REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDISE, AND VARIOUS BARANGAYS IN BACOOR CITY, CAVITE FOR THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF THE INSTALLED TRASH TRAP IN VARIOUS ESTEROS AND CREEKS IN THE CITY OF BACOOR. (PCR 596-2024 dated June 10, 2024)*

Members of the committee met in order to call the Committee hearing on 13 June, 2024 at 1:09 PM. It was presided over by Chairperson of Environment and Natural Resources Hon. Levy M. Tela.

**FINDINGS:**

The government is responsible for defending and advancing citizens' rights to a healthy, balanced habitat that is in line with the rhythms and harmony of the environment. As far as the negative effects of development projects and inappropriate waste disposal on our water bodies, creeks, and rivers are concerned, the government's implemented policies and regulatory efforts need to be strengthened and harmonized.

Supreme Court Continuing Mandamus Order, the defendant government entities have been instructed to maintain and clean up the waters of Manila Bay to SB level, which is suitable for swimming, skin diving, and other contact sports.

The maintenance and security of placed trash traps, and also the collection, preparation, and proper disposal of the wastes trapped from within, shall fall within the jurisdiction of each barangay.

To prevent human-caused damage to the recently placed trash trap, the following barangays must enact an ordinance.

1. Barangay Poblacion
2. Barangay Habay 2
3. Barangay Dulong Bayan
4. Barangay Mambog I
5. Barangay P.F. Espiritu

In accordance with the proposed agreement, the DENR will offer public awareness, communication education, and technical support for managing waste and waterways in relation to the established trash trap. The city government and the barangays' reports on waste collection and disposal to authorized sanitary landfills or disposal facilities will also be integrated by the DENR.

Since the barangay has more jurisdictions over the area where the garbage traps are located, it should be in charge of protecting and maintaining the trash traps, which includes collecting, managing, and properly disposing of taken wastes.

A variety of barangays are able to put up CCTV cameras at desirable points along the road and at the built trash trap in order to watch and monitor the area and prevent individuals from disposing of their waste.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

This agreement will actively stop the diffusion of plastic litter in waterways at its source, retrieving plastic from rivers, creeks and esteros before it enters our seas. The committee respectfully recommends to **PASS** the proposed resolution "**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDISE, AND VARIOUS BARANGAYS IN BACOOR CITY, CAVITE FOR THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF THE INSTALLED TRASH TRAP IN VARIOUS ESTEROS AND CREEKS IN THE CITY OF BACOOR.**"

Hon. Tela: (pinakilala ang isa't isa at pinakita ang pagbati at pagkakilala ng kasalukuyang katayuan.) "Thank you sa inyong lahat. This is regarding sa pagtatayo ng mga trash trap sa mga ilog o estero para hindi pumunta sa Manila Bay ang mga basura."

Hon. Palabrica: "Mr. Chair, ito ba ang pinagusapan trash trap. Kasi walang PENRO dito Wala bang PENRO dito, PENRO dapat ito di ba?"

Mr. Vocalan: "PENRO funded po ito."

Hon. Palarica: "PENRO funded ito, iyun yung mga existing na trash trap. Paguusapan dito na magkakaroon ng Memorandum of Agreement with PENRO ata ulit. Tawag dito para iyun sa maintenance and conservation ng trash trap. Are you aware of this Mr. Vocalan?"

Kaya ko tinatanong Mr. Chair, kung existing na ito and this is very advantageous to the part of the Government of Bacoor in terms of river maintenance. I strongly recommend for the approval of the request from the Office of the Mayor. Maybe we hear from the Barangay representatives present here kung ano ang status ng kanilang trash trap at alam ba nila ito kung saan ito sa teritoryo nila mismo. Alamin na rin natin sa kanila kung anong status nang mga trash trap na ito, kung sira na ba ito, nalilinis ba ito ng PENRO na tinutulungan ng CENRO at ng mai report na dito sa Sangguniang Panlungsod."

Hon. Francisco: "Mauna na po ako, actually nalilinis naman po, pero CENRO walang PENRO. Walang dumadating na PENRO river warriors lang ng Bacoor ang dumating."

