Subject: *An ordinance establishing a Barangay Primary Care System in the City of Bacoor, Cavite, to be known as the "Strike (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumesponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon); Bida Caravan" intended to improve the health and wellness of Bacooreños through grassroots preventive medicine.*

(Date referred: August 18, 2025)

The above-mentioned proposed ordinance underwent its first reading on August 18, 2025 during the 7th Regular Session of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said proposed ordinance was referred by the Presiding Officer, City Vice Mayor Hon. Rowena Baustista Mendiola to the Committee on Health and Sanitation.

The Committee on Health and Sanitation sent out invitations to the resource persons and conducted a committee hearing on September 11, 2025, 9:00 a.m. at the Session Hall of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. After due consultation and deliberation hereby report back to this August Body the findings, information gathered, and recommendation on the above-subject matter. Attached hereto are the attendance sheet and photos taken during the said hearing.

FINDINGS:

After an evaluation of the growing needs of the people of Bacoor, Hon. City Mayor Strike B. Revilla in consultation with the Office of the City Health Services (OCHS) conceptualized the approval of an ordinance establishing a barangay-





based primary care to be conducted and supervised by the OCHS in partnership with the Liga ng mga Barangay (LNB) that aims to promote public health and wellness through the practice of preventive medicine.

This proposed City Ordinance was written and lobbied for the purpose of creating the STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumesponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA AND KALUSUGAN CARAVAN.

This program will create a barangay based primary care program intended to promote public health and wellness in the City of Bacoor, Cavite to be conducted and supervised exclusively by the Office of the City Health Services (OCHS) in partnership with members of the Liga ng mga Barangay.

The STRIKE: BIDA AND KALUSUGAN CARAVAN shall become a permanent component of the City Health Program of the City of Bacoor, Cavite. Upon the recommendation of the Bacoor City Health Board, sufficient funds for the said program shall be appropriated in the annual budget of the City Government by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

Along with the referral was a letter from the Office of the City Mayor dated August 25, 2025 requesting the Honorable Members of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact an ordinance establishing a barangay-based primary care system to be known as the STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumesponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough review of all the circumstances and statements from the resource persons, and the provisions of the proposed ordinance, the Committee respectfully recommends that the Sangguniang Panlungsod approve the above subject matter on 2nd reading during its next regular session.

Further recommended that the title of this proposed ordinance be changed to "STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at **RESPONSABLE** para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA SA KALUSUGAN CARAVAN, duly approved by the resource persons and all the City Councilors present.

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Good morning, honorable members of the City Council. The proposed ordinance regarding **an ordinance establishing a barangay primary care system in the City of Bacoor, Cavite to be known as the "Strike (Serbisyo tapat at rumeresponde para sa inklusibong kalusugan at edukasyon): Bida ang kalusugan caravan"** intended to improve the health and wellness of Bacooreños through grassroots preventive medicine is now called to order."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "For the record we would like to acknowledge the presence of the members of the City Council present here in this hearing and all their opening statement, we start with the gentleman from Molino 5."

COUN. HORACIO BRILLANTES JR. "Good morning, Mr. Chair, good morning po sa ating mga bisita na naririto po, mabuhay po."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Thank you, next is the gentleman from Molino 1."

COUN. SIMPLICIO DOMINGUEZ "Magandang umaga at magandang pamumuno, mabuhay po tayo."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Thank you, next is the gentleman from District one, barangay San Nicolas."





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COUN. MIGUEL BAUTISTA "Good morning, Mr. Chair and to to all honorable present, and to all resource person, mabuhay."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Thank you, mabuhay and good morning, last but not the least, the ex-officio and member of the council, Liga ng mga barangay."

COUN. RANDY FRANCISCO "Good morning, Mr. Chair at sa ating lahat."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Thank you very much. Also, from District one, honorable gentleman from Dulong Bayan."

