Subject: **AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE "REVISED ENVIRONMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOOR", IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF, AND ESTABLISHING VARIOUS PROGRAMS, PLANS AND PROJECTS THAT PROMOTES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION. (PCO 2023-143 dated November 29, 2023)**

BACKGROUND:

The proposed ordinance was first submitted for the consideration of the Sangguniang Panlungsod on 29 November 2023. It was authored by Atty. Kyle Angelo Walsh M. Atega and by Atty. Khalid A. Atega Jr., the Sangguniang Panlungsod Secretary. It was referred to this Committee on the same date. After conducting two hearings, the Committee then headed by the Hon. Levy Tela recommended the archiving of the proposed ordinance on 22 January 2024 upon the request of the then City Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) which is now known as the City Environment Services Department (CESD) to give it more time to review the proposed legislation.

On 17 February 2025, the proposed ordinance was reinstituted in the Order of Business upon the request of the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla.

The Committee held a committee hearing on 06 March 2025 and two public hearings that were held on 03 April 2025 and 25 April 2025, respectively. The said public hearings were attended by various stakeholders.

Invitations to the said stakeholders were sent via email and notices on the schedule of the said public hearings were published on the Facebook page and website of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The said Notice of Hearing was also published on the April 21-27, 2025 issue of the Souther Sparkle News and were posted at the following places: the Zapote Public Market, the Bacoor Government Center, and the Padre Mariano Gomez Plaza near the Hall of Justice starting on 22 April 2025.

Copies of the proposed ordinance was sent to the said stakeholders via email before the 25 April 2025 hearing. Beginning on 21 April 2025, a PDF copy of the proposed ordinance was also posted on the official website of the Sangguniang Panlungsod (www.bacoorcitysp.com) and a link was provided to facilitate access to, and downloading of, the proposed legislation.

The said hearings were presided over by the Chairperson of the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, Hon. Levy M. Tela. The attendance sheets during the said hearings are attached hereto and shall be made integral parts of this Report.





FINDINGS:

The proposed ordinance aims to "provide a comprehensive set of policies, regulations, and mechanisms aimed at promoting sustainable development and environmental preservation while ensuring the well-being of present and future generations of Bacoor residents" and contain numerous provisions that cannot be found in the Bacoor Environment Code (Municipal Ordinance No. 4H, Series of 2008).

After reviewing the proposed ordinance, the Committee noticed that the draft ordinance does not have a preamble and that it contains a table of content. The members of the Committee unanimously agreed that the table of contents should be deleted and that preambulatory clauses be inserted in the draft ordinance that will succinctly explain the legal bases for the approval of the ordinance and the reasons why the Bacoor Environment Code should be revised.

The Committee also noted that the proposed ordinance contained provisions that are not only unique but may also pave the way to the environmentally sustainable development of the City of Bacoor – if implemented properly – such as: (1) the creation of the Bacoor Environment Fund which will finance the various programs and projects of the CESD which includes the implementation of the proposed Revised Environment Code (the "proposed Code"), (2) the creation of "green jobs" pursuant to the Philippine Green Jobs Act of 2016 (Republic Act No. 10771), (3) the flotation of bonds to be known as "Green Bonds" by the City Government to raise revenues that can be deposited in the Bacoor Environment Fund, (4) the establishment of the Smart Bacoor Renewability Research Center (SBRRC) which is intended to "serve as a hub for research and development (R&D) focused on green technologies, renewable energy, and sustainable practices that contribute to environmental protection and economic development within the city" and to "foster innovation, disseminate knowledge, and encourage collaboration between public and private sectors to achieve a sustainable future for the City of Bacoor", and lastly (5) the creation and holding of the Sustainable Bacoor Roundtable Summit (the "SBR Summit") for the purpose of creating a "platform for dialogue, sharing of best practices, and collaborative planning among local, national, and international experts in the fields of environmental sustainability, green energy, and circular economy".

