**FINDINGS:**

2<sup>nd</sup> Legislative District of Cavite, Congresswoman Hon. Lani Mercado-Revilla requested a City Resolution requesting her to facilitate the request from the Department of Foreign Affairs for the establishment of a field Consular Office of DFA in the City of Bacoor, complying with the requirements of the Executive Order No. 45 issued by former Philippine President Hon. Rodrigo Roa Duterte dated October 20, 2017.

The said City Resolution would be her basis to request directly from the Secretary of DFA for the conduct by the OCA of a cost-benefit analysis leading to a proposal by the SFA to be submitted to the Department of Budget and Management and later on the Office of the President for the allocation of budget, and inclusion of a DFA Consular Office in Bacoor City in the NEP, to become part of the General Appropriations Act.



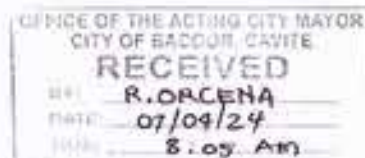

**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A ONE-WAY TRAFFIC POLICY IN VILLAGE HOMES AND MAGDIWANG**

**WHEREAS**, there have been numerous complaints from residents of Village Homes and Magdiwang regarding double parking, obstructions, and a general lack of passability and convenience for motorists;

**WHEREAS**, these issues pose a significant risk to public safety, particularly in situations where emergency vehicles such as ambulances and fire trucks need to access the area;

**WHEREAS**, a one-way traffic policy and designated one-side parking have been identified as potential solutions to address these concerns and improve traffic flow within the subdivision;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the barangay council of Barangay Queen's Row West hereby implements a one-way traffic policy and one-side parking regulation in Village Homes and Magdiwang, effective July 05, 2024.

**Section 1. Designated Traffic Direction**

The following roads within Village Homes and Magdiwang shall be designated as one-way streets.

**Section 2. One-Side Parking Regulation**

Parking shall only be allowed on the designated side of the road along the designated one-way streets. Clear signage shall be posted to indicate the allowed parking side. Double parking and parking on the opposite side of the road will be strictly prohibited.

**Section 3. Signage and Markings**

The barangay council shall be responsible for installing appropriate signage and pavement markings to clearly indicate the one-way traffic flow and designated parking side.

**Section 4. Enforcement**

Barangay officials and deputized volunteers shall be responsible for enforcing the one-way traffic policy and parking regulation. Violators shall be penalized accordingly.

**Section 5. Public Information Campaign**

The barangay council shall conduct an information campaign to educate residents about the one-way traffic policy, designated parking side, their benefits, and the corresponding penalties for violations.

**Section 6. Review and Amendment**

This resolution shall be reviewed by the barangay council after [time period] to assess its effectiveness and make necessary amendments.


**Section 7. Effectivity**

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.