COUN. LEVY TELA "Good morning, Mr. Chair, good morning to all resource person present. Mabuhay."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Since the resource person already acknowledge their attendance, so we will proceed to discussion about the proposed ordinance, may I ask the City health officer to explain this proposal?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Good morning po honorable councilors, I am Dr. Ivy Marie Yrastorza, City Health Officer of Bacoor, so ito pong ordinance na po ito ay crafted, kumbaga, in alignment po ito sa Universal health care, nakapaloob po dito sa ordinance na ito yung mga services, kung ngayon po ay based po ang ating services sa ating health centers. Dito po sa ating Strike caravan, yung mga health workers po natin ay bababa sa mga barangays, para magibigay ng services, not only medical consultation but as mentioned po, yung preventive services po natin, kasama po dito yung health education promotion, yung mga lifestyle medicine approaches, and yung lahat po nung services na puwede pong maibigay ng City Health Office, tulad po nung dental, yung atin pong mga bakuna, family planning, na ang goal po natin is ma reach po natin yung mga parts po ng ating city na hindi po masyadong naaabot ng ating mga serbisyo. Alam naman po natin na may mga parts po talaga ng ating mga barangay na medyo malayo po sa ating mga health centers, minsan po yun yung dahilan kung bakit hindi nakakspag seek ng services, so yung goal po natin in this ay maabot po natin sila and at the same time po, nandito rin po sa ordinansa yung pagkakaroon po natin ng electronic medical record, na lahat po talaga ng taga Bacoor ay magiging part o magkakaroon po tayo ng data kung ano po yung health profile ng bawat isa, para doon din po natin kukunin yung ating magiging





plano at sa susunod po nating pag bubudget at pag propose po ng mga programa."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "May I ask about the section 4? This is all about the Strike teams? Bakit may Strike 1? Strike 2? 3? Ano ba itong mga strike teams na ito?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Opo, iyang strike teams ay, dahil alam naman po natin na mayroon po tayong district one and district two, maari po kasing sa strike team, kumbaga mayroon po tayong mga staff na imobilize, during the conduct of the caravan, yung team 1 and 2, mayroon po mag identify sa district one and mayroon din po sa district two, puwede rin po kasing para mas mabilis po yung pag abot po sa mga serbisyo, puwede po kasing both teams ay bababa sa mga barangay na nasasakupan, kumbaga sabay po, may kanya-kanya silang team para mas mabilis po yung pag abot po sa serbisyo and the strike support team naman, ito po yung halimbawa, nandito po yung ating social worker, and other medical professionals na maari pong makatulong kung ano po yung maidentify na needs pa sa community, so sila po yung puwede nating itap para po tumulong sa ating mga services."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Okay, nalito lang kami kasi iba-iba yung composition ng bawat strike team."

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Depende po, supposedly, hindi po pare-pareho yung services naibibigay."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Okay, anyway, naiintindahan na natin ngayon. May I ask the attention of the representative from social services department. Ano yung magiging role ninyo dito?"

GINA PORNELOS "Good morning, Mr. Chair at sa lahat po, sa amin po sa CSWD, as indicated po dito sa ating draft ordinance, will be the assessment, kung ano yung nakikita nating pangangailangan, kung anong social services na maibibigay natin sa ating mga clients, yun po naman sa part sa ating CSWD."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Talang part naman kayo lagi, City Health Office at saka CSWD. Anyway, from the members of city council present, do you have





any inquiry or manifestation? So, the chair could recognize you. Yes, honorable Bautista? You are recognized."

COUN. MIGUEL BAUTISTA "May tanong lang ako dito sa Strike support team, Strike team 1 and 2. Strike team 3, Strike support team, kasi dito, rehabilitative therapists, ito yung ating therapist dito? Pabababain pa rin ba natin kahit na busy?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Opo, actually hindi po, kumbaga ang ating physical therapist services, kakaunti lang po ang nakakaalam, and nakikita po namin sa mga barangay, marami pong nangangailangan talaga ng physical therapist services, although iisa lang po siya, sinasabi naman po sa ordinansa na hindi naman po daily na iprovide namin yung services pero kahit papaano po, yung maturuan po yung pamilya, kung paano po gagawin yung ehersisyo para po doon sa mga na stroke. So makukutulong po kasi yun, kung kasama po natin ang ating physical therapist."

COUN. MIGUEL BAUTISTA "Dapat pala magkaroon pa tayo ng isa pang therapist."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Not only one, the more, magiging effective, kaya lang because of budgetarian constraint, kaya nalilimit tayo sa ganito."

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Actually po, before naging issue na rin po kung maalala po ninyo konsi Mike, yung about po doon sa physical therapist, kasi yung item po talaga ng PT talaga, wala po sa local government, sa hospital lang po talaga siya, kaya kahit po gustuhin po natin na magdagdag or ipromote po ang ating physical therapist, may mga limitations po talaga doon sa batas."

COUN. MIGUEL BAUTISTA "Yun lang. Thank you."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Yes, honorable Randy Francisco."

COUN. RANDY FRANCISCO "Doctora, dito po sa section 7.1, wala naman pong problema, bababa kayo sa barangay pero dapat ipaalam po muna yun, okay naman po yun much better po, kasi refreshment yun for the team members, tingin ko kaya naman po iyon ng mga Kapitan, pero dito po kasi sa 7.4, nakita ko po, may chairs and table po na iprovide yung barangay, baka puwede po, sa motor pool nalang po siya, kasi po hindi naman lahat ng barangay mayroong





chairs and tables, para wala po tayong maging problema, sana maicordinate nalang po doon sa motor pool ang chairs and tables po."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Sa 7.4, yung barangay health workers assigned, siya yung magiging coordinator diba, so doon niya makikita, ang makakapag identify ng situation, kung may available ba yung barangay o wala, so, that is the time..."