Though the proposed ordinance is brimming with exciting possibilities, the Committee believes that some of its provisions require amendments. The provisions of the proposed ordinance that the Committee proposes to be amended are as follows:

Penalty Provisions	The Committee recommends that the various penalty clauses in the proposed ordinance be revised so that it will clearly state who should be held accountable in case a provision is violated.
Payment of Fees	The Committee recommends that all provisions of the proposed ordinance pertaining to the payment of fees to the City Treasurer's Office (a.k.a. the City Finance Department) where the phrase "official receipts" was used should be changed to "sales invoices" in view of changes to Philippine tax laws now being implemented by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and by the Department of Finance (DOF).
Correction of Typographical Errors	The Committee noted several typographical errors appear on the draft ordinance. The Committee recommends that the SP Secretariat be directed to correct the said errors before the proposed ordinance is included in the next Order of Business.
ARTICLE III, Section 7 (A)	The Committee recommends that Article III, Section 7 (A) of the proposed Code should be revised and should read as: A) Initial Assessment: Upon receipt of a ECC/CNC application, the OBO (for activities related to the construction of structures) and the BPLO (for commercial activities not related to the construction of structures) shall conduct a preliminary review to determine the completeness and accuracy of the submitted documents. If discrepancies or missing documents are identified in the application, the applicant will be notified within three (3) working days about the said defects in the application and shall be given five (5) working days to rectify the said issues. The failure of an applicant to rectify the said issues within the 5-day period mentioned shall result in the disapproval of the application. However, the applicant shall not be precluded from re-filing the said application. The said revision is intended to make the proposed ordinance compliant with the IRR of RA 11032 (the "Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018").

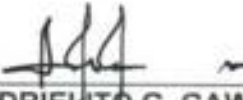

4. Introduction: Hon. Levy Tela explained the Environment Code is being reviewed and amended to better suit the present times, in light of ongoing challenges such as climate change, pollution, and the depletion of natural resources. Our goal is to make environmental policies clearer, more effective, and more inclusive—and this is where your participation is very important.

Today's discussion is an opportunity for everyone—whether a government official, sector representative, or concerned citizen—to hear and engage with the revised Environment Code. Through this open consultation, we want to ensure that our actions are not just top-down decisions, but the result of collective dialogue, grounded in local experiences and needs.

5. Proposed amendments: The resource persons from CESD Ms. Theresa Calo and Mr. Rolando Vocalan discussed the proposed environment code.

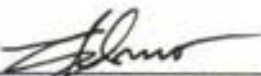

Hon. Tela: Before we conduct our public hearing, may call the attention of my staff, Neneth Sombrano, for invocation. Pwede pong tumayo po tayong lahat. At magandang tanghali po sa inyong lahat.

Ms. Neneth: Nais ko lang pong ipapatid sa inyo ang rules ng ating public hearing pong ito. Paki off po ang inyong mga cellphone. Iwasan po natin ang mag ingay dahil naka record at naka video po ang public hearing na ito. Magtaas po lamang ng kamay sa mga gustong magtanong. Itanong lang po ang may kinalaman sa pag uusapan Magpaalam po sa Committee Chairman kung lalabas ng session hall. Thank you po. Tayo po ay manalangin. Aming mapagmahal na Diyos, kami po ay nagpapakumbaba sa inyong harapan sa araw ito. Salamat po sa panibagong pagkakataon upang muli magtipon at magtalakayan para sa ikalawang public hearing na aming Environmenta Code. Gabayan nyo po kami sa bawat salita, mungkahi, at desisyong aming bibigkasin. Hinihiling po naming ang iyong karunungan upang malinaw naming makita ang pangmatagalang epekto ng aming mga hakbang sa kalikasan, at nawa'y ang bawat plano ay maging makatarungan, makatao, at maka- kalikasan. So, sa section 1 to 11, kung ano po ang existing na narakalagay sa dating ordinansa, yan din po ang sinundan po natin. Binago lamang po natin yung name ng CENRO to CESD. Yan lamang po. Kasama rin po natin dito yung City Health Office. Kasi water quality and pollution control po siya. So basically, yung plan po natin for water quality management area base. Meron po tayong tinatawag na ilang-ilang, Imus Ilang-Ilang River. So may mga plano, may plano po tayo diyan, tapos yung Manila Bay Rehabilitation. So, ito pong article na ito, sapol na sapol po dyan. Yan yung mga plan na ginagawa po natin. Nakalagay din po dito yung paglalagay ng mga waste water treatment facilities sa bawat mga commercial establishment and industrial po. May nabanggit din po dito na dapat yung mga subdivision, mga institution, magkaroon po ng tinatawag na rainwater harvesting. So sa Article 6, air pollution and noise pollution. So, including carbo sequestration. So yung Article 6, na Section 1 to 11 po siya. Sinamari lang po natin siya. Ito po ang nakalagay diyan. Ito pong Article 6, ito naman po yung pangangalaga sa ating kahangin at ang pagtakaroon ng noise pollution free environment. Nabanggit din po dito yung carbon sequestration. Ito po yung proseso ng pagkuha ng atmospheric carbon dioxide para po ma-reduce yung greenhouse gases natin in the atmosphere at ma-mitigate yung climate change. At hindi siya makakapag-contribute sa global warming. So meron din po tayong nakalagay na vehicle emission control. And eventually, dahil po dito sa article na ito, magkakaroon tayo ng transition of green transportation. Magkakaroon po tayo ng research dito kung kinakailangan. Magkakaroon tayo. Magkakaroon tayo ng mga partnerships, cities, globally with best practices. Like yung pwede tayo mag-partner dun sa better air quality and so on and so forth. Let's proceed to Article 7, biodiversity and conservation including the protection and conservation of mangroves, forests, and marine life. Mabilis po ba ako? Hanggang Article 13 po siya. Okay lang? So, Article 7 tayo. Ang nilalaman ng Article 7, ayon po ay Section 1 hanggang 6, no? So, dito naman po sa article na ito, kung ano yung existing na nakalagay sa previous ordinance natin, yun din po yung sinundan po natin. Dito po sa Bacoor, mayroon po tayong 40-hectare na mangroves at kinukonsider po itong wetland area. So, bukod dito, may Bacoor Water Territorial Zone po tayo. Sa zoning, sa zoning plan po natin, dapat ma-identify ng zoning office natin kung saan yung maaaring mangisda, sanctuaries, critical breeding, at feeding areas, among others. Ayon po yung nakalagay doon sa Article 7, Article 8, energy efficiency in building and green infrastructure. Ayon po. Ayon po ay Section 1 hanggang 21. So, ito po yung sinamari ko na lang po siya. Dito po sa article na ito, kung ano po yung existing na nakalagay sa ordinansa, yun din po yung sinundan po natin. So, the purpose of this article is to ensure that all infrastructure projects undertaken by the City Government of Bacoor are developed and executed with a focus on smart urbanization. Development, energy efficiency, and integration of green infrastructure. This commitment aligns with the City Broader objectives to mitigate the environmental