Mr. Vocalan: "Sir, Itatanong ko po sa kanila, kasi base po sa report tulong tulong po yan, sa dami po ng ating trash trap. Ang trash trap po natin actually 22 po. 22 po ang trash trap natin. Meron po sa Salinas, Mestizo River, tributary Bacoor river, meron tayong Ligas Creek, Ligas Tributary, St. Augustine Creek, San Rafael Creek, Sorrento, tributary sa Zapote River, Cherry west creek, woods wind creek, Soldier Hills 4 Creek, San Nicolas. Hon. Palabrica: "Balewala pala ang trash trap."

PB Palma: "Pag mababa po ang tubig gumagana po."

Hon. Tela: "Napansin ko nga po iyun at buti nagkaroon ng MOA, dito sa MOA kailangang kabitan din natin ng CCTV, para makita natin ang mga illegal dumping ng mga ibang tao at the same time nababantayan natin during rainy season at flooding."

Hon. Francisco: "Nasa anu naman po ng legal kung financially prepared po ang barangay kung kaya nilang maglagay ng CCTV. Nakalagay naman po sa revised ng legal. Tulad po sa amin, tapos na kaming mag installed ng CCTV so magiging additional nito baka hindi pa namin kaya. Probably by next year pwede."

Mr. Vocalan: "Yun po kasing trash trap natin naka designed po yan pag malakas na yung agos ng tubig, humihiga po yan kasi yung current dadalihin po siya kaya medyo po siya talagang mababa lahat po naman talaga ng trash trap ganun po yun. May trash trap po tayo kay Coun. Bok tinataas natin kasi po dudurugin pag masyadong malakas kaya automatic siyang humihiga po kaya medyo po siyang mababa."

Hon. Palabrica: "Yung trash trap kung hindi naka design ng ganun pag napupuno ng basura yun at umagos na yung tubig it will cost flooding on both sides kasi hindi makakatagos ang tubig mahahanap ng matatagusan kaya pupunta sa tagiliran. This trash trap should be monitor regularly para kung ano ang purpose ng trash trap ma serve. Kaya nga Mr. Chair. Balikan ko lang yung nirerequest ko kanina yung reports from different barangay present here in this hearing kung ano yung status ng kanilang mga trash traps."

PB Nolasco: "Sa Mambog 1 po naman medyo ayos naman po ang status ng pagkakatagay ng trash trap sa may tulay, actually po kakagawa lang kailan lang tulad po ng sinasabi ni Mr. Vocalan yun po ay pang harang sa basura na kung saka-sakali po na mapupuno po ng basura bababa po siya para dere-deretso ang agos ng tubig pero po sa ngayon napapangalagaan naman po ng CENRO at madalas po kaming humingi ng tulong sa CENRO at nagtutulong-tulong po kami para maalis po naming ang basura. Hon. Tela: "Thank you Mambog 1, sa Habay 2 naman ano ang status ng trash trap ninyo?"

Kag. Camello: "In the part of Habay 2 naman po actually iyung trash trap naming is located in river bank in Dulong Habay. Properly maintain naman po siya at the same time, every clean-up drive talaga naman po na tinatangal naman po ang mga dumi dun, by the way this coming Saturday in our Session, 2<sup>nd</sup> Regular Session







during the month, pag-uusapan naming iyung sa CCTV because I read the CCTV compliance about in the trash trap at this coming Saturday I a-ano ko yan sa Session namin. Nang maka comply din kami agad agad. Since we are installing already the CCTV."

Hon. Tela: "Tama."

Hon. Palabrica: "You mention that the trash trap in Dulong Habay is properly maintain by whom?"

Kag. Camello: "Actually by our river warriors there. We do have a river warrior in the Barangay in the same time also the administration of incumbent Punong Barangay is always active naman po to participate."

Hon. Palabrica: "Walang PENRO? Sabi mo properly maintain by the barangay. That is very good. As far as Barangay concern that is very good. How regular yung clean-up ninyo?"

Kag. Camello: "Ang alam ko eh, wala po, actually Sir as far as we have a river warrior there and I think weekly or even months po."

Hon. Palabrica: "Periodic?"

Kag. Camello: "Yes sir, especially this coming ano po. Di ba po umulan po last week po ng May so that's why nagka attention kaagad si Punong Barangay Myles."

Hon. Palabrica: "Kung barado ang trash trap dun sa sinasabi sa Dulong Habay, nag cause ba ito ng pagbaha sa SM area?"

Kag. Camello: "Kapag sobra ang volume ng tubig dun nan a po magbabaha pero as far as iyung concern naman po sa garbage nan a trapped sa trash trap eh nakokonti naman po siya."