COUN. RANDY FRANCISCO "Pero much better po kung ilagay nalang po sa motor pool po, kasi minsan po natatapat po sa barangay na kaunti yung tables at chairs kasi nasa hiran. Halimbawa, may patay, siyempre hindi naman po puwedeng hindi po namin pahiramin yun."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "So the proposal is..."

COUN. RANDY FRANCISCO "Much better po kung sa motor pool nalang po sana."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "So, ilagay na natin sa ordinansa ito, the participation ng ating GSO. Siguro sa committee meeting nalang natin gagawin yan. Anyway, the suggestion is noted. Before we proceed, we would like to acknowledge the present for the record, the honorable punong barangay of Molino 6, punong barangay, Ronald Javier. Any other manifestation or inquiry from the members of the city council present? Puwede ba akong mag suggest sa inyo? Parang napaka awkward ng ibig sabihin ng strike dito, Serbisyong Tapat at Rumeresponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon, parang pilipit yung rumeresponde, puwedeng responsable nalang ito? Do you accept that proposal? Para mas magandang pakinggan, Serbisyong Tapat at Responsible para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon. Mas mainam pa itong pakinggan, para mas appropriate. How about CSWD, what is your opinion about this?"

GINA PORNELOS "Good morning, Mr. Chair at sa lahat, I agree with you Mr. chair, kasi mas malalim yung word na responsable, at yung psg respond ay pumapasok naman na doon, about doon sa kalusugan, mas okay po yung term na yun. Para mas generic din po sa pandinig natin."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Ano ngang department po ulit kayo?"

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Okay sayo yun? Palitan natin yung letter R? How about from the members of the city council? Okay ba sainyo yun? Anyway, this proposal ordinance ay makakatulong ito sa taumbayan, kaya lang yung commitment ng dalawang opisina, ay kinakailangan hundred percent lalo na ang OCHS, kaya ba ng personnel ninyo? Kasi may nabanggit dito, may pharmacist, do we all have the... can you provide that?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Ayun nga po, we request po na once this ordinance is passed, kailangan po talaga yung needed na personnel ay mayroon po tayo."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "May pharmacist ba tayo?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Mayroon po tayong item na..."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Hindi pa hired? So yung nabanggit na mga position, ay available na yung position?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Opo."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Okay. Kung hindi, isasama natin dito sa ordinance yung positions, kasi obligado kapag inimplement, every word, every phrase kailangan natin iimplement. Hindi natin maimplement kung hindi available yung positions, that's why yun yung concern ko, if we already include for the creation of positions mentioned on this proposal ordinance. Anyway, sabi mo naman, okay na, mayroon na diyan?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Yes po, isa lang po konsi yung wala po sa department namin, is the dietician."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Dietician?"

DR. IVY MARIE YRASTORZA "Opo."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Edi ilagay na natin sa ordinance, sa provision yung creation ng dietician. Para makumpleto na itong ordinansa. Lagay na din natin dito, for the purpose of compliance of this ordinance."





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COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "So, there be no other matter to be asked, any opinion or suggestion, resource person? Yes, ma'am Gina?"

GINA PORNELOS "Mr. Chair, may I suggest? Kami po ni doktora Ivy, yung office po namin is nag-usap with regards po dito, napakaganda ng programa, at kung titingnan natin, talagang puwedeng-puwede siyang maincorporate doon sa nakaraan po nating napag-usapan about sa strike family day, so ito ay isa sa mga services, programs na ibababa natin, pag tayo ay nag-ikot po sa bawat barangay, thank you po."

COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "Very good manifestation. Any more manifestation? No more? May I ask for motion from the members, councilor Bautista? Can you do the honor to place the motion for the adjournment of this hearing?"

COUN. MIGUEL BAUTISTA "Thank you, Mr. Chair, since there is no other matter to be discussed in this hearing, I moved the hearing be adjourned."


COUN. REYNALDO PALABRICA "There's a motion for the adjournment of this hearing, any second to the motion? Hearing none, therefore, the hearing is adjourned."

