Subject: *Request for approval of barangay ordinance from Barangay Molino 7: Ordinance No. 001 (Series of 2024) – Barangay ordinance on ecological waste management.( PNOA-452-2024), dated (April 15, 2024).*

The above-mentioned subject matter underwent first reading on April 15, 2024 during the 86<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said subject matter was referred by the Presiding Officer Hon. Rowena Bautista Mendiola to the Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances.

The Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances sent out invitations to the resource persons and conducted a committee hearing on April 25, 2024 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panglungsod at 1:30 p.m.

A continual committee hearing was conducted on May 16, 2024 at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod at 10:45 a.m.

**FINDINGS:**

During the committee hearing held last April 15, 2024, the committee found that the proposed barangay ordinance needs revisions regarding in the sequencing of its provisions. The Presiding Officer gave suggestions on how to correct the proposed ordinance and asked the Barangay Secretary to revise it and re-submit the corrected proposed ordinance to the committee.

On May 16, 2024 during the second committee hearing, the corrected proposed barangay ordinance was submitted before the Honorable Committee and it was found out to be correct.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

After a thorough review of all the circumstances and statements from the resource persons, the Committee respectfully recommends that the Sangguniang Panlungsod approve the above subject matter.

- The Presiding Officer, City Councilor Hon. Reynaldo Palabrica read the above-subject matter and the committee hearing was called to order.
- The Presiding Officer then proceeded with the introduction of the members of the Honorable Committee and City Councilors present in the committee hearing.



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- The Presiding Officer asked the resource persons to introduce themselves before the Honorable Committee.
- The Presiding Officer asked the secretariat a copy of the proposed Molino 7 ordinance.
- The Presiding Officer asked Punong Barangay Antonio Blanquera if the proposed barangay ordinance is based on the city ordinance.
- The Punong Barangay answered that they adapted it from the city ordinance.
- The Presiding Officer looked out for the penalty provision of the said ordinance.
- The Presiding Officer noticed the arrangement or sequencing of the ordinance. He suggested that the penalty provision and the prohibited acts should be separated.
- The Presiding Officer mentioned that an ordinance should be written in simplified form to be able to easily understand by the constituents.
- The Presiding Officer instructed and tasked Mr. Edwin Pitero, barangay secretary of Molino 7 for the arrangement of the ordinance, segregate the ordinance well by putting the article 1 as title of the ordinance, article 2 as coverage, article 3 authority and purpose or goals of the ordinance, article 4 as definition of terms and so on and so forth.
- The Presiding Officer asked for the comments from the barangay officials.
- The PB Blanquera said that they will arrange the proposed ordinance based on the suggestions of the Presiding Officer.
- The Presiding Officer asked Barangay Kagawad Lorenze Gawaran on the issue of not affixing his signature.
- Barangay Kagawad Lorenze Gawaran said that he did not affix his signature at the presented barangay ordinance due to the reason that he knows that the ordinance has its lacking information. Kagawad Lorenze Gawaran believed that the proposed ordinance should be corrected first during their barangay session.
- The Presiding Officer suggested that the barangay council of Barangay Molino 7 should coordinate and cooperate with each other. Further said that they are the trusted and elected officials of their community. He also added to set aside the political motives and do their sworn duties and responsibilities for the betterment of their constituents.
- City Councilor Hon. Levy Tela, as Chairman on the Committee on Environment expressed his opinion of support to the manifestations made by the Presiding Officer to do the right things and work together.
- The Presiding Officer asked for additional comments/suggestions from the members of the Honorable Committee.



**BARANGAY ORDINANCE**  
**ON ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

**WHEREAS** the Barangay Marikina 2 is committed to the protection, preservation and management of the environment;

**WHEREAS** in the respect of law of the land, it is its duty and responsibility to implement the Solid Waste Management System under Republic Act No. 8763 on the local level;

**WHEREAS** Section 16 of the Local Government Code (RA 7160) provides:

"Section 16. General Welfare. – Every local government unit shall exercise its powers expeditiously, efficiently, economically and equitably, and shall provide services, facilities and utilities for its efficient and effective performance, and this shall be considered to be the promotion of the general welfare. Within the local government unit, the health, safety, education and other services shall be provided in such a manner as to protect and enhance the right of the people to a balanced, healthful, and better quality of life, and to provide the highest and most efficient use of its resources."

**WHEREAS** the unregulated waste disposal in the household and other establishments, industries, offices, schools, and agricultural communities is serious;

**WHEREAS** the effective regulation to have a better environment, health and safety, and the need of protection and disposal of garbage and refuse, and the need to have a clean and waste-free environment;

**NOW THEREFORE** upon recommendation of the Sangguniang Barangay Marikina 2, and in accordance with the authority vested in the Barangay Marikina 2 by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor, Cavite, under the leadership of **HON. DENZEL BRIAN C. ACVAREZ**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT**

**ARTICLE I**

**Title of the Ordinance**

The Ordinance shall be known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of Marikina 2."