Hon. Palabrica: "We comment the effort of barangay that you maintain it regularly, because it will save us manpower, para mailagay naman natin sa ibang area at sana lahat ng Barangay ay ganun."

Kag. Camello: "We will be asking the secretary to make a necessary report of the task."

Hon. Palabrica: "if you are voluntarily to submit report about your regular clean-up drive in particular trash trap. Please do so and submit to the committee on Environment that the Chairman is Hon. Tela. How about sa Dulong Bayan?"

PB Palma: "Regular din pong na maintain ng mga river warrior po iyung trash trap po natin sa Dulong Bayan. Meron po kaming request ng Presidente ng JS, kasama po ang barangay kay Mayor at na approved naman. Ngayon tag ulan na mas maganda kung may malaking effort din or at least maybe target natin 50% of clean-up activity should from the Barangays at para ma cover natin at mapagtulungan. As we strike as one dahil sa Bacoor at home tayo dito."

Mr. Vocalan: "Mr. Chair, your honor I will make appoint na to the Chairman of Environment na magbigay po kami ng weekly or monthly report sa committee po para makita ninyo po kung gaano karami iyung nililinis naming at gaano rin ang nalilinis ng mga River Rangers at saka ng mga River Warriors for your monitoring para malaman din niyo po na hindi tumitigil ang opisina ko sa paglilinis lalo na ngayong summer at inubos talaga naming lahat yan. Kaya lang nakakalungkot po N5 po tayo, hindi po maganda ang activity sa itaas at hindi maganda activity ng kapitbahay natin, tayo po ang nagsasakripisyo, tayo po ang last touch diyan eh. After a careful review, several grammatical revisions have been made and this Office notes the following observations on the above Agreement:

1. Preliminaries

This Office suggest to add the following clause after the Parties


DENR-EMB CALABARZON LGU BACOOR BARANGAY CAPTAIN and GENERAL MANAGER shall be collectively referred to as "Parties"

2. On the Responsibility of Parties

This Office suggests that Titles A, B, C, and D, fall under only one Sub-title "Responsibilities of the Parties"

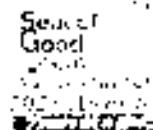
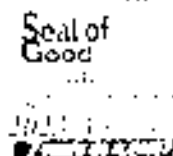
3. On the Responsibility of the City Government of Bacoor (Paragraph 2)

a. This Office suggests that instead of *directly being responsible* for the protection and maintenance of the

installed trash trap including the collection, handling, and proper disposal of the trapped wastes, the City Government

of Bacoor may opt to merely *oversee and assist the Barangay* in the protection and maintenance of the installed trash trap including the collection, handling and proper disposal of the trapped wastes.

4. On the Responsibility of the Barangay Council

- a. Under paragraph 2, this Office suggests that instead of just *being responsible* for the collection, handling and proper disposal of the trapped wastes, the Barangay, in whose territorial jurisdiction the trash traps are installed, should be responsible for the protection and maintenance of the same for it is more capable to provide protection and maintenance due to its proximity.
- b. Under paragraph 4, a determination must be made whether the pre-identified Barangay are financially-prepared to comply with its obligation of installing CCTV Cameras along the road and various vantage points of the installed trash trap for monitoring and surveillance to stop people from dumping garbage.

5. On the Responsibility of Dasebo Construction

- a. Under Paragraph 1, this office suggests to revise the sentence from "Donate one (1) unit pulley to the Barangay Captain of Brgy. \_\_\_\_\_ Bacoor City Cavite x x x" to "Donate one (1) unit of pulley to Barangay \_\_\_\_\_ Bacoor City Cavite x x x".

It must be remembered that the beneficiary of the donation is the Barangay itself and not the Barangay Captain. Accordingly, the donation should be made in favor of the Barangay, the Barangay Captain shall sign the Deed of Donation not in his own capacity but merely as a representative of the Barangay by virtue of his position.

and all forces of potential energy, fisheries, forest or timber, wild life, flora and fauna, and other natural resources are owned by the State.

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 192, mandates the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) as the primary government agency responsible for the sustainable management and development of the country's natural resources.

**WHEREAS**, Section 2 (a) 7 (f) Chapter 1 of RA 9003 otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 provides that, as part of the Declaration of Policy, (a) "to ensure the protection of the public health and environment, and (f) "encourage greater participation in solid waste management;"

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act 9275 provides for the abatement and control of pollution from land-based sources and lays down water quality standards and regulations. The Act shall apply to water quality management in all waterbodies, fresh, brackish, and marine waters.

