Subject: *A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND STRONGLY SUPPORTING THE LEGISLATION OF THE MAGNA CARTA FOR PUBLIC DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM) WORKERS. (PCR No. 589-2024) dated June 03, 2024.*

Upon review of the documents submitted, a close coordination and consultation with all the members of the council, the undersigned arrived at a conclusion that there is a need to pass a resolution approving and strongly supporting the legislation of the Magna Carta for public Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) workers.

Thus, the committee respectfully reports that:

1. The DRRM workers have been the country's frontliners and first responders during crisis situations. They carry out important tasks in providing humanitarian assistance, disseminating information, and leading relief and rescue operations during calamities.
2. The government shall guarantee that there is an adequate workforce to safeguard and save the citizens during emergencies. To make it happen, the DRRM workers must have a legal basis, a Magna Carta, to receive consideration, appreciation, and care. This will cover transportation, free medical, compensation for work related injuries and sickness, mandatory insurance coverage, and high basic salary upon retirement.
3. In light of the DRRM workers' crucial role in maintaining public health, order and safety, and considering the increased frequency and intensity of climate change-related disturbances that may occur, the honorable body deemed it proper to support the passage of a Magna Carta.
4. The Magna Carta for public DRRM workers is important in promoting a more resilient and responsive disaster management system.





**RECOMMENDATION:**

In view thereof, the committee respectfully **RECOMMENDS** that a resolution be passed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod approving and strongly supporting the legislation of the Magna Carta for public Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) workers.

## Resolution No. 02 Series of 2024

### "RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORTING THE LEGISLATION OF THE MAGNA CARTA FOR PUBLIC DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM) WORKERS"

**WHEREAS**, the Philippines has high vulnerability to natural hazards which are attributed to the nation's geographic location being in the 'Pacific Ring of Fire' and 'Typhoon Belt';

**WHEREAS**, Article II, Section 18 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that it is the duty of the State to protect the rights of workers and promote their welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10121 or the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act was enacted mainstreamed internationally in the formulation and implementation of national and local sustainable development and poverty reduction strategies. It also established Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) offices in every province, city and municipality, and barangays throughout the country. The law institutionalized the network of DRRM Workers at all levels of the government structure to ensure swift and effective disaster management and response during times of public emergencies;

**WHEREAS**, at the local level, Republic Act 10121 mandates the establishment of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office

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(LDRRMO) in every province, city and municipality, and Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee (BDRRMC) in every barangay;

**WHEREAS,** Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices are among the many workers who have tirelessly served the people before, during, and after disasters or emergencies and they deserve attention and recognition;

**WHEREAS,** the DRRM Workers have been the country's frontliners and first responders during crisis situations. They carry out important, round-the-clock tasks of providing humanitarian assistance, disseminating timely information, and leading relief and rescue operations during the onslaught of natural calamities;

**WHEREAS,** the government shall guarantee that there is an adequate workforce to safeguard and save the citizens during emergencies. To make it happen, the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Workers must have a legal basis, a MAGNA CARTA, to receive consideration, appreciation, and care since they tirelessly battle the difficulties associated with protecting and serving the communities and rendering 24/7 public service. This will also cover Transportation, Free Medical, Mental, and Psychosocial Examination, Personal Protective Equipment, Vaccination, and other Prophylaxis, Compensation for Work-Related Injuries and Sicknesses, Mandatory Insurance Coverage, and Highest Basic Salary Upon Retirement. Such benefits must be addressed as their exposure to perils from nearly all types of hazards incessantly grow;

**WHEREAS,** in light of the DRRM Workers' crucial role in maintaining public health, order and safety, and considering the increased frequency and intensity of climate change-related disturbances that occur in the country, the honorable body deemed it proper to support the said passage of a MAGNA CARTA;

**WHEREAS,** this legislative measure is meant to recognize their valuable services especially when exposed to high-risk environments to empower and boost their morale and uphold their dignity;

**WHEREAS,** the Magna Carta for Public DRM Workers is important in promoting a more resilient and responsive disaster management system;



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**WHEREAS**, this august body also finds that this type of legislative measure in congress needs support to enlighten the minds and heart of every member of congress to favorably indorse and/or vote for this legislation to pass into law;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on the motion of **Atty. Aimee T. Neri**, City Administrator, and unanimously seconded by all the members present, **BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved to support the legislation of the Magna Carta for Public Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Workers.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, to furnish the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod for appropriate action.


