Subject: BARANGAY RESOLUTION NO. 2024-003: A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND IMPLEMENTING RA 9003 KNOWN AS THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2000 AS PART OF THE ANTI-LITTERING CAMPAIGN OF BARANGAY MAMBOG 2, CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE.. (PNOA 407-2024, dated March 25, 2024).

Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod met in order to call the 84th Regular Session, at 10:00 AM, on 25 March, 2024. Presiding Officer Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola, referred the subject matter to Chairperson of Environment and Natural Resources, Hon. Levy M. Tela.

FINDINGS:

R.A. Act 9003 of Section 10 - Role of LGUs in Solid Waste Management. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, the LGUs shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their respective jurisdictions.

Ecological Waste Management, ensure the protection of public health and environment. Utilize environmentally-sound methods that maximize the utilization of valuable resources and encourage resource conservation and recovery.

The Sangguniang Barangay of Mambog 2 agreed to adopt and implement this law:

- To ensure the protection of the public health and environment.
- To utilize environmentally-sound methods that maximize the utilization of valuable resources and encourage resource conservation and recovery.
- To set guidelines and targets for solid waste avoidance and volume reduction through source reduction and waste minimization measures, including composting, recycling, re-use, recovery, before collection, and disposal in appropriate and environmentally sound solid waste management facility in accordance with ecologically sustainable development principles.
- To ensure the proper segregation, collection, and disposal of solid waste management excluding incineration.
- To encourage our constituents to participate in solid waste management.

For premises containing six (6) or more residential units, the local government unit shall promulgate regulations requiring the owner or person in charge of such premises to:

- (a) provide for the residents a designated area and containers in which to accumulate source separated recyclable materials to be collected by the municipality or private center; and
- (b) notify the occupants of such buildings of the requirements of this Act and the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto.

SECTION 22. Requirements for the Segregation and Storage of Solid Waste. — The following shall be the minimum standards and requirements for segregation and storage of solid waste pending collection:

- (a) There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources: Provided, that in the case of bulky waste, it will suffice that the same be collected and placed in a separate and designated area; and
- (b) The solid waste container depending on its use shall be properly marked or identified for on-site collection as "compostable", "non-recyclable", "recyclable" or "special waste", or any other classification as may be determined by the Commission.

The following acts prohibited:

- Littering, throwing, dumping of waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canal, esteros or parks, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;
- 2. The open burning of solid waste;
- 3. Open dumpling, burying of biodegradable or non-biodegradable materials in flood prone areas.

The Sangguniang Barangay set a penal provision wherein any person(s) who violates law shall, upon conviction, shall receive a verbal order for the first offense, provided however, that if violation is deemed to be excessive, the barangay authorities need to issue a verbal reprimand, may be in lieu thereof charge the offending person(s) with violation of this law to be punished with a in ticket form, or render community service for not less than one (1) day to not more than fifteen days, or both.



WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Mambog 2 agreed to adopt and implement this law.

- to ensure the protection of the public health and environment;
- to utilize environmentally-sound methods that maximize the utilization of valuable resources and encourage resource conservation and recovery;
- to set guidelines and targets for solid waste avoidance and volume reduction through source reduction and waste minimization measures, including composting, recycling, re-use, recovery, before collection, and disposal in appropriate and environmentally sound solid waste management facility in accordance with ecologically sustainable development principles,
- to ensure the proper segregation, collection, and disposal of solid waste through the formulation and adoption of the best environmental practice in ecological waste management excluding incineration:
- to encourage our constituents to participate in solid waste management;

WHEREAS, in Chapter 3 Article 2 Section 21 under Segregation of Wastes states that the LGUs shall evaluate alternative roles for the public and private sectors in providing collection services, type of collection system, or combination of systems, that best meet their needs: Provided, That segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources: Provided, further. That wastes shall be segregated into the categories provided in Sec. 22 of this Act.

For premises containing six (6) or more residential units, the local government unit shall promulgate regulations requiring the owner or person in charge of such premises to

- provide for the residents a designated area and containers in which to accumulate source separated recyclable materials to be collected by the municipality or private center; and
- notify the occupants of each buildings of the requirements of this Act and the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto.

Section 22. Requirements for the Segregation and Storage of Solid Waste - The following shall be the minimum standards and requirements for segregation and storage of solid waste pending collection

There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources. Provided, That in the case of bulky waste, it will suffice that the same be collected and placed in a separate designated area; and

b. The solid waste container depending on its use shall be properly marked or identified for on-site collection as "compostable", "non-recyclable", "recyclable" or "special waste", or any other classification as may be determined by the Commission.

WHEREAS, the following acts are prohibited:

- a. Littering, throwing, dumping of waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, esteros or parks, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;
- b The open burning of solid waste;
- c. Open dumping, burying of biodegradable or non-biodegradable materials in flood prone areas;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay set a penal provision wherein any person(s) who violates this law shall, upon conviction, shall receive a verbal order for the first offense, provided however, that if the violation is deemed to be excessive, the Barangay authorities need not issue a verbal reprimand, but may be in lieu thereof charge the offending person(s) with violation of this law to be punished with a fine in ticket form, or render community service for not less than one (1) day to not more than fifteen (15) days, or both:
