

Subject: LETTER OF COMPLAINT COURSED THROUGH THE 8888 CITIZENS' COMPLAINT HOTLINE ABOUT A FOLLOW-UP CONCERN IN REFERENCE TO TICKET NUMBER P20240301 907-1 REGARDING THE CLOSURE OF THE ROAD LEADING TO SITIO MALIPAY, BRGY. MOLINO 4, BACOOR CITY, CAVITE. (PCR 580-2024 dated 20 May 2024)

Acting on a letter of complaint through the 8888 Citizens' Complaint Hotline, 92nd regular session dated 27 May 2024, the aforementioned item was referred to the committee by the Sangguniang Panlungsod President Pro-Tempore, Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica during the 91st Regular Session held on 20 May 2024.

The complaint, ticket reference number P20240403-794-13, dated 03 April 2024, was filed by Herminigildo Tesorero Jr. from Sitio Malipay 3, Molino IV, Bacoor City, Cavite, and was initially routed through the 8888 Citizens' Complaint Hotline from the Office of President.

#### FINDINGS:

During the 92<sup>nd</sup> Regular Session of the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod, Hon. Palabrica recommended Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan that a resolution be passed, strictly directing the Office of the City Legal Services (OCLS) to act on this complaint. Subsequently, Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan motioned a resolution directing the OCLS to immediately address the complaint.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough evaluation, the Committee on Land Utilization and Urban Development, chaired by Hon. Pagulayan, respectfully recommends *THE PASSAGE* of a resolution directing the OCLS to promptly act on the complaint, ensuring compliance with the 8888 Citizens' Complaint Hotline, Furthermore, it is recommended that this matter be removed from the next council's order of business.

The Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola presided over the 92<sup>nd</sup> regular session of the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod, dated 27 May 2024. During the session, Hon. Alde Joselito F. Pagulayan informed the council that the complaint referenced above had been noted and referred to the Office of the City Legal Services (OCLS) for appropriate action. The OCLS was tasked with responding to the 8888 Citizens' Complaint Hotline.

Hon. Pagulayan moved for the deferment of the resolution related to this matter, which the chair declared deferred

Atty. Khalid Atega, Jr., the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP) Secretary, reported that a letter had been sent to the Legal Department on 08 April 2024, instructing the OCLS to address the issue, However, the OCLS failed to act, prompting the complainant to file another complaint with the 8888 hotline.

Further, Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica suggested that a resolution be passed strictly directing the OCLS to act on this complaint.

Hon. Pagulayan withdrew his previous motion and proposed a new resolution directing the OCLS to act immediately on the complaint. This resolution was seconded by Hon. Palabrica and subsequently APPROVED by the chair.







I write on behalf of ALTHORP LAND HOLDINGS, INCORPORATED (becauter, "ALLIP"), a composition existing under the laws of the Reguldie of the Philippines, with office address at 3rd Phoor, Stanfall – Las Piñas, C.V. State Avenue, Pumplona, Las Piñas City. ALLIT is engaged in real estate industry and owns several pancels of lead, including the subdivided lots with an approprie area of two hundred forty-nine thousand nine bundred sixty-four square meters (249,964 eq. ra.), more or less, commonly known as Sino Malipay III, Brgg. Molino IV, Barnor City, Province of Cavire (hereafter, "Propertics").

On 7 February 2024, ALHI posted notices about the road closure! of the Properties so the informal settler families ("TSPs") could move out their vehicles before the instanted implementation thereof on 29 February 2024. Needless to state, the said road clustree is a valid exercise of ALHI's right being the absolute owner thereof. The law recognizes the counter's right to enjoy and dispose of a thing, wethout other limitations than those comblished by law.

Article 430 of the Civil Code of the Philippines provides that "every owner may enclose or fence his land or recommon by means of walls, disches, live or dead hedges, or by any other means without detriment to servinutes constituted thereon." Thus, enclosing in properties is an ection that ALHI may benefully perform in the exercise of its ownership right. ALEH has the right to the natural use and emorganess of its own percels of land, for all the purposes to which such properties are usually applied.