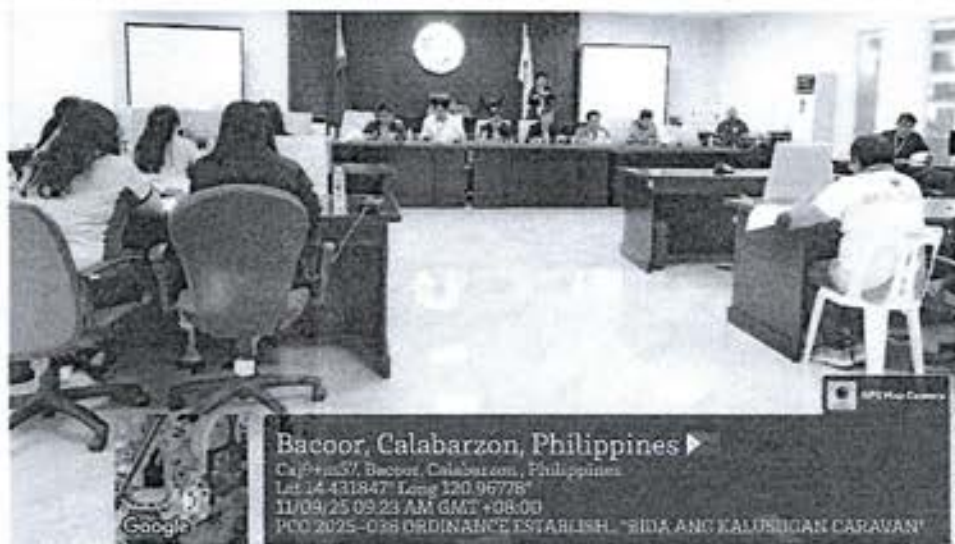

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BARANGAY PRIMARY CARE SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumeresponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN" INTENDED TO IMPROVE THE HEALTH AND WELLNESS OF BACOOREÑOS THROUGH GRASSROOTS PREVENTIVE MEDICINE.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare" as well ensure and support the promotion of health and safety.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution states that "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them".

WHEREAS, after an evaluation of the growing needs of the people of Bacoor, Mayor Strike Revilla in consultation with the Office of the City Health Services (OCHS) and its Head, Dr. Ivy Marie Yrastorza, conceptualized the approval of an ordinance establishing a barangay-based primary care program to be conducted and supervised by the OCHS in partnership with the Liga ng mga Barangay that aims to promote public health and wellness through the practice of preventive medicine.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Honorable Strike B. Revilla, endorsed Board Resolution No. ____ to the Sangguniang Panlungsod and requested the latter to pass an ordinance that will bring the recommendation of the Bacoor City Health Board to fruition.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite that:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumeresponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN Ordinance".

Section 2. Creation of the STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumeresponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN". A barangay based primary care program intended to promote public health and wellness in the City of Bacoor, Cavite to be conducted and supervised exclusively by the Office of the City Health Services (OCHS) in partnership with members of the Liga ng mga Barangay to be known as the "STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumeresponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon): BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN" (the "STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN" for brevity) is hereby created.

Section 3. Inclusion in the City Health Program and Annual Appropriation. The STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN shall become a permanent component of the City Health Program of the City of Bacoor, Cavite. Upon the recommendation of the Bacoor City Health

Board, sufficient funds for the said program shall be appropriated in the annual budget of the City Government by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

Section 4. The STRIKE Teams. The OCHS, through the City Health Officer, shall create at least three (3) STRIKE (Serbisyong Tapat at Rumeresponde para sa Inklusibong Kalusugan at Edukasyon) Teams and one (1) STRIKE Support Team comprised of the following:

Teams	Team Members
STRIKE Team 1 and 2	Two (2) physicians, two (2) nurses, and one (1) barangay health worker for each team.
STRIKE Team 3	One (1) dentist, one (1) physician, two (2) nurses, and one (1) barangay health worker.
STRIKE Support Team	One (1) social worker, one (1) rehabilitative therapist, one (1) registered dietitian, one (1) clinical pharmacist, one (1) psychologist or psychiatrist, one (1) medical technologist, one (1) registered midwife, and the City Health Officer.

The most senior doctor in each team in terms of actual healthcare experience shall be the Team Leader and shall take charge in resolving all issues that might confront the said teams. **Provided that:** both teams shall be under the direct control and supervision of the City Health Officer and shall provide the standard of care mandated under applicable regulations of the Department of Health (DOH) in the course of treating patients including policies in the proper disposal of hazardous wastes. **Provided further that:** The City Health Officer shall take charge of any STRIKE Team whenever it is needed. **Provided moreover that:** the STRIKE Support Team shall be led by the City Health Officer and shall provide support services to patients based on the recommendations of the STRIKE Teams such as rehabilitation services, mental health evaluation and treatment, pharmacological review and logistics services, nutritional support services, and social services intervention. **Provided lastly that:** the City Mayor is hereby authorized to engage the services of additional licensed health professionals even on job order basis and create more STRIKE Teams if needed subject to availability of funds and to pertinent civil service regulations.

Section 5. Frequency of Implementation. The STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN shall be conducted every week by selected OCHS personnel in pre-selected barangays of the City of Bacoor with the use of motor vehicles converted into mobile dental and medical clinics. The selected OCHS personnel to be assigned to the STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN CARAVAN shall visit each of the 47 barangays of the City of Bacoor at least thrice (3x) each year. The City Health Officer shall determine the visitation schedules of each team and shall have the power to join any STRIKE Team whenever his/her schedule permits it. **Provided that:** the OCHS and the Human Resources Development and Management Department shall use digital means to monitor and assess the attendance and work performance of STRIKE Team members. **Provided that:** the STRIKE Support Team shall maintain its own schedule and shall visit barangays based on the recommendations of the STRIKE Teams.

Section 6. The STRIKE Primary Care Principles. The following STRIKE Primary Care Principles shall guide all STRIKE Team members in performing their duties under this Ordinance:

6.1. Gamutang libre at mahusay. All treatments to be done by STRIKE Teams shall be free of charge and shall be conducted with strict adherence to the highest standard of medical care.

6.2. Pangangalaga na hatid sa bawat tahanan. The STRIKE Teams shall bring primary care services directly to the communities and homes of Bacooreños not only for the convenience of the latter but also to show how much the City Government values them.

1 **6.3. Pag-aaruga na pang-matagalan at maaasahan.** The STRIKE Teams shall
2 develop reliable, high-quality, long-term treatment regimens for all patients in need of prolonged
3 medical care.

4
5 **6.4. Gamutan na walang matagal na hintayan.** STRIKE Team members shall work
6 quickly, professionally, and efficiently and ensure that follow-up home visits shall take place as
7 scheduled.

8
9 **Section 7. Field Operations Guidelines.** The following minimum guidelines to be
10 observed by the STRIKE Teams during field operations:

11
12 **7.1. Field Clinic Preparations.** No STRIKE Team shall deploy unless it has: (a)
13 contacted the Punong Barangay having jurisdiction over the community/barangay to be visited,
14 (b) loaded all the medical and dental (if applicable) supplies and equipment needed in the mobile
15 clinics for the field operation, (c) brought electronic tablets loaded with the Electronic Medical
16 Records (EMR) of the PhilHealth members residing in the said locality, (d) identified the driver of
17 the motor medical and dental clinics to be provided by the barangay that will host the mobile
18 clinics, (e) ensure that the motor vehicles to be used are gassed up and in good running condition,
19 (f) all the medical and dental equipment needed for the field clinic are fully operational, and (g)
20 the barangay hosting the field clinic has prepared:

21
22 [i] meals and refreshments for the Team members,
23 [ii] tents to shelter the patients who are able to walk who will seek medical
24 consultation or treatment,
25 [iii] barangay tanods who will keep order and security during the field clinic, and
26 [iv] a safe parking space for the mobile clinics that is near or has access to a
27 working electrical power outlet.

28
29 **7.2. Patient Interviews.** All patients to be treated must be interviewed by team
30 members before they are given treatment. Their status as PhilHealth members shall be
31 determined as well. The data disclosed by the patients shall be uploaded in the Electronic Medical
32 Records and shall be considered confidential pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Republic Act
33 No. 10173 (the "Data Privacy Act of 2012") and its implementing rules and regulations. **Provided**
34 **that:** STRIKE Team members may ask the following questions to patients:

35
36 [a]. Medicines being taken by the patient, if any;
37 [b]. New and ongoing medical issues;
38 [c]. Mental health issues, if any;
39 [d]. Recent hospitalizations;
40 [e]. Diet, weight gain, or weight loss;
41 [f]. Physical capabilities
42 [g]. Family medical history

43
44
45 **7.3. Treatment Protocols.** During field medical or dental operations, STRIKE Team
46 members must observe treatment protocols that prioritize immediate life-saving interventions,
47 infection control, and efficient patient management under potentially austere conditions. Key
48 aspects of the treatment protocols shall include assessing the situation, providing initial care, and
49 ensuring safe evacuation in case of occurrence of emergencies. The Team Leader must ensure
50 that all services to be rendered by the Team are free of charge, that all patients are treated
51 courteously and respectfully, that the standard of care mandated under pertinent DOH guidelines
52 are strictly observed by all STRIKE Team members, and that only qualified and competent OCHS
53 personnel shall participate in the field operations.