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 20 of the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275) and Rule 20 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IARR 2005-10); Local Government Units shall share the responsibility in the management and improvement of water quality within territorial jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 2 of the Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275); Business and Industry in Environmental Management, the Department and the LGUs, in coordination with the appropriate government agencies, and in consultation with the business and industrial sectors including chambers of commerce, shall formulate appropriate incentives for the adoption of procedures that will preserve and protect our waterbodies through the introduction of innovative equipment and processes that reduce if not totally eliminate the discharge of pollutants into our waterbodies.

**WHEREAS**, the policies implemented, and regulatory efforts undertaken by the Government need to be harmonized and strengthened in coping with the adverse environmental consequences of development projects and improper waste disposal, insofar as their adverse effect on our water bodies and creek/ rivers is concerned.

**WHEREAS**, per Supreme Court Continuing Mandamus Order dated December 18, 2008 defendant government agencies are directed to clean up, and rehabilitate waterways leading to Manila Bay, to restore and maintain its waters to SB level (Class SB Sea water classification under DAO 90-34) to make them fit for swimming, skin diving and other forms of contact recreation.

**WHEREAS**, the parties have recognized the beneficial and shared responsibility in undertaking the successful implementation of the Operational Plan for Manila Bay Coastal Strategy (OPMCS), which aims to clean-up water bodies leading to Manila Bay.

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Unit of Bacoor, Cavite and Barangay Council of Brgy. Dulong Bayan, Bacoor City, Cavite has committed to working hand-in-hand with the DENR-FMB in its environmental protection activities by directly participating in protecting the installed trash trap against all forms of activities that may contribute to its degradation along the Dulong Bayan Creek, located at Brgy. Dulong Bayan, Bacoor City, Cavite;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the mutual covenant hereinafter set forth, the parties have agreed, as they hereby agreed on the following:

**A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES**

3. Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e. World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month
4. Submit the report on the status of the installed trash trap at MBCC - Central Office; and
5. Provide technical assistance in preparing the DEC materials on RA 9003, RA 9275, and other related laws

4. Install billboard signs facing the road to inform the general public within thirty (30) days from the signing of this MOA containing a message on raising awareness about the devastating impact of plastic waste on the bodies of water.

**III. BARANGAY COUNCIL OF BRGY. DULONG BAYAN, BACCOOR CITY, CAVITE shall**

1. Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e. World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month
2. Be responsible for the protection and maintenance of the installed trash trap including the collection, handling, and proper disposal of the trapped wastes
3. Pass an Ordinance for the protection of the newly installed trash trap from man-made destruction, and
4. Install CCTV cameras along the road at various vantage points of the installed trash trap for monitoring and surveillance to stop people from dumping the garbage

**IV. DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDISE shall**

1. Donate one (1) unit of pulley to Barangay Dulong Bayan, Bacoor City, Cavite for the opening and closing of the collapsible trash trap to allow solid waste to lift more easily; and
2. Provide one (1) year service warranty to the installed trash trap

**B. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

The City Environment Service Department (CESD) of Bacoor and the Environmental Focal Person from the Barangay Council of Barangay Dulong Bayan, Bacoor City, Cavite shall submit a status report of the implementation to the Office of the DENR-EMB CALABARZON quarterly.

**C. AMENDMENTS**

This Agreement may be revised, amended or modified by the Parties only through written instrument duly executed and signed by the Parties but not later than the end of the validity of this agreement.

**D. EFFECTIVITY**

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon the signature of all the Parties hereto and shall remain enforced and binding subject to review every three years until otherwise revised, amended, or revoked.

**E. TERMINATION**

This Agreement shall be terminated under the following instances,

- a. Upon mutual agreement of all parties; and
- b. Upon all valid causes for a termination of contract, with notice to all parties.

Upon such termination, no party shall have any further obligations or liabilities hereunder provided, however, that such termination shall not relieve any party from liability for any breach of this Agreement prior to such termination.

**F. COOPERATION AND MUTUAL CONSULTATIONS**

It is understood that all the Parties shall conduct periodic consultations regarding the project implementation and, in the spirit of cooperation, endeavor to resolve any dispute arising out of this Agreement through mutual agreement. In case of disagreement, the same shall be resolved by mutual consultations between all the Parties.