At any rate, a semporary path walk that measures one meter intended only as perfection access to the Properties shall be maintained. However, the said temporary foot path shall not in any manner be considered a servinule on the Properties.


RE: DEMOLITION IN SITIO MALIPAY, MOLINO, BACCOR, CAVITE

Dear SECRETARY MANUEL BONCAN AND GENTLEMEN,

This is in reference to the information received by our Office on 08 February 2024 regarding a demolition activity in Sitio Malipay, Molino, Baccor, Cavite. Please be informed that the City Government of Baccor, through its Sangguniang Panlungsod, has enacted an extinance, City







Ordinance No. 307-2023,1 which requires all government agencies or offices to coordinate with the City Government on all project planning and implementation to be introduced or implemented in the City of Baccor.

Section 4 of the City Ordinance states:

Section 4. Coordination by National Agencies and Offices. National agencies, offices, and government corporations whose projects are to be implemented within the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavits, must coordinate with the City Government of Bacoor through written correspondence to the Office of the City Mayor detailing the relevant information of the initiative or project."

Further, Section 6 thereof requires a Certificate of Coordination from the Office of the City Mayor before the government agency concerned shall be issued with permit clearance or other relevant documents necessary for the implementation of their respective project, as long as the project shall involve the City of Baccot, to wit:

Section 6. Certification of Coordination. A Certificate of Coordination issued by the Office of the City Mayor shall be required from the national government agencies, offices, and government corporations before they will be given permit clearance or other City of Baccor issued document necessary for the commencement of or related to their initiatives or projects within the City of Baccor. Consequently, a Certificate of Coordination shall be required from the above-mentioned offices before implementing their initiative or projects within the City of Baccor. This Section shall apply even if only a small portion or percentage of the project will be implemented in the City of Baccor as long as the project passes through, is implemented in a part of, or involves the City of Baccor.


It appears that the City Government of Baccor was not notified of any projects or initiatives to be undertaken by the DPWH within the City. Likewise, the DPWH demolished the houses of affected residents in Sitio Malipay without proper coordination with the City Government. Section 26 of Republic Act (RA) 7279 or the "Urban Development and Housing Act of

1992" requires the presence of local government officials or their representatives during eviction or demolition.



#### Greetings from the Marching Band Capital of the Philippines!

This refers to your 8888 Citizens' Complaint dated 01 March 2024. through the Office of the President, with Ticket Reference Number P20240301-907-1 and received by our office on 08 March 2024.

Please note that the City Government has undertaken steps relative to the demolition at the Silio Malipay. At the first instance the City Government received the information, the City of Baccar, through our City Mayor, wrote the Secretary of Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and the other DPWH officials concerned covering the Cavite jurisdiction for lack of coordination on the demolition activity, Pursuant to City Ordinance 307-2023, or the Intergovernmental Relations Ordinance, all government agencies are required to coordinate with the City Government of Baccar on all governmental projects to be rolled-out, introduced or implemented in the City of Baccar. A follow-up letter based on your counsel's letter was again sent to the DPWH a few days before the impending road closure.

The City Mayor, through the undersigned and as the Head of the Housing. Urban Development and Resettlement Department (HUDRD) likewise endorsed the matter to the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP), to which the SP issued a Resolution directing the Office of the City Legal Services (OCLS) to investigate and file appropriate legal action, when necessary.

Further, the City Government set meetings and mediated between the affected residents with Althorp Land Holdings, Incorporated (ALHI) and Villar group, respectively. The City Government even appealed, through a letter, to ALHI to expand the temporary pathway provided to the residents to allow the ingress and egress, not only of residents but also of their vehicles since most Malipay residents' livelihood is dependent upon said vehicles.

The City Government accommodated all letters coming from Sitio Malipay and addressed them accordingly. Moreover, the SP shall deliberate an a proposed ordinance where a demolition order shall not be executed without prior coordination and consultation with the HUDRD of the City of Baccor on the days to follow.
