Subject: *A resolution adapting Republic Act No. 10152 or the Act Providing for Mandatory Basic Immunization Services for Infants and Children, repealing for the purpose Presidential Decree No. 996, as amended.*

(Date referred: November 20, 2024)

The above-mentioned proposed resolution underwent its first reading on November 20, 2024 during the 117th Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed resolution was referred by the Acting Presiding Officer, City Councilor and President Pro-Tempore Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica to the Committee on Health and Sanitation.

FINDINGS:

Republic Act No. 10152 also known as the "Mandatory Infants and Children Health Immunization Act of 2011" provides mandatory basic immunization for all infants and children.

In accordance with Article II, Section 15 of the Constitution, it is the policy of the state to take proactive role in the preventive health care of infants and children and to adopt a comprehensive, mandatory, and sustainable immunization program for vaccine-preventable diseases for all infants and children.

Provided under this Act shall cover the following vaccine-preventable diseases such as Tuberculosis, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis, Poliomyelitis, Measles, Mumps, Rubella or German Measles, Hepatitis-B, Influenza type B.





The mandatory basic immunization shall be given free at any government hospital or health center to infants and children up to five (5) years.

RECOMMENDATION:

By the motion of Hon. Reynaldo C. Palabrica duly seconded by all the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the above subject matter was **APPROVED** during its 120th Regular Session.

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Now we start the hearing with the proposed ordinance adapting Republic Act No. 10152 or the act providing for mandatory basic immunization services for infants and children, repealing for the purpose Presidential Decree No. 996, as amended."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "So for the record in attendance to this hearing, yung attendance natin kanina ayun din ang attendance natin ngayon."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "We will acknowledge the presence of our honorable committee, let's start with Hon. Rogello Nolasco."

COUN. ROGELIO NOLASCO "Good morning, Mr. Chair and sa ating mga resource persons."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "The SK Federation President."

COUN. PALM ANGEL BUNCIO "Good morning, Mr. Chair, magandang umaga po sa ating mag resource persons especially po sa mga nanditong Sangguniang Kabataan."





COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Thank you, Councilor Levy Tela."

COUN. LEVY TELA "Good morning sa ating lahat."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Ang next na agenda natin ay tungkol sa mga immunization ng mga bata, ngayon iexplain satin to ni Dra. Ivy kung paano ang mangyayari."

DRA. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Good morning po, this ordinance po is the adoption of Republic Act No. 10152 providing basic immunization services para sa ating mga babies. Alam naman po natin na ito ay ginagawa natin sa ating mga health centers meron po tayong mga libreng bakuna, unfortunately nga lang po sa City of Bacoor, mababa po yung ating FIC or Fully Immunized Child nasa 40% lang po ng ating mga babies ang nakatanggap po ng bakuna. Of course, hindi naman natin na-eencode dito yung mga nagpapabakuna sa private, kung idadagdag man po natin I don't think na maaabot po natin yung hundred percent."

DRA. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Kasi up to now marami po sa mga babies natin ang ayaw po mapa bakunahan o hindi kaagad nakakapag avail, kung sakali po kasi na hindi sila mabakunahan pwede po kasi mag lift into possible outbreak in the future. Alam naman po natin na nagkakaroon tayo ng measles outbreak, kahit isa lang po kasi ang magka measles sa ating barangay, binababaan po talaga natin ng bakuna yung surrounding na yun to avoid po na dumami. So, after the pandemic bumaba po yung immunization rate natin, kaya we are trying na magbaba ng mga information dissemination campaign and ma-encourage yung mga nanay to avail the basic immunization services, yung mga preventive vaccine natin. Libre naman po to sa ating mga health centers."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "So, walang babayaran noh?"

DRA. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Yes po, even po doon sa mga nakapaloob po sa ating mga lying-ins pino-provide po nila yung HEPA B, BCG, and birth, kino-cover po kasi yun ng PhilHealth so libre po."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Mga SK officials and Barangay Kagawad in health, tulungan natin ang City Government and City Health Office regarding pagbabakuna na maintindihan ng mga nanay kung gaano ka importante ang mga bakuna na ito. Siguro, isama na natin kapag nagkaroon tayo ng AIDS awareness campaign dapat meron din na vaccination awareness campaign."

PB VIVIAN GAWARAN-RAMIREZ "Magandang umaga po sa lahat, kami naman po ay mandated nagbibigay po kami monthly ng ating bakuna at mostly naman po sa binabakuna namin ay HEPA B and BCG. Mahigpit po kasi ang DOH, tinitignan po nila kung meron kaming HEPA B and BCG yung mga owner ng lying-ins. Regarding naman po sa barangay kailangan po yung mga health worker





natin tutukan din yung areas na di nila nababakunahan para ma fully-immunize yung mga bata, kasi isa sa mga nagiging problema dito yung mga muslim kaya ang ginagawa po dito ay pinasasamahan po sa barangay marami pong ganyan, alam po ni doctora yan. Yung iba naman pong muslim ay well-educated nakakapag pa bakuna po, ayun lang naman po yung problema, kailangan po yung 47 barangays suportahan po natin."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Thank you Kapitana Vivian. We recognized the presence of the representative from Office of the City Legal Services, Atty. Marius."

