The hearing was held on Tuesday, March 26, 2025, at 11:00 a.m at MSBR Conference Room. It was lead by Committee on Social Services and presided over by Committee Chairman Hon. Adrielito G. Gawaran. Present during the hearing were Committee Vice Chairman, Hon. Simplicio G. Dominguez, Hon. Levy Tela member of Committee on Rules and Privileges, Laws and Ordinances, and Hon. Rogelio Nolasco were present.

The lead Committee Chairman Hon. Adrielito G. Gawaran explained the purpose of the hearing and requested Atty. Salve Valenciano from the City Legal Office to enlighten the body on the proposed ordinance who explained that the goal of this ordinance is to ensure that the beneficiaries are actual 4Ps members while also improving monitoring efficiency. Additionally, Mayor Strike B. Revilla, wants more sophisticated monitoring.

Republic Act No. 11310 (the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Act") was enacted to protect and enhance the right to human dignity, reduce social, economic, and political inequalities, and remove inequities by diffusing wealth and political power for the common good.

There are thousands of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries in the City of Bacoor, which would benefit, if qualified, from other government programs and projects.






The City Government of Bacoor envisions maximizing the use of available information and communication technology to harmonize the presentation of personal details and circumstances of 4Ps beneficiaries to the different programs and projects of the City Government.

Having been enlightened on all the queries raised during the conduct of committee hearing, Hon. Adrielito Gawaran moved that this proposed ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LOCAL PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM BENEFICIARIES DATABASE AND THE ENROLLMENT OF PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM BENEFICIARIES (4Ps) IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND THE ISSUANCE OF A LOCAL PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM BENEFICIARIES." be recommended for approval on their next regular session of the 5th Sanggunian, pending the improvements, modifications and revisions on the concerns raised by the resource persons present. 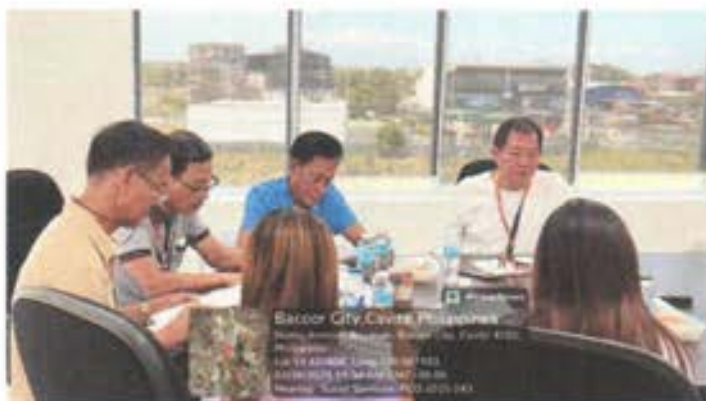

Dear Hon. Bautista-Mendiola,

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11310, otherwise known as the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Act, the City Government of Bacoor aims to implement policies that will enhance the delivery of social services to its constituents. Rule XVIII, Section 49 (b) (4) of its Implementing Rules and Regulations encourages Local Government Units to incorporate pro-poor programs, particularly in health, nutrition, and education, into their plans and budgets to ensure public safety and effective service delivery.

In line with this, the City Government of Bacoor proposes the establishment of a Local Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries Database and the issuance of a Local Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries Identification Card. This initiative seeks to harmonize the collection, storage, and use of data for the efficient identification and enrollment of beneficiaries in various government programs.

The proposed ordinance, entitled the "**Bacoor City 4Ps Database and Identification Ordinance**," aims to:

1. Establish the Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Database, which will securely store relevant personal and sensitive information of all qualified 4Ps beneficiaries identified by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD);
2. Mandate the issuance of a Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Identification Card to facilitate access to local government assistance programs;
3. Ensure the accuracy, security, and efficient utilization of the collected data for the benefit of the 4Ps beneficiaries;
4. Require all qualified 4Ps beneficiaries to enroll in the Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Database for proper identification and inclusion in local government programs and services.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11310 or the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Act declared a policy to protect and enhance the right of all the people to human dignity, reduce social, economic, and political inequalities, and remove inequities by diffusing wealth and political power for the common good;

WHEREAS, Rule XVIII, Section 49 (b) (4) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 11310, provides that Local Government Units are encouraged to incorporate pro-poor programs, particularly on the health, nutrition, and education in their plans and budget, in order to promote peace and order, ensure public safety and further strengthen local government capability aimed towards effective delivery of basic services to the citizenry;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10160 or the Charter of the City of Bacoor provides under Section 11 that the Sangguniang Panlungsod has the power to enact ordinances, approve resolutions, and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the City and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, there are thousands of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries in the City of Bacoor, which would benefit, if qualified, from other government programs and projects;

WHEREAS, it the City Government of Bacoor envisions maximizing the use of available information and communication technology to harmonize the presentation of personal details and circumstances of the beneficiaries to the different programs and projects of the City Government.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod in regular session, duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Bacoor City 4Ps Database and Identification Ordinance".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It shall be the policy of the City of Bacoor to provide for the holistic development of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Beneficiaries by ensuring accurate and efficient data processing, storage, and use, and security of personal and sensitive personal information to other programs and projects of the City Government.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms used in this Ordinance shall be defined as follows:

a. **Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Database** – a database containing all relevant personal and sensitive personal information of all qualified, identified, and enrolled Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries by the Department of Social Welfare and Development, or those who shall subsequently be issued a Bacoor City 4Ps Identification Card after enrollment to the same;

b. **Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Identification Card** – a document issued by the City Government of Bacoor to all qualified, identified, and enrolled Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries by the Department of Social Welfare and Development;

c. **Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) Beneficiary** – refers to the qualified household beneficiary previously identified by the Department of Social Welfare and Development for entitlement to monthly conditional cash grants as provided for under Republic Act No. 11310 and who has been issued a 4Ps Beneficiary ID by the Department of Social Welfare and Development;