ARTICLE II

Coverage

This Ordinance shall apply to all residential houses; commercial establishments such as restaurants, eateries, department stores, groceries, sanitary stores, auto-repair shops; institutions like hospitals, schools, churches, public and private offices; industrial establishments of any kind; and agricultural areas situated within the territorial jurisdictions of Barangay Molino 7 of the Municipality/City of Bacoor.

ARTICLE III

Authority and Purpose/Goals

SECTION 1. **Authority.** This Ordinance is enacted to implement the provisions of Republic Act No. 9003 which mandates the proper segregation and collection of household wastes.

SECTION 2. **Purpose.** This Ordinance is enacted for the following purposes:

- a) To guide, control and regulate the generation of solid wastes within the Barangay and promote an orderly and sanitary system for the same;
- b) To enhance the total environment of the locality through the necessary control and mitigation of negative environmental impacts of solid waste;
- c) To promote and protect the health, safety, peace and convenience of the general welfare of the inhabitants of the Barangay;
- d) To minimize the generation of solid waste and maximize possible resource/recovery/recycling and utilization by:
  - Maximizing the use of goods and consumption of foods;
  - Encouraging the salvaging of possible "recoverable" from solid wastes for re-use and/or recycling back to production process; and
  - Encouraging the recycling and resource recovery of wastes in own backyards through composting.

SECTION 3. **Goal.** The primary goal of this Ordinance is to Enhance ecological balance of the community through sustainable and integrated waste management.

SECTION 4. **Objectives.** The objectives of this Ordinance are the following:

- a) to ensure round-the-clock cleanliness through the orderly management of waste;
- b) to eradicate unsightly, uncovered and overflowing waste containers in streets, public places and open spaces;
- c) to maximize and optimize sanitary resource recovery for feeds, materials and others; and
- d) to minimize pollution arising from harmful gases, smoke particulates produced by needless burning/dumping, polluted runoffs into water sources/supply, and hazardous substances.

ARTICLE IV

Definition of Terms

SECTION 5. **Technical Terms.** The technical terms used in this Ordinance shall be defined as follows:

- a) Biodegradable – any material that can be reduced into finer particles (degraded or decomposed) by microbiological organisms or enzymes (synonymous with compostable).
- b) Biodegradable Wastes – fruit & vegetable peelings, spoiled food & leftovers, vegetable trimmings, fish scales, egg shells, seafood shells, animal entrails & carcasses, corn cobs & sheaths, rice hulls, peanut shells, wet newspapers & cardboards, wet papers & cartons, coconut shells & husks, seeds, garden & grass clippings, pet/poultry/livestock manure, clipped branches and sawdust;
- c) Compost – decayed organic material for use as soil conditioner or fertilizer.
- d) Composting – biological degradation under controlled conditions, the process of making biodegradables such as food waste, garden waste, animal waste and human waste into compost by mixing them with soil, water, biological additives/activators (optional) and air.

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- e) Domestic Waste- refuse from households, as distinguished from industrial waste, hospital waste, which may be classified as biodegradable (compostable materials/wastes) or non-biodegradable (Non compostable materials/waste).
- f) Recyclable Wastes. Dry papers & newspapers, dry cardboards & cartons, plastic materials like plastic water bottles, plastic caps, PVC & PE pipes, computer casing, tin cans, & covers, aluminum cans, iron steel, copper wires, broken transparent glasses, glass bottles, toner cartridges, computer ink cartridges
- g) Residual Wastes - sando bags, packing wrappers, styropor/styrofoams, cigarette butts, worn out plastic sacks, dirt from sweepings, worn out rags, sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, plastic straws, parlor & barbershop waste, household medicine bottles, broken ceramics, colored broken glasses, coco fiber from cushions, poultry feathers.
- h) Special Wastes - paint & thinner containers, spray canisters, household batteries, pharmaceutical waste, spoiled, spilled, expired cosmetic waste, lead-acid batteries, used oil filters, broken tires.
- i) Bulky Wastes - used rubber tires; garden debris, destroyed TV sets, radios, stereos, washing machines, dryers, stoves, refrigerators, & dishwashers; broken furniture, filing cabinets, book cases, beds & cushions

**ARTICLE V**

**Segregation of Wastes**

**SECTION 6. Mandatory Segregation of Solid Wastes.** The segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources: Provided, That wastes shall be segregated into the categories provided in Section 2 of this Article.

**SECTION 7. Requirements for the Segregation and Storage of Solid Waste Pending Collection.**

The following shall be the minimum standards and requirements for segregation and storage of solid waste pending collection:

- a) There shall be a suitable container such as a plastic bag or the like for the ecological solid waste before these are brought out along the streets or being brought out at the assigned dumping areas
- b) There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources. Provided, That in the case of bulky waste, it will suffice that the same be collected and placed in separate and designated area; and
- c) The solid waste container depending on its use shall be properly marked or identified for on-site collection as follows:
  - \* Biodegradables/Compostables or "Nabubulok",
  - \* Recyclables or "Di-nabubulok na magari pang pakinabangan"; and
  - \* Residuals & Special Wastes or "Di-nabubulok na di na mapapakinabangan."