impact, reduce carbon emission, and contribute to sustainable development. So, sample po dyan dito sa ating City Hall, diba? Lahat ng mga ginagamit natin dito, may solar tayo, yung ating mga LED, and everything. Yung mga materials na ginagamit natin sa construction. Okay? Yung mga inverter lahat, yung ating mga aircon. So, yan po yung napapaloob sa article 8. So, let's move on sa article 9, Green Jobs Creation. Malapit na tayo matapos. So, article 9, Section 1 to 11 po ito. Ilong article na ito, it aims to integrate the principles of sustainable development into the local labor market. By promoting the creation of green jobs through this initiative. The city seeks to achieve a harmonious balance between economic advancement, environmental protection, and societal well-being. So, ito po yung sa Green Jobs. Sa mga kasama po natin dito, yung PESO, LEDIPO, na tinatawag po natin. Okay? Tapos, yun po. Livelihood. Meron din po tayong livelihood. So, sila po yung mga makakasama natin. This program will oversee the identification, development, and support of green jobs initiatives, ensuring alignment with the city's environmental and economic goals. The program will also serve as the central hub for information, dissemination, training, and capacity building related to green employment. Article 10, Bacoor Environment Fund. So, dito po, yung section 1 niya, nakalagay dito, City of Bacoor or hereby establishes the Bacoor or Environment Fund. So, this fund is a special trust account that is solely dedicated to supporting and promoting sustainable development, environmental conservation, and green initiative of the CESD within the city. So, mamaya po, i-elaborate po natin yan. So, Article 11 is Smart Bacoor Renewability Research Center. Parang eto na yung center lahat ng mga research po natin. So, dito, the City of Bacoor or hereby establishes the Smart Bacoor Renewable Research Center, SBRRC. Yun. The purpose ng research center na ito is to serve as a hub for research and development, focus on green technologies, renewable energy, and sustainable practices, that contribute to environmental protection and economic development within the city. So, ito po, ang aim po nito is to foster innovation, dissemination, knowledge, and courage, collaboration between public and private sector to achieve a sustainable future of the City of Bacoor and then, may mga definition of terms na po siya. And then, sa section 4, pwede rin po tayong makipag-partner with industry. Stakeholders, no po? Sa Article 12, Sustainable BACO or Roundtable Summit. Dito na po papasok yung summit na tinatawag natin na pangungunahan ng LEDIPO at PESO. Dito papasok yung mga green businesses, green technologies, direct foreign investment into the city, involving business of employing green technologies, waste management, water conservation, renewable energy. So, summit po ito. Summit, no? Pangunahan po ng mga tanggapan na nabanggit po natin. So, meron din po tayong mga international collaboration with regards to this SBR. Summit aims to establish Bacoor as a hub for sustainable practices and welcomes the participation of international experts. So, yun po lahat yung sinasabi po ng Article 12. And then, last, sa Article 13, final provision, of course, exception of minors or mentally

Hon. Tela: Thank you. Sa inyo po, baka meron kayo ipag tanong para maliwanagan po natin at maintindihan po regarding sa Environment Code sa mga ating mga resource person present. Kung wala, may tatanong din pa uli ako. Base po sa proposed ordinance, ano ang mangyayari kung di kaya ng isang offender na bayaran ang penalty na katapat na ginawa niyang violation?

Mr. Vocalan: Mr. Chair, Your Honor, kung ang isang tao po ay walang kakaya ang magbayad, ito ay binibigyan natin ng community service compensated kung magkano po yung kanyang na-violate na provision po sa mabas na ginagawa natin po. Mr. Chair, Your Honor.

Mr. Vocalan: Mr. Chair, ito ba po ang gusto nyo is amendment sa batas or additional po?





Zoning Rep.: Additional lang Sir. Yung sa part na subdivision developers and homeowners' association. So, siguro po maganda po is include lahat ng development within the city government of Bacoor.

Mr. Vocalan: Mr. Chair, Your Honorable, tingin ko naman po amenable tayo dyan. We don't limit the protection of the environment from the previous na mga sinabi. Dapat kasama po as holistic. Thank you, Mr. Chair, Your Honour.

Hon. Tela: Sa legal department. Ano po masasabi mo?

Atty. Marius: Good afternoon po, I bring up ko lang po ulit yung mga na-raise ko naman na before nung last na public hearing. Kahit yung isa lang po, yung tungkol po dun sa provision ng IRR. Sa final provisions lang naman po. Kasi medyo technical po yung iba eh. Yung ibang provisions itong ordinance. So, we leave that to the expertise of the primary agency concerned which is CESD po. Pero patungkol po dun sa final provisions, baka pwede lang po maidagdag po natin yung provision na magbabalangkas ng implementing rules and regulations ang CESD with the assistance of the city legal office. Para lang po, express po yung provision. Kasi otherwise po, kung walang ganon, hindi na po gagawa ng IRR to. Ito na po talaga yan. Yun, minor suggestion lang naman po, Your Honour.

Mr. Vocalan: Mr. Chair, approve po. Okay po yun sa amin. We need the really the guidance, not only our environmental knowledge but also, they have to assist us on also on the laws na for this ordinance, Mr. Chair, Your Honour.

Atty. Marius: Maidagdag ko lang po, Mr. Chair, kanina tama po yung sinabi ni Sir Rolly, no, yun dun sa community service. Tatal, nilagay na rin po nila po dito sa final provisions, yung exemption of minors. Nasite na po dito yung, ah, City Ordinance 228, yung Uniform Implementation Procedure. Nandun din po kasi yung provision ng community service. Baka pwedeng maisama na rin po na, ah, na mag-a-apply dito yung provisions ng Uniform Implementation Procedure. Para po, ah, in case na merong gustong mag-avail nung no contest provision. Ibig sabihin, pag nahuli ka, tapos ayaw nga, mali naman ako doon, sige, babayaran ko na lang yung penalty. Ma-avail niya po yun, hindi through the Environment Code, kundi sa City Ordinance 228, which is the Uniform Implementation Procedure. Yun lang po, minor suggestion lang po, Your Honor.

Mr. Vocalan: Mr. Chair, noted po. Your Honor.

Zoning Rep: Hello po ulit, Sir Chair. Last na po to. Ah, first of all po, we would like to comment po yung CESD for this very, ah, well, ano po, ah, crafted na Environment Ordinance together with our Sanggunian. And, ah,





maganda rin po kasi since ia-update po yung ating CLUP next year, meron kasing mga hindi naisama na zone like yung no-take zones doon sa CLUP. Currently that we have. So, maganda siya na-include po next year for the updating ng ating CLUP. So, we will be asking for the guidance po ng CESD for the other zones that are not included in the current CLUP. Thank you po.

Mr. Vocalan: Good po yan, ah, Mr. Chair, Your Honor. Ah, lahat naman po ng suggestion at, ah, panukala na mas kakaganda. Kasi po, this is a one-time, one-time environmental code. Nakasalang na po ito lahat. Ah, gusto natin pag lumabas ito, all sectors are included and nagkaroon po sila ng suggestion. Mr. Chair, Your Honor.

Hon. Tela: Thank you. Si ma'am.

HOA Shapell: ko si Angie po ng Shapell, last time po kasi, there was a meeting doon sa yung proposal that there will be smaller tasks kung may crush inside the subdivisions. I don't know kung ano naman po yung magiging status.

Hon. Tela: Sa ibang ordinance, pero sasagot din po ni Boss Rolly.

Mr. Vocalan: Ma'am, Mr. Chair, Your Honor. Ma'am, guest. Papunta po ang city doon. Kaya lang po, we're crafting an ordinance. Hon Palabrica: Mr. Chair, with the kind of indulgence of Mr. Vocalan. Ma'am, pwedeng hindi na muna natin sasagutin yung question nyo kasi separate ordinance po yun. We are on the process of of that particular ordinance. Ibang ordinance po itong pinag-uusapan natin ngayon. Thank you, ma'am. Mr. Chair.

Hon. Tela: Environmental code yung ating ordinance. Yun po eh, yung sinasabi ni ma'am, may ordinance po natin. Yan na may gagawin po tayong ordinance regarding po sa nabanggit ni ma'am. Yung iba po, baka ibig pong magtanong para maklaro po natin itong ating environment code na para naiintindihan po natin lahat.

Ekplika ni Ms. Tere sa CEC. Ano po ba yan? Di ba yun? City Environment Certificate? Is it correct?

Ms. Calo: Compliance

Hon. Gawaran: Okay. Okay. Compliance. Ibig nyo sabihin po, pag nag-convert tayo, kasi pag ECC, it's composed from farm to market road to agricultural, to residential, tapos commercial, saka industrial. Di ba dumadami po yan? Without permission yun, hindi tayo bibigyan ng permit. Kaya ngayon, nagkaroon din tayo ng problema dahil sa ganyan. Hindi dumaan din misan sa ECC. Binaliwala eh. Ngayon po, yung sa CEC, ano ngayon po, sa CEC, hindi kaya natin ma-bypass ang ECC. Dito nagagawin natin CEC. Na alam ko naman, makakabutihan din, makakabuti sa ating city government. 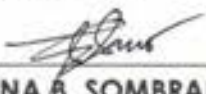

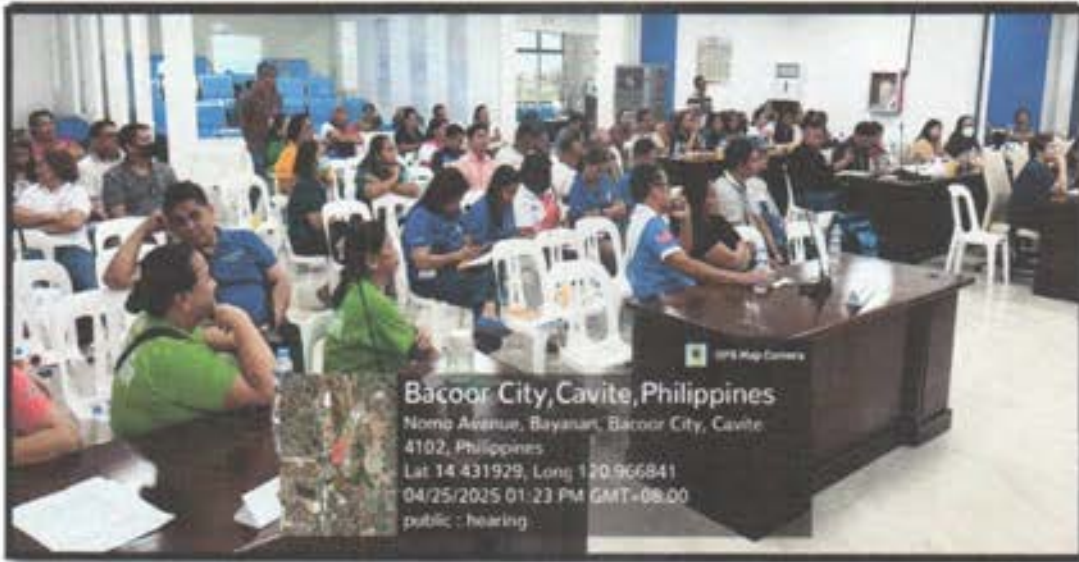

So, ang kagandahan po nito, yung ating policies at mga patakaran na dati po hiwa-hiwalay, ngayon po ay pinagsama-sama po natin sa iisang ordinansa para hindi na po tayo mahirapan doon. Paano kung hindi kaya ng barangay dito sa penalties na sinasabi nyo na mayroong maliit ang nilalaman ng budget doon sa environment ng bawat barangay. Kasi alam po naman natin na yung environment ay walang sapat na budget para gawin ang mga nais ng isang kagawad ng committee ng environment na pwede naming I improve na sindi sapat yung budget or

