

Subject: A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES - ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT BUREAU (DENREMB), THE BARANGAY GOVERNMENT OF HABAY II AND DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDISE REGARDING THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF THE INSTALLED TRASH TRAP AT IMUS RIVER, BARANGAY HABAY II, CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE. (PCR 683-2024 dated September 23, 2024).

Members of the Sangguniang Panlunsod met in order to call the 109th regular session, at 10:30 am on September 23 2024. Presiding Officer Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola referred the subject matter to Chairperson of Environment and Natural Resources Hon. Levy M. Teia.

FINDINGS:

The agreement is to protect and conserve the installed trash trap at Imus River, Barangay Habay II, City of Bacoor, Cavite.

The ratification of the MOA is a significant step in ensuring the long-term protection and conservation of the installed trash trap at Imus River. The agreement provides framework for collaboration and cooperation among the parties involved, which is crucial in addressing the environmental issues affecting the area.

Its ratification also identified potential challenges and risks that may affect the implementation of the agreement. For instance, the MOA notes that strong currents and flooding may impact the effectiveness of the trash trap, and that regular maintenance and repairs will be necessary to ensure its continued functionality.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 20 of the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275) and Rule 20 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (DAO 2005-10), Local Government Units shall share the responsibility in the management and improvement of water quality within territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 21 of the Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275), Business and Industry in Environmental Management, the Department and the LGUs, in coordination with the appropriate government agencies, and in consultation with the business and industrial sectors including chambers of commerce, shall formulate appropriate incentives for the adoption of procedures that will preserve and protect our waterbodies through the introduction of innovative equipment and processes that reduce if not totally eliminate the discharge of pollutants into our waterbodies;

WHEREAS, the policies implemented and regulatory efforts undertaken by the Government need to be harmonized and strengthened in coping with the adverse environmental consequences of development projects and improper waste disposal, insofar as their adverse effect on our water bodies and creek/rivers is concerned;

Mambog I, Bacoor City, Cavite;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenant hereinafter set forth, the parties have agreed, as they hereby agreed, on the following: /

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A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

- Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e., World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month;
- Submit the report on the status of the installed trash trap at MBCO Central Office;

- Provide technical assistance in preparing the IEC materials on RA 9003, RA 9275, and other related laws.

II. CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR shall:

- Jointly monitor the installed trash trap with the DENR-EMB CALABARZON Region;
- Oversee and assist the Barangay in protecting and maintaining the installed trash trap, including collecting, handling, and properly disposing of the trapped wastes.
- Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e., World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month; and
- 4. Install billboard signs facing the road to inform the general public within thirty (30) days from the signing of this MOA, containing a message on raising awareness about the devastating impact of plastic waste on bodies of water.

III. BARANGAY COUNCIL OF BRGY. MAMBOG I, BACOOR CITY, CAVITE shall:

- Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e., World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month
- Be responsible for the protection and maintenance of the installed trash trap including the collection, handling, and proper disposal of the trapped wastes;
- Pass an Ordinance for the protection of the newly installed trash trap from manmade destruction; and
- Install CCTV cameras along the road at various vantage points of the installed trash trap for monitoring and surveillance to stop people from dumping the garbage.

IV. DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDIZE shall:

- Donate one (1) unit of pulley to Barangay Mambog I, Bacoor City, Cavite, for the opening and closing of the collapsible trash trap to allow solid waste to lift more easily; and
- 2. Provide one (1) year service warranty to the installed trash trap.

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B. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The City Environment Service Department (CESD) of Bacoor and the Environmental Focal Person from the Barangay Council of Barangay Dulong Bayan, Bacoor City, Cavite shall submit a status report of the implementation to the Office of the DENR-EMB CALABARZON quarterly.



C. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be revised, amended, or modified by the Parties only through written instrument duly executed and signed by the Parties but not later than the end of the validity of this agreement.



D. EFFECTIVITY

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon the signature of all the Parties hereto and shall remain enforced and binding, subject to review every three years, until otherwise revised, amended, or revoked.



Provided that, after one (1) year from the date of effectivity of this MOA, the DENR - EMB shall donate the aforementioned pulley and trash trap to the LGU concerned through a deed of donation

E. TERMINATION

This Agreement shall be terminated under the following instances;

- Upon mutual agreement of all parties; and
- b. Upon all valid causes for a termination of contract, with notice to all parties.

Upon such termination, no party shall have any further obligations or liabilities hereunder; provided, however, that such termination shall not relieve any party from liability for any breach of this Agreement prior to such termination.

F. COOPERATION AND MUTUAL CONSULTATIONS

It is understood that all the Parties shall conduct periodic consultations regarding the project implementation and, in the spirit of cooperation, endeavor to resolve any dispute arising out of this Agreement through mutual agreement. In case of disagreement, the same shall be resolved by mutual consultations between all the Parties.

TORRIJOS, Punong Barangay, with office address at Brgy. P.F. Espiritu I, Bacoor City, Cavite, hereinafter referred to as BARANGAY CAPTAIN.

DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDIZE with principal address at Bik 5 Lot 12 Mangga St., Glowing Field Subd. Brgy. Sahud Ulan, Tanza, Cavite, represented by its General Manager ENGR, DANTE L. BOBADILLA and hereinafter called the GENERAL MANAGER.

DENR-EMB CALABARZON, LGU BACOOR, BARANGAY CAPTAIN, and GENERAL MANAGER shall be collectively referred to as "Parties".

WITNESSETH


WHEREAS, Section 16, Article II of the Philippine Constitution provides that "the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with rhythm and harmony of nature";

WHEREAS, Section 2, Article XII of the same Philippine Constitution provides that "All lands of the public domain, waters, minerals, coal, petroleum and other mineral oils, all forces of potential energy, fisheries, forest or timber, wildlife, flora and fauna, and other natural resources are owned by the State ... ";

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 192, mandates the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) as the primary government agency responsible for the sustainable management and development of the country's natural resources;

WHEREAS, Section 2 (a) 7 (f), Chapter 1 of RA 9003 otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 provides that, as part of the Declaration of Policy, (a) "to ensure the protection of the public health and environment, and (f) "encourage greater participation in solid waste management";

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9275 provides for the abatement and control of pollution from land-based sources and lays down water quality standards and regulations. The Act shall apply to water quality management in all waterbodies: fresh, brackish, and marine waters;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 20 of the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275) and Rule 20 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (DAO 2005-10), Local Government Units shall share the responsibility in the management and improvement of water quality within territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 21 of the Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275), Business and Industry in Environmental Management, the Department and the LGUs, in coordination with the appropriate government agencies, and in consultation with the business and industrial sectors including chambers of commerce, shall formulate appropriate incentives for the adoption of procedures that will preserve and protect our waterbodies through the introduction of innovative equipment and processes that reduce if not totally eliminate the discharge of pollutants into our waterbodies;

WHEREAS, the policies implemented, and regulatory efforts undertaken by the Government need to be harmonized and strengthened in coping with the adverse environmental consequences of development projects and improper waste disposal, insofar as their adverse effect on our water bodies and creek/ rivers is concerned;

WHEREAS, per Supreme Court Continuing Mandamus Order dated December 18, 2008, defendant government agencies are directed to clean up, and rehabilitate waterways leading to Manila Bay, to restore and maintain its waters to SB level (Class SB Sea water classification under DAO 90-34) to make them fit for swimming, skin diving and other form of contact recreation;

WHEREAS, the parties have recognized the beneficial and shared responsibility in undertaking the successful implementation of the Operational Plan for Manila Bay Coastal Strategy (OPBMCS), which aims to clean-up water bodies leading to Manila Bay;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bacoor, Cavite and Barangay Council of Brgy. P.F. Espiritu I, Bacoor City, Cavite has committed to working hand-in-hand with the DENR-EMB in its environmental protection activities by directly participating in protecting the installed trash trap against all forms of activities that may contribute to its degradation along the Panapaan Creek, located at Brgy. P.F. Espiritu I, Bacoor City, Cavite;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenant hereinafter set forth, the parties have agreed, as they hereby agreed on the following:

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A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

I. DENR-EMB CALABARZON Region shall:

- Jointly monitor the installed trash trap with the LGUs;
- Maintain its jurisdiction and supervision over the installed trash trap with the Local Government Unit of Bacoor, Cavite;
- 3. Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e., World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Constal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment
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- Provide technical assistance in preparing the IEC materials on RA 9003, RA 9275. and other related laws.



II. CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR shall:

- Jointly monitor the installed trash trap with the DENR-EMB CALABARZON Region;
- 2. Oversee and assist the Barangay in protecting and maintaining the installed trash trap including collecting, handling, and properly disposing the trapped wastes.
- Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e., World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month; and
- Install billboard signs facing the road to inform the general public within thirty (30) days from the signing of this MOA containing a message on raising awareness about the devastating impact of plastic waste on the bodies of water.

III. BARANGAY COUNCIL OF BRGY. P.F. ESPIRITU I, BACOOR CITY, CAVITE shall:

- Participate in the cleanup activities during Environmental events, i.e., World Water Day, National Clean Up Month/Coastal Clean-up, and Philippine Environment Month
- 2. Be responsible for the protection and maintenance of the installed trash trap including the collection, handling, and proper disposal of the trapped wastes;
- 3. Pass an Ordinance for the protection of the newly installed trash trap from manmade destruction; and
- 4. Install CCTV cameras along the road at various vantage points of the installed trash trap for monitoring and surveillance to stop people from dumping the garbage.

IV. DALEBO CONSTRUCTION AND GENERAL MERCHANDIZE shall:

- Donate one (1) unit of pulley to Barangay P.F. Espiritu I, Bacoor City, Cavite for the opening and closing of the collapsible trash trap to allow solid waste to lift more easily; and
- Provide one (1) year service warranty to the installed trash trap.

B. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The City Environment Service Department (CESD) of Bacoor and the Environmental Focal Person from the Barangay Council of Barangay P.F. Espiritu I, Bacoor City, Cavite shall submit a status report of the implementation to the Office of the DENR-EMB CALABARZON quarterly.

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This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon the signature of all the Parties hereto and shall remain enforced and binding subject to review every three years until otherwise revised, amended, or revoked.

Provided that, after one (1) year from the date of effectivity of this MOA, the DENR

- EMB shall donate the aforementioned pulley and trash trap to the LGU concerned through a deed of donation

E. TERMINATION

This Agreement shall be terminated under the following instances;

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It is understood that all the Parties shall conduct periodic consultations regarding the project implementation and, in the spirit of cooperation, endeavor to resolve any dispute arising out of this Agreement through mutual agreement. In case of disagreement, the same shall be resolved by mutual consultations between all the Parties.
