### COMMITTEE REPORT

Subject: *AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE SEGREGATION AT SOURCE OF ALL HOUSEHOLD, INSTITUTIONAL, AGRICULTURAL AND COMMERCIAL WASTE INTO WET BIODEGRADABLE AND DRY OR NON-BIODEGRADABLE WASTE, REQUIRING THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES HEREOF. (PNOA 468-2024 dated April 22, 2024).*

Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod met in order to call the 88th Regular Session, at 10:00 AM, on 29 April, 2024. Presiding Officer Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola referred the subject matter to Chairperson of Environment and Natural Resources Hon. Levy M. Tela. Barangay Queen's Row West Ordinance No. 001 Series of 2024 which promotes responsible consumption habits and encourages individuals/communities to take responsibility for their environmental impact.

#### FINDINGS:

In section 10 of R.A. No. 9003 (also known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) provides that the "LGU's shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this act within their respective jurisdictions. Segregation and collection of solid wastes shall be conducted in the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes; provided that the collection of non-recyclable material and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the city".

In Section 21 of R.A 9003 further provides that LGUs shall evaluate alternative roles for the public and private sectors in providing collection services, type of collection system, or combination of systems, that best meet their needs: Provided, that segregation of wastes shall primarily be conducted at the source, to include household, institutional, industrial, commercial and agricultural sources.

With the growing population of the Barangay, now producing more solid waste than ever before necessitating the immediate and mandatory segregation of wastes from its source in order to promote public health and protect the general welfare of the Bacooreños.




**RECOMMENDATION:**

After thorough review of the foregoing and found it beneficial to Bacooreños, the Committee respectfully recommends that the proposed notice of approval mentioned above be **APPROVED**.

Subject: ***AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE SEGREGATION AT SOURCE OF ALL HOUSEHOLD, INSTITUTIONAL, AGRICULTURAL AND COMMERCIAL WASTE INTO WET BIODEGRADABLE AND DRY OR NON-BIODEGRADABLE WASTE, REQUIRING THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES HEREOF. (PNOA 468-2024 dated April 22, 2024).***

The 88th Regular Session started at 10:00 am on 29 April, 2024. The presiding officer Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Bautista- Mendiola referred the subject matter to the Chairperson of Environment and Natural Resources, Hon. Levy M. Tela. An ordinance mandating the segregation at source of all household institutional, agricultural and commercial waste into wet biodegradable and dry or non-biodegradable waste, requiring the proper disposal of solid waste and providing penalties hereof.

Hon. Tela noticed and must be carried out that the aforementioned subject matter need to implement for cleanliness and awareness of the said barangay. The Garbage collector, sanitary inspectors must have a proper training with the environmental policing and shall be empowered to inspect all waste containers to determine if its content is properly segregated, refuse to collect unsegregated waste and to issue violation ticket to any person or establishment who violates this ordinance. Household, business owners, agricultural sectors, institutional and other business sources must aware of penalties for non-segregation of waste.