Hon. Palabrica:

Mr. Chair, may I have the floor to answer the inquiry? Kagawad, Macky. First and foremost, gusto lang natin malaman to everybody that the city government ay may budget layo rito. Sa basura pa lang ang budget natin dito ay 400 million. Bukod pa yung operations ng CSD, we are spending more than half a billion of pesos for our environmental care sa city. Ngayon, ang concern ninyo sa barangay ninyo, kung paano makakabahagi ang barangay, ang bawat barangay doon sa penalty ng ating city ordinance. Kung maalala ninyo, we passed already an ordinance or if my recollection is correct, a resolution na lahat kayo ng barangay, even homeowners association was authorized, was empowered by the city government, by the mayor para i-implement ang city ordinance, including the environmental ordinance for the environmental code. We are talking about right now. Yung penalties ay kung sino yung nag-i-implement, kung sino mang barangay man o homeowners association ay may share doon sa penalty. So yung share na yun ay i-remit sa inyong account, barangay man o homeowners association man yan, sa account ng homeowners, official account, doon mapupunta yung share ninyo dahil sa pag-i-implement ninyo ng city ordinance. Iyan ay isang batas ng ating pamahalaang lungsod. 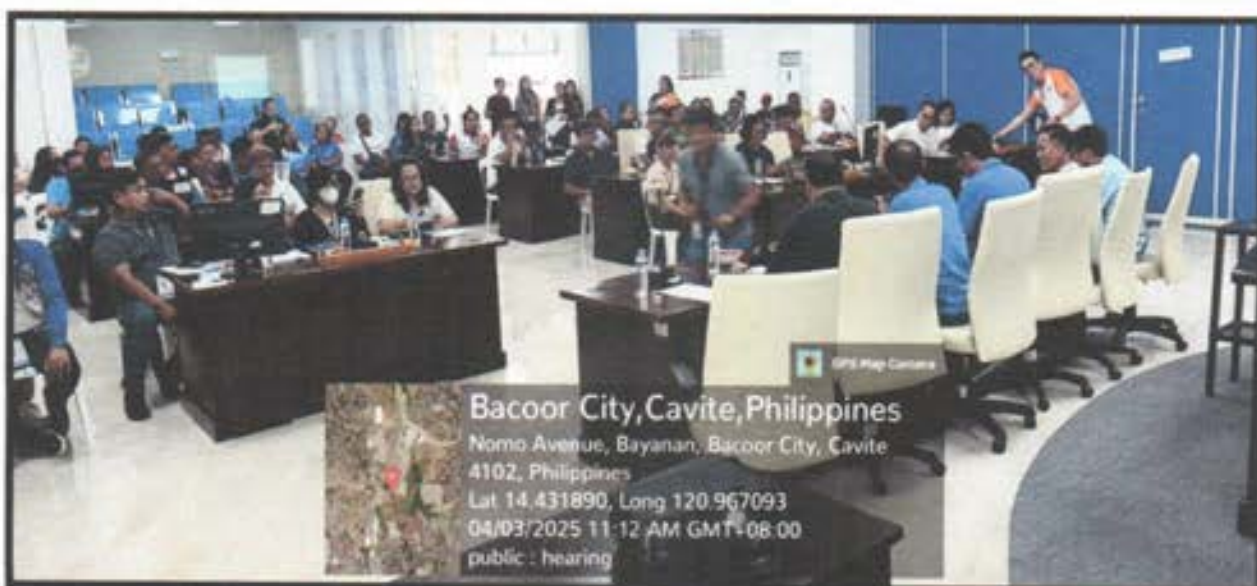

Tela: An ordinance approving the "revised environment code of the city of Bacoor," imposing penalties for violations hereof, and establishing various programs, plans, and projects that promote environmental protection is now court to order. 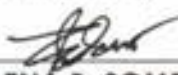

Hon. Tela: Noted..Noted due to your good reason to submit some of the papers of comprehensive environmental code. And promise to submit in the 4th quarter of 2025.

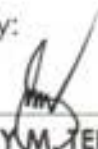