SECTION 4. BACoor CITY 4PS BENEFICIARY DATA BASE. The Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Data Base is hereby established. The Bacoor City 4Ps Beneficiary Data Base shall contain the following information gathered from the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries:

1. Full Name;
2. Household ID Number;
3. 4Ps Beneficiary ID Control Number;
4. Set Group;
5. Residential Address;
6. Sex;
7. Birthdate;
8. Names of Children;
9. Educational Facilities of Respective Children;
10. Health Facility.

SECTION 5. MANDATORY ENROLLMENT TO BACoor CITY 4PS BENEFICIARY DATABASE. All qualified and identified Pantawid ng Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries are hereby mandated to enroll themselves into the Bacoor City 4PS Beneficiary Data Base. The relative City Government Offices or Units, as may be provided for by the implementing rules and regulations, shall facilitate the enrollment of the beneficiaries to the database.

The mandatory enrollment of all qualified and identified Pantawid ng Pamilyang Pilipino Program Beneficiaries is for the following exclusive purposes:

1. To properly identify the personality, legitimacy, and qualification of enrolled beneficiaries;
2. To prevent fraudulent and malicious impersonation of unqualified persons in the database;
3. To avoid and deter the unlawful grant of benefits, grants, and aid to unqualified persons;
4. To distinguish persons who may qualify for benefits, grants, and aid from those who are already qualified and identified.

SECTION 6. THE BACoor CITY 4PS BENEFICIARY ID. All beneficiaries enrolled as mandated in the previous section and as may be provided for in the

implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance shall be issued a Bacoor City 4PS Beneficiary Identification Card.

The purpose of the issuance of the Bacoor City 4PS Beneficiary Identification Cards to qualified beneficiaries is for the following:

- a. To ensure proof of the personality, legitimacy, and qualification, of each beneficiary that is enrolled in the Bacoor City 4PS Beneficiary Database;
- b. To prevent fraudulent and malicious impersonation of unqualified persons or unenrolled persons to the Bacoor City 4PS Database, and the eventual grant of benefits and privileges;
- c. To manage efficiently the provision of grants, benefits, and privileges to qualified and enrolled beneficiaries to the Bacoor City 4PS Database, and their access to services provided for by the City;
- d. To streamline the process of receiving benefits and ensure that the distribution process is organized;
- e. To establish an empirical and quantitative recording of the grants, benefits, and privileges received by each beneficiary that may be recorded through their respective identification card.

The Bacoor City 4PS Beneficiary Identification card shall solely and exclusively be used for the efficient processing of information of the beneficiaries to the programs and projects of the City Government.

SECTION 7. GRANTS, BENEFITS, AND PRIVILEGES. All qualified and enrolled beneficiaries to the Bacoor City 4PS Database and were issued their Bacoor City 4PS Identification Card may enjoy the following privileges from the City Government of Bacoor:

1. Financial aid or assistance;
2. Medical aid or assistance;
3. Educational aid or assistance;
4. Food or nutritional aid or assistance;
5. Access to livelihood opportunities or skills training; and
6. Such other grants, benefits, privileges, aid, or assistance as may be determined by the City Mayor, by the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance, or by some other ordinance.
7. Other programs and projects in partnership with private organizations or institutions.

SECTION 8. DATA PRIVACY. The collection and processing of personal and sensitive personal information directly from beneficiaries as data subjects shall strictly adhere to the provisions and principles of Republic Act No. 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012 and all applicable issuances of the National Privacy Commission.

The beneficiary shall be informed and assured, that their information, prior to collection or processing or enrollment to the database, of the lawful purpose of collection and processing, the identity of personal information controllers or personal information processors that will be given access to their personal data, the purpose of data sharing, the rights of the beneficiaries as data subjects, including the right to access and correction, and the right to object.

The relative City Government Office or Unit as may be determined by the Implementing Rules and Regulations shall use appropriate safeguards to protect the personal data from misuse and unauthorized access or disclosure, including maintaining adequate physical controls, and password protections for any server or system which the

personal data is stored, ensuring that personal data, unless encrypted is not stored on any mobile device, or transmitted electronically, provide that encryption standards shall abide by those prescribed by the National Privacy Commission. The relevant City Government Office or Unit shall undertake measures that are reasonably necessary to prevent any use or disclosure of personal data other than as allowed in this Ordinance.

In all instances, the rights of the beneficiaries as data subjects shall be observed, including the right to access and correction, as well as the right to object where data is shared or processed. However, should the beneficiary object to the enrollment and the disclosure of his or her data, the objecting beneficiary must be informed that the application for his or her benefits may be considered waived or otherwise denied.

SECTION 9. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The City Social Welfare Development Department, the City Health Office, and the Management Information System/ E-Governance Department as lead City Government Office, with the assistance of the Office of the City Legal Service, shall prepare the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. MODIFYING CLAUSE. All ordinances, orders, resolutions, and rules inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CAUSE. Any provision of this Ordinance not declared void or unconstitutional by the proper court of law shall remain valid.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacoor Cavite and posted in at least two (2) conspicuous places in the City of Bacoor.