**ARTICLE VI**

**Collection and Disposal**

**SECTION 8. Residential Areas.** The garbage shall be collected through the present system of collection within the Barangay. Independent collection systems of the composite barangays shall be followed

**SECTION 9. Schools, Churches, and Business Establishments.** All garbage in these locations shall also be collected in the same manner as in Section 8.

**SECTION 10. Agricultural Areas.** Agricultural areas shall convert organic wastes into compost in their respective areas.

**SECTION 11. Industrial Areas.** All factories and plants shall separate their garbage into toxic and non-toxic. It is mandatory that all factories contact the industrial waste exchange (IWE) to exchange their wastes with others who may be able to use them. Existing industrial areas already having their proper way of collection and disposal shall continue practicing the same

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SECTION 12. Time of dumping of ecological solid wastes for collection at the collection sites shall be from five o'clock to six o'clock in the morning (5-6 am) on the day of collection of the garbage scheduled to be collected only.

**ARTICLE VII**

**Penal Provisions**

SECTION 13. Prohibited Acts and Its Fines and Penalties. The following acts are prohibited and its corresponding Fines and Penalties:

- (1) Bringing out and dumping of garbage outside of collection day and proper time of dumping for collection, indiscriminately dumping garbage, littering, throwing, dumping of solid waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, drainage systems, curbs and gutters, esteros or parks, creeks, rivers, tributaries, rivulets and other natural waterways, and establishment, or causing or permitting the same;
- (2) The open and indiscriminate burning of residual and special wastes;
- (3) Causing or permitting the collection of non-segregated or unsorted waste/non-segregation of wastes into biodegradable, recyclable, and residual/special;
- (4) Littering, scattering, throwing and dumping of waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, esteros, gutters, manholes, parks, public playgrounds, public school campuses, public buildings, establishments, riverbanks, coastlines, rivers, lakes, creeks and seas, or causing or permitting the same;
- (5) Littering from vehicles;
- (6) Leaving or abandoning construction materials or debris on the public road;
- (7) Dumping of human excreta in mobile garbage bins or collection points;
- (8) Dumping excreta or carcass of animals in mobile garbage bins or collection points;
- (9) Removal of mobile garbage bin from designated collection points without authorization from the Barangay.
- (10) The open burning of solid waste;
- (11) Non-segregation of solid waste;
- (12) Causing or permitting the collection of non-segregated or unsorted waste;
- (13) Mixing, causing or permitting the mixing of toxic and hazardous wastes from health care facilities, industries and other generators in the barangay waste collected by the City;
- (14) Open dumping, burying of biodegradable or non-biodegradable materials in flood-prone areas;
- (15) Operating without a Solid Waste Management Certificates as prescribed in this Ordinance;
- (16) Non-implementation of the Solid Waste Management Plan and Program submitted as part of the requirements for the issuance of the Solid Waste Management Certificate;
- (17) Refusing entry to the City ENRD or its duly authorized representative while in the exercise of its visitorial powers provided in this Ordinance; and
- (18) Violation of any other provisions of this Ordinance.
- (19) a | Any person who violates Sec. 13 shall, upon conviction be punished with a fine of not less than Three Hundred Pesos (300.00) but not more than One Thousand Pesos (1,000.00) or render community service for not less than one (1) day to not more than fifteen (15) days or both;

violators shall not be given barangay clearance until he/she has paid and/or served his/her fines/penalties.

SECTION 14. Utilization of Collected Fines. Thirty percent (30%) of the collected fines shall accrue to the General Fund for appropriations for the next fiscal year and the remaining Seventy percent (70%), which shall be called as Ecological Solid Waste Management (ESWM) Fund, shall be used within the fiscal year of which the fines were collected.

- (1) Procurement of Materials, Equipment, Protective Gears and other items necessary for the proper implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of the Barangay
- (2) Information, education, communication and monitoring activities of the Ecological Solid Waste Management of Barangay Molino
- (3) Acquisition of products, facilities, technologies and processes necessary to enhance proper ecological solid waste management;
- (4) Transportation/Hauling of ecological solid wastes;

- (5) Awards and incentives;
- (6) Research programs;
- (7) Technical assistance;

ARTICLE VIII

Miscellaneous Provisions

SECTION 15. Citizen Suits. For purposes of enforcing the provisions of this Ordinance, any citizen may file an appropriate civil or criminal action in the barangay against any person who violates or fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. The Barangay concerned shall exempt such action from payment of filing fees.

SECTION 16. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstances is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.

SECTION 17. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances and resolutions of this barangay found to be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 18. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.
