Subject: A RESOLUTION RESPECTULLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, THROUGH CHIEF ROMMEL FRANCISCO MARBIL, FOR A SPECIAL RECRUITMENT QUOTA FOR THE BACOOR CITY COMPONENT POLICE STATION. (PCR 555-2024 dated April 15, 2024)

Upon review of the letter submitted by the Bacoor City Police Chief, Lt. Col. John Paolo V. Carracedo, regarding his request for the allocation of additional police personnel, the undersigned arrived at a conclusion that the said request should be taken into consideration in order to meet the police-to-population ratio.

Thus, the committee respectfully reports that:

- As per record, there is a significant rise of reported crimes in the City of Bacoor during the month of March;
- Currently, the Bacoor PNP is compromised of 7 PCOs, 187 PNCOs, and 5 NUPs;
- To address the growing concerns regarding public safety and security, it is imperative that police force should be augmented;
- There is a proposal of additional 120 personnel to maximize police presence in order to effectively deter crime in strategic areas in the City.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view thereof, the committee respectfully **RECOMMENDS** to pass a resolution respectfully requesting the Philippine National Police, through Chief Rommel Francisco Marbil, for a special recruitment quota for the Bacoor City component police station.

During the Council's regular session on April 15, 2024, Coun. Alejandro F. Gutierrez moved for the approval of the above-mentioned subject matter. According to Coun. Gutierrez, there is a need to allocate additional personnel due to an increase in focused crimes in the City of Bacoor and in order to enhance the capability of the Bacoor City Police to combat criminality by improving the prevailing police-to-population ratio which stands at 1:3.245. Since the internal rules were already supended, the motion met no objection and was unanimously seconded by the Council.

Dear Mayor Revilla.

Greetings with warmest Felicities!

I am writing to bring to your attention the recent increase in focused crimes in Bacoor City during the month of March 2024. As per our records, there were a total of 25 index crimes reported, marking a significant rise from the 15 cases recorded in February 2024.

Currently, the Bacoor PNP is comprised of 7 PCOs, 187 PNCOs, and 5 NUPs. However, considering the total population of Bacoor City, which stands at 664,625, our police to population ratio is at 1:3,425. This ratio is well above the standard police to population ratio of 1:500, with a variance of 1400 to meet the ideal ratio.

To address the growing concerns regarding public safety and security, it is imperative that we augment our police force. Therefore, this station proposes the addition of 120 personnel, consisting of 3 PCOs and 117 PNCOs. These additional personnel will enable us to enhance our coverage, maximize police presence, and effectively deter crime in strategic areas of the city.

In this regard, the undersigned request your favorable consideration and support for the allocation of additional police personnel as outlined above. Your support on this on this matter is highly appreciated to ensure the safety and well-being of our community.
