

Subject: A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF CALAMITY IN BARANGAY ZAPOTE 1, CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE AND AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF THREE MILION PESOS (PHP 3,000,000,00) FROM THE CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND TO BE USED FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, RELIEF GOODS, AND OTHER INCIDENTAL EXPENSES RELATED TO RELIEF AND REHABILITATION OPERATIONS. (PCR 736-2025 dated 13 January 2025).

Respectfully submitted to the Sangguniang Panlungsod the hereunder report on the above-mentioned subject matter. Thus, the committee respectfully reports that:

- In the early morning of 13 January 2025, a fire broke out in a residential unit in Waling-waling Street, Barangay Zapote 1, that rapidly spread to adjacent residential units which were mostly made from light materials;
- Initial damage and needs assessment showed that there were around 315 families affected by the fire incident;
- The affected families were relocated and presently staying at Zapote 1.
 Covered Court which serves as the evacuation center;
- There is a need to extend immediate assistance to the fire victims i.e., hot
 meals and dry goods, financial assistance for their temporary shelters.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view thereof, the committee respectfully recommends the APPROVAL of a resolution declaring the existence of a state of calamity in Waling-waling Street, Barangay Zapote 1 and to authorize City Mayor Strike B. Revilla. City DRRM Council Chairperson, to disburse the amount of three million pesos (PHP 3,000,000,00) from the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund to be used as quick response fund for relief goods and other incidental expenses related to relief and rehabilitation operations.

Hon, Alejandro Gutierrez informed the Council members regarding the fire that broke out in a residential unit on Waling-waling Street, Barangay Zapote 1, Bacoor City, Cavite in the early morning of 13 January 2025. He also mentioned that the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council passed Resolution No. 1-2025 recommending the utilization of three million pesos (Php 3,000,000.00) from the Quick Response Fund (QRF) of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (CDRRMF) by the City Mayor for various disaster prevention, mitigation, recovery and relief operations for the benefit of Bacooreños who were affected by the aforementioned fire incident. He then moved that a resolution be passed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor declaring the existence of a state of calamity in Barangay Zapote 1. Sine the internal rules were already suspended, the motion met no objection and was unanimously seconded by the Council. It was deemed approved by the Chair.

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