54
55 **7.4. Mobile Clinic Operations.** Patients that will visit the mobile clinic shall be made
56 to line up while seating down on chairs provided by the host barangay and placed under a shaded
57 area. The barangay health worker assigned to each Team shall be authorized to: [a] distribute
58 and collect survey forms prepared by the E-Governance Department, the City Planning and
59 Development Coordination Office, the City Treasurer's Office, the City Assessor's Office, the
60 Sangguniang Panlungsod, and/or any other department of the City Government pursuant to the
61 implementation of various city ordinances and government regulations and their Implementing

Rules and Regulations, [b] distribute public information materials prepared by various departments of the City Government explaining the features of various City Government programs and projects, and/or [c] assist Team members in interviewing patients. The type of treatment given, the generic names/quantities of medicines prescribed, the medical advice given to all patients, and the approximate date of the next scheduled visit of the STRIKE Team shall be encoded in the Electronic Medical Record by the Team members concerned. Patients that require diagnostic or laboratory examinations shall be referred by the STRIKE Team members to the OCHS which shall in turn coordinate with healthcare facilities within the City of Bacoor that are accredited PhilHealth Konsulta Health providers for the schedule of the appointment of the said patients. As much as possible, the barangay health worker assigned to each STRIKE Team shall inform the patients concerned as to the schedule of their appointment at the accredited PhilHealth Konsulta healthcare facility mentioned above.

7.5. Home-based Primary Care. Patients who are too ill, too feeble, or who are unable to visit the mobile clinic for justifiable reasons such as — but not limited to — solo parents who cannot leave behind their minor children, women who are subject to physical abuse, or persons who are suffering from communicable diseases that prevent them from leaving their places of residence shall be subjected to home visits by STRIKE Team members. The barangay health worker assigned to the host barangay shall email the names, addresses, medical condition, and other relevant personal circumstances of the patient that justifies the home visitation to the OCHS at least three (3) days prior to the schedule of the field operations. The Team Leader shall choose who among the Team members shall conduct the home visitation. **Provided that:** at least one doctor and one nurse shall remain in the mobile clinic and the Team Leader shall request police assistance or assistance from the barangay in case the safety of Team Leaders or of the patient is in peril during the conduct of the home visitation. **Provided further that:** Team members who shall conduct home visits shall also interview and — if needed — treat the other residents of the said house and practice preventive medicine for the purpose of preventing disease, disability, and death. **Provided lastly that:** the various data gathered from all persons residing in the same house shall be encoded in the Electronic Medical Records of the OCHS.

7.6. Prescription Records and Home Delivery of Medicines. The Team members shall ensure that the prescription records of all patients are properly filled up in the Electronic Medical Record and that the correct medicines — when available — are dispensed. In case the medicines needed by the patient are unavailable at the time the field operations were conducted, the Team Leader shall report the situation to the City Health Officer who shall arrange that the said medicines are delivered to the house of the patient concerned by the officials of the host barangay subject to pertinent government regulations. **Provided that:** the OCHS shall develop a digital system — subject to pertinent government regulations — that will enable the said department to keep track of the quantity of medicine/s prescribed to, and received by, the patient and replenish them before they run out even without any prior request from the patient or from his/her relatives or caregivers for the delivery of fresh supplies of the said medicine/s.

7.7. Mandatory Follow-up Visits. The STRIKE Teams are hereby mandated to conduct follow-up visits to their patients, determine the efficacy of the treatment regimens prescribed to them, revise the said regimens if needed, and recommend any additional medical interventions to the City Health Officer such as, but not limited to, hospitalization or surgery or referral to diagnostic and laboratory examinations at PhilHealth accredited healthcare facilities within the City of Bacoor.

7.8. Inter-Department Access to EMR. After exercising particular care in protecting the identity, address, and other personal details of patients, the OCHS may allow other departments of the City Government to gain limited and strictly-regulated access to the Electronic Medical Records in order to enhance the quality of the services to be given to patients and their loved ones, exceed the quality of service expected by the public from the City Government, and use relevant data in the formulation of various policies for the promotion of the general welfare. **Provided that:** the sharing of the said records should be done in a manner that strictly adheres to the provisions of RA 10173 and its implementing rules and regulations.

7.9. Non-Replacement of Ongoing Treatment for Pre-Existing Conditions. STRIKE Team members must explain to the community and to the patients that none of the treatment regimens to be provided by virtue of this ordinance shall replace ongoing treatment

1 protocols for pre-existing health conditions and neither can STRIKE Team members replace the
2 personal physicians or health providers of the said patients.