ATTY. MARIUS SUMIRA "Good morning po, Atty. Marius po from Office of the City Legal Services."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "With kind indulgence of my colleagues here in front isama ko na dito yung isang ordinance regarding granting free basic laboratories for pregnant women in the City of Bacoor. Kasi magkaka-ugnay naman eh, kapag nagbubuntis may free basic laboratories sa City Health Unit na nakakasakop sa inyo, kasama na doon ang HIV test para related doon sa task force."

DR. MICHAEL ANGELO MARQUEZ "Regarding hepatitis meron na po tayong libreng gamot po. Sa ngayon meron po tayong limang rubrics doon."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Nag-upgrade rin tayo sa mga services natin. Aside from HIV test meron pa tayong hepatitis B, pati gamot meron regarding hepatitis. So Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and Barangay Kagawad on Health ito yung mga services na gusto nating ma institutionalize sa ating mga centers para maging malusog ang ating mga kababayan. So, any question?"

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "May I request the SK Federation President to place the motion for the adjournment of this hearing."

COUN. PALM ANGEL BUNCIO "Wait lang po mag tatanong lang po ako kay Dra. Ivy, Doc may tanong lang po ako kung ano po kaya yung reason bukod doon sa hindi po tayo makapag disseminate ng maayos tungkol po doon sa mga bakuna natin. Kasi meron naman po talaga every Wednesday may bakuna sa health center ng barangay."

DRA. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Isa po sa mga reason na nakikita namin is parang nasanay kasi yung mga nanay sa door to door vaccination. So, every time po na may program ang DOH tas nagbabahay-bahay kami, nakikita namin na hindi kumpleto yung bakuna then pag tinanong namin na "bakit hindi kumpleto yung





bakuna", ang sagot samin "eh diba nag do-door to door naman kayo? Hihintayin na lang namin kayo".

DRA. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Kaya po kami napipilitan mag door to door kasi nga po hindi po sila pumupunta which is pag nag door to door kami napapabayaang po yung ibang mga health services, hindi lang naman yun ang ginagawa namin."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Siguro yung proper dissemination makikiusap na lang tayo sa mga barangay officials na kapag may event kayo, basketball man yan or kahit anong event baka pwede niyo naman isingit."

DRA. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "I believe lahat naman po ng barangay may FB page, social media account. Tulungan niyo rin po kami na mag post sa inyong mga social media pages, para mapaalam po natin sa ating mga constituents na hindi alam yung mga libreng serbisyo. Na hindi alam kung saan yung mga health centers, I-disseminate po natin."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "So the motion for adjournment of this hearing."

COUN. PALM ANGEL BUNCIO "I respectfully moved to adjourned the committee hearing."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Seconded, any objection? Therefore, this hearing is now adjourned."

REPUBLIC ACT No. 10152

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MANDATORY BASIC IMMUNIZATION SERVICES FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN,
REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE No. 996, AS AMENDED.*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled***Section 1. Title** - This Act shall be known as the "Mandatory Infants and Children Health Immunization Act of 2011"**Section 2. Declaration of Policy** - In accordance with Article II, Section 15 of the Constitution, it is hereby declared to be the policy of the State to take a proactive role in the preventive health care of infants and children. Towards this end, the State shall adopt a comprehensive, mandatory and sustainable immunization program for vaccine-preventable diseases for all infants and children.**Section 3. Coverage** - The mandatory basic immunization for all infants and children provided under this Act shall cover the following vaccine-preventable diseases:

- (a) Tuberculosis;
- (b) Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis;
- (c) Polio/myelitis;
- (d) Measles;
- (e) Mumps;
- (f) Rubella or German measles;
- (g) Hepatitis-B;
- (h) H. Influenza type B (HB) and
- (i) Such other types as may be determined by the Secretary of Health in a department circular

The mandatory basic immunization shall be given for free at any government hospital or health center to infants and children up to five (5) years of age.

Hepatitis-B vaccine shall be administered by any duly licensed physician, nurse or midwife to all infants born in hospitals, health infirmaries, health centers or lying-in centers with obstetrical and pediatric services, whether public or private, within twenty-four (24) hours after birth. *Provided, however,* That in cases of infants born in

The DOH, other government agencies, nongovernment organizations, professional and academic societies, and local government units shall make available appropriate information materials and shall have a system of its distribution to the public.

Section 5. *Obligation to Inform* - Any physician, nurse, midwife, nursing aide or skilled birth attendant, who delivers, or assists in the delivery of, a newborn shall, prior to delivery, inform parents or legal guardian of the newborn of the availability, nature and benefits of immunization against Hepatitis-B and other vaccine-preventable diseases at birth.

Section 6. *Continuing Education and Training of Health Personnel* - The DOH, with the assistance of local government units, academe, professional societies and nongovernmental organizations, shall undertake continuing information, education and training programs for all health personnel on the rationale and benefits of as well as modern procedures for immunization of infants and children against vaccine-preventable diseases.

Section 7. *Appropriations* - The amount necessary to carry out the implementation of this Act shall be charged against the current year's appropriations for expanded program on immunization of the DOH. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for the continued implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHIC) shall include the basic immunization services in its benefit package.

Section 8. *Implementing Rules and Regulations* - The DOH, in consultation with the National Immunization Committee, shall issue the implementing rules and regulations within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act.

Section 9. *Separability Clause* - If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. *Repealing Clause* - All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 11. *Effectivity* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
