Subject: APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2023-003: ANNUAL GENERAL FUND OF BARANGAY SAN NICOLAS III FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 IN THE AMOUNT OF PHP38,497,292.00 – PNOA-427-S-2024 dated March 25, 2024

Referred to this Committee during the 84th Regular Session is the above-subject matter for appropriate action and recommendation.

Consistent with the approved 2024 Annual Investment Program and DILG approved GAD Plan for Fiscal Year 2024, the Sangguniang Barangay of SAN NICOLAS III enacted Ordinance No. 2023-003 approving the 2024 Annual General Fund to cover the Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Capital Outlay (CO) and Special Purpose Allocation (SPA) which involved the total amount of THIRTY-EIGHT MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY-TWO PESOS (PHP38,497,292.00).

The attached documents to support the proposed Annual General Fund will readily show that it has been examined and reviewed by the concerned City Accounting Office and City Budget Office and that the same is in conformity with the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160 and existing budget circulars/issuances.

Upon the suspension of internal rules and referral to this Committee of said Barangay **Ordinance No. 2023-003**, Honorable Rogelio M. Nolasco moved for the approval of the same and the motion was unanimously seconded by the majority of the Honorable Members of the 5<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod. The Annual General Fund for Fiscal Year 2024 of **Barangay SAN NICOLAS III**, Bacoor City for FY2024 was **APPROVED**, charge to its Receipt Program.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the foregoing, the Honorable Members of the Committee hereby recommend **TO APPROVE** the Appropriation Ordinance authorizing the Barangay Annual General Fund of **Barangay SAN NICOLAS III**, Bacoor City in the total amount of **THIRTY-EIGHT MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY-TWO PESOS (PHP38,497,292.00)**, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Honorable Rogelio M. Nolasco moved the approval for the Appropriation Ordinance No. 2023-003 for the Annual General Fund for Barangay San Nicolas III for the calendar year 2024 in the amount of PHP 38,497,292.00 Following the recommendation of City Budget Officer the annual budget has not exceeded the estimates income for the year. And the Barangay AIP is in accordance with the projected programs and included in annual budget.

Gentlemen/Mesdames,

This refers to the FY 2024 Annual General Fund Budget of Barangay San Nicolas 3 Invelving an appropriation of P 38,497,292.00 passed and approved under Sangguniang Barangay Appropriation Ordinance No.2023-003 on December 20, 2023 and received by this Office for review and evaluation.

Preliminary review of the submitted budget has been undertaken pursuant to Republic Act. No. 7160 and other related issuances; the following are our findings and recommendation as basis for deliberation of the council.

1 The aggregate amount appropriated in the annual budget has not exceeded the estimates of income for the budget year.

 Appropriation for development projects is set at P 7,421,458.40 which is equivalent to 20% of estimated NTA for the budget year. Utilization of the said fund is covered by DBM-DOF- DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No.1 dated Nov. 4, 2020.

3. Appropriation for Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (BDRRMF) is set at 5% of the estimated revenue from regular sources. Disbursements thereof shall be in accordance with RA 10121 otherwise known as Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010. The attached BDRRM Plan shows the distribution of the fund as per RA 10121.

SK fund was provided at 10% of the estimated revenue from regular sources.

BCPC Fund was provided at 1% of NTA for the budget year as mandated by RA 9344 for the strengthening and implementation of the programs of the council.

 1% of the total budget was set aside for programs/projects/activities for Elderly/PWD as per DBM/DSWD Joint Circular No. 2003-01.

 The rate of honoraria of barangay officials is within the rate of Salary Grade 14 and 10 of the salary schedule implemented by the city for the chairman and members of the council/secretary/treasurer, respectively.

 Approved GAD Plan and Budget is also submitted as an integral part of the barangay annual budget

 Barangay Annual Investment Program (AIP) is hereto attached wherein projected programs are included in the Annual Budget.

 Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Plan is hereto attached comprises of detailed plans and programs for the budget year.

11. All items in the barangay plantilla of personnel other than the mandatory positions prescribed under RA 7160 shall be in accordance with DBM LBC No. 137 (Index of Occupational Services, Position Titles and Salary Grades) dated July 13, 2021.

12 All other disbursement shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



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#### Section 4. General Provisions

- 1. All items of appropriation in this Ordinance shall be used only for the purpose for which they are appropriated.
- 2. In the use of savings, priority shall be given to the augmentation of existing but deficient amounts set aside for the payment of compensation, personnel benefits, leave credits. Savings refer to portions or balances of any release appropriations in this Ordinance free from any obligation or encumbrance, still available after the satisfactory completion or - the the unavoidable discontinuance or abandonment of the work, activity or purpose for which the appropriation is authorized, or arising from unpaid compensation and related costs pertaining positions and leaves of absence without pay.
- 3. The 30% Quick Response Fund(QRF) appropriated under the Barangay Disaster. Risk Reduction and Management Fund (BDRRMF) shall be used as standby fund for relief and recovery program. The release and use of QRF shall be supported by a resolution of the Sangguniang Bayan declaring the barangay under a state of calamity or a Presidential declaration of a state of calamity.
- The BDRRMF shall be used in accordance with R.A. No. 10121.
- This Appropriation Ordinance will serve as the release document and all items of appropriation are comprehensively released, provided that if there is a shortfall in revenues, the Punong Barangay is authorized to issue a negative Allotment Release Order to reduce some of the amounts in the Appropriation Ordinance without need of further action from the Sangguniang Barangay.

Section 5. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any Section or provision of this Appropriation. Ordinance is disallowed in Budget Review or declared invalid by proper authorities, other Sections or provisions hereof that are not affected thereby shall continue to be full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity. The Provisions of this Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2024.

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