3 **7.10. Focus on Preventive Care.** STRIKE Team members must focus on preventive
4 care by: [1] educating patients on how to take care of themselves and on topics such as the value
5 of weight goal setting, eating a balanced diet, the importance of vaccines, avoiding smoking and
6 taking too much alcohol, and the like, [2] ensuring health compliance and medications adherence,
7 [3] maintaining a healthy work-life balance, and [4] other preventive care strategies.

8
9 **7.11. Safety First.** The STRIKE Team members are hereby authorized to prioritize their
10 safety at all times. They shall be empowered to refrain from treating or to discontinue ongoing
11 treatment if they are being harassed, threatened, or abused by any patient or any person in the
12 host barangay.

13
14 **7.12. Express Consent.** The STRIKE Team members must obtain the written
15 consent of patients who will undergo home based primary care by requiring them to— or their
16 adult relatives or caregivers — sign a PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT to home based primary
17 care (the "PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT") which shall provide the following minimum
18 provisions:

19 [a]. The patient reviewed and understood his/her responsibilities and received the
20 STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN Handbook;

21 [b]. The patient agreed to partner with the STRIKE Team by providing complete and
22 accurate information about his/her health, notifying the OCHS about changes in his/her condition,
23 and by asking STRIKE Team members any question in case there is something he/she does not
24 understand;

25 [c]. The patient agreed to treat STRIKE Team members with courtesy and respect,
26 provide a safe and non-threatening environment for the STRIKE Team by: removing pets where
27 team members will be providing care, removing any weapons from the area where the preventive
28 care will take place, and by refraining from smoking, drinking alcohol, or using drugs while STRIKE
29 Team members are in their home;

30 [d]. The patient authorizes the OCHS and other departments of the City Government to
31 use various health related personal data for his health and welfare and for the welfare of his
32 relatives and caregivers; and

33
34 [e]. The patient agreed to be present during scheduled visits of the STRIKE Team and to return
35 OCHS staff phone calls in a timely manner.

36

ng loob, o nakakainsultong pananalita.
- 4) Pumapayag ako na ang mga data na may kaugnayan sa aking kalusugan ay maaaring gamitin ng OCHS at
ng iba pang departamento ng Pamahalaang Lungsod ng Bacoor para sa aking kapakanan at sa kapakanan
ng mga kamag-anak at mga kasama ko sa bahay.
- 5) Pinapangako ko rin na ako ay dadalo sa susunod na schedule ko ng gamutan at ipapabatid ko sa OCHS kung
ako ay hindi available sa susunod na schedule.

1 **Provided that:** the signed or thumb marked copy of the PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
2 shall form part of the Electronic Medical Record of the patients concerned.
3

4
5 **Section 8. Services Available.** The barangay based primary care system herein
6 created shall make the following services available:
7

- 8 8.1. Medical Care
- 9 8.2. Part-time Nursing Care
- 10 8.3. Social Services
- 11 8.4. Physical Therapy/Kinesiotherapy
- 12 8.5. Nutritional Therapy
- 13 8.6. Mental Health Consultation Service; and
- 14 8.7. Clinical Pharmacological Services
- 15

16 **Provided that:** the rendition of the said services shall depend on the availability of the
17 necessary personnel, supplies, and equipment and on the prevailing field conditions at the time
18 of the operations that might affect the ability of the STRIKE Team and the STRIKE Support Team
19 to provide the said services.
20

21 **Section 9. Services that are Not Available.** The following services shall not be
22 provided by the STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN program:
23

- 24 9.1. Full-time nursing care
- 25 9.2. Daily physical therapy at home
- 26 9.3. Personal comfort items (such as toiletry supplies)
- 27 9.4. General housekeeping/chore services
- 28 9.5. Meals
- 29 9.6. Daily personal care such as bathing or changing of adult diapers
- 30

31 **Section 10. Duties of STRIKE Team and STRIKE Support Team Members.** The
32 members of the STRIKE Team and the STRIKE Support Team shall have the following duties:
33

34 10.1. The **City Health Officer** shall have over-all control over all the STRIKE Teams and
35 the STRIKE Support Team/s. He/she shall have the power to approve/revise work schedules,
36 over rule Team Leaders if needed to improve the quality of patient care, discipline Team
37 members, and perform such other functions as may be directed by the City Mayor or as may be
38 needed to achieve the goals of the Ordinance.
39

40 10.2. The **Physicians** to be assigned to the STRIKE Teams shall assume the primary
41 medical management of the patient and resolve any issue during field operations. They shall also
42 lead lectures on HIV-AIDS prevention and curtailing the spread of infectious diseases,
43 hypertension, diabetes and other lifestyle modifiable diseases. **Provided that:** The City Health
44 Officer may overrule decisions of the physicians if needed.
45

