental organizations to engage in the delivery of

certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversity agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education is the Department of Education, City Schools Division Office of Baccor ("DEPED BACCOR") is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Education of the Philippines, the primary government instrumentality mandated to formulate, implement, and coordinate policies, plans, programs, and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal basic education;

WHEREAS, the Bacoor City Organization of Private Schools ("BCOPS") is a private organization that works for the benefit and furtherance of the education and learning of all students attending the private schools within the City of Bacoor;

WHEREAS, the leadership of the LNB BACOOR, SK FED BACOOR, DEPED BACOOR, BCOPS, and LGU BACOOR has agreed to work hand-in-hand by strengthening its partnership on youth programs and activities through this MOU to ensure the proper coordination, collective efforts, safety in health and security, and widest information dissemination of programs and activities geared towards the betterment of the youth in the City of Bacoor,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and covenants hereinafter stated, the Perties hereto agree as follows:

I. SCOPE OF PARTICIPATION

- All programs and activities geared towards the enrichment of the knowledge, skills, and experience of the student learners enrolled in both private and public schools within the jurisdiction of the City of Baccor;
- Strengthening of the Adopt-A-School Program of the LGU;
- Establishment of a Federation of Private School Student Government; and
- Other programs and activities that may be agreed upon after the signing of the MOU.

II. <u>DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES</u>

A. DEPED BACOOR.

- DEPED BACOOR may inform the LGU BACOOR, LNB BACOOR, and SK FED BACOOR of all its youth programs and activities; and
- After the required coordination with the LGU BACOOR, LNB BACOOR, and SK FED BACOOR, the PARTIES shall work together in unity to implement the Programs and Activities for the benefit of the student learners enrolled in both private and public schools within the jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor.

B. BCOPS.

- BCOPS shall coordinate with the LGU BACOOR, LNB BACOOR, and SK FEO BACOOR on all its youth of programs and activities; and
- After the required coordination with the LGU BACOOR, LNB BACOOR, and SK FED BACOOR, the PARTIES shall work together in unity to implement the Programs and Activities for the benefit of the youth of Bacoor.

C. LNB BACOOR.

- The LNB BACOOR, through its President, shall extend the necessary assistance to DEPED BACOOR and BCOPS in the implementation of its youth programs and activities in identified Barangeys in the City of Bacoor, in order to achieve the purpose of this MOU;
- The LNB BACCOR, through its President, may sponsor, subject to the availability of funds of the respective barangays, youth programs and activities geared towards the enrichment of the knowledge, skills, and experience of the City's youth; and
- 3. The LNB BACOOR, through its President, may recommend or include as part of its Barangay Projects, in coordination with the SK FED BACOOR and LGU BACOOR, youth programs and activities, such as Peacebuilding & Security, and Social Inclusion and Equity, among others that will promote the enrichment of the knowledge, skills, and experience of the City's youth.

D. SK FED BACOOR.

- The SK FED BACOOR, through its Federation President, shall extend the necessary assistance to DEPED BACOOR and BCOPS in the implementation of its youth programs and activities in identified Barangays in the City of Bacoor in order to achieve the purpose of this MOU;
- The SK FED BACOOR, through its Federation President, may sponsor, subject to the availability of funds of the respective Sangguniang Kabataan, youth programs and activities geared towards the enrichment of the knowledge, skills, and experience of the City's youth and
- 3. The 8K FED BACOOR, through its Federation President, may recommend or include as part of its Sangguniang Kabataan Projects, in coordination with the LNB BACOOR and LGU BACOOR, youth programs and activities, such as Peacebuilding & Security and Social Inclusion and Equity, among others that will promote the enrichment of the knowledge, skills, and experience of the City's youth.



E. LGU BACCOR.

- LGU BACOOR shall extend the necessary assistance to DEPED BACOOR and BCOPS in the implementation of its youth programs and activities in identified Barangays in the City of Baccor in order to actileve the purpose of this MOU:
- 2. LGU BACOOR may, depending on the availability of funds, provide funding or assist in sponsorships for the recommended youth programs and activities of DEPED BACOOR, BOOPS, LNB BACOOR, and SK FED BACCOR:
- The LGU BACOOR may recommend or include as part of its City's Projects, youth programs and activities, such as Peacebuilding & Security, and Social Inclusion and Equity. among others that will promote the enrichment of the knowledge, skills and experience of the City's youth.
- LGU BACOOR, through its City Information Office (CIO), shall:
 - Promote the Youth **Programs** and Activities implemented in partnership with the LGU BACQOR;
 - b. Assist in creating promotional and educational materials containing the announcement and other promotion for the successful implementation of the Youth Programs and Projects sponsored by the LGU BACOOR as mentioned in the preceding paragraph.
- III. INDIVIDUAL AND SEPARATE GUIDELINES. Every partnership. between or among any of the Parties herein shall be subject to individual and separate Implementing Guidelines, fit-for-purpose, in order to ensure that the Youth Programs and Activities of either the DEPED BACCOR, BCOPS, FPTA BACCOR, FOUNDATION, LNB BACOOR and/or SK FED BACOOR are well-coordinated and will be duly implemented based on the pertinent national and local taws, rules and regulations.
- ſY. EFFECTIVITY. Unless otherwise terminated as provided herein, this MOU shall commence to take effect on the Effective Date abovementioned and shall remain effective unless sooner terminated by any of the Parties herein. Any of the Parties may terminate this MOU based only on valid and equitable grounds by written notice to the other Parties at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination.
- ٧. AMENDMENT. This MOU may be amended if any of the Parties deem it fit in order to create and strengthen the partnership and

coordination for the implementation of youth programs and activities. This MOU may not be modified except in writing and signed by the duty authorized representatives of the Parties after reasonable negotiations and discussion.

VI. <u>AUTHORITY</u>. Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual or representative signing this MOU is fully authorized to sign on behalf of its respective organization and that it has the power and authority to enter into it. The Parties further warrant that they have read and understood this MOU and bind themselves to its full and proper execution.


