Subject: A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,866,00.00) FROM THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT FUND TO BE USED FOR THE PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO FAMILIES AFFECTED BY THE MASSIVE FIRE IN CAVITE CITY LAST JULY 14, 2024 – PCR-632-2024 dated July 22, 2024

Referred to this Committee on the 100th Regular Session is the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

LEGAL BASIS

Section 21 of Republic Act of 10121 otherwise known as "AN ACT STRENGTHENING THE PHILIPPINE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDING FOR THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FRAMEWORK AND INSTITUTIONALIZING THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" provides that, and we quote:

"Section 21. Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF). - The present Local Calamity Fund shall henceforth be known as the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF). x x x **Upon the recommendation of the LDRRMO and approval of the sanggunian concerned, the LDRRMC may transfer the said fund to support disaster risk reduction work of other LDRRMCs which are declared under state of calamity.**"

RESOLUTION NO. 4, SERIES OF 2024 OF THE CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (CDRRMC).

The CDRRMC explained that on July 14, 2024, a massive fire occurred in Barangays 5 and 6 in Cavite City and that there were 933 affected families based on the Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA). Hence, The Sangguniang Panlungsod of Cavite City approved Resolution No. 2024-094 declaring the affected area under the state of calamity.

In line with the afore-cited provision Republic Act No. 10121, the CDRRMC resolved to request the Sangguniang Panlungsod to approved the authority of the

City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, CDRRMC Chairperson, to disburse the amount of **ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,866,000.00)** which shall be used to finance the provision of financial assistance for the families affected by the massive fire.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Honorable Members of the Committee hereby recommend **TO APPROVE** the City Resolution authorizing the disbursement of the amount of **ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,866,000.00)** from the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund (LDRRMF) for the financial assistance to the affected families in Cavite City as per CDRRMC Resolution No. 4, Series of 2024, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations

WHEREAS, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council aims to assist our fellow Caviteño families that were severely affected by the massive fire that engulfed Barangays 5 and 7 in Cavite City;

WHEREAS, based on the Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) report, there are a total of 933 families that were affected by the massive fire incident;

WHEREAS, on 16 July 2024, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Cavite City has passed Resolution No. 2024-094 declaring a State of Calamity in the area;

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Republic Act No. 10121 and Section 1, Rule 18 of its IRR provides for the utilization of Local DRRM Funds of an LGU to support DRRM activities of other LGUs that are under the state of calamity or under imminent threat;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Mr. Richard T. Quion, City DRRM Officer, and unanimously seconded by all the members present, **BE IT RESOLVED,** as it is hereby resolved to request the Sangguniang Panlungsod to authorize City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, CDRRMC Chairperson, to disburse the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Pesos (P1,866,000.00) from the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund to be used for the provision of financial assistance to families affected by the massive fire in Cavite City last July 14, 2024.

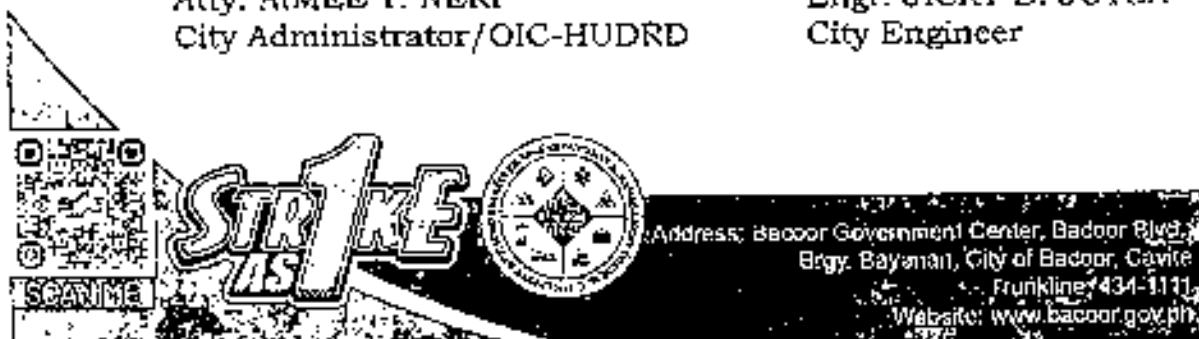

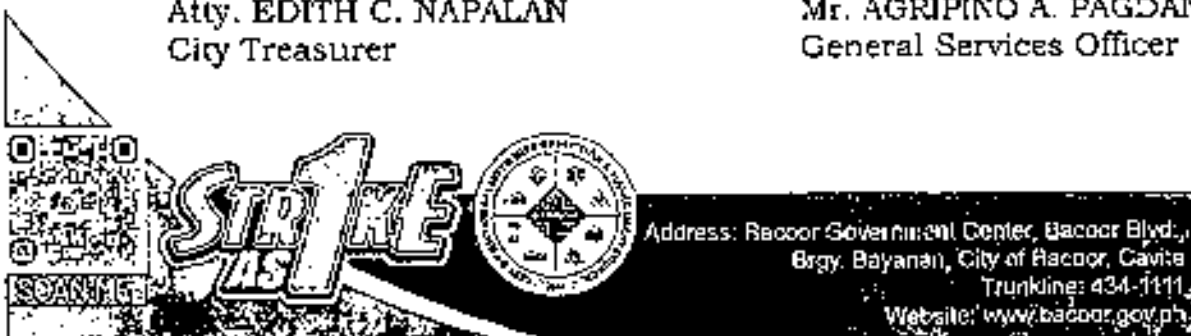