46 10.3. The **Nurses** to be assigned to the STRIKE Teams shall be the case manager and
47 shall provide medication management, provide health education, and assess/re-assess the health
48 needs of patients and of their caregivers.
49

50 10.4. The **Dentist** to be assigned to the STRIKE Teams shall provide limited dental
51 treatment to patients that can be performed at the mobile clinic, educate patients on proper oral
52 care, prescribe medicines to improve dental care, and perform such other tasks as may be
53 allowed by law or by city ordinances.
54

55 10.5. The **Barangay Health Worker** to be assigned to the STRIKE Teams shall
56 distribute and collect survey forms prepared by various departments of the City Government,
57 distribute public information materials prepared by various departments of the City Government
58 explaining the features of various City Government programs and projects, assist Team members
59 in interviewing patients, and coordinate with officials of the host barangay on various concerns of
60 the OCHS, the STRIKE Teams and the STRIKE Support Teams.

1 10.6. The **Social Worker** to be assigned to the STRIKE Support Team/s shall determine
2 if a patient or his/her caregivers/relatives are in need of the various social services being offered
3 by the City Government and shall be primarily responsible in assisting the said persons in
4 receiving or benefiting from the said services.

5
6 10.7. The **Rehabilitative Therapist** to be assigned to the STRIKE Support Team/s shall
7 assess the functional abilities of patients, suggest improvements in the home environment in order
8 to prevent accidents and prevent falls, and provide adaptive devices and education as needed.

9
10 10.8. The **Clinical Pharmacist** to be assigned to the STRIKE Support Team shall review
11 medications on a regular basis and recommend changes thereto to the medical provider of the
12 patient. He/she will also make available the medicines to be delivered to the patient's home and
13 coordinate with officials of the barangay where the patient/s reside in the schedule of medicines
14 delivery.

15
16 10.9. The **Registered Dietitian** to be assigned to the STRIKE Support Team shall
17 assess the nutritional status of the patient, recommend dietary modifications and interventions,
18 and provide nutritional education if needed.

19
20 10.10. The **Mental Health Practitioner (Psychologist/Psychiatrist)** to be assigned to
21 the STRIKE Support Team shall assess provide mental health counseling, if needed, to the
22 patient and to his/her relatives or caregivers.

23
24 10.11 The **Medical Technologist** to be assigned to the STRIKE Support Team shall
25 provide mobile laboratory services such as the collection of blood and urine samples and the
26 conduct of various laboratory examinations.

27
28 10.12. The **Registered Midwife** to be assigned to the STRIKE Support Team shall assist
29 STRIKE Team Members in educating the public on family planning, proper maternal and child
30 care, and other matters authorized by the City Health Officer.

31
32 **Section 11. Duties of Barangay Officials and Personnel.** All barangay officials and
33 personnel of the Barangay that will host a STRIKE Team or STRIKE Support Team shall be duty-
34 bound to provide all the necessary support mentioned in the this Ordinance, maintain security
35 and cleanliness in the field operation site before, during, and after the said operations, provide
36 security support to team members and allow the members of the said teams to perform their jobs
37 without any untoward interference from anyone. The failure to fulfill the said duties and to assist
38 in the implementation of this Ordinance and its IRR shall be deemed a violation of this Ordinance.

39
40 **Section 12. Support or Assistance from Private Practitioners.** The OCHS is
41 authorized to receive support or assistance from private healthcare practitioners based locally or
42 abroad who might wish to assist or join the STRIKE Teams and/or the STRIKE Support Team/s
43 subject to compliance with pertinent DOH regulations and city ordinances with regard regulating
44 medical/dental missions and donations of medicines and medical supplies to members of the
45 public.

46
47 **Section 13. The Bacoor Digital Clinical Management System.** The OCHS, in
48 partnership with the E-Governance Department or with private contractors shall, subject to
49 pertinent laws and government regulations, develop a software to be known as the Bacoor Digital
50 Clinical Management System (BDCMS). The BDCMS shall contain features that will enable
51 OCHS personnel to effectively implement every aspect of the STRIKE: BIDA ANG KALUSUGAN
52 CARAVAN and the various provisions of this Ordinance and of its implementing rules and
53 regulations as well as perform their various duties and functions pursuant to pertinent civil service
54 regulations. The cost of the said software may be taken from the maintenance and other operating
55 expenses budget of the OCHS if it does not exceed P100,000.00 subject to pertinent government
56 regulations.

58 **Section 14. Implementing Rules and Regulations.** The OCHS, with the assistance
59 of the Office of the City Legal Services, shall submit the implementing rules and regulations of
60 this Ordinance for the review and approval of the City Mayor not later than sixty (60) days from
61 the date of effectivity hereof.
