Subject: A RESOLUTION DECLARING A MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GASOLINE STATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE. (PCR 662-2024 dated August 27, 2024).

During the 105th Regular Session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod chaired over by Presiding Officer, Vice Mayor Rowena Bautista - Mendiola held on August 27, 2024 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP) Session Hall, 6th Flr. City of Bacoor Legislative and Disaster Resilience Building, Bacoor Government Center. The above subject was referred to the Committee on Labor, Trade Commerce and Industry and Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances.

FINDINGS:

Ms. Sallie C. Lacson, the president of the City of Bacoor Gasoline Stations Association, wrote a letter requesting a halt to the construction of new gasoline stations in the city. The aforementioned request is based on the premise that the City of Bacoor already has over 60 gasoline stations that share the volume requirements of the residents.

RECOMMENDATION:

On November 4, 2024, during the 115th Regular Session, Coun. Reynaldo M. Fabian proposed that the aforementioned subject be TEMPORARILY ARCHIVED. This decision will allow for comprehensive review and analysis to ensure that all aspects are carefully considered.

The motion was approved by the presiding officer after it was unanimously seconded by the council members.

During the 105th Regular Session of the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod, chaired over by Presiding Officer, Vice Mayor Rowena Bautista-Mendiola, held on August 27, 2024 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod (SP) Session Hall, 6th Flr. City of Bacoor Legislative and Disaster Resilience Building, Bacoor Government Center. The above subject was referred to the Committee on Labor, Trade Commerce and Industry as the lead committee and the Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances as the subcommittee.


The first joint committee hearing was held on September 19, 2024,1:00 pm at the MSBR Conference Room, 4th floor of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. It was headed by the Coun. Reynaldo Fabian. In attendance were Coun. Roberto Advincula, Coun. Michael Solis and Coun. Adrielito Gawaran.

The resource persons were as follows:

Ms. Lacson mentioned that during the earlier times, the selection of dealers wasn't based solely on the capacity to pay. The selection process includes panel interviews and trainings. Nowadays, all you have to do is pay. In addition, there are lots of gasoline stations being erected. Molino Boulevard used to have fourteen (14) gasoline stations.

Mr. Gawaran stated that there was a moratorium, but it was lifted later on. Due to client division, the owners/association has consistently appealed over the last five (5) years. Nowadays, gas stations seldom provide repair services and just sell fuel products. Due to the large number of stations, they usually reduce their prices.
